### Hokies set to battle No. 4 Seminoles at English Field

**The weekend series:** The Hokies continue their 120th season of baseball this weekend with a three-game ACC series against No. 4 Florida State at English Field.

**Facing the Seminoles:** Tech and Florida State have played each other 48 times, with the Seminoles winning 40 of them. Exactly half of those games and wins have been since the two teams have been members of the ACC (24 & 20).

The Seminoles have been ranked every time the Hokies have played them in an ACC contest, and have mostly seen them when they've been in the top 5 - this year at No. 4. Tech is 2-9 against Florida State at English Field.

**A fast start in the ACC:** Before this season, Tech had never been above .500 after nine games of the ACC slate. In 2007 and 2010, the Hokies were 4-5 after nine games.

After 12 games, the team has never been above .500, but was a best 6-6 in 2010, while in 2007 they were 4-8 (the second-best record after 12 games).

**20 wins, no fooling:** After the weekend, the Hokies will say farewell to the month of March. Only twice in their history have the Hokies reached the 20-win mark before April 1 - 1985 (March 30), and 1992 (March 29).

Also, only 17 times in their history has Tech reached 20 victories by its 30th game, the last time 2010 (20-9), while in 2003 it took just 28 games.

**The turning point:** The 2010 season has now been referenced in both previous notes in regards to successful starts. Looking back, on March 31, the team was 18-9 after a win at ETSU and entered the ACC weekend 4-5 as the Hokies were heading to ... ironically, No. 4 Florida State. The Hokies took the first two games of that series - their first ever series win over the Seminoles - to get to 20-9 overall and 6-5 in the ACC. The rest as they say is history, as the team posted its only winning record in the ACC (16-14) and advanced to both the ACC and NCAA Tournaments.

## English Field - Home of the Hokies

English Field was officially dedicated during a special ceremony on April 8, 1989 and is named for the late E.R. 'Red' English and his wife, Ruth, who provided financial support for construction of the field.

English, a native of Altavista, Va., played as an offensive and defensive guard on the Tech football teams from 1930-33 and graduated from Tech in 1934. English contributed to Tech athletics for more than 50 years and was one of the founders of The Student Aid Association in 1949. He served as president of that organization two of its first three years. English received the most outstanding alumni award at Tech in 1984.

Through a generous gift from alumnus George Sampson, the home team dugout was named for long-time Tech baseball coach G.F. 'Red' Laird during a ceremony on April 12, 1991. Laird recruited and coached Sampson at Tech.

The Tech athletics department continues to make upgrades to the facility, with its newest completed in the spring of 2012. The natural grass surface was replaced with artificial turf. The \$1 million field enables the Hokies to practice even during inclement weather, as grounds keepers can remove snow off of it quickly.

Plus, it also drains quickly, allowing for a speedy resumption of play following any rain delays. Also, as part of this project, the dugouts were expanded to almost twice the size, and a new batter's eye and a new padded outfield fence were added.

The Hokies opened play at their new home with a 7-2 victory against George Mason on March 22, 1989, and went on to post a 17-7 home record during their first season in the facility. The team's year-by-year and overall mark in its 25th seasons at English Field can be seen in the graph on the right.

Prior to the 2004 season, a new lighting system was installed and the Hokies played their first baseball game under the lights in Blacksburg on April 28 of that year, defeating VMI, 8-0.

Before English Field, Tech played its home baseball games at Tech Park, where it compiled a 431-122-1 record over 34 seasons.

**The yo-yo that is the Tech ranking:** With its success the first weekend of the season, Tech found itself ranked in the Top 25 in the first in-season Baseball America poll, entering at No. 24. It marked the first time the Hokies had been ranked since the end of the 2010 season, when they were 16th in the BA poll heading into the NCAA Baseball Championship.

After dropping a pair to No. 14 Georgia Tech, the Hokies fell out of the top 25, but returned to the No. 24 position after a 5-1 week and an ACC sweep at Duke. They again fell out of the rankings after a 2-2 week that included a pair of losses at Miami.

**Facing ranked teams:** In the column to the left is the history of Virginia Tech baseball versus ranked opponents all-time, as well as a detailed breakdown of the Hokies under head coach Pete Hughes.

With No. 4 Florida State coming to town, the second game will mark the 40th time under Hughes that the Hokies have faced a team in the top 5. All-time, Tech is 8-30 against teams ranked in the top five, while they are 3-6 against teams ranked No. 4.

**Facing RV teams:** Although Tech is just 1-3 against ranked opponents this year (top 30), Tech was 5-0 against teams receiving votes in various polls the week they played them - Kent State (2-0), UNCW (2-0) and Radford (1-0) (chart on left).

**As a ranked team:** The Hokies aren't ranked this week, but as a ranked team, under Hughes, overall they are 30-18 - a respectable 9-12 against other ranked teams - and 16-6 at English Field. They are 10-6 as a ranked team this year.

**Four games versus 2012 conference champs:** In the opening weekend of 2013, Tech was the only team in the country to face two conference tournament champions (who were also picked to repeat), and went 4-0 over the weekend.

Tech was one of just four teams in the nation that started the year with a total of four games against a team (or teams) that won a 2012 conference tournament title. The others:

- Portland (0-4) at Mississippi State (SEC)
- Miss. Valley St. (1-3) vs. Prairie View A&M (SWAC)
- West Michigan (0-4) at Pepperdine (West Coast)

**Tech in Blacksburg:** All-time, Tech is 408-212-3 in 24 seasons at English Field (chart previous page). The Hokies are also 1,178-499-17 in games played in Blacksburg and a 6-4 this year.

**Helping to Strike Out ALS:** The Virginia Tech baseball team is partnering with Bull & Bones Brewhaus and Grill to help raise awareness and funds for ALS research. With every strikeout recorded by Tech's pitching staff this season, \$5 will be donated to The Angel Fund in the name of Pete Frates - a former Hughes player (at Boston College) who was diagnosed with the disease just last year. The amount will go up to \$10 for strikeouts recorded in any ACC Tournament game and \$25 for any strikeout in an NCAA Regional or Super Regional game.

**A long non-conference win streak comes to an end:** The Hokies ended the 2012 season on an 18-game non-conference winning streak, the longest streak at the school since 1982, when Tech posted 20 straight in a single season. There has been just three streaks longer than the 2012 Hokies' streak in a single season.

Tech then extended its non-conference winning streak to 22 straight, before losing to Temple (2/23). That streak was the third longest ever in the program's history (spanning more than one season and excluding postseason).

Before the loss to the Owls, the Hokies were just three wins shy of matching the streak that set the standard almost a century ago.

**More non-conference win streaks end:** With the Hokies' 4-3 loss to Elon earlier this season, a pair of Hokie win streaks were snapped by the Phoenix.

First, a 21-game midweek non-conference win streak came to an end - the last loss was on March 29, 2011 versus Radford (7-5).

The other was a 14-game midweek non-conference road win streak - the last loss was on April 22, 2009 at Liberty (ironically 4-3).

With the Hokies' loss to VMI on Tuesday, it ended a 14-game winning streak on Tuesdays, the last loss being the Radford defeat.

**Comeback wins:** Certainly, it's up for debate what is truly a comeback win, but last year Tech pulled out wins in 25 games in which they trailed. However there should be no debate to the 19 times they came back when trailing as late as entering their at-bats in the fifth and included four games entering their at-bats in the ninth.

They have four wins this year when trailing as late as their half of the fifth frame.

**Comeback win - not necessary in first weekend:** Twenty-five of 34 (73.5 percent) of Tech's victories last year saw the team trail at one time during the contest. This season, its been just eight of 18 (44.4 percent).

The reason, Tech did not trail at any point during its first weekend. More impressive, excluding its first at-bats of the game, the Hokies came to the plate just four times in 30 innings with the game tied. That was mostly due to the team scoring in the first frame in three of the games.

So far this year, the Hokies have 32 first-inning runs (compared to allowing just five). They are 9-3 when scoring in the first inning.

**Still haven't trailed too often:** Going into weekend number six, the Hokies have come to the plate just 62 times in 227 innings (27.3 percent of the time) trailing in the contest. That includes 35 times in ACC games (82 innings, 42.6 percent). The ACC innings include 18 versus Georgia Tech, in which they won one, seven times in a three-game sweep at Duke, and 10 frames at Miami.

**A welcomed rest:** Tech's scheduled game with William & Mary on March 6 was cancelled due to weather, giving Tech a four-day rest heading into its first weekend ACC series. It may have been welcomed as the Hokies were just coming off a stretch of playing nine games in nine days - they went 7-2 - and a week in which they played six games - 5-1.

The last time that happened was in 2010, when Virginia Tech played nine games from March 12-20, and they went just 4-5. They also played six games in a week in that span (March 15-20) and posted a 2-4 mark.

**Starting pitching a question coming in:** A huge unknown entering the 2013 season was going to be starting pitching, as the Hokies returned just 15 career starts from its rotation minus those of staff ace **Joe Mantiplly** and his 34 career starts. Interestingly, Mantiplly has made just three starts all season, while **Brad Markey** and **Devin Burke** have made six each, **Tanner McIntyre** has made four and **Eddie Campbell** and **Sean Keselica** also have made three each.

In those 22 starts, those five (minus Mantiplly) have combined for 13 quality starts (6.0+ IP, 3ER or less) and in seven games, the starter has lasted at least seven innings.

**Burke in rare company: Devin Burke** improved to 5-0 with his win over Duke two weekends ago to become the first Tech pitcher as a member of the ACC to win his first five starts in a season. He also joined Rhett Ballard (2007) as the only pitchers to earn wins in the first two ACC weekends.

Josh Biber was the last Hokie starter to post a 5-0 mark, but that was after six starts of the 2003 season (as a member of the Big East). Joe Saunders was the last Hokie to post a 6-0 mark, but that was after nine starts during the 2002 season. Brad Clontz was Tech's last pitcher to win his first five starts, and actually won his first seven starts to the 1992 season.

Burke was on the losing end of a 2-0 loss at Miami, ending his bid to make it six for six.

**Pounding out some offense at Duke:** Tech registered a season-high 16 hits in a 14-7 win at Duke, which was the most by the team in an ACC game since 2011, when the team had 18 against Florida State (4/16). The 14 runs scored were the most scored in an ACC game by Tech since May 15, 2000 when the Hokies beat Duke at English Field, 18-8. The last time they scored 14 or more on the road in the ACC was a 19-18 loss at NC State on March 29, 2009.

**Making some history at Duke:** In the March 16 game at Duke, **Tyler Horan** recorded a pair of triples, tying both a Tech and ACC record for most triples in a game. He became the 13th Hokie to do it, the last was Alex Perez, last year against Boston College. He became the 57th ACC player to accomplish the feat.

**The road sweep and ACC win streak:** Tech swept its first ever road ACC series outside of Maryland (2009 and 2011) with its sweep at Duke. The three wins also extended the Hokies' ACC win streak to four games for just the third time in their history (2010 - five and 2009 - six).

**After 500 came 200?: Pete Hughes** notched his 500th career win as a baseball coach with the Hokies' victory at Duke on March 17. With the Hokies' win at Miami a week later (March 24), Hughes picked up career win number 200 as Tech's head coach.

**Another rare feat: Sean Keselica** won his second game of the season after throwing six frames in a start against Liberty on March 19. He also hit a two-run home run in the game, becoming the first Hokie to hit a home run and pick up a win as the starting pitcher since Larry Bowles accomplished the feat on May 1, 1999 at Duquesne.

**Hokies walk-off seven times:** Under Hughes, Tech has registered 12 walk-off victories in six years, which included seven last season.

**Andrew Rash's** solo home run in game 1 of a doubleheader against Yale (3/4/12) lifted the Hokies to a 6-5 win. He became the second Hokie (under Hughes) to hit a walk-off home run, as Austin Wates did the same, but in the 10th of a 5-4 win over No. 10 Virginia (5/14/09). Of the 12 walk-off wins, three have been in extra innings.

**Speaking of extra innings:** Last weekend, when the Hokies defeated Miami, 8-5 in 10 innings on Sunday, it marked the sixth straight victory in extra innings on the road for the team. Their last extra inning road loss was at North Carolina on March 15, 2008.

In regular-season games, Tech has won eight-of-nine (since the Wates' home run), with the only loss a 4-2 decision in 11 innings to NC State last year at English Field.
