Tech looks to continue road success in Durham

Success on the road: After dropping its first ACC series at Miami, Tech was gone 10-3 overall in its last 13 road games, 6-3 in conference, and have won 9-of-10. The Hokies are averaging 8.6 runs per contest in the stretch, while limiting its opposition to just 3.7 runs a game. Overall Tech's 12 wins on the road is the most since 2009 (13) and before that was the 16 won in 2003. Their 14 wins away from Blacksburg is tied with the 2009 squad (14, includes regular-season neutral wins). Both the 2003 and 2000 teams had 16 wins away from Tech, the most of any team since the turn of the century.

Team power: The Hokies have hit 53 home runs this season, which leads the ACC by 13 over Wake Forest, and was fifth in the nation entering the week. Tech was also second in the nation entering the week in doubles with 104 and 10th in triples at 20, which they increased to 23 with three in Tuesday's win. Overall, Tech's slugging percentage of .498 entering the week was third in the nation.

More on the power: Andrew Rash leads the ACC with 16 home runs, 116 total bases and a .795 slugging percentage. Those numbers put him third, fourth and fifth respectively in the nation entering the week. (More information on rankings can be found on page 7.) Tim Smalling is second in the conference in home runs (9) and total bases (103), which is 39th and 31st in the country.

Last thing on the power: Of the 53 home runs hit by the Hokies this season, more than half have been solo (29), while 13 of those have been lead-off shots. Sixteen have been hit with one man on, eight have been hit with two on board, and Ronnie Shaban hit the team's first grand slam versus Florida State (4/16). In all, Tech has recorded 285 RBI, 86 on home runs (30.2%).

More national numbers: Entering the week, Michael Seaborn was 11th in the nation in runs, 47th in doubles and 16th in sacrifice flies, Shaban was 49th in triples and 15th in RBI, Rash was 28th in doubles and 34th in RBI, Johnny Morales was 15th in sacrifice bunts, and Marc Zecchino was 26th in strikeouts and 18th in Ks per nine innings.

The Tech Ironman: Seaborn has now started 137 consecutive games at second base. The last time Seaborn was not starting at second was March 22, 2009.

The series: Tech is 18-24 against the Blue Devils all-time, 8-10 in ACC games, and 9-16 at Duke - 4-5 during ACC play - and are 5-7 overall under Coach Pete Hughes.

Double-Play Duo: Second baseman **Michael Seaborn** and shortstop **Tim Smalling** have more in common than just the name on their uniform. They were born on the same day - October 14, 1987 - separated by 745 miles (Smalling in Clifton, N.J. and Seaborn in Atlanta, Ga.). Each started their college days at SEC schools (Arkansas and Kentucky, respectively). The seniors have each started at least 190 collegiate games and, last season ranked in the top 15 in assists (Seaborn, ninth, 163 and Smalling, 13th, 152) in the ACC, while turning 49 double plays.

200-Hit Club: With all those games played, it should come as no surprise that both Smalling and Seaborn have each reached the 200-hit milestone this season. Smalling registered his 200th hit in Lynchburg, Va., blasting a solo home run against Liberty (3/22) in the fourth inning. Seaborn picked up his 200th hit last weekend in a home series against Florida State (4/17), with an RBI double in the third. Ironically, hit #201 for Seaborn was a fourth-inning two-run home run.

Impressive numbers: Just a junior, **Ronnie Shaban** is already putting up impressive number in just under three full seasons as a Hokie. He is just nine hits shy of joining the 200-hit club, but more impressive are his 52 career doubles, which is just two shy of tying **Marc Tugwell** (2000-03) for fifth on the Tech all-time career list. Also (according to research by Ben Warnick, Marshall SID), he is one of 40 in the nation with more than 150 career RBI (153). Lastly, in the field, the first baseman has not committed an error all season (while at first) in 357 chances. He committed two while on the mound.

Speaking of the record books: The numbers Andrew Rash is putting up this season have not been seen at Tech in more than a decade with his 16 home runs and .795 slugging percentage. The last man to hit more than 15 home runs in a single season was Kevin Barker during the 1996 season in which he hit 20 (and had 160 total bases for a .792 slugging percentage). The last Hokie to hit the season with at least a .700 slugging percentage was Larry Bowles in 1999, as he finished right at .700% (147 total bases in 210 at-bats).

Offensive Coming Alive: Over the last 13 games, Tech is 10-3 and has reached double figures in hits 12 times including seven straight. The Hokies have also hit a home run in 13 of their last 15 games. They are averaging 9.3 runs per game in the span and are batting .348, while their opponents at hitting just .282 and scoring 5.5 runs.

Winning the dose ones: Tech won its first one-run game with a 2-1 victory over #11 Florida State (4/15), but was winless in their prior seven, 0-4 in the ACC. They are now 2-7 after a 5-4 victory Tuesday against NC A&T. They finished the 2010 season 5-1 in one-run games, 2-0 in the conference. The Hokies are also just 2-4 in two-run games, 0-3 in the ACC. They were 5-4 overall last year and 4-3 in the conference.

Driving Tech to wins: Known as "Big Ron", Tech is now 12-2 this season when the Abbott bus driver has driven the Hokies to the game-day site. The only two losses were both on walk-off home runs - 6-5 at Coastal Carolina (2/20) and 5-3 at Wake Forest (4/10).

Using all three outs: The Hokies have scored 311 runs and 136 of those (43.7%) have been with two outs. Players have driven in 118, with **Tim Smalling** (23), **Ronnie Shaban** (17) and **Andrew Rash** (16) leading the way. With two outs, Tech has scored on wild pitches six times, on passed balls twice, and 10 runs crossed the plate on two-out errors.

Putting runs on the scoreboard: Tech has scored 10+ runs 16 times, and was 11-0 in those games before the FSU series. They are now 14-2, but 0-6 when their opponent scores 10+.

Meanwhile, Tech is 3-0 in shutouts this season. They have not been shutout in 81 straight games. The Hokies were last held without a run in a 5-0 loss to Wake Forest (3/27/10-G1).
