Hokies open 2012 season with unfamiliar foes

The weekend series: Tech opens its 119th season of baseball this weekend at the Kennesaw State Tournament just 18 wins shy of 2,000 in the program's history. Ironically, in their previous 3,366 games played, the Hokies have never faced either of their weekend opponents - Bradley or the host Owls.

History vs. Bradley: This will be the first ever meeting between the two schools and will be only the eighth and ninth meetings ever between Tech and a team from the Missouri Valley Conference. The Hokies are 4-0 all-time against Evansville, 1-0-1 versus Indiana State and lost their only game to Creighton (0-1). The Hokies have not faced a team from the MVC since a 7-3 victory over Evansville on March 11, 1999.

History vs. Kennesaw State: This will be the first ever meeting between the two schools, but the Hokies have a long history with teams from the Atlantic Sun Conference. The Hokies hold a 53-33 record against those foes. They have winning records against four teams - ETSU (33-17), Campbell (3-7), USC Upstate (4-0) and Belmont (1-0) and are .500 versus Mercer (1-1). They have two losing records all-time versus A-Sun opponents - Stetson (1-7) and Lipscomb (0-1).

On these dates: Here is what the Hokies have done on these dates in their program's prior 118 seasons in its history.

Feb. 17: Tech is 2-1 and has won two in a row. The Hokies last played in 2007, defeating Pittsburgh, 7-3. They have scored 15 runs and have allowed 15 runs. The other win was at Campbell (2006, 5-2) and the loss was at Campbell (2001).

Feb. 18: Tech is 2-2, evening its record last year with a 4-2 victory over Indiana to open the 2011 season. They have scored 30 runs and have allowed 25. The other victory was at Campbell (2006, 16-6) and losses include versus St. Johns (2000) and at Coastal Carolina (2007).

Feb. 19: Tech is 2-2, again, evening its record last year with an 11-9 victory over Tennessee Tech. They have scored 25 runs and have allowed 32. The other win was over Tennessee (2000, 5-3) and losses are to Villanova (2005) and Kentucky (2010).

Tech in season openers: The Hokies will open their 119th season of baseball with this weekend's trip to Kennesaw, Ga. Tech has posted a 60-56-2 record in season-opening games. The last time a Tech season opener was played at home was in 1995, and in the 16 years since, the Hokies have gone 9-7. The Hokies have won four of their last six season openers, as they defeated Indiana, 4-2, in last year's Caravelle Resort Tournament first day in Conway, S.C.

Playing in the state of Georgia: In its program history, Tech has played 84 games in the Peach State and have compiled a 34-50 overall record. More than half (49) of their games have been played in Statesboro and 24 have been in Atlanta. The last time the Hokies played a non-conference game in the state was in 2005, in the Savannah State Invitational, going 2-1,. They lost the season opener to Villanova (Feb. 19), but came back with wins over Navy (Feb. 20, 9-0) and the host Tigers (Feb. 21, 11-7).

Preseason All-American: After a stellar 2011 campaign, redshirt-junior Andrew Rash has been named to a pair of preseason All-American teams. He picked up his first major honor as he was selected as preseason Louisville Slugger All-American, third team as an outfielder, as chosen by Collegiate Baseball. That was followed by a third team outfield AA honor by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association.

Hitting a milestone: Entering his senior season, Ronnie Player (Years) Shaban has already put up impressive numbers in just three George Canale (1984-86) full seasons at Tech. He became just the sixth Hokie to reach the 200-hit plateau before their senior year (box right) with the milestone hit coming on an RBI double on May 19 against Georgia Tech.

Austin Wates (2008-10) 233 231 Addison Bowman (1998-00) 229 Trey McCoy (1986-88) 213 Brad Bauder (2000-02) 204 Ronnie Shaban (2009-11) 203

More impressive could be his 56 career doubles, which is already tied with Sean O'Brien (2004-08) for fourth on the Tech all-time career list. He is one double shy of the third spot - currently Shaun Sullivan (1982-85, 57) and just four behind second spot's Bo Durkac (1993-95, 60).

Among some of the record book writing Shaban can reach this season (reaching the top all time) include career at-bats (177 shy), hits (59), triples (3), total bases (115) and RBI (39). He also has a chance to move into the top 25 all-time in the ACC in doubles (six shy) and RBI (57 shy).

A streak ends, another begins?: Graduating senior Michael Seaborn (2008-11) was Tech's ironman. He started 149 consecutive games at second base. With the Hokies' season-opener this year, it will mark the first time since March 22, 2009 that Seaborn will not be making the start at second base.

Starting pitching is deep: For the first time in head coach Pete Hughes' tenure at Tech, he will have two starting pitchers returning to the mound that made 14 starts each and logged more than 84 innings apiece. Redshirt-senior Marc Zecchino and junior Joe Mantiply highlight an experience starting rotation that adds redshirt-senior Manny Martir (six career starts in two years at Tech), junior Patrick Scoggin (eight starts) and sophomore Eddie Campbell (six starts). Newcomers with starting experience include redshirt-senior Andrew Aizenstadt (26 career starts at Babson College), junior Tanner McIntyre (26 career starts at Butte College) and redshirt-sophomore Devin Burke (three career starts at Duke).

Driving Tech to wins: Known as "Big Ron", Tech finished its 2011 regular season with a 14-3 mark when the Abbott bus driver drove the Hokies to their game-day site. Of the three losses, two were on walk-off home runs - a 6-5 defeat at Coastal Carolina (2/20) and a 5-3 loss at Wake Forest (4/10). The other one, a 3-2 loss at Duke, in which the winning run was scored in the eighth frame. Good news for Hokie fans, Big Ron will be transporting the team to its destination this weekend.

Team power: The Hokies hit 60 home runs last season, which led the ACC during the regular season, but finished one behind Florida State, who played 10 more overall games. Overall, Tech was fourth in the nation last year in doubles per game (2.4) and triples per game (0.51) and fifth in home runs per game (1.09) and slugging percentage (.485).

Home run breakdown: Of the 60 home runs hit last season, more than half were solo shots (31), with 13 of those leading off an inning. There were 20 hit with one man on, eight had been hit with two on board, and **Ronnie Shaban** hit the team's only grand slam versus Florida State (4/16). In all, Tech recorded 334 RBI, 99 on home runs (29.6%).

Home run differential: Offensive production was supposed to go down in 2011, but the 60 home runs were the fifth most in a single year since a school record 140 were hit during the 1988 season. The 140 home runs - combined with the 2010 season output - in back-to-back seasons was the most since the 1988-89 seasons (193).

Factor that with the pitching staff, who allowed just 23 home runs last season, the lowest since 1977 (17), and the Hokies were among one of the top five teams in the nation in home run differential at +37 (of note: only 65 teams in the country hit more than 37 home runs all season). The fewest home runs allowed since 1977 were 25 (in 1979), 30 ('89), 32 ('92 &'96) and 39 ('03 & '04).

Putting runs on the scoreboard: With all that power, it was no surprise that Tech scored 10+ runs 16 times in 2011, and was 11-0 in those games before the FSU series. They finished the season 14-2, but were 0-6 when their opponent scored 10+.

Meanwhile, Tech was 4-0 in shutouts last year. They have not been shutout in 90 straight games. The Hokies were last held without a run in a 5-0 loss to Wake Forest (3/27/10-G1).

Adding to that, on March 18, 2008, the Hokies were shutout in an exhibition game to the New York Yankess, 11-0. Since then, a combined 208 games, they have only been shutout three times.




