## Hokies travel to the Greensboro Coliseum for season's first road game vs. UNC Greensboro

### NOTING THE HOKIES

#### **About Tonight's Game**

The Hokies are 3-0 on the season after defeating VMI, 95-80, on Thursday night. UNC Greensboro is 1-2 on the season after losing at East Carolina, 76-73, on Friday. Virginia Tech leads the all-time series, 7-0.

#### Virginia Tech 95, VMI 80

Erick Green led five Hokies in double-figures, as Tech defeated VMI, 95-80, on Thursday night. Cadarian Raines recorded his second-straight double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds and Jarell Eddie scored 17 points for the Hokies.

#### The New Boss

This season marks the head coaching debut of James Johnson.

Johnson earned his first head coaching victory with an 80-62 win over ETSU on Saturday.

#### A Milestone

Erick Green scored 23 points in the win over VMI and in doing so, became the 43rd person in school history to record 1,000 career points.

#### No Time for Rest

This is the Hokies' fourth game in the first nine days of the season.

#### Low Percentage

Virginia Tech has limited its opponents to just 12-of-74 from three-point range (16.2 percent).

#### **Player Notes**

Erick Green is second in the ACC in scoring.

Marquis Rankin missed the win over ETSU due to family concerns. He returned to the team on Monday, but did not play against Rhode Island. He played against VMI.

Cadarian Raines recorded his second consecutive double-double in the win over VMI.

Will Johnston has made six career field goals. All six are three-pointers. He hit three of them in the win over VMI, setting a new career-high of nine points.

**C.J. Barksdale** scored 11 points in the VMI, establishing a new career high.

#### Johnson's Debut

The season-opening victory against East Tennessee State was the debut of James Johnson as the head coach of the Hokies ... Johnson, a former assistant and associate head coach with



the Hokies, was named to the position on May 2, 2012 ... Johnson is now 3-0 as the coach of the Hokies ... He brings with him 19 years experience as an assistant coach ... He is the only new coach in the ACC this season... For a full bio on Johnson, please go to: http:// www.hokiesports.com/staff/j.johnson.html.

#### Join the Club

Virginia Tech senior guard Erick Green scored 23 points in the win over VMI ... With 19:08 remaining in the game, he hit a jumper near the top of the key and in doing so, he became the 43rd players in

Virginia Tech history to reach the 1,000 career point plateau.

#### The Series vs. UNCG

The Hokies hold a 7-0 advantage in the all-time series against the Spartans ... Tech defeated UNCG, 92-70, in 2011 in the Greensboro Coliseum ... The Hokies are 1-0 in road games and 1-0 in neutral site games vs. UNCG, with both of those games played in the Greensboro Coliseum.

#### Making It a Habit

Erick Green scored 21 points in the season-opening win over ETSU and followed that with a career-high tying 25 point game in the win over URI ... That was the first time in his career that he scored 20-or-more points in consecutive games ... He scored 23 points in the win over VMI, making for three 20-plus point games in a row ... The VMI game was the 10th career game of 20-or-more points and the 59th time in his collegiate career that he has scored in double figures..

#### **Must Be Doing This Right**

In the first three games of the season, Hokie opponents are shootinf a combined 12-for-74 from three-point range, just 16.2 percent from that distance ... That mark leads the ACC in three-point field goal defense so far this season.

#### Wheels on the Bus Go Round & Round

Virginia Tech plays its first road game of the season tonight ... This is also James Johnson's first road game as a head coach.

#### C.J. Breaks Through

Virginia Tech sophomore forward, C.J. Barksdale had started the season slowly in the first two games, scoring just two points and grabbing four rebounds in those first two wins ... In the third game of the season,

those trends quickly changed, as Barksdale scored a career-high 11 points and grabbed six rebounds in a career-high 25 minutes of action in the win over VMI.

#### A First, and then, Second for Raines

With his 10 points and career-high 12 rebounds in the win over

Rhode Island, Cadarian Raines recorded his first career double-double ... It marked the second consecutive game in which a Hokies had recorded a double-double, as Jarell Eddie acheived the same feat in the win over East Tennessee State ... Raines

made it two consecutive double-doubles when he scored 14 points and had 10 rebounds ... It also marked the Hokies' third straight game with a double-double.

#### Stay Back There

Virginia Tech sophomore walk-on Will Johnston has earned significant playing time so far this season ... One of the areas that has impressed the coaching staff is his shooting from the three-point arch ... In Johnston's career at Virginia

Tech, he has made six field goals and all six have been three-pointers ... He hit a careerhigh three, three-pointers in the win over VMI, earning him a career-high nine points in a career-high 19 minutes of action.

#### We Know This Place

Tonight marks the third time that the Hokies and Spartans have played in the Greensboro Coliseum, with Tech holding a 2-0 mark in those games ... Tech has played in the Greensboro Coliseum 15 times over the years, with a 6-9 record ... Tech is 3-9 all-time in the building against teams currently in the ACC ... Tech's last appearance in the building was on March 12, 2011, when the Hokies lost to No. 5 Duke, 77-63, in the semifinals of the 2011 ACC Tournament ... Tech is 2-3 in ACC Tournament games in this arena ... The 2013 ACC Tournament will be played in this building.

#### **Hitting the Ground Running**

As James Johnson begins his head coaching tenure at Virginia Tech, the Hokies will begin the season fast out of the gates ... Tonight will be the fourth game in the first nine days of the season ... Tech played (and won) three games in the first five games of the season.

#### **Walking On to Minutes**

With just seven scholarship players available to him in the win over ETSU, head coach James Johnson was forced to use a number of walk-ons in the win ... Joev Racer. Marcus Patrick, Christian Beyer and Will Johnston all played ... Tech played four walkons in the game, who combined for six points, a rebound, three assists and just one turnover in 18 minutes of action ... Johnston played 15 minutes and scored three points and had a steal ... Johnston played a total of eight minutes last season, with three points ... Both of Johnston's career field goals have been three-pointers.

#### Rankin Returns

Marquis Rankin did not play in the season opening win over ETSU due to family concerns ... He returned to the team on Monday ... He dressed, but did not play in the win over URI ... He returned to action in the win over VMI, playing three minutes.

#### Making the Debut

Three Hokies made their collegiate debut in the win over East Tennessee State ... Freshmen Marshall Wood and Marcus Patrick, along with sophomore Chrisitian Beyer, saw their first collegiate action ... The trio combined for five points, seven rebounds and three assists.

#### **Welcoming Back Old Foes**

This season, the Hokies are welcoming back two traditional rivals to the schedule ... Tech defeated VMI, 95-80, on Nov. 15 in a rivalry that dates back to 1909 and will then play West Virginia on Dec. 8 in Morgantown ... Tech and WVU first met in basketball in 1921 and have played 75 times since then ... The teams last met in the 2003-04 season, the Hokies' last as a member of the BIG EAST Conference ... The teams will meet next season in Blacksburg.

#### **Brown's Back**

Robert Brown missed 12 weeks of workouts and on-court activities following surgery to repair a fracture to the fifth metatarsal of the left foot, suffered in workouts ... Brown had surgery at Lewis Gale Hospital at Montgomery,

performed by Virginia Tech team orthopaedic surgeon Dr. **Marc Siegel** ... Brown was cleared to return to action on Oct. 11 ... In his first game back, Brown scored 16 points, had five assists and made a career-high four three-point field goals.

#### New, Improving Eddie

Virginia Tech's **Jarell Eddie** was fourth in the ACC in improved scoring from the previous season ... As a freshman, Eddie averaged just 2.9 points per game ... Last season, he improved to 9.1 points per game ... That +6.2 ppg trailed

only Terrell Stoglin of Maryland (+9.8) and C.J. Williams of NC State and C.J. Harris of NC State (+6.5) ... Eddie is averaging 14.3 points per game this season.

#### The State We're In

With the win over VMI, Virginia Tech is 421-305 (.580) all-time against schools from Virginia ...Tech is 1-0 this season and was 2-1 against state schools last year ... The Hokies have played 14 schools from the state ... With the win over Norfolk State on Dec. 11, 2011, the only state Division I school that Tech has not played is Hampton ... Tech holds winning records against 10 of the schools and even records against two others.

#### **Hokies vs. Ranked Teams**

With the loss to #5 Duke in the ACC Tournament last season, the Hokies are 12-38 against nationally ranked teams since joining the ACC for the 2004-05 season ... Tech is 29-146 all-time against teams ranked in the AP poll ... These numbers are only for teams ranked in the AP poll.

#### **Doubles in Threes**

The 10 three-point field goals the Hokies made in the win over Rhode Island marks the first time since Feb. 18, 2012, that Tech had made at least 10 three-pointers in a game ... On that date, Tech made 11 three-pointers against Georgia Tech in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech made 11 three-pointers in the win over VMI ... That marked the first time since Feb. 21 and Feb. 25 of 2009 that Tech made at least 10 three-pointers in back-to-back games.

#### Stingy with the Ball

**Erick Green** enters tonight's game with 221 assist and just 114 turnovers ... Each of the last two seasons, Green has had at least 40 more assists than turnovers and has more assists than turnovers in each of his first three seasons.

#### Lots of Youth

Among Virginia Tech's eight active scholarship players, **Erick Green** is the only senior and **Cadarian Raines** and **Jarell Eddie** are the only juniors ... Four players, **Robert Brown, C.J. Barksdale, Marquis Rankin** and **Joey van Zegeren**, played as freshmen last season, although van Zegeren only played eight minutes and was granted a medical redshirt ... **Marshall Wood** is the lone scholarship freshman this season.

#### **Building Makes it Better?**

A case can be made that the Hokies have shown marked improvement in many areas of their game since moving into the Hahn Hurst Basketball practice facility in August 2009 ... One such improvement comes to the forefront ... In the six years before the opening of the practice facility, the Hokies shot a combined 66.2 percent from the free throw line ... Since the opening of the facility, the Hokies are shooting 71.4 percent from the free throw line.

#### Lights, Camera, Hokies

All but one Virginia Tech game this season will either be televised or broadcast over the internet ... Only the Virginia Tech game against Bradely in the Continental Tire Las Vegas Classic will be shown.

#### 300 and Counting

The Hokies have hit at least one three-pointer in every game since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season ... Tech has now hit a three in 306 consecutive games, the most in school history ... Since the three-point arc was added to college basketball for the 1986-87 season, the Hokies have hit at least one three in all but three games ... The last time that the Hokies did not record a three-point field goal in a game was at Providence on Feb. 1, 2003.

#### **Hokies in Overtime**

With the loss at #5 Duke last season, the Hokies are now 57-43 all-time in overtime games ... Tech is 25-21 in road overtime games, 26-9 in home overtime games and 6-13 on neutral courts ... Tech is 11-3 in ACC overtime games ... Prior to the loss at #5 Duke, the last time the Hokies had lost a true road overtime game was Feb. 11, 2006, when Tech fell to Virginia, 81-77, in University Hall ... Tech is 3-6 all-time in overtime games against ranked teams ... Tech is 5-8 in double overtime games and 1-2 in triple overtime games.

#### 500-Plus in the Cassell

The Hokies have a 521-157 overall record in the Cassell, good for a .768 winning percentage ... Tech is 3-0 in Cassell Coliseum this season ... Tech was 11-7 last season and was 12-4 in Cassell the season before, the 50th year for the arena ... The win over Florida State on Jan. 8, 2011, was the 500th victory in the building ... The win over FSU in 2008 marked the Hokies' 600th game played in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech defeated Rhode Island, 86-63, on Nov. 20, 2002, in its 500th game in the arena ... Tech has had just one break-even home season and one losing season in Cassell Coliseum ... The 17 victories for the Hokies at home in the 2009-10 season set a new Cassell Coliseum and school record.

#### **Roster News**

Along with scholarship freshman Marshall Wood, the Hokies have two other new faces on the team ... Freshman Marcus Patrick and sophomore Christian Beyer have joined Joey Racer and Will Johnston as walk-ons this season.

#### **Beginning to Raines**

**Cadarian Raines** started nine games last season, including the final eight games of the season ... In those eight games, Raines scored 81 points and grabbed 37 rebounds ... Raines had entered that stretch of games with career totals of 147 points and 132 rebounds in 50 games ... Raines had missed most of the two previous seasons with foot injuries.

#### **Rolling Out the Honors**

Will Johnston and Joey Racer were named to the 56th annual Atlantic Coast Conference Academic Honor Roll, recognizing academic excellence by student-athletes during the 2011-12 academic year.

Tech is 2-5 all-time in the Challenge and is 1-2 in home Challenge games ... The ACC has won 10 of the 13 Challenges to date ... The Big Ten has won the last three events.

#### What We Return

The Hokies return 1,354 of 2,147 points from last year's team, or 63.1 percent of the scoring ... Tech also returns 51.7 percent of the rebounding and 64.0 percent of the assists.

#### What The ACC Returns

The Atlantic Coast Conference returns three players from last season's All-ACC second team ... Virginia Tech's Erick Green, NC State's C.J. Leslie and Florida State's Micael Snaer were all on the second team last year ... All five members of the third team return ... NC State is the only school that returns more than one all-league performer (Leslie and Lorenzo Brown) ... No first team members return.

#### Young But Experienced

The Hokies have but one scholarship senior on this year's team, **Erick Green** ... Tech also has two juniors ... Everyone else is either a sophomore or freshman ... However, the Hokies' returning players have accounted for 314 game appearances, including 110 career starts, entering the 2012-13 season ... Green has 57 of those career starts and **Jarell Eddie** has 32 of the career starts.

#### **The New Assistants**

Along with the hiring of James Johnson as the Hokies' new head coach, Tech has added expierenced aides for Johnson in his first season ... Kurt Kanaskie, Ramon Williams and Mark Byington bring 60 years of college basketball coaching experience to the stafff ... Andy Moore, who was an assistant at Michigan, Bowling Green and Eastern Michigan has joined the staff as Director of Men's Basketball Operations.

#### **Newer Than New**

Freshman **Greg Donlon** has joined the Hokies program, but you will not find him in the media guide or the game program ... Donlon, a 6-8 forward from Midlothian, Va., was added to the Hokies' roster on Nov. 5.

#### Won't Get Lost

Two of the new assistants this season, **Ramon Williams** and **Mark Byington**, won't have to ask for too many directions around town ... Williams is a native of Roanoke and played collegiately at VMI, while Byington was raised in Salem and lived in Blacksburg for a short time ... Williams and his twin brother, Damon, have remained very active in the Roanoke community through the years ... New video coordinator, **Winston Curry**, is also a Roanoke native.

#### Win 10

With Virginia Tech's win over Boston College last season, it marked the ninth straight season that the Hokies had won at least 10 home games ... Tech's longest streak of 10-or-more home victories is 11 consecutive seasons, from 1975-76 through the 1985-86 season.

#### **Eddie is Honored**

**Jarell Eddie** was named to the 2012 All-Atlantic Coast Conference Academic Men's Basketball team ... The junior from Charlotte, N.C., was one of 12 players from seven ACC schools named to the team.

#### From the Line

**Erick Green** enters tonight's game shooting 78.3 percent from the free throw line for his career, just outside the Virginia Tech top 10 in career free throw percentage ... Green, along with junior wing **Jarell Eddie**, combined for 84.2 percent from the free throw line last season ... Eddie is 81.7 percent from the line in his career, but does not, at this point, have enough free throw attempts to qualify for the list ... Eddie's 86.8 percent from the line last season was the fifth-best season in Virginia Tech history.

#### **Hokies in Season and Home Openers**

With the win over ETSU, Virginia Tech is now 9-0 in season openers since joining the ACC and the same 9-0 in home openers since joining the ACC ... The Hokies are 40-10 in season openers since the opening of Cassell Coliseum (this does not include the season opener of the 1961-62 season, since Cassell opened in January of that season, nor does it include the season opener in the 2002-03 season that the Hokies lost to St. Bonaventure in the Paradise Jam, that was later vacated by St. Bonaventure due to an ineligible player) ... The Hokies are 50-2 all-time in home openers in Cassell Coliseum and won their first 25 home openers in the arena before losing to James Madison, 70-67, in the home opener in 1986.

Virginia Tech has announced the signing of four players to national letters of intent ... Donte Clark, a 6-4 guard from Charlotte, N.C., Ben Emelogu, a 6-5 guard from Grand Prairie, Tex., Maurice Kirby, a 6-9 forward from Chandler, Ariz., and Trevor Thompson, a 6-10 forward from Indianapolis, Ind., all signed with the Hokies on Nov. 14 and will join the program in the fall of 2013.

### **Making Their Debuts**

James Johnson is the 13th person to make their collegiate head coaching debut as a head coach at an Atlantic Coast Conference school ... The first was Horace "Bones" McKinney at Wake Forest in 1957 ... Among the others on this list are Jeff Jones, Vic Bubas, Bill Guthridge and the legandary Dean Smith ... One of the 12 other coaches, Sidney Lowe at NC State in 2006, had been an NBA head coach prior to making his collegiate debut.

## **Head Coach James Johnson**

James Johnson begins his first season as Virginia Tech's head men's basketball coach. Director of Athletics Jim Weaver named Johnson to the position on May 1, 2012.

On Nov. 10, 2012, in his first game as a collegiate head coach, Johnson picked up his first head coaching victory, an 80-62 win over East Tennessee State in Cassell Coliseum. Johnson is now 3-0 as head coach of the Hokies.

No stranger to the Hokie Nation, Johnson spent the last five seasons on the men's basketball staff at Virginia Tech. He was an assistant coach from 2007-2011 before being promoted to associate head coach prior to last season. He had accepted an assistant coaches' position at Clemson on April 13 of this year, but returns to Blacksburg to take over the reins of the men's basketball program.

"I am very pleased to welcome James Johnson as the new head men's basketball coach at Virginia Tech," Weaver said. "He is an individual with 19 years of coaching experience, who has spent the last five years here at Virginia Tech. He knows and has recruited most of our current players. We believe that he is the right person at this moment in time."

Johnson joined the Hokies following two seasons as an assistant at George Mason. While at Mason, he focused on organizing the team's defensive efforts in practice and games. The Patriots were a combined 45-23 in his two seasons and advanced to the 2006 NCAA Final Four.

Before GMU, Johnson spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Penn State. He was the recruitment coordinator for the Nittany Lions. Prior to Penn State, Johnson had a one-year stint as an assistant at the College of Charleston and he spent two years as an assistant at Elon.

"Virginia Tech and the Hokie Nation have a special place in my heart and I am blessed and excited for the opportunity to become the head basketball coach," Johnson said. "I look forward to working with a great group of young men and moving forward with this program."

Johnson, a native of Powhatan, Va., was a four-year player and three-year

starter at Ferrum College. A three-time Defensive Player of the Year, he helped guide his team to two conference championships and a berth in the NCAA Division III Tournament. He was also voted his team's Most Valuable Player in 1993. In 2001, Johnson was selected as one of the Top 10 players in Ferrum basketball history. In September of 2009, Johnson was elected into the Ferrum College Athletic Hall of Fame.

After graduating from Ferrum with a bachelor of science in psychology in 1993, he immediately stepped into the coaching ranks at his alma mater and served as an assistant for two seasons. Johnson helped guide the Panthers to a regular-season conference title.

In 1995, Johnson moved on to Longwood College as an assistant and then spent one year at Hargrave Military Academy, where he worked with the post-graduate team. In 1997, he began a three-year run as an assistant at Old Dominion. Johnson is a member of the Black Coaches Association (BCA) and the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC). In March 2001, Rivals. com named Johnson one of the Top 20 Assistant Coaches at Mid-Major Division I Schools. He was a squad leader in the Army National Guard from 1989-91.



### GAME 1

#### VIRGINIA TECH 80, ETSU 62

NOV. 10, 2012 • 2 P.M. • BLACKSBURG, VA.

**Erick Green** scored 21 points to pace three players in double figures, as the Hokies made a winner of head coach James Johnson in his debut, downing East Tennessee State 80-62 at Cassell Coliseum in the season opener for both teams.

The Hokies' first-half shooting was just too much for ETSU to overcome, as Tech shot 56.5 percent from the floor (13 of 23) in running out to a 15-point lead at the break. The Buccaneers were within eight points with about six minutes left in the first half, but **Robert Brown** hit two 3-pointers sandwiched around a **Jarell Eddie** 3-pointer to give the Hokies a 15-point bulge, and the Buccaneers never recovered.

Green scored 14 of his 21 points in the first half and Brown added 13 for the Hokies, hitting three 3-pointers. Brown, coming off foot surgery this summer, finished with 16, while Eddie had 17 points and 10 rebounds for his second career double-double.

Nearly everything went right for Johnson in his debut. He planned to have his team play a more up-tempo style, and the Hokies scored 80 points – something they did just three times a year ago. They shot a respectable 46.6 percent from the floor and made 10 of 25 from beyond the 3-point arc. They also dished out 19 assists (six by Green) compared to 10 turnovers.

**Cadarian Raines** scored nine points and grabbed four rebounds for the Hokies, while **Marshall Wood**, a freshman, grabbed six rebounds and scored five points.

Freshman Lester Wilson came off the bench to lead the Buccaneers with 20 points. ETSU, which trailed by as many as 25 in the second half, shot just 38.7 percent from the floor (24 of 62).

### GAME 2

#### VIRGINIA TECH 69, RHODE ISLAND 50

NOV. 12, 2012 • 7 P.M. • BLACKSBURG, VA.

**Erick Green** tied his career high with 25 points to lift the Hokies past Rhode Island 69-50 at Cassell Coliseum.

With the win, the Hokies moved to 2-0 overall on the season. Rhode Island fell to 0-2.

Green scored 17 of his 25 in the first half, as Tech jumped out to a 13-0 lead and never trailed. The Rams missed their first seven shots from the floor and didn't score in the first 5:08 of the game.

Rhode Island cut the lead to 28-24 on a basket by Xavier Munford with 1:59 left in the first half. But the Hokies scored the last eight points of the half – six of those coming on two Green 3-pointers – to take a 36-24 lead at halftime.

Rhode Island got no closer than 11 the rest of the game. The Rams had a chance to cut the lead to nine with 10:02 remaining, but Nikola Malesevic missed a layup, and Green responded for the Hokies by making two free throws with 9:46 left to push the lead back to 13.

Tech led by as many as 21 in the second half.

Malesevic's missed layup was part of a terrible shooting night for the Rams, who made just 33.9 percent from the floor (20 of 59). Even worse, they made just 1 of 21 from beyond the 3-point arc.

Green, in particular, was great on offense. He hit 8 of 15 from the floor, including four 3-pointers. He made 5 of 8 from the free-throw line, and he also dished out four assists.

**Robert Brown** scored 12 for the Hokies, and **Cadarian Raines** recorded his first career double-double, with 10 points and 12 rebounds.

As a team, the Hokies shot 45.6 percent from the floor and out-rebounded the Rams 42-37 after getting out-rebounded by East Tennessee State in the season opener.

### GAME 3

#### VIRGINIA TECH 95, VMI 80

NOV. 15, 2012 • 7 P.M. • BLACKSBURG, VA.

Virginia Tech point guard **Erick Green** scored 23 points, including the 1,000th of his career, as the Hokies rolled past VMI 95-80.

Tech trailed in the early going, but a Green 3-pointer with 15:38 left in the first half sparked a 19-3 run in which five different players scored. A second Tech run late in the first half essentially put the game away. The Hokies led 35-21 at the media timeout with less than eight minutes left and then scored seven straight points out of the timeout to take a 42-21 bulge.

Tech led 46-30 at halftime and then opened the second half with a 12-2 run to build a 26-point lead. The Hokies, who are adapting to new coach James Johnson's fast-paced philosophies, would later lead by as many as 31. Only a 16-0 run by VMI late in the game against Tech's backups made the score respectable.

A Green jumper in that 12-2 run with 19:08 remaining in the game marked his 1,000th career point.

Green nailed 9 of 13 from the floor, including his lone 3-point attempt, and the Hokies, as a team, shot 52.9 percent. Four other players finished in double figures, with Jarell Eddie scoring 17, Cadarian Raines adding 14 and both Robert Brown and C.J. Barksdale each scoring 11.

Tech nailed 11 of 24 from beyond the 3-point arc, as Eddie and walk-on **Will Johnston** hit three 3-pointers and Brown and freshman Marshall Wood hit two each.

The Hokies' height and length bothered VMI the entire game, as Tech held the Keydets to just 35.5 percent from the floor in the first half and 40 percent for the game. The Keydets got a career-high 23 points from D.J. Covington.
