### Entering Tonight's Game

The Hokies enter tonight's game with a 20-10 overall record and was 9-7 in ACC action ... Florida State is 21-9 the season and was 11-5 in conference action ... The Hokies are the sixth seed in the tournament and the Seminoles are the third seed.

### Last Time Out: Virginia Tech 59, Georgia Tech 43

The Hokies opened ACC Tournament play with a 59-43 victory over Georgia Tech in the opening round on Thursday night in the Greensboro Coliseum ... The Hokies jumped out to a big early lead and never trailed ... **Malcolm Delaney** led all scorers with 15 points, while **Jeff Allen** added a double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds ... **Erick Green** added 11 points in the win ... Virginia Tech held the Yellow Jackets to 32.1 percent from the field.

### Jeff Moves Up

In the Hokies' win over Georgia Tech on Thursday night, **Jeff Allen** passed Bill Matthews and Bryant Matthews (no relation) into 12th place in career scoring at Virginia Tech ... Allen now has 1,662 career points ... He also has 1,083 career rebounds, 227 career steals and 149 career blocked shots.

### Odds & Ends from the Georgia Tech Game

**Jeff Allen** has now played six ACC Tournament games ... In three of those six games, he has recorded a double-double ... The Hokies held Georgia Tech to 43 points ... That's the fewest points the Hokies have allowed in an ACC Tournament game and the fewest points scored in an ACC Tournament game since Georgia Tech defeated Virginia, 94-42, in the first round of the 2008 ACC Tournament in Charlotte ... Last night marked the third time in 10 total ACC Tournament games that the Hokies have held an opponent to less than 50 points in a game ... The 19 points Georgia Tech scored in the first half ties for the fewest points the Hokies have allowed in a half to an ACC opponent this season ... Tech held FSU to 19 first half points on Jan. 8 ... Tech only committed 10 personal fouls in the game, the fewest of the season.

## Heading to The Gate City

Virginia Tech is making its seventh appearance in the ACC Tournament this week in Greensboro, N.C. ... Tech finished the regular season 19-10 overall and 9-7 in ACC action ... Tech finished the regular season in a tie for fourth place with Clemson and Boston College and is the sixth seed in this season's tournament ... Tech defeated Georgia Tech, 59-43, in the first round on Thursday ... The Tech will play Florida State at 9:30 p.m., on Friday night.

## The Hokies in Greensboro

With the win over Georgia Tech, Tech has now played in the Greensboro Coliseum 14 times over the years, with a 5-8 record ... Tech is 2-8 all-time in the building against teams currently in the ACC ... The Hokies are 2-0 in the building this season ... Tech's last appearance in the building was on Nov. 21, 2010, when the Hokies defeated UNC Greensboro, 92-70 ... Tech is 1-2 in ACC Tournament games in this arena.

## The Series vs. Florida State

This is the 44th meeting between the Hokies and the Seminoles ... FSU leads the all-time series, 25-18 ... Virginia Tech won the last meeting, 71-59 in Cassell Coliseum on Jan. 8 ... Virginia Tech has never played Florida State in the ACC Tournament ... The Hokies are 1-3 against FSU in conference tournaments, all coming when the two schools were members of the Mtero Conference.

## Virginia Tech in Conference Tournaments

This is the seventh ACC Tournament for the Hokies and the eighth-straight conference tournament for the Hokies in Seth Greenberg's eight seasons ... Tech is 4-6 in ACC Tournament action ... The Hokies were 1-1 in the 2004 BIG EAST Tournament in Greenberg's first season in Blacksburg ... The Hokies have a combined 28-46 all-time record in post-season conference tournaments ... Tech is 5-13 all-time against current ACC members in post season conference tournaments.

## The ACC Tournament

Virginia Tech makes its seventh appearance in the ACC Tournament ... This is the 58th annual ACC Tournament ... This is the Hokies' third trip to the Greensboro Coliseum for an ACC Tournament ... Greensboro has hosted 23 ACC Tournaments ... The next most-common venue is Reynolds Coliseum in Raleigh (13) ... Of the nine other arenas to host the event, three, the Capital Centre in Landover, Maryland, the Charlotte Coliseum and the Omni in Atlanta, are no longer standing.

## Hokies in the ACC First Round Games

The Hokies are now 2-1 in ACC first round games since joining the league ... Tech won its previous first round game, 65-47, in the 2009 ACC Tournament in the Georgia Dome in Atlanta .

## Hokies in the ACC Quarterfinal Games

The Hokies are 2-3 in ACC quarterfinal games since joining the league ... Tech lost its last quarterfinal game, 70-65, to Miami in the 2010 ACC Tournament in the Greensboro Coliseum.

## ACC Wins

Virginia Tech's senior class finished the regular season with 35 ACC wins ... That is the most ACC wins for a Virginia Tech senior class since entering the ACC in 2004.

## We Are Honored

Two Virginia Tech players have earned All-ACC honors this season ... **Malcolm Delaney** was first-team All-ACC selection for the second consecutive season, as selected by the Atlantic Coast Sports Media Association ... He was a third team selection as a sophomore ... **Jeff Allen** was named to the league's second-team ... Delaney is the first Hokie to be named to the first team twice.

## Ty is also Honored

**Tyrone Garland** has been named to the 2011 All-ACC Academic team for men's basketball ... The freshman guard from Philadelphia is one of 13 players on the team.

## More Honors

Two Virginia Tech players have earned All-District honors this season ... **Malcolm Delaney** was a first-team All-District 2 selection for the second consecutive season, as selected by the National Association of Basketball Coaches ... He was also named to the U.S. Basketball Writers Association's All-District III team ... **Jeff Allen** was named to the NABC's second-team and was also named to the USBWA's All-District III team.

## Seeding the Hokies

The Hokies are competing in their seventh ACC Tournament ... Tech has received a first round bye in four of the seven events ... Tech was the three-seed once, the four-seed three-times, the six-seed this season, the eight-seed once and the 10th seed once.





### Malcolm Moving Up

**Malcolm Delaney** enters tonight's game with 2,177 career points, in 19th place on the all-time ACC list ... He passed Len Chappell of Wake Forest and Greivis Vasquez of Maryland in the win over Georgia Tech ... Delaney is second in career scoring among active ACC players, trailing only Kyle Singler of Duke.

### A Bunch of Winners

The Virginia Tech senior class of **Jeff Allen**, **Terrell Bell** and **Malcolm Delaney** have achieved an overall record of 85-48 (.639) ... The winningest senior class in school history was the 1985-86 season senior class, which was 87-42 (.674).

### Doubling Up His Game

**Jeff Allen's** now has 16 double doubles this season and 44 for his career following his 14 point, 11 rebound performance in the win over Georgia Tech ... He has scored in double figures in 20 of his last 24 games ... He has recorded double doubles in 14 of his last 22 games ... His streak of seven straight double-doubles earlier this season was the most consecutive double-doubles for a Hokie since at least 1978.

### Going Green

Since entering the starting line-up in the win over Penn State, **Erick Green** has become one of the most improved players in the ACC ... In the 22 games since he stepped into the starting line-up, Green has had a great assist/turnover ratio ... In that span, he has 68 assists and just 26 turnovers ... He had 31 assists last season ... Green currently leads the ACC in assist/turnover ratio.

### Putting in the Time

In the Hokies' home win over Maryland, **Malcolm Delaney** passed Dell Curry to become the all-time leader in minutes played at Virginia Tech ... Delaney now has 4,536 minutes played.

### Closing In on Threes Record

**Malcolm Delaney** enters tonight's game 254-of-701 from three-point range ... The school record for made three-point field goals in a career is 267 by former teammate A.D. Vassallo ... In the loss at Clemson, he broke the school's career record for attempted three-point field goals, previously held by Wally Lancaster at 694.

### Another Milestone

In Virginia Tech's win over Penn State, **Seth Greenberg** recorded his 350th victory as a collegiate head coach ... His record in 21 years as a head coach is 365-274 (.571).

### On the Injury Front

The Virginia Tech bench got shorter just before the holidays, as senior guard **Dorenzo Hudson** and sophomore forward **Cadarian Raines** were both ruled out for the season due to foot injuries ... Hudson originally injured the foot last season and had difficulties with the injury during the summer and into the current season ... He had successful surgery on the foot on Jan. 17 ... Raines originally had surgery on his left foot last season ... He reinjured the foot at the end of last season and had a second surgery in April, which did not heal as expected ... He has undergone a variety of treatments to aid the healing process ... He will continue to be monitored by the Virginia Tech medical staff to determine the best course of action ... Raines saw limited action this season, but Hudson is third on the team in scoring average, at 10.4 points per game ... Both players are eligible for medical redshirts ... Senior forward, **JT Thompson**, will miss the 2010-11 season following surgery to repair a torn anterior cruciate ligament in his left knee ... The injury occurred during the preseason ... Thompson is expected to be ready to return for next season ... **Allan Chaney**, a redshirt sophomore forward for the Hokies, has yet to be cleared to return to action following a viral inflammation of the heart ... He will continue to be evaluated by medical staff ... New to the list is **Prince Parker**, who suffered a sprained right big toe in practice on Feb. 28 ... He will miss the remainder of the season.

### Allen Honored by ACC Again

**Jeff Allen** was named the ACC Player of the Week for the week ending Feb. 27 ... Allen scored 17 points and had eight rebounds in the win at Wake Forest on Tuesday and scored 18 points and had 15 rebounds in the win over #1 Duke ... This was the third time this season that Allen has earned the award ... He also was honored on Jan. 10 and Feb. 6 ... This was the fifth time this season that a Virginia Tech player has earned this honor, following **Malcolm Delaney** on Nov. 29, Allen on Jan. 10 and Feb. 6 and **Erick Green** on Jan. 24 ... This marked the fourth time in Allen's career that he has garnered this award.

### Since Expansion (And Beyond)

Since the ACC expanded to include Virginia Tech and Miami in 2004 (and BC in 2005), the Hokies are fourth in the most conference regular season victories ... Tech is 57-55 in that stretch ... Only Duke (83-29), North Carolina (83-29) and Maryland (60-52) have more wins in that span ... Since the start of the 2006-07 season, the Hokies have the fourth-best victory total in ACC regular season games (45-35 in that span) (as of the regular season).

### Add One for Malcolm

With his 19 points in the loss to Clemson, **Malcolm Delaney** finished with 1,137 points in ACC regular season action, tops among current ACC players ... Delaney was the 20th player in ACC history to score 1,000 points in ACC regular season games and currently stands in fifth place on the all-time list ... The only four players ahead of Delaney on that list are J.J. Redick of Duke, Tyler Hansbrough of North Carolina, Bryant Stith of Virginia and Matt Harpring of Georgia Tech.

### All By Myself

**Jeff Allen** is the only active ACC player with 1,600 career points, 1,000 career rebounds and 200 career steals ... He is one blocked shot from becoming the first player in ACC history with 1,500 career points, 1,000 career rebounds, 200 career steals and 150 career blocked shots.

### Close Games

With the win over #1 Duke, the Hokies are 46-43 under **Seth Greenberg** in games that have been decided in overtime or by five-or-fewer points ... Tech was 8-3 in such games last season and is 4-4 this season.

### Malcolm Makes It

In the loss at North Carolina, **Malcolm Delaney** tied a career-high with seven made three-point field goals ... The other time he made seven in a game was in the finals of the 76 Classic, when he was 7-for-9 from beyond the arc ... In the UNC game, seven of his eight made field goals were three-pointers ... The team made a season-high 11 three-pointers at Chapel Hill, including 3-of-4 from **Manny Atkins** ... Delaney made six three-pointers in the loss at Virginia.

### Malcolm Reaches Another Milestone

**Malcolm Delaney** scored 17 points in the home loss to Boston College and in doing so, passed Dale Solomon into third place in career scoring at Virginia Tech ... He scored 17 points in the win at Wake Forest and, with it, scored his 2,100th career point ... Delaney now has 2,177 points for his career ... Delaney scored his 1,600th career point in the loss to Rhode Island to end the 2009-10 season ... In doing so, he became the first Hokie junior to accomplish that feat since Bimbo Coles, who ended his junior season with 1,699 points ... Delaney scored his 1,000th career point at Tech in the win at Campbell in 2009.
