#### IN THE POLLS THIS WEEK

- -Tech is receiving votes in the Inside Lacrosse poll this week and ranked 20th in the IWLCA Coaches Poll.
- -The Hokies entered the Inside Lacrosse Poll at No. 20 on February 20th. It was the program's first ranking since March of 2011.
- -The Hokies had been ranked for nine consecutive weeks in the IL poll, the longest stretch in program history.

#### TRIP TO THE CAPITAL CITY

- -The ACC Championships are being contested in the state capital, Richmond, a city the program has not played in since 2007.
- -All-time, the Hokies are 0-3 in RVA with all contests against ranked University of Richmond teams.

#### **QUICK TURNAROUND**

- -The Hokies and Orange played a regular season game on April 9th in Syracuse, N.Y. In that game, the Orange came away victorious in overtime 12-11.
- -Taylor Caskey scored with four seconds in regulation from a free position to tie the game up and force the extra period.
- -In overtime, the Orange took the draw and Mary Rahal finished a Syracuse move to win.

#### **THE 30-GOAL CLUB**

- -Five Hokies have reached 30 goals in 2017.
- -Kristine Loscalzo (47), Tristan McGinley (47), Emma Harden (37) and Zan Biedenharn (32) and Marissa Davey (30) have each eclipsed the 30 goal plateau.
- -The Hokies have the 27th leading offense in the nation, scoring 13.33 goals per game.

#### **SCOUTING THE ORANGE**

-In their season finale, the Orange were upset by Louisville 9-8, forcing them into the No. 2 seed for the ACC Tournament this week.

-Syracuse is led by point leaders:

Riley Donahue: 55 pts (33 goals, 22 assists)
Emily Hawryschuk: 37 pts (31 goals, 6 assists)
Nicole Levy: 37 pts (20 goals, 17 assists)

-In goal, Asa Goldstock owns a 12-4 record and a 11.15 goals against average.

#### **2017 CAPTAINS**

- -Leading the Hokies this season are senior Kristine Loscalzo, redshirt-junior Meagh Graham, junior Tristan McGinley and redshirt-sophomore MC Byrne.
- -Graham has started every game in her career registering 21 wins. Against Syracuse on April 9th, she made 10 saves.
- -McGinley and Loscalzo lead the attack for the Hokies. They have each scored 47 times this season
- -Byrne returned to the team from injury against JMU, having sat out all of last season. She leads the ACC with 2.25 caused turnovers a game. She registered career-highs in goals (3), assists (2) and points (5) against Elon March 1. Byrne also had a career-high four ground balls and tied her best mark with five caused turnovers.

#### **SHARPER IN FRONT OF GOAL**

-So far in 2017, the Hokies are averaging 13.33 goals per game. Last season the team finished the year with an average of 8.72.

#### **BATTLE FOR STATE SUPREMACY**

- -The 2017 schedule features seven opponents from the Commonwealth of Virginia. (JMU, Liberty, ODU, Radford, George Mason, William & Mary, Virginia)
- -Virginia Tech went 5-2 against in-state rivals in 2017.

#### THIS IS HOME

- -The Hokies have split time between two home fields, Thompson Field and the Indoor Practice Facility this season.
- -Tech is 1-2 playing games on the grass surface of Thompson and 5-2 playing games on the artificial surface of the Indoor Practice Facility.
- -The game on March 18th that was scheduled to be played at Thompson Field was completed at the Indoor Practice Facility after a weather delay during the second half. That game has been counted as being played at Thompson Field.

#### WELCOME COACH SUNG

- -New head coach John Sung takes over a Virginia Tech program in 2017.
- -Sung brings experience from his four seasons at Winthrop where he started the Eagles' program.
- -He was named the Big South coach of the year each of the past two seasons.
- -At Winthrop he won 62 games, two Big South championships and earned two NCAA berths.

# JOHN SUNG HEAD COACH FIRST SEASON OVERALL RECORD: 111-57

Hired May 27, 2016, John Sung joins Virginia Tech after building the Winthrop University program from scratch beginning in May of 2011. He oversaw the program's rapid ascent as a regional powerhouse after beginning competition in 2013. In the program's third season, Sung led Winthrop to a 17-4 record, as the Eagles qualified for the NCAA Tournament after winning both the Big South regular-season and tournament titles. In 2016, Winthrop went 20-3, winning the Big South Tournament championship and advancing to another NCAA Tournament. The 2016 season marked the team's second consecutive Big South regular-season and tournament titles.

The 2015 and 2016 Big South Coach of the Year, Sung currently chairs the NCAA Division I Lacrosse Committee and also serves on the U.S. Lacrosse Convention Education Committee. His 2015 squad set Big South single-season records for points, goals (314), free-position goals (67), shots (633), shots on goal (459), ground balls (384), draw controls (312), and caused turnovers (213). In 2016, Winthrop scored 301 goals, including 58 free-position goals. The Eagles set Big South single-season marks for shots (662), ground balls (434), and caused turnovers (266).

In addition to compiling a 54-26 overall record at Winthrop, Sung led the Haudenosaunee Nation to the quarterfinals of the 2013 Federation of International Lacrosse World Cup held in Canada. The team finished in seventh place out of a total of 19 teams. He also coached the team in the 2009 Federation of International Lacrosse in the Czech Republic.

Sung's ascent as an NCAA coach began at Division III Adrian College in Michigan, where he started the program from the ground up and compiled a 46-19 overall record. His 2011 squad started the season 1-4 before registering 15 consecutive victories to earn a berth in the NCAA Division III Tournament. After posting a 6-7 overall record in its first season in 2008, the program went 10-4 in 2009, 14-3 in 2010 and 16-5 in 2011.

Before beginning the program at Adrian College, Sung spent five years as the assistant women's club lacrosse coach at the University of Michigan, setting the groundwork for that program to eventually become a varsity sport in the Big Ten. The Wolverines accumulated a 93-22 record during this tenure.

A longtime trainer of goalies, Sung has held various coaching positions with Birmingham Seaholm High School and the Detroit Lacrosse Club. He has been the assistant director of the Great Lakes Women's Lacrosse Camp since 1997. In addition to his work at various levels in the lacrosse community, Sung has a wealth of sales and management experience in the private sector.

Sung was the starting goalkeeper of the Oakland University lacrosse team in 1997 and 1998 and was also a two-year captain. He was also member of two International Cup U16 championship teams in 1993 and 1994. He completed his degree in Bachelor of Arts degree in communications from Oakland in 2007.

Married to his wife, Tina, Sung also has three stepsons, Darek, Devin and Zachary, and a daughter, Abby.

#### JUST VIRGINIA TECH, PLEASE

While the full name of the school is Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, the school is commonly referred to as "Virginia Tech." Founded in 1872, as Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College, the university changed its named to Virginia Polytechnic Institute in 1896. Fans of the athletic department, as well as media covering the Hokies, shortened the name to VPI, but it eventually became Virginia Tech. The "State University" was added in 1970 to bring the official title to what it is today. Those covering Hokie athletics are asked to refer to the university as simply "Virginia Tech." Virginia Tech University, VPI and SU, VPI&SU, VT or VA Tech are not recognized names and should not be used.
