Tech begins conference play with three at Miami

Tech opening in the ACC: The Hokies will open their seventh season in the conference with this three-game series at Miami. In the previous six, Tech is 2-4 in ACC opening games, and also 2-4 in ACC series openers. The two series the Hokies won were 2-1 at Georgia Tech in 2007 and, the only time they've opened conference play at home, 2-1 versus Maryland in 2010. Tech was swept at Miami in the 2006 opener. The Hokies only two ACC season-opening wins were at Georgia Tech (5-3, 3/9/07) and at Duke (19-4, 3/6/09). In the second game, Tech has only won once, last year versus the Terrapins (13-4, 3/13). They are 3-3 in the final game of the series openers.

Hokies past century milestones: Senior Michael Seaborn has now started 108 consecutive games at second base. The last time Seaborn was not starting at second was March 22, 2009. He also just passed the 100-RBI plateau, and now has 107, as did shortstop Tim Smalling (111), and junior starter Marc Zecchino went over 100 innings pitched for his career, now with 110. Center fielder Tony Balisteri has now started in 104 games, and is three hits shy of 100. Finally, Ronnie Shaban is eight runs scored shy of reaching 100. (More countdown information can be found on page 5.)

Power surge: Virginia Tech opened its 118th season of baseball at home in firework fashion. In the bottom of the first, Balisteri and Smalling hit back-to-back home runs and after Seaborn drew a walk, **Andrew Rash** belted a two-run shot. In all, they blasted seven home runs in the game - a 17-9 victory over Niagara - and 13 in the four-game series. Three weeks into the season, Tech's seven in that game still leads seven ACC teams overall output and its 20 total is six more than Florida State's 14. Rash leads the conference with six home runs, which is also better than six ACC teams, while Balisteri and Smalling are all tied for third in the league with three home runs. (More information on the Hokies rankings in the ACC can be found on page 7.)

The series vs. Miami: Tech is 4-14 all-time against the Hurricanes, which includes a 1-5 record on the road. However, in the last eight, the Hokies are 4-4 and includes their only win in Coral Gables - 7-4 on April 25, 2009. All-time in the state of Florida, the Hokies are 46-81, but are just 12-48 as the visitor. They are 4-9 under Coach Hughes.

A number of new faces: Thanks to a school record eight Hokies selected in the 2010 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft last June (one player decided to return to Blacksburg), Virginia Tech started six players with less than 20 starts at their position in the season opener. Five positions – third base, center field, right field, designated hitter and catcher – had zero starts at their position as a Hokie in 2010, and Tech had lost its entire weekend starting rotation. Despite the challenges that faced the team on opening weekend, Tech posted a 3-1 start to their season, bettering last year's 2-2 start. Through 14 games, the Hokies are 10-4, equalling last year's mark 14 games into the season.

Double-Play Duo: Second baseman **Michael Seaborn** and shortstop **Tim Smalling** have more in common than just the name on their uniform. They were born on the same day – October 14, 1987 – separated by 745 miles (Smalling in Clifton, N.J. and Seaborn in Atlanta, Ga.). Each started their college days at SEC schools (Arkansas and Kentucky, respectively). The seniors have started more than 160 collegiate games and, last season ranked in the top 15 in assists (Seaborn, ninth, 163 and Smalling, 13th, 152) in the ACC, while turning 49 double plays.

Home Cooking: Of the five ACC teams that received first-place votes in the preseason coaches' poll, all but Miami will be visiting Blacksburg this season, where the Hokies have increased its home-field advantage the last two years. During the 2009 and 2010 seasons, Tech was 42-18 at home and won 17 conference games, more than the prior four years combined (13).

Using all three outs: The Hokies have scored 118 runs so far through 14 games, and 43 of those (36.4%) have been with two outs. Players have driven in 40, with **Tim Smalling** and **Andrew Rash** leading the way with 11 two-out RBI each. Tech has twice scored on wild pitches with two, and the other was on a two-out error.

Putting runs on the scoreboard: Through 14 games, Tech has now scored at least 10 runs six times, and it comes as no surprise they are 6-0 such games. Through the same period last year, they also had six double-figure run scoring games.

Meanwhile, Tech has not been shutout this season and has gone 52 games since its was last held scoreless, a 5-0 loss to Wake Forest (3/27/10-G1).

Give me two: Tech has now turned 15 double plays in 14 games, more than one per game. Seven pitchers have been on the mound for the twin killings, with four pitchers having benefitted from three each - Eddie Campbell, Joe Mantiply, Manny Martir and Joe Parsons. With one each are Jake Atwell, Patrick Scoggin and Marc Zecchino.

double play.

Stay there: So far this season, Hokie pitchers have inherited 13 runners, with five of them scoring. Sean McDermott and Jake Joyce have each inherited two and neither have scored.


