Tech faces third straight top five program at home

The series: Tech continues its 120th season of baseball this weekend with a three-game ACC series against No 5 Virginia, the third straight home series for the Hokies against a team ranked nationally in the top 5, and the fourth overall against a top 15 opponent at English Field.

Facing the Cavaliers: The Hokies have faced Virginia 168 times in their history, which trails only Tuesday's opponent VMI in most games played against any one team (175). Tech's overall mark is 78-90, but own a 40-31 record in games played at home, 12-12 at English Field.

Facing the nation's best: With this series against another top five team, it will mark the first time Tech will host three teams ranked fifth or better in its history.

Only twice before have the Hokies hosted three teams in the top 10 - in 2009: No. 1 UNC, No. 3 GT and No. 10 UVa; and 2011: No. 1 UVa, No. 8 FSU and No. 8 GT.

It will mark the fourth time the Hokies will face three teams ranked in the top five in a single season, also doing it in 2010, 2008 and 2007.

Doing it first: With this weekend's series, the Hokies become the first team in the country this season to face three top five

opponents (ranked in top five in at least three of the four major polls - see page 4). Five teams in the nation have faced top five teams twice already - Auburn, Maryland, Mississippi State, Missouri and Washington.

Knocking off a top five team: Tech has won a series against a top five opponent three times in its history, and two have been against No. 4 Florida State (at FSU in 2010 and this season). Tech's other series win was at No. 3 Georgia Tech, also in 2010. Hence, the Hokies won their first ever series over a top five opponent at English Field with their win over the Seminoles.

English Field - Home of the Hokies

English Field was officially dedicated during a special ceremony on April 8, 1989 and is named for the late E.R. 'Red' English and his wife, Ruth, who provided financial support for construction of the field.

English, a native of Altavista, Va., played as an offensive and defensive guard on the Tech football

teams from 1930-33 and graduated from Tech in 1934. English contributed to Tech athletics for more than 50 years and was one of the founders of The Student Aid Association in 1949. He served as president of that organization two of its first three years. English received the most outstanding alumni award at Tech in 1984.

Through a generous gift from alumnus George Sampson, the home team dugout was named for long-time Tech baseball coach G.F. 'Red' Laird during a ceremony on April 12, 1991. Laird recruited and coached Sampson at Tech.

The Tech athletics department continues to make upgrades to the facility, with its newest completed in the spring of 2012. The natural grass surface was replaced with artificial turf. The \$1 million field enables the Hokies to practice even during inclement weather, as grounds keepers can remove snow off of it quickly.

Plus, it also drains quickly, allowing for a speedy resumption of play following any rain delays. Also, as part of this project, the dugouts were expanded to almost twice the size, and a new batter's eye and a new padded outfield fence were added.

The Hokies opened play at their new home with a 7-2 victory against George Mason on March 22, 1989, and went on to post a 17-7 home record during their first season in the facility. The team's year-by-year and overall mark in its 25th seasons at English Field can be seen in the graph on the right.

Prior to the 2004 season, a new lighting system was installed and the Hokies played their first baseball game under the lights in Blacksburg on April 28 of that year, defeating VMI, 8-0.

Before English Field, Tech played its home baseball games at Tech Park, where it compiled a 431-122-1 record over 34 seasons.

The yo-yo that was the Tech ranking: With its success the first weekend of the season, Tech found itself ranked in the Top 25 in the first in-season Baseball America poll, entering at No. 24. It marked the first time the Hokies had been ranked since the end of the 2010 season, when they were 16th in the BA poll heading into the NCAA Baseball Championship.

The Hokies had been on a yo-yo since entering and dropping out practically every other weekend. After dropping a pair to No. 14 Georgia Tech, the Hokies fell out of the top 25, but returned to the No. 24 position after a 5-1 week and an ACC sweep at Duke. They fell out of the rankings after a 2-2 week that included a pair of losses at Miami, but found themselves back in the poll at No. 22 after a series win over No. 4 Florida State.

They fell out after being swept at No. 25 NC State and have not returned.

Facing ranked teams: In the column to the left is the record of Tech baseball versus ranked opponents all-time, as well as a detailed breakdown under head coach Pete Hughes.

Overall in Blacksburg, Tech now holds a 24-52 record all-time against ranked opponents after dropping three to visiting No. 1 UNC two weeks ago.

The Hokies are 3-10 this season against teams ranked in the top 30 - vs. No. 1 UNC (0-3), vs. No. 4 FSU (2-1), vs. No. 14 GT (1-2), vs. No. 22 Notre Dame (0-1) and at No. 25 NC State (0-3).

Facing a ranked Virginia squad: In 22 of the last 23 meetings between the two schools, the Cavaliers have been ranked in the national polls. In those, Tech is 4-18 against them, and includes a 2-7 mark at home. Fifteen of those previous games have seen Virginia ranked in the top 10, including six when they were No. 1.

Facing a team ranked No. 5: In its history, Tech has played just six games against teams ranked No. 5 in the country and lost all six as both were three-game ACC sets. The first was May 13-15, 2005 at Georgia Tech, and the last time was March 30-April 1, 2007 versus Virginia at English Field.

Facing RV squads: Tech is 5-0 against teams receiving votes in various polls the week they played them - Kent State (2-0), UNCW (2-0) and Radford (1-0) (chart on left).

Tech in Blacksburg: All-time, Tech is 412-214-3 in 24 seasons at English Field (*chart previous* page) and is also 1,182-501-17 in games played in Blacksburg, 10-8 this year.

Helping to Strike Out ALS: The Virginia Tech baseball team is partnering with Bull & Bones Brewhaus and Grill to help raise awareness and funds for ALS research. With every strikeout recorded by Tech's pitching staff this season, \$5 will be donated to The Angel Fund in the name of Pete Frates - a former Hughes player (at Boston College) who was diagnosed with the disease just last year. The amount will go up to \$10 for strikeouts recorded in any ACC Tournament game and \$25 for any strikeout in an NCAA Regional or Super Regional game.

Comeback wins: Certainly, it's up for debate what is truly a comeback win, but last year Tech pulled out wins in 25 games in which they trailed. However there should be no debate to the 19 times they came back when trailing as late as entering their at-bats in the fifth and that included four games entering their at-bats in the ninth.

They have just six wins this year when trailing as late as their half of the fifth frame.

Comeback win - not necessary - especially in first weekend: In twenty-five of Tech's 34 wins (73.5 percent) last year, the team trailed at least once during the contest. This season, it's been just 10 of 25 (40.0 percent).

One reason is Tech did not trail at any point during its first weekend and excluding its first at-bats of the game, the Hokies came to the plate just four times in 30 innings with the game tied. That was mostly due to the team scoring in the first frame in three of the games.

So far this year, the Hokies have scored 44 first-inning runs (compared to allowing just 28). They are 12-5 when scoring in the first inning and 17-7 when scoring first.

Still haven't trailed too often: Going into the weekend, the Hokies have come to the plate just 125 times in 374 innings (33.5 percent of the time) trailing in the contest. That includes 79 times in ACC games (195 innings, 40.5 percent). The ACC innings include 18 versus Georgia Tech, in which they won one, seven times in a three-game sweep at Duke, 10 frames at Miami, nine against Florida State, 11 at NC State, 19 against UNC and just five at Maryland.

At least taking a split: After splitting the doubleheader at Maryland last weekend, the Hokies have not lost both ends of a doubleheader (or two games in a single day, with both games starting on the same day) since May 14, 2011, versus Clemson. In those 10 doubleheaders, the Hokies have won five and have split the other five in that span and includes going 2-0-3 this season.

20 wins, no fooling: The Hokies said farewell to the month of March with a 20-9 record, thanks to a series win over FSU. Only twice in their history before this year had the Hokies reached the 20-win mark before April 1 - 1985 (March 30) and 1992 (March 29). They won game 20 this year on March 30.

Also, now only 18 times in their history had they reached 20 wins before its 30th game, the last time 2010 (20-9), while in 2003 it took just 28 games and 1993 it took 27 games.

Hokies walk-off seven times: Under Hughes, Tech has registered 13 walk-off victories in seven years, which included seven last season. The team registered its first of the year April 9 versus Longwood when Tyler Horan smacked a two-run home run in the 10th frame to lift the Hokies to a 7-5 victory. Horan became just the third player under Hughes to hit a walk-off home run, joining Andrew Rash and Austin Wates.

Rash hit a solo home run in game 1 of a doubleheader against Yale (3/4/12) lifting the Hokies to a 6-5 win. Wates did the same - a solo home run - but in the 10th of a 5-4 win over No. 10 Virginia (5/14/09). Of the 13 walk-off wins, four have been in extra innings.

Speaking of extra innings: The Hokies have now gone extra innings five times this year, tying a single season record. With their 3-2 mark, the wins tie for the most extra-inning victories in a single season with the 2007 squad (3-1 in four games) and the 2006 team (3-2 in five extra-inning games).

When the Hokies defeated Miami, 8-5 in 10 frames, it marked the sixth straight victory in extra innings on the road for the team. Their last extra-inning road loss was at North Carolina on March 15, 2008 before succumbing to NC State in 14 frames two Fridays ago.

The 14 frames matched the longest games ever played (by inning) in the program's history - March 30, 1995, a 6-5 loss at James Madison and April 9, 1990, a 5-4 win over Liberty.

More on extra innings: In its last 20 extra-inning games, Tech is 12-8 and, interestingly, of those 20 games, they are 6-8 against opponents from either North or South Carolina.

Three of the losses were to the Wolfpack, 8-7 in 10 innings (April 5), 4-2 in 11 innings May 11, 2012 at English Field and a 10-9 in 10 frames May 29, 2010, at the ACC Championship tournament in Greensboro, N.C. Two losses are to UNC, 9-8 last Saturday, and 6-5 in 11 frames March 15 2008. The Hokies have also lost one to Wake Forest (15-14 in 10 on 4/4/09), Coastal Carolina (4-3 in 10 on 2/25/08) and Clemson (5-2 in 10 on 4/8/07).

The last time Tech lost in extras to a team not from a Carolina state was also the last time they played back-to-back extra-inning games, at Boston College (March 25-26).

After 500 came 200?: Pete Hughes notched his 500th career win as a baseball coach with the Hokies' victory at Duke on March 17. With the Hokies' win at Miami a week later (March 24), Hughes picked up career win number 200 as Tech's head coach. (Hughes' year-by-year can be seen on page 3)

Helping Hughes to 200: Andrew Rash has played in 106 of Hughes' victories (207) as his record stands at 106-74 (a 58.9 winning percentage). Only two men have helped Hughes to more wins at Tech than Rash - Ronnie Shaban (2009-12) compiled a 123-80 (60.6%) mark and Michael Seaborn (2008-11) held a 116-97 (54.5%) record.

More on Rash: In his four-year career at Tech, Rash is now among the top 10 in many offensive categories since the team has been playing in the ACC. He is first in home runs (38, 13 more than the closest player, Seaborn), second in RBI (150, 28 behind first), total bases (370, seven back), slugging percentage (.586), and tied for second in doubles (51, 14 back). He is third in hit-by-pitch (29, two back of first), fourth in runs (132), sixth in hits (199) and seventh in games played (180), started (161) and at-bats (631). In a Tech career, he is five doubles and five home runs back of tying for the top five.

Burke was in rare company: Devin Burke improved to 5-0 with his win over Duke to become the first Tech pitcher as a member of the ACC to win his first five starts in a season. He also joined Rhett Ballard (2007) as the only pitchers to earn wins in the first two ACC weekends.

Josh Biber was the last Hokie starter to post a 5-0 mark, but that was after six starts of the 2003 season (as a member of the Big East). Joe Saunders was the last Hokie to post a 6-0 mark, but that was after nine starts during the 2002 season. Brad Clontz was Tech's last pitcher to win his first five starts, and actually won his first seven starts to the 1992 season.

Burke was on the losing end of a 2-0 loss at Miami, ending his bid to make it six for six.

Mantiply returned to form: Joe Mantiply, who missed three starts due to forearm stiffness, has now improved to 3-0 on the season (all ACC wins) with his seven scoreless frames at Maryland last weekend. He also has a win in starts at Duke and versus Florida State, which at the time, he joined Georgia Tech's Buck Farmer as the only two pitchers with two career regular season wins over Florida State - he also beat the Seminoles 2-1 back in 2011.

The only Hokie starting pitcher to post a 3-0 record in the ACC before Mantiply was Mathew Price during the 2010 season, while Justin Wright was 3-0 in 2008 (one win out of the pen) and Tanner McIntyre was 3-0 last year (all out of the pen).

More on Mantiply: In his four-year career at Tech, Mantiply is now among the top three in a number of categories since the team has been playing in the ACC. He ranks first in career starts (41, seven better than the next pitcher), second in innings pitched (264.0, 10 behind first), and third in wins (17, two behind) and strikeouts (207, 56 behind). He has a chance to become just the second pitcher to win 10 ACC games, entering the weekend with ninth, with only Justin Wright having more with 12.

ACC game three success: Thanks in part to Mantiply (the team was 3-0 in his three game three starts), the Hokies have now matched the most game threes wins ever during an ACC season with the 2010 squad, who also won five. They have outscored their opponents 34-22 in game threes this season.

In their history in the ACC, the Hokies had never won four straight games (in terms of game 1s, game 2s or game 3s) until this year when they won their first four game threes of the season (Mantiply actually closed the game three win versus Georgia Tech in the first ACC weekend). Prior, Tech's longest streak before was three in a row, done seven times.

The most games won, in terms of series games, is six game one victories during the 2010 season.

Pounding out some offense at Duke: Tech registered a season-high 16 hits in a 14-7 win at Duke, which was the most by the team in an ACC game since 2011, when the team had 18 against Florida State (4/16). The 14 runs scored were the most scored in an ACC game by Tech since May 15, 2000 when the Hokies beat Duke at English Field, 18-8. The last time they scored 14 or more on the road in the ACC was a 19-18 loss at NC State on March 29, 2009.

The Hokies matched their season-high for hits with 16, now done four times, with a 16-hit, 11-run outing in their shutout victory at Maryland last weekend.

The road sweep and ACC win streak: Tech swept its first ever road ACC series outside of Maryland (2009 and 2011) with its sweep at Duke. The three wins also extended the Hokies' ACC win streak to four games for just the third time in their history (2010 - five and 2009 - six).

Interestingly, Tech has only swept two ACC home weekends, both against Boston College, winning three in both 2010 and 2012.

Making some history at Duke: In the March 16 game at Duke, **Tyler Horan** recorded a pair of triples, tying both a Tech and ACC record for most triples in a game. He became the 13th Hokie to do it, the last was Alex Perez, last year against Boston College (April 6). He became the 57th ACC player to accomplish the feat.

Another rare feat: Sean Keselica won his second game of the season after throwing six frames in a start against Liberty on March 19. He also hit a two-run home run in the game, becoming the first Hokie to hit a home run and pick up a win as the starting pitcher since Larry Bowles accomplished the feat on May 1, 1999 at Duquesne.



Home (state) away from home: During the 2013 season, Tech is scheduled to play 28 games at English Field, a good sign, because entering the season the team had a .659 winning percentage in its 24-year history and have had just two losing seasons at their home.

Of their 28 road games scheduled, the Hokies played in the state of North Carolina 16 times, which got them used to the I-81 to I-77 road trip. The results - 4-0 start to open the season, a 3-1 mark the third weekend, a 4-1 stretch during the fifth weekend that included a three-game sweep at Duke, and an 0-3 record in an ACC weekend at NC State to conclude the regular season 11-5 in the state.

The other locations Tech traveled to, so far, included three games in the state of Florida (went 1-2 at Miami) and Maryland (2-1 versus the Terrapins) and one in Tennessee (0-1 against the Vols). They only have a trip to Radford (Tuesday) and an ACC series in Massachusetts (Boston College) left.

The 28 games in North Carolina does not include any games in the ACC Championship, if the Hokies advance, which will be played in Durham at the DBAP. Interestingly, with its three-game sweep earlier at Duke, Tech has now won five straight games at DBAP.

Hosting the top teams: This weekend, as stated, will mark the first time Tech will host three top five teams in the same season. They have, however, hosted two top five teams four times before at English Field. Below are all four years and the results.

According to Warren: The website WarrenNolan.com has the Hokies playing the third toughest schedule in all of Division I baseball (vs. only DI opponents) behind Florida and Miami. They trail both schools in three different categories. Tech's strength of schedule is .5935 to Florida's .6214 and Miami's .6119. In opponents' winning percentage, Tech's is .6180 to the Gators' .6601 and the Hurricanes' 6450. Lastly, the Hokies' opponents have compiled 1021 wins trailing only Florida's 1045 and Miami's 1030 (the number does not including wins against that team).

It will be interesting to see the numbers after this weekend, as Tech will play Virginia (37 wins coming in), while Florida has Tennessee (17 wins) and Miami is at 6-game winner Boston College.

A doser look at the opponents: Of the Hokies' 42 games played this season, only four of the teams are currently under .500 (Tennessee and VMI account for two games each). Of those six games Tech has played against teams currently under .500, only one has less than 15 wins entering the weekend, opposed to 36 of them already with 20 wins - 19 have at least 25 victories, 11 have 30 wins.

Ten of their last 13 games are against teams with at least 20 wins already.

A long non-conference win streak comes to an end: The Hokies ended the 2012 season on an 18-game non-conference winning streak, the longest streak at the school since 1982, when Tech posted 20 straight in a single season. There has been just three streaks longer than the 2012 Hokies' streak in a single season.

Tech then extended its non-conference winning streak to 22 straight, before losing to Temple (2/23). That streak was the third longest ever in the program's history (spanning more than one season and excluding postseason).

Before the loss to the Owls, the Hokies were just three wins shy of matching the streak that set the standard almost a century ago.

More non-conference win streaks end: With the Hokies' 4-3 loss to Elon earlier this season, a pair of Hokie win streaks were snapped by the Phoenix.

First, a 21-game midweek non-conference win streak came to an end - the last loss was on March 29, 2011 versus Radford (7-5). The other was a 14-game midweek non-conference road win streak - the last loss was on April 22, 2009 at Liberty (ironically 4-3).

With the Hokies' loss to VMI on Tuesday, March 26, it ended a 14-game winning streak on Tuesdays, the last loss being the Radford defeat.

WHAT'S A HOKIE

That's the most frequently asked question regarding Virginia Tech athletics. The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute.

With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body. Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Old Hokie" yell which still is used today.

Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the words he used had no hidden or symbolic meaning, but had been thought up in an effort to get attention. Hokie soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

Following is the "Old Hokie" yell in its original form:

Hoki, Hoki, Hoki Hy! Tech! Tech! V.P.I.! Sola-Rex Sola-Rah Polytech-Vir-gin-i-a!! Rae, Ri, V.P.I.

JUST VIRGINIA TECH, PLEASE

While the full name of the school is Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, the school is commonly referred to as "Virginia Tech."

Founded in 1872, as Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College, the university changed its named to Virginia Polytechnic Institute in 1896

Fans of the athletic department, as well as media covering the Hokies, shortened the name to VPI, but it eventually became Virginia Tech.

The "State University" was added in 1970 to bring the official title to what it is today.

Those covering Hokie athletics are asked to refer to the university as simply "Virginia Tech."

Virginia Tech University, VPI and SU, VPI&SU, VT or VA Tech are not recognized names and should not be used.
