Hokies finish regular season with #12 Georgia Tech

Tech success at home: Since 1989, when the Hokies began playing at English Field, they are 18-5 all-time in home openers including its 17-9 win over Niagara to open this year. Tech is 380-199-3 in 23 seasons at English Field and had won 58 games at home over the past three seasons, just under 20 per season. They have 13 this year and will finish the regular season with a three-game set with Georgia Tech this weekend.

Team power: The Hokies have hit 58 home runs this season, which leads the ACC by 10 over Florida State, and was fifth in the nation entering the week. Tech was also second in the country in doubles (128), fifth in triples (25) and sixth in slugging (.487).

Individual power: Andrew Rash leads the ACC with 17 home runs, 127 total bases and a .713 slugging percentage. Those numbers put him seventh, 29th and 13th respectively in the nation entering the week. Tim Smalling is tied for fourth in the conference in home runs (9) and tied for second in total bases (115), which is 87th and 69th in the country.

Home run breakdown: Of the 58 home runs hit by the Hokies this season, more than half have been solo (31), while 13 of those have been to lead off an inning. There have been 19 hit with one man on, eight have been hit with two on board, and Ronnie Shaban hit the team's first grand slam versus Florida State (4/16). In all, Tech has recorded 322 RBI, 94 on home runs (29.2%).

More national numbers: Entering the week, Michael Seaborn was 56th in the nation in runs, 25th in doubles and 36th in sacrifice flies, Shaban, Smalling and Chad Pinder were 85th in triples, Rash and Shaban were 65th in RBI, Johnny Morales was 23rd in sacrifice bunts, Joe Parsons was 84th in wins, and Marc Zecchino was 28th in strikeouts and 21st in Ks per nine innings. (More information on rankings can be found on page nine).

The Tech Ironman: Seaborn has now started 146 consecutive games at second base. The last time Seaborn was not starting at second was March 22, 2009.

The series: Tech is 9-16 all-time against the Yellow Jackets, 2-4 at English Field. In the last six games with Georgia Tech, the Hokies are 4-2 which includes a 2-1 mark in last year's series in Atlanta, Ga. and a 6-2 victory in the 2010 ACC Tournament in Greensboro, N.C. on May 27.

WEEKEND #14 GAME NOTES

Facing nationally ranked teams: It has been the practice of Virginia Tech to use Baseball America's national rankings when it comes to baseball. Under Coach Hughes, Tech has faced a No. 12 ranked team once (at Coastal Carolina, 13-5 loss, 2/20/10). The Hokies are 2-10 against ranked foes this year (more on page 5).

Home Cooking?: Of the five ACC teams that received first-place votes in the preseason coaches' poll, all but Miami visit Blacksburg this season, where the Hokies had increased its home-field advantage the last two years. During the 2009 and 2010 seasons, Tech was 42-18 at home and won 17 conference games, more than the prior four years combined (13). However, they started 0-6 against those five opponents (UNC and Virginia) and are 2-10 overall (Ironically, they were all ranked teams).

Double-Play Duo: Second baseman **Michael Seaborn** and shortstop **Tim Smalling** have more in common than just the name on their uniform. They were born on the same day – October 14, 1987 – separated by 745 miles (Smalling in Clifton, N.J. and Seaborn in Atlanta, Ga.). Each started their college days at SEC schools (Arkansas and Kentucky, respectively). They have each started 200 collegiate games and, last year ranked in the top 15 in assists (Seaborn, ninth, 163 and Smalling, 13th, 152) in the ACC, while turning 49 double plays. This year, Seaborn third (152) and Smalling fourth (146) in assists and have already helped turn 55 double plays this year.

200-Hit Club: With all those games played, it should come as no surprise that both **Smalling** and **Seaborn** have each reached the 200-hit milestone this year. Smalling registered his 200th hit in Lynchburg, Va., blasting a solo home run against Liberty (3/22) in the fourth. Seaborn picked up his 200th hit in a home series against Florida State (4/17), with an RBI double in the third. Ironically, hit #201 for Seaborn was a fourth-inning two-run home run. **Ronnie Shaban** is closing in - just one hit shy (see next note) - and would give the Hokies three players with 200 hits for the first time since Brian Rupe, Jim Stewart and Jimmy Foit each passed the 200-hit milestone in 1982.

Impressive numbers: Just a junior, Shaban is already putting up impressive numbers in just under three full seasons. If he joins the 200-hit club, he becomes just the sixth Hokie to reach the plateau before their senior year (box below). More impressive could be his 54 career doubles, which is tied with Marc Tugwell (2000 Player (Years) Hits 03) for fifth on the Tech all-time career list. Also (according Austin Wates (2008-10) George Canale (1984-86) 231 to research by Ben Warnick, Marshall SID), he is one of 56 Addison Bowman (1998-00) 229 in the nation with more than 150 career RBI (155). Lastly, Trey McCoy (1986-88) 213 in the field, the first baseman has not committed an error Brad Bauder (2000-02 204 all season (while at first) in 442 chances. He committed two Ronnie Shaban (2009-11) 199 while on the mound.

More on that research: Smalling is just 13 hits shy of 250 for his career and 12 total bases shy of 400 and, according to Warnick's numbers, there are only 31 active players in the nation with 250 hits and 33 with 400.





Success on the mound: Since the Virginia series, Tech has gotten strong pitching performances and two are definitely worth noting. Over his last six starts, Joe Mantiply is 3-2 with a 2.87 ERA in 37.2 innings. He has allowed just 12 earned runs and struck out 33 batters in that time. He had won three straight ACC starts and was a 3-2 loss at Duke (4/29) shy of matching Justin Wright (2009) as the only two Hokies to win four straight starts in the ACC.

Ironically, Joe Parsons, who sports a 2.04 ERA over his last 35.1 innings, has won his last three ACC starts. He has allowed just eight earned runs in that span with 25 strikeouts. His outings include Tech's only complete game shutout of the year at Duke (5/1) - only the third by a Hokie in the ACC (Wright, 3/26/10 & Ryan Kennedy, 5/1/05) - and a scoreless innings streak that reached 17 innings. He has allowed just two earned run over his last 25 full innings. After allowing a two-run home run in the fifth versus Florida State (4/17), Parsons numbers include 27.0 IP, 18 H, 11 BB, 18 K, 2 ER (0.67 ERA).

Gimme two: Tech has turned 55 double plays, which leads the ACC and was 15th in the nation entering the week.

Eleven pitchers have been on the mound for the twin killings, with five pitchers benefitting from at least eight each - Marc Zecchino (12), Manny Martir (9), Joe Mantiply (8) and Joe Parsons (8). The others include Eddie Campbell (6), Patrick Scoggin (4), Jake Atwell (3), Sean McDermott (2), and Kyle Cichy, Brandon Fisher and Ronnie Shaban each have one. Atwell, Campbell, Parsons and Zecchino each have a K-CS double play.

Staying put: This season, the Hokie bullpen has inherited 104 runners, with 37 of them scoring (35.6%). Eddie Campbell (6) has allowed just one to cross the plate. Pitchers with double digit IRs include - Ronnie Shaban (15/2), Brandon Fisher (14/4), Jake Atwell (14/5), Jake Joyce (16/5), Manny Martir (18/8) and Sean McDermott (17/9).

Getting help from the outfield: Tech has 10 outfield assists with seven on the road.

Tony Balisteri 5 - at Boston College (3/26), at Wake Forest (4/1) DP, vs. Florida State (4/16), vs. NC A&T (4/26) at the plate, vs Clemson (5/15) at the plate.

Chad Pinder 2 - at Duke (4/30) DP, at Duke (5/1) at the plate, preserving shutout. Andrew Rash 2 - at Miami (3/12), at Miami (3/13).

1 - at Boston College (3/25). Jake Atwell

Home run differential: With the new bats, offensive production was supposed to go down, but tell that to Tech, who has now hit 58 home runs this season, which is the fifth most in a single season since the team set the school record with 140 in the 1988 season. Combined with last season, the 138 in back-to-back seasons is the most since the 1988-89 seasons

(193). But the Hokie arms certainly got the memo, as they have allowed just 20 home runs this season, which is the lowest since 1977 (17). Since then, the fewest allowed have been 25 ('79), 30 ('89), 32 ('92 &'96) and 39 ('03 & '04).

More from the record books: The numbers Andrew Rash is putting up this season have not been seen at Tech in more than a decade - 17 home runs, .713 šlugging percentage, 127 total bases (178 at-bats). The last man to hit more than 14 home runs in a single season (before this year) was Kevin Barker in 1996, when he hit 20 with 160 total bases for a .792 slugging percentage. The last Hokie to finish a season with at least a .700 slugging percentage was Larry Bowles in 1999, finishing right at .700 (147 total bases in 210 at-bats).

Home run duo: If Smalling hits another home run, it will give the Hokies a pair of 10 homer guys for the second straight year, but would give them a combined total of 27, the most by a pair of teammates since 1997 - Barry Gauch (14) and Matt Griswold (13).

Team record book watch: Currently, Tech has 25 triples, which is tied for the team record set in 1994. The Hokies' 32 sacrifice bunts are four shy of the school record set in 1992 and equalled in 2007. The 1995 team set the fielding percentage record at .968, which Tech is currently better than at .970. It will take some work, but the 55 doubles is 11 shy of the school record 66, turned by the 2000 squad. Lastly, not a record, but the Tech pitching staff is posting a 4.49 ERA, the best mark since 1996 (4.45).

Success on the road: After dropping its first ACC series at Miami, Tech went 12-4 in its last 16 road games, 8-4 in conference, and won 11-of-13. Overall, Tech's 14 wins on the road was the most since 2009 (13) and before that was the 16 won in 2003. It also ranked tied for the 18th most won in the nation, entering the week. Their 16 wins away from Blacksburg tied the 2003 and 2000 teams, which had 16 wins away from Tech, the most of any team since the turn of the century. That mark is tied for 14th in the country entering the week.

Driving Tech to wins: Known as "Big Ron", Tech finished its regular season 14-3 when the Abbott bus driver drove the Hokies to the game-day site. Two losses were on walk-off home runs - 6-5 at Coastal Carolina (2/20) and 5-3 at Wake Forest (4/10) - the other was a 3-2 loss at Duke, in which the winning run was scored in the eighth.

Using all three outs: The Hokies have scored 355 runs and 155 of those (43.7%) have been with two outs. Players have driven in 135, with **Tim Smalling** (23), **Andrew Rash** (20) and **Ronnie Shaban** (18) leading the way. With two outs, Tech has scored on wild pitches seven times, on passed balls twice, and 11 runs crossed the plate on two-out errors.

Putting runs on the scoreboard: Tech has scored 10+ runs 16 times, and was 11-0 in those games before the FSU series. They are now 14-2, but 0-6 when their opponent scores 10+. Meanwhile, Tech is 4-0 in shutouts this season. They have not been shutout in 90 straight games. The Hokies were last held without a run in a 5-0 loss to Wake Forest (3/27/10-G1).

Rebounding after last being swept: Since the Hokies were last swept in an ACC series by Virginia (4/1-3), they have gone 15-7 overall and 9-7 in ACC play. They have swept one series (at Maryland), won two others (at Wake Forest and Duke) and took a game from nationally-ranked Florida State and Clemson.

They reached double figures in hits 15 times, had three nine-hit games and two eight-hit contests. The Hokies are averaging 7.2 runs per game in the span, are batting .321 and slugging .541, while their opponents are hitting .281, slugging .396 and scoring 4.9 rpg.

Winning the close ones: Tech won its first one-run game with a 2-1 victory over #11 Florida State (4/15), but was winless in their prior seven, 0-4 in the ACC. They are now 4-8 overall and 3-5 in the ACC after their 3-2 victory over Clemson on Sunday (5/15). They finished the 2010 season 5-1 in one-run games, 2-0 in the conference.

Meanwhile, the Hokies are 3-5 in two-run games, 0-3 in the ACC. They were 5-4 overall last year and 4-3 in the conference.
