## Tech takes on four more opponents in week two

**The weekend series:** Tech continues its 119th season of baseball this weekend at the 13th annual Caravelle Resort's Baseball at the Beach tournament in Myrtle Beach, S.C. facing four different teams. With three wins last weekend, the Hokies are now just 15 wins shy of 2,000 in the program's history.

**History vs. WVU:** A long history will resume on Friday, as the Mountaineers and Hokies have battled 83 times before with Tech leading the series, 51-31-1. They are also 10-3 at a neutral site. The last time the two teams faced each other was two years ago, Feb. 21, 2010 in Conway, S.C. with the Hokies winning the game 14-3.

**History vs. Coastal Carolina:** A newer rivalry for Tech - the teams have played five times in five years and will play twice this year - has seen the Chanticleers getting the better with a 6-1 overall mark and winners of five straight. However, four of those have been decided by a single run. Every game of the series has been played in South Carolina.

**History vs. George Mason:** Tech has not faced George Mason since a 2-0 loss during the 2005 season, but the Hokies hold a 15-13-1 edge in the all-time series against the Dukes. The teams have only played once on a neutral field, March 3, 1995 in Wilmington, N.C., a 10-3 victory for the Dukes.

**History vs. Iowa:** The Hokies and the Hawkeyes have only played three times in the history of the programs, all at a neutral field in DeLand, Fla. in March of 1986. Iowa won the first two meetings, but Tech took the final on the 31st, 5-3.

**On these dates:** Here is what the Hokies have done on these dates in their program's prior 118 seasons in its history.

**Feb. 24:** Tech is 3-6 and has lost three straight. The last time they played on the date was in 2009, a 7-3 loss to ETSU. The Hokies have scored 48 runs and have allowed 51. The wins include UNC Asheville, 9-6 in 10 innings in 2007, at ODU, 16-11 in 1998, and at High Point, 2-0 in 1985.

**Feb. 25:** Tech is 6-4 and have won its last two. They have scored 66 runs and have allowed 47. Their last two wins were versus Niagara, 17-9 last year, and versus ETSU, 10-2 in 2009. Their last loss was in 2008 at Coastal Carolina, 4-3 in 10 innings.

**Feb. 26:** Tech is 8-2 and have won five straight. They have scored 85 runs and have allowed just 31. Wins on this date include a doubleheader sweep against Niagara last year (7-2, 11-7) and a 17-2 win at Charleston Southern in 2010. Their last loss was in 2000 at Wake Forest, 11-7.

**Playing in the state of South Carolina:** In its program history, Tech has played 144 games in the Palmetto State and have compiled a 67-74-3 overall record, while going 3-1 last season. They have played the most games in Columbia (45), but Clemson and Charleston have each seen 32 games. The Hokies have played just three times in Myrtle Beach (2-1) - the site of the first three games for the team - and have played 12 in Conway (5-7) - the site of Sunday's contest.

**Preseason All-American:** After a stellar 2011 campaign, redshirt-junior **Andrew Rash** has been named to a pair of preseason All-American teams. He picked up his first major honor as he was selected as preseason Louisville Slugger All-American, third team as an outfielder, as chosen by Collegiate Baseball. That was followed by a third team outfield AA honor by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association.

**Doubling up on history:** **Chad Pinder** each made a bit of history in the team's first weekend at the Kennesaw State Tournament. Pinder tied an ACC and Tech record for doubles in a game with his four two-baggers against Bradley on Feb. 18, becoming just the ninth ACC player to accomplish the feat (see chart below).

**Shaban's record watch:** Before his senior season, **Ronnie Shaban** became just the sixth Hokie to reach the 200-hit plateau as a junior (*box right*) with the milestone hit coming on an RBI double on May 19 against Georgia Tech.

He has a chance to place his name in a number of categories in Tech's record book, as he approaches the top five all-time in the following career categories: at-bats (161 shy), hits (54), triples (3), total bases (107) and RBI (37).

The double record is within reach for Shaban, as he needs just one more to tie **Bo Durkac** (1993-95, 60) for second and is seven away from school record holder **Addison Bowman** (1998-01, 66).

He also has a chance to move into the top 25 all-time in the ACC in doubles (three shy) and RBI (55 shy).

**One more note on Ronnie:** According to research compiled by East Carolina SID Malcolm Gray, Shaban is the nation's active career leader in doubles with 59 and is among the nation's top 10 in career RBI with 159. He sits just outside the top 10 in hits and total bases.

**Driving Tech to wins:** Known as "Big Ron", Tech finished its 2011 regular season with a 14-3 mark when the Abbott bus driver drove the Hokies to their game-day site. Of the three losses, two were on walk-off home runs - a 6-5 defeat at Coastal Carolina (2/20) and a 5-3 loss at Wake Forest (4/10). The other one, a 3-2 loss at Duke, in which the winning run was scored in the eighth frame. Good news for Hokie fans, "Big Ron" will be transporting the team to its destination this weekend after the team posted a 3-1 mark last week with him at the wheel.

**Starting pitching is deep/experienced:** For the first time in head coach **Pete Hughes'** tenure at Tech, he will have two starting pitchers returning to the mound that made 14 starts each and logged more than 84 innings apiece. Redshirt-senior **Marc Zecchino** and junior **Joe Mantiply** highlight an experience starting rotation that adds redshirt-senior **Manny Martir** (six career starts in two years at Tech), junior **Patrick Scoggin** (eight starts) and sophomore **Eddie Campbell** (six starts).

Newcomers with starting experience include redshirt-senior **Andrew Aizenstadt** (26 career starts at Babson College), junior **Tanner McIntyre** (26 career starts at Butte College) and redshirt-sophomore **Devin Burke** (three career starts at Duke).

**Starters start season strong:** Last weekend, the Tech starters allowed just one earned run over 24 innings pitched with 26 strikeouts. An unearned run streak for starters is at 22 straight frames, with Martir (5), Mantiply (7), Zecchino (5) and Scoggin (5) getting it down. However, last year, starters went 27 straight innings without allowing an earned run, from March 4-11 (a six-game stretch).

**Bullpen continues unearned streak:** The starters combined with the bullpen last weekend to throw 28 straight frames and not allow an earned run. It is the second longest streak of consecutive innings without allowing an earned run overall in the Hughes' era, as the staff notched 29 straight last year during the Bryant series (March 4-5). The relievers also combined to pick up two wins and two saves.

**Right where he belongs:** Jake Atwell found himself in a familiar spot to open the season, as the leadoff man for the Hokies. Last year, Tech was 13-8 with Atwell batting first and he turned in a 3-1 weekend to start off 2012. He had a team-high five runs scored and also had four hits, four RBI and a .450 on-base percentage, adding three walks and two HBP.

**Putting runs on the scoreboard:** Last year, Tech scored 10+ runs 16 times and finished the season 14-2, but were 0-6 when their opponent scored 10+. They are 1-0 so far in 2012.

Meanwhile, Tech was 4-0 in shutouts last year and have not been shutout in 94 straight games - the longest such streak in the ACC. The Hokies were last held without a run in a 5-0 loss to Wake Forest (3/27/10-G1).

Adding to that, on March 18, 2008, the Hokies were shutout in an exhibition game against the New York Yankees, 11-0. Since then, a combined 212 games, they have only been shutout three times.

**Newcomers helping out already:** Tech lost three major position players to graduation and freshmen have already joined in to lessen the burden of the returners. **Alex Perez** has made four starts at second base and has a hit in all four games and has driven in two. **Sean Keselica** played in two games and has four hits as well, and played a flawless first base (11 putouts). **Mark Zagunis** made a start behind the plate and was 1-for-2 with two runs, three RBI, a walk, a hit-by-pitch and a stolen base. **Carson Helms** also singled in his only game played. Meanwhile, on the mound, no freshman saw action, but a newcomer to the Hokies did in Aizenstadt, who threw three frames and struck out five.

**Home run breakdown:** Of the three home runs hit this season, two have been solo shots - with one of those leading off an inning - and one has been hit with one man on. Last year, Tech recorded almost 30 percent of its RBI via the long ball, this season just 18 percent (4 of 22).

**Home run differential:** Offensive production was supposed to go down in 2011, but Tech hit 60 home runs, which were the fifth most in a single year since a school record 140 were hit during the 1988 season. The 140 home runs - combined with the 2010 season output - in back-to-back seasons was the most since the 1988-89 seasons (193).

Factor that with the pitching staff, who allowed just 23 home runs last season, the lowest since 1977 (17), and the Hokies were among one of the top five teams in the nation in home run differential at +37 (of note: only 65 teams in the country hit more than 37 home runs all season). The fewest home runs allowed since 1977 were 25 (in 1979), 30 ('89), 32 ('92 & '96) and 39 ('03 & '04).
