Tech plays third ACC weekend looking for wins

Team power surge: Virginia Tech opened its 118th season of baseball at home in firework fashion. In the bottom of the first, **Tony Balisteri** and **Tim Smalling** hit back-to-back home runs and after **Michael Seaborn** drew a walk, **Andrew Rash** belted a two-run shot. In all, they blasted seven home runs in the game and 13 in the four-game series. Five weeks into the season, Tech's seven in that game still leads five ACC teams' overall output this season and its 28 total is nine more than Florida State's 19.

More on the power: The Hokies are 4-1 when Rash hits a home run (seven in five games), while Tech is 4-0 when teammate Smalling (five in four games) hits one out. Rash leads the ACC with those seven home runs and is also first in slugging percentage (.778). (More information on ACC rankings can be found on page 7.)

The Tech Ironman: Senior Seaborn has now started 117 consecutive games at second base. The last time Seaborn was not starting at second was March 22, 2009.

Getting to the bullpen: In the last four games, Tech's starting pitcher's combined ERA is 12.00 opposed to 4.56, while the Hokies' bullpen is 2.45 and their opponents is 7.15. The numbers are somewhat similar the Tech's numbers all season.

The series vs. Boston College: Tech is 11-12 (47.8%) against the Eagles, 2-7 in Chestnut Hill (but this series is in Kingston, R.I.). Last year, the Hokies swept BC out of Blacksburg 9-4, 3-1, and 10-5. However, the last time they were at BC, the Eagles took two of three in 2007. Tech has been shutout twice by the Eagles (5/16/04, 3-0; 5/12/02, 2-0) with both in Massachusetts. Overall, the teams scoring differential is 90-88 in favor of BC.

The series at Rhode Island: For only the second time in the school's history, the Hokies will play in the state of Rhode Island. They last played in 1997, taking the Atlantic 10 series against the Rams, 2-1, April 5-6. They split a doubleheader on Saturday, losing game one, 10-2, before taking game two, 16-5. The Hokies won on Sunday, 9-8.

A number of new faces: Thanks to a school record eight Hokies selected in the 2010 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft last June (one player decided to return to Blacksburg), Virginia Tech started six players with less than 20 starts at their position in the season opener. Five positions – third base, center field, right field, designated hitter and catcher – had zero starts at their position as a Hokie in 2010, and Tech had lost its entire weekend starting rotation. Despite the challenges that faced the team on opening weekend, Tech posted a 3-1 start to their season, bettering last year's 2-2 start. Through 19 games, the Hokies are 13-10, two wins shy of last year's 15-8 mark 23 games in.

Double-Play Duo: Second baseman **Michael Seaborn** and shortstop **Tim Smalling** have more in common than just the name on their uniform. They were born on the same day – October 14, 1987 – separated by 745 miles (Smalling in Clifton, N.J. and Seaborn in Atlanta, Ga.). Each started their college days at SEC schools (Arkansas and Kentucky, respectively). The seniors have each started at least 170 collegiate games and, last season ranked in the top 15 in assists (Seaborn, ninth, 163 and Smalling, 13th, 152) in the ACC, while turning 49 double plays.

Happy Birthday times three: Seaborn and Smalling are not the only teammates to share a birthday, two other pairs do as well. Ironically, they are one day apart.

Home Cooking: Of the five ACC teams that received first-place votes in the preseason coaches' poll, all but Miami will be visiting Blacksburg this season, where the Hokies have increased its home-field advantage the last two years. During the 2009 and 2010 seasons, Tech was 42-18 at home and won 17 conference games, more than the prior four years combined (13). However, they started 0-3 against those five opponents.

Using all three outs: The Hokies have scored 165 runs so far through 23 games, and 72 of those (43.6%) have been with two outs. Players have driven in 67, with **Tim Smalling** (14) and **Andrew Rash** (13) leading the way. With two outs, Tech has scored on wild pitches twice, on passed balls once, and two times runs came in on two-out errors.

Putting runs on the scoreboard: Through 23 games, Tech has now scored at least 10 runs eight times, and they are 8-0 when they do, 0-2 when its opponent hits double figures.

Meanwhile, Tech is 3-0 in shutouts this season. They have not been shutout in 61 straight games. The Hokies were last held without a run in a 5-0 loss to Wake Forest (3/27/10-G1).

Gimme two: Tech has now turned 24 double plays in 23 games, more than one per contest. Nine pitchers have been on the mound for the twin killings, with five pitchers benefitting from at least three each - **Manny Martir** (5), **Eddie Campbell** (4), **Joe Mantiply** (3), **Joe Parsons** (3) and **Marc Zechino** (3). With two each are **Jake Atwell** and **Patrick Scoggin**, while **Sean McDermott** and **Brandon Fisher** each have one.

Atwell, Campbell and Parsons each have a strikeout-caught stealing double play.
