Hokies face Yale in home-opening four-game series

The weekend series: Tech continues its 119th season of baseball this weekend as the Hokies welcome Yale to English Field for a four-game series starting on Saturday with a doubleheader at 1 p.m. With three wins last weekend and a victory at High Point, Tuesday, the Hokies are now just 11 wins shy of 2,000 in their program's history.

Tech success in home openers and in Blacksburg: Since 1989, when the Hokies began playing at English Field, they are 18-5 all-time in home openers. They have won 11 of their last 14 home openers and under Coach Hughes, they are 4-1. That mark includes a 17-9 victory over Niagara last year, the most runs scored in a home opener since 1994 - a 17-12 win over Richmond on March 14. All-time, Tech is 379-200-3 in 23 seasons at English Field and 1,149-487-17 in games played at home.

History vs. Yale: This will be the third time this season that Tech will face an opponent for the first time in the program's history. They were victories in the other first meetings with Bradley (6-4) and Kennesaw State (3-2), wins that opened the season. All-time against teams from the Ivy League, the Hokies are 7-2 (Brown, 2-0; Columbia, 1-0; Cornell, 3-1; Dartmouth, 0-1; Princeton, 1-0) and all nine previous games were played in Blacksburg. Tech's first game ever against an Ivy team was a 9-1 loss to Dartmouth on March 31, 1923. The last time the Hokies played an Ivy team was March 15, 2010 and they beat Columbia, 22-10.

On these dates: Here is what the Hokies have done on these dates in their program's prior 118 seasons in its history.

March 3: Tech is 12-5 all-time and has won four straight. The last time they played on the date was in 2007, an 11-10 win over N.C. A&T in Blacksburg. They are 7-1 all-time in Blacksburg. The Hokies have outscored their opponents 120-88. Tech has played two doubleheaders on the date and split them both - in 2002 at home against Western Michigan and in 1984 at Elon.

March 4: Tech is 11-11-1 all-time and are 6-2 in its last eight after splitting a doubleheader against Bryant in Blacksburg last year. The Hokies have played three extra inning games on this date and they have all been at home. They have outscored their opponents 103-82.

March 5: Tech is 14-11 all-time and just 5-5 at home, again after splitting a doubleheader against Bryant in Blacksburg last year. The Hokies have outscored 142-112, which includes a pair of 15-run games, one they won (15-0, Bryant, 2011) and one they lost (19-15, Ohio, 2000).

Irony runs through walk-off win: The Hokies walk-off win last Sunday against Iowa at Watson Stadium on Coastal Carolina's campus held a bit of irony. The last time Tech had played a game on that field, the Chanticleers were celebrating a 6-5 walk-off win (Feb. 20, 2011) over Tech. The second ironic part of the victory, was the last time the Hokies played on the field before that loss, they registered their last win when trailing entering the ninth inning. The Hokies trailed Tennessee Tech 9-8, but scored three in the top of the ninth and held on for an 11-9 victory.

Preseason All-American: After a stellar 2011 campaign, redshirt-junior **Andrew Rash** has been named to a pair of preseason All-American teams. He picked up his first major honor as he was selected as preseason Louisville Slugger All-American, third team as an outfielder, as chosen by Collegiate Baseball. That was followed by a third team outfield AA honor by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association.

Doubling up a record: **Chad Pinder** made a bit of history in the team's first weekend at the Kennesaw State Tournament. Pinder tied an ACC and Tech record for doubles in a game with his four two-baggers against Bradley on Feb. 18, becoming just the second Hokie and ninth ACC player to accomplish the feat (see chart below).

Assisting a record: Second baseman **Alex Perez** also made a bit of history in the team's win at High Point (2/28). He became just the third Hokie to register 10 assists in a single game, matching Rick Wade (3B, vs. Marshall, 4/28/76) and Mike Terhune (2B, vs. Fresno State, 3/17/95) for the most in a game.

Shaban's record watch: Before his senior season, **Ronnie Shaban** became just the sixth Hokie to reach the 200-hit plateau as a junior (box right) with the milestone hit coming on an RBI double on May 19 against Georgia Tech.

He has a chance to place his name in a number of categories in Tech's record book, as he approaches the top five all-time in the following career categories: at-bats (147 shy of fifth), hits (49), triples (2), total bases (100) and RBI (35).

The double record is within reach for Shaban, as he needs just one more to tie **Bo Durkac** (1993-95, 60) for second and is seven away from school record holder **Addison Bowman** (1998-01, 66).

He also has a chance to move into the top 25 all-time in the ACC in doubles (three shy) and RBI (53).

Driving Tech to wins: Known as "Big Ron", Tech finished its 2011 regular season with a 14-3 mark when the Abbott bus driver drove the Hokies to their game-day site. Of the three losses, two were on walk-off home runs - a 6-5 defeat at Coastal Carolina (2/20) and a 5-3 loss at Wake Forest (4/10). The other one, a 3-2 loss at Duke, in which the winning run was scored in the eighth frame. Good news for Hokie fans, "Big Ron" has been behind the wheel for all of Tech's destination this season and have posted a 7-2 mark so far in 2012.

Starting pitching is deep/experienced: For the first time in head coach **Pete Hughes'** tenure at Tech, he will have two starting pitchers returning to the mound that made 14 starts each and logged more than 84 innings apiece. Redshirt-senior **Marc Zecchino** and junior **Joe Mantiply** highlight an experience starting rotation that adds redshirt-senior **Manny Martir** (six career starts in two years at Tech), junior **Patrick Scoggin** (eight starts) and sophomore **Eddie Campbell** (six starts).

Newcomers with starting experience include redshirt-senior **Andrew Aizenstadt** (26 career starts at Babson College), junior **Tanner McIntyre** (26 career starts at Butte College) and redshirt-sophomore **Devin Burke** (three career starts at Duke).

Starters start season strong: Opening weekend, Tech starters allowed just one earned run (second inning of game one) over 24 innings pitched with 26 strikeouts. In all, the starters combined to throw 31 straight frames without allowing an earned run before Coastal Carolina scored a single run in the sixth. Martir (9), Mantiply (12), Zecchino (5) and Scoggin (5) notched the unearned outings, which was the longest such stretch during the Hughes' era.

Bullpen continued unearned streak: The starters combined with the bullpen during the opening weekend to throw 28 straight frames and not allow an earned run. That streak continued until the fifth inning against West Virginia, but the 32 total frames was the longest in the Hughes' era, passing last year's staff that notched 29 straight during the Bryant series (March 4-5).

The relievers have combined to pick up five wins and four saves in 29 innings pitched with 33 strikeouts.

Right where he belongs: Jake Atwell found himself in a familiar spot to open the season, as the leadoff man for the Hokies. Last year, Tech was 13-8 with Atwell batting first and he turned in a 6-2 (as the lead-off man) start to 2012. He has scored a team-high nine runs and is tied for second on the team with six RBI.

Putting runs on the scoreboard: Last year, Tech scored 10+ runs 16 times and finished the season 14-2, but were 0-6 when their opponent scored 10+. They are 2-0 so far in 2012.

Meanwhile, Tech was 4-0 in shutouts last year and have not been shutout in 102 straight games - the longest such streak in the ACC. The Hokies were last held without a run in a 5-0 loss to Wake Forest (3/27/10-G1).

Adding to that, on March 18, 2008, the Hokies were shutout in an exhibition game against the New York Yankees, 11-0. Since then, a combined 216 games, they have only been shutout three times.

Newcomers helping out already: Tech lost three major position players to graduation and freshmen have already joined in to lessen the burden of the returners. **Alex Perez** has made nine starts at second base and has seven hits and six RBI. **Sean Keselica** has three starts and five games played, and has five hits in 12 at-bats. **Mark Zagunis** has two starts behind the plate and is 2-for-5 with two runs, three RBI, a walk, a hit-by-pitch and two stolen bases. **Carson Helms** singled in his first at-bat, while **Brendon Hayden** has two hits and two RBI early on.

Meanwhile, no freshman has seen action on the mound, but newcomers to the Hokies did find Aizenstadt and McIntyre, who each have a win in relief, and Aizenstadt made the weekday start at High Point.

Home run breakdown: Of the four home runs hit this season, three have been solo shots - with one of those leading off an inning - and one has been hit with one man on. Last year, Tech recorded almost 30 percent of its RBI via the long ball, this season just 11.1 percent (5 of 45).

Hokies a bit sloppy: In their first loss of the season at Kennesaw State (2/19) and in the first game of the Baseball at the Beach tournament versus West Virginia (2/24), the Hokies registered back-to-back five-error games. The last time Tech committed at least five errors and won was April 9, 2012 - they actually had six - in a 9-7 win over Miami. Since the win over the Mountaineers, the Hokies have registered just two errors in 105 chances.
