Hokies open 2011 baseball season in familiar state

Tech in season openers: Virginia Tech will open its 118th season of baseball with this weekend's trip to Conway, S.C. Tech has posted a 59-56-2 record in season-opening games. The last time a Tech season opener was played at home was in 1995, and in the 15 years since, the Hokies have gone 8-7. The Hokies have won three of their last five season openers, as they dropped a 15-6 decision to Kentucky in last year's Caravelle Resort Tournament first day.

Starting in a familiar place and state: Tech will open its second straight season in the Caravelle Resort Tournament, going 1-2 last year. This will be the fourth time the Hokies are playing in a tournament in this location and are 4-6 all-time.

Not only are the Hokies starting this season in the same location, but, Tech played more games in the state of South Carolina last year than in any other (outside of the 36 in Virginia) with 13 games within the border. Tech went 6-7 during the 2010 season, which included ending its season with a 2-2 mark in the NCAA Regional in Columbia. All-time Tech is 64-73-3 in the state of South Carolina, 16-14 in neutral site games.

The series vs. Indiana: The Hokies and Hoosiers have played just three times in the teams' history, with Tech taking all three. The games were played in DeLand, Fla. during the 1980 season (March 24, 26, & 28). The Hokies outscored Indiana 30-14 in the three games. All-time, Tech is 6-13 against the Big 10 Conference.

The series vs. Tennessee Tech: This will be the first ever meeting between the two schools and this will be only the third meeting ever between Tech and a team from the Ohio Valley Conference. The Hokies twice played a pair of games against Morehead State, winning all four by a combined 60-26 score. March 22-23, 2003, the Hokies played in Morehead, Ky. and March 6-7, 2004, the teams played in Blacksburg.

The series vs. Coastal Carolina: The Hokies and Chanticleers have met six times in the history of the series, which started in 1988. Coastal holds a 5-1 advantage, after taking last year's meeting 13-5. All six games have been played at Coastal's home field, with Tech registering its only win in the series on March 1, 1988 (8-3). The three meetings in 2007 and 2008 were all one-run games, which includes a extra-inning affair. All-time against teams from the Big South Conference, the Hokies hold a 31-14-1 record.

A number of new faces: Thanks in part to a school record eight Hokies selected in the 2010 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft last June (one player decided to return to Blacksburg), Virginia Tech will be starting at least six players with less than 20 starts at their position this season. There are five positions – third base, center field, right field, designated hitter and catcher – that have zero starts at that position as a Hokie, and Tech lost its entire weekend starting rotation (see more on chart below).

Strong Points: On the other hand, the middle infield and its bullpen are the 2011 strengths for Tech, as second baseman **Michael Seaborn** and shortstop **Tim Smalling** have a combined 306 starts in their collegiate careers. **Brandon Fisher**, **Jake Joyce**, **Ronnie Shaban** and **Sean McDermott** combined to pitch almost 70 innings in 52 appearances with a 4-1 record and 60 strikeouts.

Double-Play Duo: Seaborn and Smalling have more in common than just the name on their uniform. They were born on the same day – October 14, 1987 – separated by 745 miles (Smalling in Clifton, N.J. and Seaborn in Atlanta, Ga.). Each started their college days at SEC schools (Arkansas and Kentucky, respectively). The seniors have started at least 150 collegiate games and, last season ranked in the top 15 in assists (Seaborn, ninth, 163 and Smalling, 13th, 152) in the ACC, while turning 49 double plays.

Home Cooking: Of the five ACC teams that received first-place votes in the preseason coaches' poll, all but Miami will be visiting Blacksburg this season, where the Hokies have increased its home-field advantage the last two years. During the 2009 and 2010 seasons, Tech was 42-18 at home and won 17 conference games, more than the prior four years combined (13).

On these dates: Here is what the Hokies have done on these dates in their program's prior 117 seasons in its history.

Feb 18: Tech is 1-2 all-time only win, 16-6 over Campbell in 2006
Feb 19: Tech is 1-2 all-time only win, 5-3 over Tennessee in 2000
Feb 20: Tech is 3-3 all-time wins were over West Virginia (12-2, 2000), Navy (9-0, 2005) and UNC Asheville (21-4, 2008)

Unfortunately, the Hokies have lost their last game played on each of these dates, Feb. 19 and 20 last year, and Feb. 18 to Coastal Carolina (6-5) in 2007.
