JMU ranked No. 13 in the 2012 meeting and has been ranked in eight of the ten meetings ... Tech was ranked No. 20 when it faced the No. 9 Dukes in 2011, this was the first time the Hokies broke into the top 20.

Scouting James Madison

James Madison enters the midweek game at 1-0 on the year after topping California at home 11-5 in its season opener. The Dukes outscored their opponent 8-3 in the second half to earn the victory.

Casey Ancarrow, who finished last season second on the team in scoring (34) and points (43,) helped lead the team with four goals, while Steph Finley also put away four goals, nearly matching her total of five from a year ago.

Schylar Healy got the season-opening win, making a career-high 14 saves. She finished last season with an 8-4 record and a .437 save percentage.

Scouting Mount St. Mary's

The Mount enters the week at 0-3 on the year and will not play a midweek game before arriving in Blacksburg on Saturday. Most recently, Mount St. Mary's fell at Columbia 15-4, and have yet to play a game at home.

Kaitlyn Larrimore leads the team so far with four goals on the year, while Hannah Gutscher has also tallied four points on the year. Gabe Little leads the defensive unit with 12 ground balls this season.

Sarah Jane Leder has a .529 save percentage this year and has started all three games. Leder has made 36 saves in her 120 minutes in cage.

Last Time Out

The Hokies righted the ship last week, bringing home two victories as they wrapped up a four-game road stretch that opened the season. Tech began the week of play with its first midweek game of 2013, at Davidson. The Hokies walked away with the 12-8 win. Senior Julia Heaps helped lead the attack with five points, by way of three assists and two goals, while sophomore Megan Will set a new career best with five points as well (4g, 1 a).

Tech kept things rolling with a thrashing of Coastal Carolina, 18-8. It was a true team effort for the squad as all 31 players checked into the game. While senior Brooke Martin led the charge with four goals, and Will added three of her own, the Hokies saw a great effort from junior Kelly Naslonski and sophomore Cawley Bromley. Naslonski put away two goals and assisted two more, while Bromley added a goal and two assists.

Senior Leaders

Captaining the Hokies this season will be seniors Libby Rosebro, Brooke Martin, Julia Heaps and Christina Patten. All four bring a wealth of on-field experience. Entering the season they have combined to play in 190 games and make 137 start, even with Heaps being sidelined for much of last season due to injury and Patten suffering a torn Achilles causing her to miss 2011.

Veteran Experience

Tech returns a wealth of experience this season as it welcomes back 12 seniors. As a class, these veterans have been an integral part of the transition the program has recently made. They have helped lead their squad to back-to-back winning seasons for the first time in over 10 years. They have also assisted in taking down ranked conference opponents in back-to-back years, topping then-No. 16 Boston College in 2011 and then-No. 7 Virginia in 2012.

Progressing Program

The Virginia Tech lacrosse team has seen a steady momentum shift over the past few seasons. Since former assistant Megan Burkner took over as head coach the Hokies have put together back-to-back 10-win seasons for the first time in program history while also knocking off ranked conference opponenets in back-to-back years. Tech earned its best ACC finish in 2011 when a tiebreak awarded the Hokies the three-seed in the annual ACC Tournament. Tech also set a new program best in 2012 when it finished the year with a 7-2 record at Thompson Field.

Against The Best

The Hokies have a chance to play numerous ranked opponents and NCAA Tournament participants every season, especially

within conference play. This year Tech opened with No. 7/6 Duke on the road. Although Tech is just 5-73 against ranked opponents, the Hokies have knocked off two ranked opponents in the last two seasons, earning their first-ever defeat of a top-10 foe when they topped then-No. 7 Virginia last year.

Strong Conference

The Atlantic Coast Conference has made a name for itself as a strong lacrosse conference. This season, five teams entered the year ranking in the top 20 of both the IWLCA Poll and the deBeer Media Poll. Maryland currently ranks No. 1 in both polls this week, with North Carolina also holding down the No. 3 spot in both polls. Duke and Virginia help round out the top 10 in both polls, and Boston College sits at No. 15 in the media poll.

Will to be the Best

Sophomore Megan Will broke onto the scene her in collegiate debut last year, earning a starting spot right away. Will picked up right where she left off to start her second season and has scored in three of the four games so far this year. She has also helped lead the team in scoring and/or points in three of the four games. and set a new career mark for herself with five points (4g, 1a) at Davidson.

Gale in Goal

Senior goalie Alex Gale has been the primary starter in cage since her arrival in 2010. Her 315 career saves lands her in fifth place all-time Tech. Gale finished 2012 with 90 saves and a 10-7 record.

Gale is currently tied for third in the ACC averaging 2.50 ground balls per game and ranks fourth, making 7.00 saves per game.

Right Back to Business

Senior Brooke Martin returns great experience to the Hokie attack and midfield this year. She has played in every game since arriving on campus. After finishing her junior season as the third-leading scorer on the team, Martin has gone straight to work in 2013. She put away three goals in the opener a week ago at Duke.

The Hunt Valley, Md., native leads the team so far with nine goals on the year and has scored in all four games this season.

Bartley, an Unexpected Surprise

Sophomore Meg Bartley walked on to the Tech lacrosse team in the Fall of 2011 and as the 2012 season began she made a quick and efficient impact. The Lewes, Del., native earned a starting job on attack by the fifth game, after scoring four goals and assisting another against UC Davis at home.

Bartley has been a huge threat for the Hokies on the draw and currently leads the conference averaging 5.25 draws per game. She also leads the team, having one 21 on the year.

True Team Player

Senior Libby Rosebro has been a team-first player for the Hokies over the years. She has started and played in every game since the beginning of her sophomore outing. The middle made the transition to defense as sophomore to add game-experience and help fill in where injuries and inexperience left the Hokies at a disadvantage. Contributing on both sides of the field, the Richmond, Va., native has scored in three of the four games so far and has had an assist in the last two outings.

Fresh Meat

Freshman Jessi Thon earned a starting spot to begin her collegiate career and has made an impact for the Hokies early. She currently leads the ACC averaging 3.00 ground balls per game.

Joining her in the starting line up has been classmate Meghan Macera, who ranks fourth in the fourth in the league averaging 3.00 draw per game.

Welcome Aboard

Tech welcomes eight freshmen to the squad this season, hailing from six different states. Hannah Sieger is the only goalie in the new mix for the Hokies and she joins the team from San Diego and Rancho Bernardo High School. Laney Clarke (Virginia Beach, Va./ Cape Henry) and Mikayla Sweeney (Waxhaw, N.C./ Waxhaw) will look to add depth for the Hokies on attack.

The remaining newcomers will contribute in the coming years from the midfield or on the defensive side of things. Gracee Hendrix (Vero Beach, Fla./ Vero Beach), Claiborne Lucas (Roanoke, Va./ Patrick Henry), Jessi Thon (Victor, N.Y./ Victor), Kelsey Allen (West Islip, N.Y./ West Islip) and Meghan Macera (Westminster, Md./ Westminster) will look to earn playing time in their debuts.

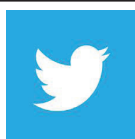
