Tech opens ACC play with familiar foe - Virginia

The weekend series: Tech continues its 119th season of baseball this weekend as the Hokies travel to a familiar foe in No. 27 Virginia for a three-game ACC-opening series in Charlottesville starting on Friday with a game at 5 p.m.

The series will continue at Davenport Field with games on Saturday and Sunday at 1 p.m. Tech has won six straight entering the weekend and are now just seven wins shy of 2,000 in their program's history.

History vs. Virginia: The Hokies have faced the Cavaliers 166 times, trailing only the VMI series (172) in most games played versus one opponent in the program's history. The team owns a 77-88-1 record all-time versus Virginia, but are just 28-48-1 on the road, including a 1-8 record in ACC play.

However, the last time the teams met in Charlottesville, the Hokies registered an 8-5 victory on April 18, 2010 ending an 11-game slide at Virginia. Tech is also just 3-16 when the Cavaliers have been ranked.

A familiar start: In its eighth season in the ACC, this will be the seven straight year Tech will open the conference slate on the road. Unfortunately, the Hokies only won one of those series, 2-1 at No. 21 Georgia Tech in 2007. Since, the team is 1-11 overall in the previous four series included at No. 19 Georgia Tech (2008, 0-3), at Duke (2009, 1-2), at No. 7 Clemson (2010, 0-3) and at Miami (2011, 0-3).

Including this year, the Hokies have faced a ranked opponent in six of their eight openers, also starting at No. 21 Miami (2006, 0-3) and versus No. 11 North Carolina (2005, 0-1) - the only time they hosted an league-season opener. That year, they went on the road next and dropped all three at No. 16 Florida State.

However, Tech is 2-5 in ACC season openers, with wins over the Yellow Jackets (5-3) in 2007 and the Blue Devils (19-4) in 2009 in the first game of the three-game set.

Coming in hot: Tech enters the weekend with a six-game winning streak, the longest by the team since the 2010 squad won nine straight from Feb. 21 through March 9. Interestingly, in five of the previous seven ACC openers, whatever the Hokies result in the previous game before the conference opener, they repeated in the opener.

The only two times the result was not repeated was last year, after the Hokies beat Florida Atlantic, they lost at Miami, and in 2008. Unfortunately, that season those Hokies also entered ACC play with a six-game win streak, but dropped a 14-1 decision to Georgia Tech.

On these dates: Here is what the Hokies have done on these dates in the program's prior 118 seasons in its history.

March 9: Tech is 15-7-1 all-time and is 7-3 on the road. The last time they played on the date was 2010, a 5-4 win over Bryant. They are 1-1 in ACC play.

March 10: Tech is 7-15 all-time and are just 2-9 on the road. Their last victory was a 15-1 win at Radford in 2009. The Hokies are also 0-2 in ACC play.

March 11: Tech is 10-10 all-time and are 4-4 on the road. Their last win was 5-4 at No. 21 Georgia Tech in 2007. The Hokies are 1-3 in ACC play.

Preseason All-American: After a stellar 2011 campaign, redshirt-junior **Andrew Rash** has been named to a pair of preseason All-American teams. He picked up his first major honor as he was selected as preseason Louisville Slugger All-American, third team as an outfielder, as chosen by Collegiate Baseball. That was followed by a third team outfield AA honor by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association.

Doubling up a record: **Chad Pinder** made a bit of history in the team's first weekend at the Kennesaw State Tournament. Pinder tied an ACC and Tech record for doubles in a game with his four two-baggers against Bradley on Feb. 18, becoming just the second Hokie and ninth ACC player to accomplish the feat (see chart below).

Assisting a record: Second baseman **Alex Perez** also made a bit of history in the team's win at High Point (2/28). He became just the third Hokie to register 10 assists in a single game, matching **Rick Wade** (3B, vs. Marshall, 4/28/76) and **Mike Terhune** (2B, vs. Fresno State, 3/17/95) for the most in a game.

Shaban's record watch: Before his senior season, **Ronnie Shaban** became just the sixth Hokie to reach the 200-hit plateau as a junior (box right) with the milestone hit coming on an RBI double on May 19 against Georgia Tech.

He has a chance to place his name in a number of categories in Tech's record book, as he approaches the top five all-time in the following career categories: at-bats (147 shy of fifth), hits (49), triples (2), total bases (100) and RBI (35).

The double record is within reach for Shaban, as he needs just one more to tie **Bo Durkac** (1993-95, 60) for second and is seven away from school record holder **Addison Bowman** (1998-01, 66).

He also has a chance to move into the top 25 all-time in the ACC in doubles (three shy) and RBI (53).

Driving Tech to wins: Known as "Big Ron", Tech finished its 2011 regular season with a 14-3 mark when the Abbott bus driver drove the Hokies to their game-day site. Of the three losses, two were on walk-off home runs - a 6-5 defeat at Coastal Carolina (2/20) and a 5-3 loss at Wake Forest (4/10). The other one, a 3-2 loss at Duke, in which the winning run was scored in the eighth frame. Good news for Hokie fans, "Big Ron" has been behind the wheel for all of Tech's destination this season and has posted a 7-2 mark so far in 2012.

Starting pitching is deep/experienced: For the first time in head coach **Pete Hughes'** tenure at Tech, he has two starting pitchers returning to the mound that made 14 starts each and logged more than 84 innings apiece. Redshirt-senior **Marc Zechino** and junior **Joe Mantiply** highlight an experience starting rotation that adds redshirt-senior **Manny Martir** (six career starts in two years at Tech), junior **Patrick Scoggin** (eight starts) and sophomore **Eddie Campbell** (six starts).

Newcomers with starting experience include redshirt-senior **Andrew Aizenstadt** (26 career starts at Babson College), junior **Tanner McIntyre** (26 career starts at Butte College) and redshirt-sophomore **Devin Burke** (three career starts at Duke).

Starters start season strong: Opening weekend, Tech starters allowed just one earned run (second inning of game one) over 24 innings pitched with 26 strikeouts. In all, the starters combined to throw 31 straight frames without allowing an earned run before Coastal Carolina scored a single run in the sixth. Martir (9), Mantiply (12), Zecchino (5) and Scoggin (5) notched the unearned outings, which was the longest such stretch during the Hughes' era.

Bullpen continued unearned streak: The starters combined with the bullpen during the opening weekend to throw 28 straight frames and not allow an earned run. That streak continued until the fifth inning against West Virginia, but the 32 total frames was the longest in the Hughes' era, passing last year's staff that notched 29 straight during the Bryant series (March 4-5).

The relievers have combined to pick up six wins and five saves in 42.0 innings pitched with 52 strikeouts.

Putting runs on the scoreboard: Last year, Tech scored 10+ runs 16 times and finished the season 14-2, but were 0-6 when their opponent scored 10+. They are 5-0 so far in 2012.

Meanwhile, Tech was 4-0 in shutouts last year and just posted their first on Sunday. The Hokies have not been shutout in 106 straight games - the longest such streak in the ACC. The Hokies were last held without a run in a 5-0 loss to Wake Forest (3/27/10-G1).

Adding to that, on March 18, 2008, the Hokies were shutout in an exhibition game against the New York Yankees, 11-0. Since then, a combined 220 games, they have only been shutout three times.

Home run breakdown: Of the 12 home runs hit this season, nine have been solo shots - with five of those leading off an inning. Two have been hit with on man aboard, and one has been hit with two. Last year, Tech recorded almost 30 percent of its RBI via the long ball, this season just 17.2 percent (16 of 93).

Irony runs through first walk-off win: The Hokies 4-3 walk-off win over Iowa (2/26) at Watson Stadium on Coastal Carolina's campus held a bit of irony. The last time Tech played a game on that field, the Chanticleers were celebrating a 6-5 walk-off win (Feb. 20, 2011) over Tech.

The second ironic part of the victory, was the last time the Hokies played on the field before that loss, they registered their last win when trailing entering the ninth inning. The Hokies trailed Tennessee Tech 9-8, but scored three in the top of the ninth and held on for an 11-9 victory.

Hokies walk-off again: Under Coach Hughes, Tech has registered seven walk-off victories, which includes a pair this season against Iowa and versus Yale. Rash's solo home run against the Bulldogs in Game 1 (3/4) lifted the Hokies to a 6-5 win. He became the second Hokie to hit a walk-off home run, as *Austin Wates* did the same, but in the 10th frame, a 5-4 win over No. 10 Virginia on May 14, 2009. Of the seven wins, two have been in extra innings.

Tech a bit sloppy: In their first loss of the season at Kennesaw State (2/19) and in the first game of the Baseball at the Beach tournament versus West Virginia (2/24), the Hokies registered back-to-back five-error games. The last time Tech committed at least five errors and won was April 9, 2012 - they actually had six - in a 9-7 win over Miami

Since the win over the Mountaineers, the Hokies have registered just six errors in 318 chances, for a fielding percentage of .981.

Facing nationally ranked teams: Under Coach Hughes, Tech has never faced an opponent ranked No. 27 in the polls, but are 5-7 against teams ranked No. 21-30. At this point, there are six teams on the Tech schedule that are nationally ranked by one poll. All-time under Hughes, the Hokies are 25-63 against ranked opponents (*more on page 5*).

Success on the road: Last year, after dropping its first ACC series at Miami, Tech finished 12-4 in its last 16 road games, 8-4 in conference, and won 11-of-13. Overall, Tech's 14 wins on the road was the most since 2009 (13) and before that was the 16 won in 2003.

It also ranked tied for the 18th-most win in the nation at the end of the regular season. Their 16 wins away from Blacksburg tied the 2003 and 2000 teams, which had 16 wins away from Tech, the most of any team since the turn of the century. That mark was tied for 14th in the country at the end of the regular season.

Lastly, their eight wins on the road in the conference was the most ever since joining the ACC Conference and the Hokies overall 8-7 record marked the first time they finished over .500 in league play.

Gimme two: Tech has turned 13 double plays, which is tied for fifth in the ACC and is among the top 100 in the nation.

Nine pitchers have been on the mound for the twin killings, with four pitchers benefitting from two already - **Andrew Aizenstadt** (2), **Joe Mantiply** (2), **Manny Martir** (2) and **Colin O'Keefe** (2), while **Eddie Campbell** (1), **Jake Joyce** (1), **Patrick Scoggin** (1), **Ronnie Shaban** (1) and **Marc Zechino** (1) each have one.

Staying put: This season, the Hokie bullpen has inherited 16 runners, with five of them scoring (31.3%). **Eddie Campbell** (4) and **Andrew Aizenstadt** (1) have not allowed any, while **Jake Joyce** has inherited 11 with five crossing the plate.

Getting help from the outfield: Tech has just one outfield assists this season.

Kyle Wernicki 1 - vs. Bradley (2/17) at third base.

Tech success in home openers and in Blacksburg: Since 1989, when the Hokies began playing at English Field, they are 19-5 all-time in home openers after its 15-3 win over Yale in game one on March 3. They have won 12 of their last 15 home openers and under Coach Hughes, they are 5-1. All-time, Tech is 384-200-3 in 23 seasons at English Field and 1,158-487-17 in games played at home.
