Tech takes last regular-season road trip to Boston College

The weekend: Tech continues its 120th season of baseball this weekend with a three-game ACC series at Boston College, which concludes the Hokies regular-season road schedule, as they close with seven straight home games.

Facing the Eagles: Tech is 15-14 all-time against Boston College, and have won four in a row in the series. However, the Hokies are just 3-9 at the Eagles home and have never won a series at BC, in either ACC or Big East play.

Doing it first: With last weekend's series, the Hokies become the first team in the country this year to face three top five opponents (ranked in top five in at least three of the four major polls - see page 4). Just five other teams have faced top five teams twice, so far - Arizona State, Auburn, Maryland, Mississippi State, Missouri and Washington - while Florida, Long Beach State and South Carolina face their second this weekend.

Knocking off a top five team: Tech had won a series against a top five opponent just twice in its history before this year, and both were on the road and in 2010 - at No. 4 Florida State and at No. 3 Georgia Tech. The Hokies have done it again, knocking off two top five teams this year, but this time both were at English Field, as they defeated No. 4 Florida State and No. 5 Virginia.

Doing it first, again: By knocking off No. 5 Virginia last weekend, the Hokies became the first team in the nation to beat two top five teams this year. Only four other schools can claim a series win (or two wins in one weekend) over one top five school (same criteria as above) and that is South Carolina, San Diego, Washington and Arizona State.

Joe Mantiply is the only starting pitching in the nation with wins over two top five teams, while Max MacNabb of San Diego also has two, but both were in relief outings versus Oregon State.

English Field - Home of the Hokies

English Field was officially dedicated during a special ceremony on April 8, 1989 and is named for the late E.R. 'Red' English and his wife, Ruth, who provided financial support for construction of the field.

English, a native of Altavista, Va., played as an offensive and defensive guard on the Tech football teams from 1930-33 and graduated from Tech in 1934. English contributed to Tech athletics for more than 50 years and was one of the founders of The Student Aid Association in 1949. He served as president of that organization two of its first three years. English received the most outstanding alumni award at Tech in 1984.

Through a generous gift from alumnus George Sampson, the home team dugout was named for long-time Tech baseball coach G.F. 'Red' Laird during a ceremony on April 12, 1991. Laird recruited and coached Sampson at Tech.

The Tech athletics department continues to make upgrades to the facility, with its newest completed in the spring of 2012. The natural grass surface was replaced with artificial turf. The \$1 million field enables the Hokies to practice even during inclement weather, as grounds keepers can remove snow off of it quickly.

Plus, it also drains quickly, allowing for a speedy resumption of play following any rain delays. Also, as part of this project, the dugouts were expanded to almost twice the size, and a new batter's eye and a new padded outfield fence were added.

The Hokies opened play at their new home with a 7-2 victory against George Mason on March 22, 1989, and went on to post a 17-7 home record during their first season in the facility. The team's year-by-year and overall mark in its 25th seasons at English Field can be seen in the graph on the right.

Prior to the 2004 season, a new lighting system was installed and the Hokies played their first baseball game under the lights in Blacksburg on April 28 of that year, defeating VMI, 8-0.

Before English Field, Tech played its home baseball games at Tech Park, where it compiled a 431-122-1 record over 34 seasons.

The yo-yo that was the Tech ranking: With its success the first weekend of the season, Tech found itself ranked in the Top 25 in the first in-season Baseball America poll, entering at No. 24. It marked the first time the Hokies had been ranked since the end of the 2010 season, when they were 16th in the BA poll heading into the NCAA Baseball Championship.

The Hokies have been on a yo-yo since, entering and dropping out practically every other weekend. After dropping a pair to No. 14 Georgia Tech, the Hokies fell out of the top 25, but returned to the No. 24 position after a 5-1 week and an ACC sweep at Duke. They fell out of the rankings after a 2-2 week that included a pair of losses at Miami, but found themselves back in the poll at No. 22 after a series win over No. 4 Florida State.

They fell out after being swept at No. 25 NC State and did not return until this week, after taking a series from then No. 5 Virginia, the Hokies are back in at No. 25.

Facing ranked teams: In the column to the left is the record of Tech baseball versus ranked opponents all-time, as well as a detailed breakdown under head coach Pete Hughes.

Overall in Blacksburg, Tech now holds a 26-53 record all-time against ranked opponents after defeating the Cavaliers in two of three meetings last weekend.

The Hokies are 5-11 this season against teams ranked in the top 30 - vs. No. 1 UNC (0-3), vs. No. 4 FSU (2-1), vs. No. 5 UVa (2-1), vs. No. 14 GT (1-2), vs. No. 22 Notre Dame (0-1) and at No. 25 NC State (0-3).

As a ranked team: Under head coach Pete Hughes, the Hokies have been ranked during just two seasons, this year and back in 2010. Below is a chart that breaks down all the scenarios for the Hokies as a ranked team.

Helping to Strike Out ALS: The Virginia Tech baseball team is partnering with Bull & Bones Brewhaus and Grill to help raise awareness and funds for ALS research. With every strikeout recorded by Tech's pitching staff this season, \$5 will be donated to The Angel Fund in the name of Pete Frates - a former Hughes player (at Boston College) who was diagnosed with the disease just last year. The amount will go up to \$10 for strikeouts recorded in any ACC Tournament game and \$25 for any strikeout in an NCAA Regional or Super Regional game.

Comeback wins: Certainly, it's up for debate what is truly a comeback win, but last year Tech pulled out wins in 25 games in which they trailed. However there should be no debate to the 19 times they came back when trailing as late as entering their at-bats in the fifth and that included four games entering their at-bats in the ninth.

They have just six wins this year when trailing as late as their half of the fifth frame.

Comeback win - not necessary - especially in first weekend: In twenty-five of Tech's 34 wins (73.5 percent) last year, the team trailed at least once during the contest. This season, it's been just 10 of 25 (40.0 percent).

One reason is Tech did not trail at any point during its first weekend and excluding its first at-bats of the game, the Hokies came to the plate just four times in 30 innings with the game tied. That was mostly due to the team scoring in the first frame in three of the games.

So far this year, the Hokies have scored 44 first-inning runs (compared to allowing just 28). They are 12-5 when scoring in the first inning and 17-7 when scoring first.

Still haven't trailed too often: Going into the weekend, the Hokies have come to the plate just 135 times in 408 innings (33.1 percent of the time) trailing in the contest. That includes 89 times in ACC games (220 innings, 40.5 percent). The ACC innings include 18 versus Georgia Tech, seven times in a three-game sweep at Duke, 10 frames at Miami, nine against Florida State, 11 at NC State, 19 against UNC, just five at Maryland and 10 times against Virginia.

At least taking a split: After sweeping a doubleheader versus Virginia last weekend (the Cavaliers first time swept since 2008), the Hokies have not lost both ends of a doubleheader (or two games in a single day, with both games starting on the same day) since May 14, 2011, versus Clemson. In those 11 doubleheaders, the Hokies have won six and have split the other five in that span and includes going 3-0-3 this season.

20 wins, no fooling: The Hokies said farewell to the month of March with a 20-9 record, thanks to a series win over FSU. Only twice in their history before this year had the Hokies reached the 20-win mark before April 1 - 1985 (March 30) and 1992 (March 29). They won game 20 this year on March 30.

Also, now only 18 times in their history had they reached 20 wins before its 30th game, the last time 2010 (20-9), while in 2003 it took just 28 games and 1993 it took 27 games.

Hokies walk-off seven times: Under Hughes, Tech has registered 13 walk-off victories in seven years, which included seven last season. The team registered its first of the year April 9 versus Longwood when **Tyler Horan** smacked a two-run home run in the 10th frame to lift the Hokies to a 7-5 victory. Horan became just the third player under Hughes to hit a walk-off home run, joining **Andrew Rash** and Austin Wates.

Rash hit a solo home run in game 1 of a doubleheader against Yale (3/4/12) lifting the Hokies to a 6-5 win. Wates did the same - a solo home run - but in the 10th of a 5-4 win over No. 10 Virginia (5/14/09). Of the 13 walk-off wins, four have been in extra innings.

Speaking of extra innings: The Hokies have now gone extra innings five times this year, tying a single season record. With their 3-2 mark, the wins tie for the most extra-inning victories in a single season with the 2007 squad (3-1 in four games) and the 2006 team (3-2 in five extra-inning games).

When the Hokies defeated Miami, 8-5 in 10 frames, it marked the sixth straight victory in extra innings on the road for the team. Their last extra-inning road loss was at North Carolina on March 15, 2008 before succumbing to NC State in 14 frames two Fridays ago.

The 14 frames matched the longest games ever played (by inning) in the program's history - March 30, 1995, a 6-5 loss at James Madison and April 9, 1990, a 5-4 win over Liberty.

More on extra innings: In its last 20 extra-inning games, Tech is 12-8 and, interestingly, of those 20 games, they are 6-8 against opponents from either North or South Carolina.

Three of the losses were to the Wolfpack, 8-7 in 10 innings (April 5), 4-2 in 11 innings May 11, 2012 at English Field and a 10-9 in 10 frames May 29, 2010, at the ACC Championship tournament in Greensboro, N.C. Two losses are to UNC, 9-8 last Saturday, and 6-5 in 11 frames March 15 2008. The Hokies have also lost one to Wake Forest (15-14 in 10 on 4/4/09), Coastal Carolina (4-3 in 10 on 2/25/08) and Clemson (5-2 in 10 on 4/8/07).

The last time Tech lost in extras to a team not from a Carolina state was also the last time they played back-to-back extra-inning games, at Boston College (March 25-26).

After 500 came 200?: Pete Hughes notched his 500th career win as a baseball coach with the Hokies' victory at Duke on March 17. With the Hokies' win at Miami a week later (March 24), Hughes picked up career win number 200 as Tech's head coach. (*Hughes' year-by-year can be seen on page 3*)

Helping Hughes to 200: Andrew Rash has played in 109 of Hughes' victories (210) as his record stands at 109-75 (a 59.2 winning percentage). Only two men have helped Hughes to more wins at Tech than Rash - Ronnie Shaban (2009-12) compiled a 123-80 (60.6%) mark and Michael Seaborn (2008-11) held a 116-97 (54.5%) record.

More on Rash: In his four-year career at Tech, Rash is now among the top 10 in many offensive categories since the team has been playing in the ACC. He is first in home runs (39, 14 more than the closest player) and total bases (381, four up), second in RBI (154, 24 behind first) and slugging percentage (.590), and T-second in doubles (51, 14 back). He is third in hit-by-pitch (29, two back of first), fourth in runs (136), T-fourth in hits (205), fifth in at-bats (646) and sixth in games played (184) and started (165). In a Tech career, he is five doubles and four homers back of tying for the top five.

Burke was in rare company: Devin Burke improved to 5-0 with his win over Duke to become the first Tech pitcher as a member of the ACC to win his first five starts in a season. He also joined Rhett Ballard (2007) as the only pitchers to earn wins in the first two ACC weekends.

Josh Biber was the last Hokie starter to post a 5-0 mark, but that was after six starts of the 2003 season (as a member of the Big East). Joe Saunders was the last Hokie to post a 6-0 mark, but that was after nine starts during the 2002 season. Brad Clontz was Tech's last pitcher to win his first five starts, and actually won his first seven starts to the 1992 season.

Burke was on the losing end of a 2-0 loss at Miami, ending his bid to make it six for six.

Mantiply returned to form: Joe Mantiply, who missed three starts due to forearm stiffness, has now improved to 4-0 on the season (all ACC wins) with his outing versus Virginia last weekend.

He also has a win in starts at Duke, versus Florida State - which at the time, he joined Georgia Tech's Buck Farmer as the only two active pitchers with two career regular season wins over Florida State, he also beat the Seminoles 2-1 back in 2011 - and at Maryland.

He became the first Hokie starting pitcher to post a 4-0 record in the ACC passing Mathew Price, who was 3-0 as a starter during the 2010 season. Only two pitchers - Price and Justin Wright - have ever won five games during an ACC season, as both were 5-2 in 2010.

More on Mantiply: In his four-year career at Tech, Mantiply is now among the top three in a number of categories since the team has been playing in the ACC. He ranks first in career starts (42, eight better than the next pitcher), second in innings pitched (271.0, 3.2 behind first), and third in wins (18, one behind) and strikeouts (212, 51 behind). He became just the second pitcher to win 10 ACC games joining Justin Wright (12) as the only two.

ACC game three success: Thanks in part to Mantiply (the team was 3-0 in his three game three starts), the Hokies have now won more game threes (6) during an ACC season than ever before, passing the 2010 squad that won five. They have outscored their opponents 45-28 in game threes this season.

In their history in the ACC, the Hokies had never won four straight games (in terms of game 1s, game 2s or game 3s) until this year when they won their first four game threes of the season (Mantiply closed the game three win versus Georgia Tech in the first ACC weekend). Prior, Tech's longest streak before was three in a row, done seven times.

They also have now tied the 2010 squad for most games won, in terms of series games, with the six game three wins. In the 2010 season, the team posted six game one victories.

Pounding out some offense at Duke: Tech registered a season-high 16 hits in a 14-7 win at Duke, which was the most by the team in an ACC game since 2011, when the team had 18 against Florida State (4/16). The 14 runs scored were the most scored in an ACC game by Tech since May 15, 2000 when the Hokies beat Duke at English Field, 18-8. The last time they scored 14 or more on the road in the ACC was a 19-18 loss at NC State on March 29, 2009.

The Hokies matched their season-high for hits with 16, now done four times, with a 16-hit, 11-run outing in their shutout victory at Maryland two weeks ago.

The road sweep and ACC win streak: Tech swept its first ever road ACC series outside of Maryland (2009 and 2011) with its sweep at Duke. The three wins also extended the Hokies' ACC win streak to four games for just the third time in their history (2010 - five and 2009 - six).

Tech has only swept two home ACC weekends, both against Boston College, in 2010 and 2012.

Making some history at Duke: In the March 16 game at Duke, **Tyler Horan** recorded a pair of triples, tying both a Tech and ACC record for most triples in a game. He became the 13th Hokie to do it, the last was Alex Perez, last year against Boston College (April 6). He became the 57th ACC player to accomplish the feat.

Another rare feat: Sean Keselica won his second game of the season on the mound after throwing six frames in a start against Liberty on March 19. He also hit a two-run home run in the game, becoming the first Hokie to hit a home run and pick up a win as the starting pitcher since Larry Bowles accomplished the feat on May 1, 1999 at Duquesne.

Home (state) away from home: During the 2013 season, Tech is scheduled to play 28 games at English Field, a good sign, because entering the season the team had a .659 winning percentage in its 24-year history and have had just two losing seasons at their home.

Of their 28 road games scheduled, the Hokies played in the state of North Carolina 16 times, which got them used to the I-81 to I-77 road trip. The results - 4-0 start to open the season, a 3-1 mark the third weekend, a 4-1 stretch during the fifth weekend that included a three-game sweep at Duke, and an 0-3 record in an ACC weekend at NC State to conclude the regular season 11-5 in the state.

The other locations Tech traveled to included three games in the state of Florida (1-2 at Miami) and Maryland (2-1 versus the Terrapins) and one in Tennessee (0-1 against the Vols). They had an in-state trip to Radford on Tuesday (a win) before ending with ACC series in Massachusetts (Boston College).

The 16 games in North Carolina does not include any games in the ACC Championship, if the Hokies advance, which will be played in Durham at the DBAP. Interestingly, with its three-game sweep earlier at Duke, Tech has now won five straight games at DBAP.

Hosting the top teams: Last weekend marked the first time Tech hosted three top five teams in the same season. However, they have, in prior seasons, hosted two top five teams three times before at English Field. Below are all four years and the results.

According to Warren: The website WarrenNolan.com has the Hokies playing the second toughest schedule in all of Division I baseball (vs. only DI opponents through Wednesday) behind Florida. They trail Florida in SOS .6126 to .5993, while Miami is third at .5942.

In the category of opponents' winning percentage, Tech's is third at .6263, while the Gators lead that as well at .6441, with Hawaii second at .6327. Lastly, the Hokies' opponents have compiled 1,235 wins, which is the most among DI schools, ahead of Wake Forest (1,205), Maryland (1,192) and Florida at 1,191 (the number does not including wins against that team).

A closer look at the opponents: Of the Hokies' 46 games played this season, only six of the teams are currently under .500 (Tennessee and VMI account for two games each). Of those eight games Tech has played against teams currently under .500, only one has less than 17 wins entering the weekend, opposed to 34 of them already with 25 wins, 14 have at least 30 victories, nine have 35 wins.

Six of their last nine games are against teams with at least 22 wins already.

A long non-conference win streak comes to an end: The Hokies ended the 2012 season on an 18-game non-conference winning streak, the longest streak at the school since 1982, when Tech posted 20 straight in a single season. There has been just three streaks longer than the 2012 Hokies' streak in a single season.

Tech then extended its non-conference winning streak to 22 straight, before losing to Temple (2/23). That streak was the third longest ever in the program's history (spanning more than one season and excluding postseason).

Before the loss to the Owls, the Hokies were just three wins shy of matching the streak that set the standard almost a century ago.

More non-conference win streaks end: With the Hokies' 4-3 loss to Elon earlier this season, a pair of Hokie win streaks were snapped by the Phoenix.

First, a 21-game midweek non-conference win streak came to an end - the last loss was on March 29, 2011 versus Radford (7-5). The other was a 14-game midweek non-conference road win streak - the last loss was on April 22, 2009 at Liberty (ironically 4-3).

With the Hokies' loss to VMI on Tuesday, March 26, it ended a 14-game winning streak on Tuesdays, the last loss being the Radford defeat.

WHAT'S A HOKIE

That's the most frequently asked question regarding Virginia Tech athletics. The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute.

With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body. Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Old Hokie" yell which still is used today.

Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the words he used had no hidden or symbolic meaning, but had been thought up in an effort to get attention. Hokie soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

Following is the "Old Hokie" yell in its original form:

Hoki, Hoki, Hoki Hy!
Tech! Tech! V.P.I.
Sola-Rex Sola-Rah
Polytech-Vir-gin-i-a!!
Rae, Ri, V.P.I.

JUST VIRGINIA TECH, PLEASE

While the full name of the school is Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, the school is commonly referred to as "Virginia Tech."

Founded in 1872, as Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College, the university changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute in 1896.

Fans of the athletic department, as well as media covering the Hokies, shortened the name to VPI, but it eventually became Virginia Tech.

The "State University" was added in 1970 to bring the official title to what it is today.

Those covering Hokie athletics are asked to refer to the university as simply "Virginia Tech."

Virginia Tech University, VPI and SU, VPI&SU, VT or VA Tech are not recognized names and should not be used.
