LAST TIME OUT

The Hokies suffered a tough road loss at No. 7 Syracuse last weekend. Tech fell 22-8 to the Orange, as Megan Will and Meghan Macera each put away a pair of goals in the game. A 6-1 run to open the game helped create some early distance for the Orange, as they continued to score in surges throughout the game and never let up.

Meg Bartley matched a career high with 10 draws in the game.

SENIOR DAY

Tech will recognize its six seniors (Meg Bartley, Jack Boissonneault, Cawley Bromley, Maddy Hess, Rachel Skay and Megan Will) prior to Saturday's game. These Hokies have been a part of 31 wins, including one of the biggest in program history when Tech up set then-No. 7 Virginia in 2012. As a class, they have combined to start 212 of the 307 games they've played in, and tallied 453 points, 349 draws and 84 caused turnovers.

HEADED HOME

Eight Hokies are headed to their home state last weekend as Tech took on Syracuse. Four of the New York residence hail from Long Island, while the other four are upstate natives.

The only state that more current Hokies call home is Maryland.

HOKIES IN OVERTIME

Tech is 5-1 all-time in overtime games following the victory at Michigan. The Hokies are 2-0 in overtime under Head Coach Megan Burker, with the other win coming in 2012 when Tech knocked off then-No. 7 Virginia at home.

IT'S HERS TO SET

Meg Bartley became Tech's all-time career draw controls leader after winning the opening draw of the second session of overtime in Tech's win at Michigan. Bartley finished the game with six draws, and currently has 267 in her career. The Lewes, Delaware, native also holds the single-season record after propelling herself to 90 with a career-high 10 in the final game of the 2014 season.

RECORD WATCH

Megan Will is quickly climbing the all-time charts at Tech, chasing her cousin, Dawn Will, who sits atop the career goals and points lists. Megan currently ranks second with 161 career goals and 207 career points. She is also tied for sixth all-time at Tech with 46 career assists.

Will is one of just two players to rank among the all-time top 10 in all three offensive categories (Allie Emala 08-11).

Meg Bartley, who holds the all-time draws record at Tech recently propelled herself onto the all-time scoring list, ranking ninth with 104 goals to date.

Meghan Macera joined Bartley on the all-time draws list, as she has won 122 so far, good for sixth.

SCORING AT WILL

Senior Megan Will is currently in the midst of an 18-game scoring streak that dates back to last season. The Bel Air, Maryland, native entered the week tied for second in the ACC with 41 goals and tied for third with 51 points.

Will has scored at least three goals in 13 of the last 18 games, as she climbs all three all-time offensive stat lists at Tech.

BARTLEY, AN UNEXPECTED SURPRISE

Senior Meg Bartley walked on to the Tech lacrosse team in the fall of 2011 and as the 2012 season began she made a quick and efficient impact. The Lewes, Delaware, native earned a starting job on attack by the fifth game, after scoring four goals and assisting another against UC Davis at home and has been a staple in the lineup ever since.

AGAINST THE BEST

Being in the Atlantic Coast Conference, the Hokies play a number of the nation's best teams and players on a weekly basis. Tech's schedule includes nine teams that are currently ranked in the top 20. Last week Tech traveled to No. 7 Syracuse and this weekend it hosts No. 3 Boston College.
