Hokies head back to Georgia for 2nd ACC weekend

The weekend series: Tech continues its 119th season of baseball this weekend as the Hokies travel to No. 14 Georgia Tech for a three-game ACC series in Atlanta, Ga. starting on Friday with a game at 6 p.m. The series continues at Russ Chandler Stadium with games on Saturday (4 p.m.) and Sunday (1 p.m.) with all three games on ESPN3.

Tech enters with a two-game winning streak. They opened their ACC slate 1-2 at Virginia last weekend, and the Hokies are now just four wins shy of 2,000 in their program's history.

History vs. Georgia Tech: The Hokies have faced the Yellow Jackets just 28 times in their history, and since 2004, every time the two teams have faced off, Georgia Tech has been ranked. Overall, the Hokies are 10-18 versus the Yellow Jackets.

In Atlanta, Virginia Tech is 6-12 all-time, which includes taking two of three the last time the teams met at Russ Chandler Stadium. Ironically, one of those games was a 3-1 victory in 11 innings (April 23, 2010), the last time before the UVa. game last Friday that the Hokies played into the 11th frame.

Playing in the state of South Carolina: In its program history, Tech has played just 88 games in the Peach State and have compiled a 37-51 overall record, which includes a 3-1 mark already this year after opening the season just up the road at the Kennesaw State Tournament. More than half (49) of their games have been played in Statesboro with 28 games being contested in Atlanta.

Off to a hot start: The Hokies come into the weekend's ACC series with an overall record of 14-4, which is the best start at the school in 20 years and bettering the 2010 squad by a single game. That team, which made the NCAA tournament, was 13-5 after 18 games, while in 1993, the Hokies started that season 15-3. The fastest team to 20 wins over the last 20 years, includes 2010 (29), 2003 (28) and 1993 (27).

Speaking of that 2010 squad: For only the second time in Tech's history in the ACC (seven seasons prior), the 2010 team opened the season with a series win, defeating Maryland, 2-1, in Blacksburg. The other was a 2-1 series win at Georgia Tech in 2007. After defeating the Yellow Jackets, the Hokies won a game at N.C. State, marking the only time two weeks into ACC play Tech was .500. They didn't finish well, though, going 4-20 the rest of the way. After the Maryland series win, the Hokies were swept at Clemson, but those two wins was still the second-most after two weeks of ACC action.

On these dates: Here is what the Hokies have done on these dates in the program's prior 118 seasons in its history.

March 16: Tech is 5-8-1 all-time with an 0-4-1 mark on the road. The Hokies have only faced one conference foe - at North Carolina - on this date, losing 6-0.

March 17: Tech is 11-11 all-time and is 6-8 on the road. Again, they have never won an ACC game on the date, holding a 0-3 mark - two at N.C. State and one versus FSU.

March 18: Tech is 17-12 all-time and are 5-7 on the road. They are 4-2 against ACC teams, including a win over No. 1 Florida State back in 2006.

Preseason All-American: After a stellar 2011 campaign, redshirt-junior **Andrew Rash** has been named to a pair of preseason All-American teams. He picked up his first major honor as he was selected as preseason Louisville Slugger All-American, third team as an outfielder, as chosen by Collegiate Baseball. That was followed by a third team outfield AA honor by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association.

Doubling up a record: **Chad Pinder** made a bit of history in the team's first weekend at the Kennesaw State Tournament. Pinder tied an ACC and Tech record for doubles in a game with his four two-baggers against Bradley on Feb. 18, becoming just the second Hokie and ninth ACC player to accomplish the feat (see chart below).

Assisting a record: Second baseman **Alex Perez** also made a bit of history in the team's win at High Point (2/28). He became just the third Hokie to register 10 assists in a single game, matching **Rick Wade** (3B, vs. Marshall, 4/28/76) and **Mike Terhune** (2B, vs. Fresno State, 3/17/95) for the most in a game.

Shaban's record watch: Before his senior season, **Ronnie Shaban** became just the sixth Hokie to reach the 200-hit plateau as a junior (box right) with the milestone hit coming on an RBI double on May 19 against Georgia Tech.

He has a chance to place his name in a number of categories in Tech's record book, as he approaches the top five all-time in the following career categories: at-bats (147 shy of fifth), hits (49), triples (2), total bases (100) and RBI (35).

The double record is within reach for Shaban, as he needs just one more to tie **Bo Durkac** (1993-95, 60) for second and is seven away from school record holder **Addison Bowman** (1998-01, 66).

He also has a chance to move into the top 25 all-time in the ACC in doubles (three shy) and RBI (53).

Driving Tech to wins: Known as "Big Ron", Tech finished its 2011 regular season with a 14-3 mark when the Abbott bus driver drove the Hokies to their game-day site. Of the three losses, two were on walk-off home runs - a 6-5 defeat at Coastal Carolina (2/20) and a 5-3 loss at Wake Forest (4/10). The other one, a 3-2 loss at Duke, in which the winning run was scored in the eighth frame. Good news for Hokie fans, "Big Ron" has been behind the wheel for all of Tech's destination this season and has posted an 8-4 mark so far in 2012.

Starting pitching is deep/experienced: For the first time in head coach **Pete Hughes'** tenure at Tech, he has two starting pitchers returning to the mound that made 14 starts each and logged more than 84 innings apiece. Redshirt-senior **Marc Zecchino** and junior **Joe Mantiply** highlight an experience starting rotation that adds redshirt-senior **Manny Martir** (six career starts in two years at Tech), junior **Patrick Scoggin** (eight starts) and sophomore **Eddie Campbell** (six starts).

Newcomers with starting experience include redshirt-senior **Andrew Aizenstadt** (26 career starts at Babson College), junior **Tanner McIntyre** (26 career starts at Butte College) and redshirt-sophomore **Devin Burke** (three career starts at Duke).

Starters start season strong: Opening weekend, Tech starters allowed just one earned run (second inning of game one) over 24 innings pitched with 26 strikeouts. In all, the starters combined to throw 31 straight frames without allowing an earned run before Coastal Carolina scored a single run in the sixth. Martir (9), Mantiply (12), Zecchino (5) and Scoggin (5) notched the unearned outings, which was the longest such stretch during the Hughes' era.

Bullpen continued unearned streak: The starters combined with the bullpen during the opening weekend to throw 28 straight frames and not allow an earned run. That streak continued until the fifth inning against West Virginia, but the 32 total frames was the longest in the Hughes' era, passing last year's staff that notched 29 straight during the Bryant series (March 4-5).

The relievers have combined to pick up six wins and five saves in 42.0 innings pitched with 52 strikeouts.

Gimme two: Tech has turned 17 double plays, which is tied for third in the ACC and was 32nd in the nation entering the week.

Ten pitchers have been on the mound for the twin killings, with six pitchers benefitting from at least two already - **Eddie Campbell** (3), **Manny Martir** (3), **Andrew Aizenstadt** (2), **Joe Mantiply** (2), **Colin O'Keefe** (2) and **Patrick Scoggin** (2) - while **Jake Joyce** (1), **Ronnie Shaban** (1) and **Marc Zecchino** (1) each have one.

Staying put: This season, the Hokie bullpen has inherited 30 runners, with 10 of them scoring (33.3%). **Eddie Campbell** (9) and **Andrew Aizenstadt** (1) have not allowed any, while **Jake Joyce** has inherited 16 with eight crossing the plate and **Clark Labitan** has allowed two-of-four to score.

Getting help from the outfield: Tech has just one outfield assists this season.

Kyle Wernicki 1 - vs. Bradley (2/17) at third base.

Getting help from the bench: Tech has been helped, not only from its pinch-hitters, who have come through with six hits, two RBI and two walks in 15 pinch-hit opportunities, but from its bench as a whole. Below are the differences between Tech and its opponents from both batters and pitchers.

Success on the road: Last year, after dropping its first ACC series at Miami, Tech finished 12-4 in its last 16 road games, 8-4 in conference including winning its last three series. Overall, Tech's 14 wins on the road was the most since 2009 (13) and before that was the 16 won in 2003.

It also ranked tied for the 18th-most won in the nation at the end of the regular season. Their 16 wins away from Blacksburg tied the 2003 and 2000 teams, which had 16 wins away from Tech, the most of any team since the turn of the century. That mark was tied for 14th in the country at the end of the regular season.

Lastly, their eight wins on the road in the conference was the most ever since joining the ACC Conference and the Hokies overall 8-7 record marked the first time they finished over .500 in league play.

Tech success in home openers and in Blacksburg: Since 1989, when the Hokies began playing at English Field, they are 19-5 all-time in home openers after its 15-3 win over Yale in game one on March 3. They have won 12 of their last 15 home openers and under Coach Hughes, they are 5-1. All-time, Tech is 386-200-3 in 23 seasons at English Field and 1,160-487-17 in games played at home.
