Hokies face one of nation's best this weekend

Team power: Virginia Tech opened its 118th season of baseball at home in firework fashion. In the bottom of the first, **Tony Balisteri** and **Tim Smalling** hit back-to-back home runs and after **Michael Seaborn** drew a walk, **Andrew Rash** belted a two-run shot. In all, they blasted seven home runs in the game and 13 in the four-game series. The 29 round trippers leads the ACC, by five over Florida State, and is sixth in the nation.

More on the power: The Hokies are 4-2 when Rash hits a home run (eight in six games), while Tech is 4-0 when teammate Smalling (five in four games) hits one out. Rash leads the ACC with those eight home runs and is also first in slugging percentage (.767). (More information on ACC rankings can be found on page 7.)

The Tech Ironman: Senior Seaborn has now started 121 consecutive games at second base. The last time Seaborn was not starting at second was March 22, 2009.

Getting to the bullpen: Facing some unusual pitching last week - eight relievers on Friday and one reliever that went seven frames on Saturday - the Hokie numbers are still in favor of the bullpen over starters for pitching and facing. Tech scored five runs off BC starter John Leonard on Sunday, but have only scored 16 runs total off starters this year in ACC action (see next note).

Tech success at home: Since 1989, when the Hokies began playing at English Field, they are 18-5 all-time in home openers including its 17-9 win over Niagara to open this year. Tech is 375-191-3 in 23 seasons at English Field and had won 58 games at home over the past three seasons, just under 20 per season. They have eight already this year.

The series: Tech is 77-85-1 (47.5%) versus Virginia, 40-28 (58.8%) at home, including taking 2-of-3 in Blacksburg in 2009. They are 3-3 in the last six, including an 8-5 win over No. 1 Virginia last year, but are just 3-13 since joining the ACC. The run differential in the 163 game-series that started back in 1900 is 986-972 in favor of Virginia.

Scoring Early: Tech has scored just two first-inning runs in ACC play, and both were last weekend at Boston College. **Tony Balisteri** scored both, on Saturday and Sunday. Needless to say, the Hokies have led only three times in ACC games, for a half-inning versus North Carolina (3/20) in the bottom of the second, for four frames at Boston College (3/26) and for the entire game against the Eagles (3/27).

Scoring Late: In their nine ACC games, the Hokies have scored 29 runs, with almost half coming in the late innings (14). They have plated three in the seventh, none in the eighth, and have pushed 11 across the plate in the ninth.

Scoring Period: Tech is now 0-7 in one-run games, 0-4 in the ACC. They finished the 2010 season 5-1 in one-run games, 2-0 in the conference. The Hokies are also just 2-3 in two-run games, 0-2 in the ACC. They were 5-4 overall last year and 4-3 in the conference.

Double-Play Duo: Second baseman **Michael Seaborn** and shortstop **Tim Smalling** have more in common than just the name on their uniform. They were born on the same day – October 14, 1987 – separated by 745 miles (Smalling in Clifton, N.J. and Seaborn in Atlanta, Ga.). Each started their college days at SEC schools (Arkansas and Kentucky, respectively). The seniors have each started at least 180 collegiate games and, last season ranked in the top 15 in assists (Seaborn, ninth, 163 and Smalling, 13th, 152) in the ACC, while turning 49 double plays.

Happy Birthday times three: Seaborn and Smalling are not the only teammates to share a birthday, two other pairs do as well. Ironically, they are one day apart.

Feb. 20 - Marc Zecchino (1989) and Devin Burke (1991)

Feb. 21 - Chad Morgan (1991) and Patrick Scoggin (1991).

Home Cooking: Of the five ACC teams that received first-place votes in the preseason coaches' poll, all but Miami will be visiting Blacksburg this season, where the Hokies have increased its home-field advantage the last two years. During the 2009 and 2010 seasons, Tech was 42-18 at home and won 17 conference games, more than the prior four years combined (13). However, they started 0-3 against those five opponents.

Facing nationally ranked teams: It has been the practice of Virginia Tech to use *Baseball America's* national rankings when it comes to baseball. So even though Virginia is ranked No. 1 in a pair of polls, this series constitutes playing a No. 2 team. Under Coach Hughes, Tech has never faced a No. 2 ranked team, but is 8-24 all-time against teams ranked in the top five, which includes a 2-9 record against No. 1 teams.

Using all three outs: The Hokies have scored 182 runs through 27 games, and 79 of those (43.4%) have been with two outs. Players have driven in 72, with **Tim Smalling** (15), **Andrew Rash** (13), and **Chad Morgan** (11) in double figures. With two outs, Tech has scored on wild pitches twice, on passed balls once, and four runs crossed the plate on two-out errors.

Putting runs on the scoreboard: Through 27 games, Tech has now scored at least 10 runs eight times, and they are 8-0 when they do, 0-2 when its opponent hits double figures.

Meanwhile, Tech is 3-0 in shutouts this season. They have not been shutout in 65 straight games. The Hokies were last held without a run in a 5-0 loss to Wake Forest (3/27/10-G1).

Gimme two: Tech has now turned 26 double plays in 27 games, which ranks first in the ACC and 18th in the nation.

Nine pitchers have been on the mound for the twin killings, with five pitchers benefitting from at least three each - **Manny Martir** (5), **Marc Zechino** (5), **Eddie Campbell** (4), **Joe Mantiply** (3) and **Joe Parsons** (3). With two each are **Jake Atwell** and **Patrick Scoggin**, while **Sean McDermott** and **Brandon Fisher** each have one.

Atwell, Campbell and Parsons each have a strikeout-caught stealing double play.

Getting help from the outfield: The Hokies have just four outfield assists in 2011, however all four have come during conference play and all four have been on the road. **Andrew Rash** had one in two of the games at Miami (3/12 & 3/13), while **Jake Atwell** (3/25) and **Tony Balisteri** (3/26) each had one at Boston College.
