Entering Today's Game

The Hokies enter today's game with a 21-10 overall record and was 9-7 in ACC action ... Duke is 28-4 the season and was 13-3 in conference action ... The Hokies are the sixth seed in the tournament and the Blue Devils are the second seed ... Duke is ranked No. 5 in both major polls.

Last Time Out: Virginia Tech 52, Florida State 51

The Hokies advanced in the ACC Tournament on a 52-51 victory over Florida State in the quarterfinal on Friday night ... Tech trailed most of the game before taking a 52-51 lead with 4.7 seconds remaining on a jumper by Erick Green ... FSU's Derwin Kitchen made what appeared to be a game-winning shot at the buzzer, but the shot came after the clock went :00.0 and the Hokies earned the emotional win ... Malcolm Delaney led all scorers with 16 points and Manny Atkins came off the bench with 14 points ... Tech shot just 17.9 percent in the first half, but made 12-of-26 in the second half ... Tech forced FSU into 20 turnovers.

Odds & Ends from the Florida State Game

The Hokies have won two conference tournament games in one season for the first time since 1984, when Tech defeated Tulane and Louisville in the 1984 Metro Tournament in Memphis ... The Hokies' 31.5 percent from the field for the game was the lowest for Tech in an ACC Tournament game ... **Manny Atkins** was the only Hokie reserve to play and his 14 points is his high in a post-season game ... Tech becomes the first team to play just six players in an ACC Tournament game since NC State in 1997 ... Tech committed just 14 fouls and FSU took just five free throws, making only one ... **Erick Green** missed his first nine shots, but made two of his last four, including the game-winner ... **Malcolm Delaney** has five-or-more assists in five of the seven ACC Tournament games.

What 2 Watch 4

Malcolm Delaney needs seven points to reach 2,200 for his career ... **Jeff Allen** needs nine rebounds for 1,100 for his career.

Heading to The Gate City

Virginia Tech is making its seventh appearance in the ACC Tournament this week in Greensboro, N.C. ... Tech finished the regular season 19-10 overall and 9-7 in ACC action ... Tech finished the regular season in a tie for fourth place with Clemson and Boston College and is the sixth seed in this season's tournament ... Tech defeated Georgia Tech, 59-43, in the first round on Thursday and Florida State, 52-51, in the quarterfinal on Friday ... The Tech will play Duke at 3:30 p.m., on Saturday.

The Hokies in Greensboro

With the win over Florida State, Tech has now played in the Greensboro Coliseum 15 times over the years, with a 6-8 record ... Tech is 3-8 all-time in the building against teams currently in the ACC ... The Hokies are 3-0 in the building this season ... Tech's last appearance in the building was on Nov. 21, 2010, when the Hokies defeated UNC Greensboro, 92-70 ... Tech is 2-2 in ACC Tournament games in this arena.

Virginia Tech in Conference Tournaments

This is the seventh ACC Tournament for the Hokies and the eighth-straight conference tournament for the Hokies in Seth Greenberg's eight seasons ... Tech is 5-6 in ACC Tournament action ... The Hokies were 1-1 in the 2004 BIG EAST Tournament in Greenberg's first season in Blacksburg ... The Hokies have a combined 29-46 all-time record in post-season conference tournaments ... Tech is 6-13 all-time against current ACC members in post season conference tournaments.

The ACC Tournament

Virginia Tech makes its seventh appearance in the ACC Tournament ... This is the 58th annual ACC Tournament ... This is the Hokies' third trip to the Greensboro Coliseum for an ACC Tournament ... Greensboro has hosted 23 ACC Tournaments ... The next most-common venue is Reynolds Coliseum in Raleigh (13) ... Of the nine other arenas to host the event, three, the Capital Centre in Landover, Maryland, the Charlotte Coliseum and the Omni in Atlanta, are no longer standing.

Hokies in the ACC First Round Games

The Hokies are now 2-1 in ACC first round games since joining the league ... Tech won its previous first round game, 65-47, in the 2009 ACC Tournament in the Georgia Dome in Atlanta.

Hokies in the ACC Quarterfinal Games

The Hokies are now 3-3 in ACC quarterfinal games since joining the league.

The Hokies in ACC Semifinal Games

Virginia Tech' is 0-2 in ACC Tournament Semifinal games ... This is the first time that the Hokies have reached the ACC Tournament Semifinal without receiving a first round bye.

ACC Wins

Virginia Tech's senior class finished the regular season with 35 ACC wins ... That is the most ACC wins for a Virginia Tech senior class since entering the ACC in 2004.

We Are Honored

Two Virginia Tech players have earned All-ACC honors this season ... **Malcolm Delaney** was first-team All-ACC selection for the second consecutive season, as selected by the Atlantic Coast Sports Media Association ... He was a third team selection as a sophomore ... **Jeff Allen** was named to the league's second-team ... Delaney is the first Hokie to be named to the first team twice.

More Honors

Two Virginia Tech players have earned All-District honors this season ... **Malcolm Delaney** was a first-team All-District 2 selection for the second consecutive season, as selected by the National Association of Basketball Coaches ... He was also named to the U.S. Basketball Writers Association's All-District III team ... **Jeff Allen** was named to the NABC's second-team and was also named to the USBWA's All-District III team.

Ty is also Honored

Tyrone Garland has been named to the 2011 All-ACC Academic team for men's basketball ... The freshman guard from Philadelphia is one of 13 players on the team.

Seeding the Hokies

The Hokies are competing in their seventh ACC Tournament ... Tech has received a first round bye in four of the seven events ... Tech was the three-seed once, the four-seed three-times, the six-seed this season, the eight-seed once and the 10th seed once. ... Today's game will be Tech's first-ever against the No. 2 seed in the ACC Tournament.

The Series vs. Duke

This is the 45th meeting between the Hokies and the Seminoles ... Duke leads the all-time series, 36-8 ... Virginia Tech won the last meeting, 64-60 in Cassell Coliseum on Feb. 26, when the Blue Devils were ranked No. 1 ... Virginia Tech has never played Duke in the ACC Tournament ... The Hokies are 0-6 against the Blue Devils in Greensboro, all games played before Tech joined the ACC.

The Hokies vs. #5

The Hokies are 2-8 all-time against teams ranked No. 5 in the AP poll ... Tech is 1-2 against Duke with the Blue Devils are ranked No. 5 ... Tech is 1-5 against No. 5 teams that are currently in the ACC ... Tech's last win over a No. 5 team was a 69-67 overtime win over the Blue Devils in Cameron Indoor Stadium on Jan. 6, 2007.



Malcolm Moving Up

Malcolm Delaney enters today's game with 2,193 career points, tied with Mark Price of Georgia Tech in 18th place on the all-time ACC scoring list ... Delaney is second in career scoring among active ACC players, trailing only Kyle Singler of Duke.

A Bunch of Winners

The Virginia Tech senior class of **Jeff Allen**, **Terrell Bell** and **Malcolm Delaney** have achieved an overall record of 86-48 (.642) ... The winningest senior class in school history was the 1985-86 season senior class, which was 87-42 (.674).

Doubling Up His Game

Jeff Allen's now has 16 double doubles this season and 44 for his career following his 14 point, 11 rebound performance in the win over Georgia Tech ... He has scored in double figures in 20 of his last 24 games ... He has recorded double doubles in 14 of his last 22 games ... His streak of seven straight double-doubles earlier this season was the most consecutive double-doubles for a Hokie since at least 1978.

Jeff Moves Up

In the Hokies' win over Georgia Tech on Thursday night, **Jeff Allen** passed Bill Matthews and Bryant Matthews (no relation) into 12th place in career scoring at Virginia Tech ... Allen now has 1,671 career points ... He also has 1,091 career rebounds, 229 career steals and 149 career blocked shots.

Going Green

Since entering the starting line-up in the win over Penn State, **Erick Green** has become one of the most improved players in the ACC ... In the 23 games since he stepped into the starting line-up, Green has had a great assist/turnover ratio ... In that span, he has 70 assists and just 27 turnovers ... He had 31 assists last season ... Green currently leads the ACC in assist/turnover ratio.

Putting in the Time

In the Hokies' home win over Maryland, **Malcolm Delaney** passed Dell Curry to become the all-time leader in minutes played at Virginia Tech ... Delaney now has 4,575 minutes played.

Closing In on Threes Record

Malcolm Delaney enters today's game 257-of-709 from three-point range ... The school record for made three-point field goals in a career is 267 by former teammate A.D. Vassallo ... In the loss at Clemson, he broke the school's career record for attempted three-point field goals, previously held by Wally Lancaster at 694.

Low Point Wins

Virginia Tech defeated Florida State, 52-51, on Friday night ... The 52 points is the fewest in a win for the Hokies since March 8, 2000, when the Hokies defeated Fordham, 51-48, in the first round of the 2000 Atlantic 10 Tournament in Philadelphia.

Odds & Ends

Jeff Allen has now played seven ACC Tournament games ... In three of those six games, he has recorded a double-double ... The Hokies held Georgia Tech to 43 points on Thursday night ... That's the fewest points the Hokies have allowed in an ACC Tournament game and the fewest points scored in an ACC Tournament game since Georgia Tech defeated Virginia, 94-42, in the first round of the 2008 ACC Tournament in Charlotte ... The Georgia Tech game marked the third time in 10 total ACC Tournament games that the Hokies have held an opponent to less than 50 points in a game ... The 19 points Georgia Tech scored in the first half ties for the fewest points the Hokies have allowed in a half to an ACC opponent this season ... Tech held FSU to 19 first half points on Jan. 8 ... Tech only committed 10 personal fouls in the Georgia Tech game, the fewest of the season.

On the Injury Front

Just before the holidays, senior guard **Dorenzo Hudson** and sophomore forward **Cadarian Raines** were both ruled out for the season due to foot injuries ... Raines originally had surgery on his left foot last season ... He has been allowed to return to limited practice ... Raines saw limited action this season, but Hudson is third on the team in scoring average, at 10.4 points per game ... Both players are eligible for medical redshirts ... Senior forward, **JT Thompson**, had surgery to repair a torn anterior cruciate ligament in his left knee ... **Allan Chaney**, a redshirt sophomore forward for the Hokies, has yet to be cleared to return to action following a viral inflammation of the heart ... New to the list is **Prince Parker**, who suffered a sprained right big toe in practice on Feb. 28 ... He will miss the remainder of the season.

Add One for Malcolm

With his 19 points in the loss to Clemson, **Malcolm Delaney** finished with 1,137 points in ACC regular season action, tops among current ACC players ... Delaney was the 20th player in ACC history to score 1,000 points in ACC regular season games and currently stands in fifth place on the all-time list ... The only four players ahead of Delaney on that list are J.J. Redick of Duke, Tyler Hansbrough of North Carolina, Bryant Stith of Virginia and Matt Harpring of Georgia Tech.

Allen Honored by ACC Again

Jeff Allen was named the ACC Player of the Week for the week ending Feb. 27 ... Allen scored 17 points and had eight rebounds in the win at Wake Forest on Tuesday and scored 18 points and had 15 rebounds in the win over #1 Duke ... This was the third time this season that Allen has earned the award ... He also was honored on Jan. 10 and Feb. 6 ... This was the fifth time this season that a Virginia Tech player has earned this honor, following **Malcolm Delaney** on Nov. 29, Allen on Jan. 10 and Feb. 6 and **Erick Green** on Jan. 24 ... This marked the fourth time in Allen's career that he has garnered this award.

Since Expansion (And Beyond)

Since the ACC expanded to include Virginia Tech and Miami in 2004 (and BC in 2005), the Hokies are fourth in the most conference regular season victories ... Tech is 57-55 in that stretch ... Only Duke (83-29), North Carolina (83-29) and Maryland (60-52) have more wins in that span ... Since the start of the 2006-07 season, the Hokies have the fourth-best victory total in ACC regular season games (45-35 in that span) (as of the regular season).

All By Myself

Jeff Allen is the only active ACC player with 1,600 career points, 1,000 career rebounds and 200 career steals ... He is one blocked shot from becoming the first player in ACC history with 1,500 career points, 1,000 career rebounds, 200 career steals and 150 career blocked shots.

Close Games

With the win over Florida State, the Hokies are 47-43 under **Seth Greenberg** in games that have been decided in overtime or by five-or-fewer points ... Tech was 8-3 in such games last season and is 5-4 this season.

Malcolm Reaches Another Milestone

Malcolm Delaney scored 17 points in the home loss to Boston College and in doing so, passed Dale Solomon into third place in career scoring at Virginia Tech ... He scored 17 points in the win at Wake Forest and, with it, scored his 2,100th career point ... Delaney now has 2,193 points for his career ... Delaney scored his 1,600th career point in the loss to Rhode Island to end the 2009-10 season ... In doing so, he became the first Hokie junior to accomplish that feat since Bimbo Coles, who ended his junior season with 1,699 points ... Delaney scored his 1,000th career point at Tech in the win at Campbell in 2009.
