Hokies face JMU in non-conference weekend

Tech success at home: Since 1989, when the Hokies began playing at English Field, they are 18-5 all-time in home openers including its 17-9 win over Niagara to open this year. Tech is 378-19-3 in 23 seasons at English Field and had won 58 games at home over the past three seasons, just under 20 per season. They have 11 this year, but finish the regular season with a 10-game home stand (now with nine more left).

Team power: The Hokies have hit 57 home runs this season, which leads the ACC by 17, over Wake Forest, and was fifth in the nation entering the week. Tech was also third in the country in doubles (112), fourth in triples (24), and fifth in slugging & (.494).

More on the power: **Andrew Rash** leads the ACC with 17 home runs, 125 total bases and a .776 slugging %. Those numbers put him fourth, sixth and 10th respectively in the nation entering the week. (More information on rankings can be found on page 7.) **Tim Smalling** is second in the conference in home runs (9) and total bases (108), which is 53rd and 34th in the country.

Last thing on the power: Of the 57 home runs hit by the Hokies this season, more than half have been solo (30), while 13 of those have been lead-off shots. There have been 19 hit with one man on, eight have been hit with two on board, and **Ronnie Shaban** hit the team's first grand slam versus Florida State (4/16). In all, Tech has recorded 303 RBI, 93 on home runs (30.7%).

More national numbers: Entering the week, **Michael Seaborn** was 25th in the nation in runs, 84th in doubles and 19th in sacrifice flies, **Shaban** was 58th in triples and 33rd in RBI, **Rash** was 55th in doubles and 39th in RBI, **Johnny Morales** was 25th in sacrifice bunts, and **Marc Zecchino** was 30th in strikeouts and 18th in Ks per nine innings.

The Tech Ironman: **Seaborn** has now started 141 consecutive games at second base. The last time Seaborn was not starting at second was March 22, 2009.

Offensive coming alive: Over the last 17 games, Tech is 13-4 (8-4 in the ACC) and has reached double figures in hits 13 times (in the three-game series at Duke they had nine hits in each game). The Hokies have also hit a home run in 15 of their last 19 games. They are averaging 8.5 runs per game in the span and are batting .330, while their opponents at hitting just .276 and scoring 4.9 runs a game.

The series: Tech is 23-31 against the Dukes all-time and are 11-14 in Blacksburg. The teams last met in 2009 for a home-and-home and the Hokies took both including a 13-9 decision at English Field to extend their win streak to three straight over JMU.

Double-Play Duo: Second baseman **Michael Seaborn** and shortstop **Tim Smalling** have more in common than just the name on their uniform. They were born on the same day - October 14, 1987 - separated by 745 miles (Smalling in Clifton, N.J. and Seaborn in Atlanta, Ga.). Each started their college days at SEC schools (Arkansas and Kentucky, respectively). They have each started (after this weekend) 200 collegiate games and, last year ranked in the top 15 in assists (Seaborn, ninth, 163 and Smalling, 13th, 152) in the ACC, while turning 49 double plays. This year Smalling is third (133), Seaborn fourth (132) in assists and have already matched last year's double play mark.

200-Hit Club: With all those games played, it should come as no surprise that both Smalling and Seaborn have each reached the 200-hit milestone this season. Smalling registered his 200th hit in Lynchburg, Va., blasting a solo home run against Liberty (3/22) in the fourth inning. Seaborn picked up his 200th hit last weekend in a home series against Florida State (4/17), with an RBI double in the third. Ironically, hit #201 for Seaborn was a fourth-inning two-run home run.

Impressive numbers: Just a junior, **Ronnie Shaban** is already putting up impressive numbers in just under three full seasons. He is just three hits shy of joining the 200-hit club - only five Hokies have reached the plateau before their senior year (box right). More impressive could be his 54 career doubles, which just tied **Marc Tugwell** (2000-03) for fifth on the Tech all-time career list. Also (according to research by Ben Warnick, Marshall SID), he is one of 50 in the nation with more than 150 career RBI (153). Lastly, in the field, the first baseman has not committed an error all season (while at first) in 357 chances. He committed two while on the mound.

More on that research: Smalling is just 18 hits shy of 250 for his career and 19 total bases shy of 400 and, according to Warnick's numbers, there are only 27 active players in the nation with 250 hits and 30 with 400.

Speaking of the record books: The numbers **Andrew Rash** is putting up this season have not been seen at Tech in more than a decade - 17 HRs, .776 slugging %, 125 TBs. The last man to hit more than 14 home runs in a single season (before this year) was Kevin Barker in 1996, when he hit 20 with 160 total bases for a .792 slugging %. The last Hokie to finish a season with at least a .700 slugging % was Larry Bowles in 1999, finishing right at .700 (147 total bases in 210 at-bats).

Winning the dose ones: Tech won its first one-run game with a 2-1 victory over #11 Florida State (4/15), but was winless in their prior seven, 0-4 in the ACC. They are now 3-8 overall and 2-5 in the ACC. They finished the 2010 season 5-1 in one-run games, 2-0 in the conference. The Hokies are 3-4 in two-run games, 0-3 in the ACC. They were 5-4 overall last year and 4-3 in the conference.

Driving Tech to wins: Known as "Big Ron", Tech finished its regular season 14-3 when the Abbott bus driver drove the Hokies to the game-day site. Two losses were on walk-off home runs - 6-5 at Coastal Carolina (2/20) and 5-3 at Wake Forest (4/10) - the other was a 3-2 loss at Duke, in which the winning run was scored in the eighth.

Using all three outs: The Hokies have scored 334 runs and 145 of those (43.4%) have been with two outs. Players have driven in 126, with **Tim Smalling** (23), **Andrew Rash** (20) and **Ronnie Shaban** (17) leading the way. With two outs, Tech has scored on wild pitches six times, on passed balls twice, and 11 runs crossed the plate on two-out errors.

With four is **Patrick Scoggin**, **Jake Atwell** has three, **Sean McDermott** two and **Kyle Cichy**, **Brandon Fisher** and **Ronnie Shaban** each have one.

Atwell, Campbell and Parsons each have a strikeout-caught stealing double play.
