Tech takes on #11 Seminoles in key ACC series

Team power: Virginia Tech opened its 118th season of baseball at home in firework fashion. In the bottom of the first, **Tony Balisteri** and **Tim Smalling** hit back-to-back home runs and after **Michael Seaborn** drew a walk, **Andrew Rash** belted a two-run shot. In all, they blasted seven home runs in the game and 13 in the four-game series. The 43 overall home runs the Hokies have hit leads the ACC, by 12 over Wake Forest, and was fifth in the nation entering the week.

More on the power: Rash leads the ACC with 11 home runs and with a .708 slugging percentage. Those numbers put him sixth and 13th respectively in the nation entering the week. (More information on rankings can be found on page 7.) Smalling is tied for second in home runs (7) and was 111th in the country. Tech is 5-0 when he hits one out.

Last thing on the power: Of the 43 home runs hit by the Hokies this season, more than half have been solo (24), while 10 of those have been lead-off shots. Twelve have been hit with one man on, and seven have been hit with two on board. In all, Tech has recorded 219 RBI, 69 on home runs (31.5%).

Hot Hokies: Over the last five games, Tech is 4-1 and that might have something to do with a switch at the top of the line-up, as Jake Atwell was inserted into the lead-off spot, as he has 11 hits (.423), eight runs and six RBI in the span. Other notable efforts over the last five games include: Smalling, five straight multi-hit games, 14 hits, a .609 average, 25 total bases (3 2Bs, 3B, 2 HRs for a 1.087 Slug%), six runs and eight RBI; Balisteri, four multi-hit games in the stretch with a .391 average, five runs and five RBI; Gabe Ortiz, seven hits (4 2Bs) and five runs in four games; Seaborn, eight runs and a .364 average; and Ronnie Shaban, nine RBI in the last five contests.

The Tech Ironman: Seaborn has now started 129 consecutive games at second base. The last time Seaborn was not starting at second was March 22, 2009.

The series: Tech is 7-35 against Florida State, with a 3-15 mark in the ACC. The Hokies did win their first series over the Seminoles by winning a pair of games last year in Tallahassee. Tech is just 1-7 at English Field, but it was a big one, as they knocked off No. 1 FSU, 9-7 on March 18, 2006. They are 0-6 when the game has been televised.

Double-Play Duo: Second baseman **Michael Seaborn** and shortstop **Tim Smalling** have more in common than just the name on their uniform. They were born on the same day – October 14, 1987 – separated by 745 miles (Smalling in Clifton, N.J. and Seaborn in Atlanta, Ga.). Each started their college days at SEC schools (Arkansas and Kentucky, respectively). The seniors have each started at least 185 collegiate games and, last season ranked in the top 15 in assists (Seaborn, ninth, 163 and Smalling, 13th, 152) in the ACC, while turning 49 double plays.

In need of support: Starting pitchers Joe Mantiply and Marc Zecchino enter last weekend with 0-4 records in ACC contests, despite pitching well enough to earn a win in at least a pair of starts. Mantiply allowed just one earned run over five innings in a 3-1 loss at Miami (3/11) and dropped a 5-3 game at Boston College (3/25). In each, while he was on the mound, the Hokies scored zero runs. Meanwhile, Zecchino had gone five frames in each of his starts (22.1 IP total) and had received just one run of support while on the mound. He suffered three one-run losses - 2-1 at Miami (3/12) and Boston College (3/26), and 5-4 to North Carolina (3/19). Last week at Wake Forest, Mantiply got four runs before he was done (6 IP), while Zecchino benefitted from 10 in seven.

Scoring Early: Tech has scored just four first-inning runs in ACC play. Needless to say, the Hokies had only led four times (15 total innings) in 12 ACC games before last weekend - a half-inning versus North Carolina (3/20) in the bottom of the second, four frames at Boston College (3/26), the entire game against the Eagles (3/27), in their first ACC victory, and an inning and a half against Virginia (4/1). At Wake Forest, the Hokies led for 16.5 innings and took two of the three games.

Scoring Late: In their 15 ACC games, the Hokies have scored 60 runs, with almost half coming in the last three frames (29). They have plated seven in the seventh, seven in the eighth, and 14 in the ninth. They also scored seven in the fifth and sixth.

Scoring Period: Tech is now 0-7 in one-run games, 0-4 in the ACC. They finished the 2010 season 5-1 in one-run games, 2-0 in the conference. The Hokies are also just 2-4 in two-run games, 0-3 in the ACC. They were 5-4 overall last year and 4-3 in the conference.

Facing nationally ranked teams: It has been the practice of Virginia Tech to use Baseball America's national rankings when it comes to baseball. Under Coach Hughes, Tech has faced a No. 11 ranked team just once in a three-game series - at Miami in 2009. They went 1-2, taking the middle game of the series, a game that was televised on CSS.

Home Cooking?: Of the five ACC teams that received first-place votes in the preseason coaches' poll, all but Miami visit Blacksburg this season, where the Hokies had increased its home-field advantage the last two years. During the 2009 and 2010 seasons, Tech was 42-18 at home and won 17 conference games, more than the prior four years combined (13). However, they started 0-6 against those five opponents (UNC and Virginia). Tech is 375-194-3 in 23 seasons at English Field and won 58 games at home over the past three seasons. They have eight this year and have lost their last seven.

Using all three outs: The Hokies have scored 237 runs and 108 of those (45.6%) have been with two outs. Players have driven in 95, with Tim Smalling (19), Andrew Rash (15), and **Chad Morgan** (12) leading the way. With two outs, Tech has scored on wild pitches three times, on passed balls twice, and eight runs crossed the plate on two-out errors.

Putting runs on the scoreboard: Tech has scored at least 10 runs 11 times, and they are 11-0 when they do, 0-4 when its opponent hits double figures.

Meanwhile, Tech is 3-0 in shutouts this season. They have not been shutout in 73 straight games. The Hokies were last held without a run in a 5-0 loss to Wake Forest (3/27/10-G1).

Gimme two: Tech has now turned 32 double plays, which ranks tied for first in the ACC and was 48th in the nation entering the week.

Ten pitchers have been on the mound for the twin killings, with five pitchers benefitting from at least three each - Manny Martir (8), Marc Zecchino (6), Eddie Campbell (4), Joe Mantiply (4) and Joe Parsons (3). With two each are Jake Atwell and Patrick Scoggin , while Brandon Fisher, Sean McDermott and Ronnie Shaban each have one.

Atwell, Campbell and Parsons each have a strikeout-caught stealing double play.

Getting help from the outfield: Tech has five outfield assists in 2011, and all have come during conference play and have all been on the road. Rash had one in two games at Miami (3/12 & 3/13), while Jake Atwell (3/25) and Tony Balisteri (3/26) each had one at Boston College. Balisteri notched a second at Wake Forest (4/1) on a double play.
