The Hokies enter today's game 3-2 overall following a 78-63 win over Miami University in Puerto Aventuras, Mexico on Wednesday night ... Morgan State is 1-5 on the season,



following a 51-50 win over Liberty in Puerto Aventuras, Mexico on Wednesday afternoon.

Last Time Out: VT 78, Miami (OH) 63

The Hokies won the consolation game of the Cancun Classic on Wednesday night with a 78-63 win over Miami University in Puerto Aventuras, Mexico ... Adam Smith came off the bench with 26 points and Justin Bibbs posted a career-high 22 points in the win ... Tech out rebounded the RedHawks, 35-35 and made 18-of-24 at the free throw line in the victory.

Series Against The Bears

The Hokies are 7-0 all-time against Morgan State, with all games being played in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech won the most recent meeting, 94-62, in Cassell on March 19, 2008, in the NIT ... The Hokies are 26-0 all-time against schools currently in the MEAC.

A Great Start Continues

Justin Bibbs scored a career-high 22 points in the win over Miami University, making five-of-six from three-point range ... He is the first Virginia Tech freshman to score more than 20 points in a game since Ben Emelogu scored 21 points at home against Maryland on Feb. 1, 2014.

Youthful Scoring

Freshman **Justin Bibbs** leads the Hokies in scoring so far this season, averaging 13.0 points per game ... That is the highest scoring average for a Virginia Tech freshman five games into his career since the 2007-08 season, when Jeff Allen

was averaging 15.2 ppg five games into his Virginia Tech career ... At the five game mark, since joining the ACC in 2004-05, no Hokie freshman was leading the team in scoring.

JVZ Honored

Joey van Zegeren had 17 points and 10 rebounds in the win over Liberty, his first career double-double ... In the loss to UNI, he scored 15 points and a team-high six rebounds ... In the win over Miami University, he had eight points and a team-

high nine rebounds ... For his efforts, he was named to the All-Tournament team of the Cancun Challenge.

Teaming Up on the RedHawks

In the win over Miami University, **Adam Smith** scored 26 points and **Justin Bibbs** added 22 points ... Smith and Bibbs became the first Hokie teammates to each score 20-or-morepoints in the same game since that same Wake Forest

game last season, when Jarell Eddie scored 20 points to go along with **Devin Wilson's** 26 points.

Putting a Lid on the Basket

Miami's 17 points in the first half on the Hokies' win on Wednesday is the fewest points Tech has allowed in a half this season and the fewest in any half since Miami (Fla.) scored 15 points in the first half in Cassell Coliseum on Feb. 15, 2013.

From 3 by 2

Tech made a season-high 10 three-point field goals in the win over Miami University, the most since the Hokies made 12 three-pointers in the win at the University of Miami on Dec. 8, 2013 ... Oddly enough, two players, **Justin Bibbs** and **Adam Smith**, accounted for all 10 three-pointers in the contest tonight, each making five.

Gimme That!

Malik Müller had four steals in the win over Liberty ... That surpasses the high in steals for a Hokie during last season ... The last Hokie with four steals in a game was Erick Green at Florida State on Feb. 16, 2012.

Hot, Hot, Hot from the Field

The Hokies shot 61.0 percent from the field in the win over Liberty ... The last time the Hokies shot better than 61 percent from the field in a game was on Nov. 14, 2011, when Tech shot 62.5 percent from the floor in a win over Monmouth ... Tech shot 73.7 percent from the field in the second half vs. Liberty.

Taking as a Team

The Hokies recorded nine steals in the win over Liberty ... The last time the Hokies had nine steals in a single game was in the loss at Florida State on Feb. 16, 2012.

Müller Returns

The NCAA ruled freshman guard **Malik Müller** ineligible for the 2013-14 season due to initial eligibility rules ... Müller was able to practice with the team last season ... He is now eligible to play four years and is listed as a redshirt freshman ... Müller played his first game for the Hokies last Friday night after redshirting last season, but the freshman guard was busy playing over the summer ... He had five games in double figures for his native Germany in FIBA U20 Championships in Crete this summer ... Müller scored 15 points in his first collegiate game against UMES and followed that with nine points, four assists and four steals in the win over Liberty.

A Young Three

In Tech's win over Maryland-Eastern Shore on Friday night, freshmen Malik Müller, Justin Bibbs and Ahmed Hill all scored in double-figures ... That marked the first time since Nov. 18, 2000 that three freshmen making their

collegiate debuts for the Hokies all scored in double figures ... That night, a 92-68 win over VMI, Carlos Dixon (21 points), Chris Exilus (20 points) and Bryant Matthews (17 points) pulled off the same feat.

High on Low Points

In the season-opening win over Maryland-Eastern Shore, the Hokies allowed the Hawks just 46 points ... That's the fewest points Tech has allowed an opponent since a 52-45 win over Miami in Cassell Coliseum last season ... It is the fewest points allowed in a season-opener since Nov. 10, 2006, when Tech defeated Coppin State, 94-43, in Cassell.

Playing Tight Defense

In the win over Maryland-Eastern Shore, the Hokies held UMES to just 13 field goals in the game ... That is the fewest number of field goals allowed to an opponent since Jan. 2, 2011, when the Hokies held Mount St. Mary's to just nine field goals ... UMES managed just 27.7 percent from the field for the game, the lowest field goal percentage allowed by the Hokies since Dec. 10, 2012, when the Hokies allowed Mississippi Valley State just 25.7 percent from the field.

Not in a Giving Mood

Virginia Tech committed just six turnovers in the win over UMES, including none in the first half ... That is the fewest turnovers committed by the Hokies in a game since March 12, 2014, when the Hokies committed just three turnovers against Miami in the ACC Tournament ... The Hokies went 32 minutes and 15 seconds before committing their first turnover this season.

500-Plus in the Cassell

The Hokies have a 540-175 overall record in Cassell Coliseum, good for a .755 winning percentage ... The win over Florida State on Jan. 8, 2011, was the 500th victory in the building ... Tech defeated Rhode Island, 86-63, on Nov. 20, 2002, in its 500th game in the arena ... Tech has had just one break-even home season and two losing season in Cassell Coliseum ... The Hokies are 2-1 in Cassell Coliseum this season.

Finally a Two

After hitting a threepointer in the loss to Northern Iowa, **Will Johnston** has made 51 field goals and all but three of them have been three-pointers ... He made a career-high four threepointers in the win over

Furman, a feat he matched at FSU last season.

Three current Hokies have earned All-ACC Academic team honors while at Virginia Tech ... Joey van Zegeren and Will Johnston were named to the team last season and Christian Beyer was named to the team in 2013 ...

Last year, Beyer won the Skelton Award, given annually to the top male student-athlete at Virginia Tech.

South of the Border

This was not the first trip south of the border for the Hokies ... On Jan. 2, 2010, the Hokies defeated Seton Hall, 103-94, in overtime in the Cancun Governor's Cup at the Poliforum Benito Juarez ... Dorenzo Hudson scored 41 points and Jeff Allen had 23 points in the win ... Tech is now 2-1 in games played in Mexico.

370 and Counting

The Hokies have hit at least one three-pointer in every game since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season ... Tech has now hit a three in 370 consecutive games, the most in school history ... Since the three-point arc was added to college basketball for the 1986-87 season, the Hokies have hit at least one three in all but three games ... The last time that the Hokies did not record a three-point field goal in a game was at Providence on Feb. 1, 2003.

Larger Than Last Year

In the win over Miami University, the Hokies led the game, 67-38, with 9:09 remaining ... That 29-point lead was larger than the largest lead of last season, which was 27 points in the win over UMES ... The last time the Hokies led a game by more than 28 points was on Nov. 15, 2012, when Tech led VMI, 86-51, in the second half ... Tech's 25-point margin of victory against UMES tied the largest margin of victory from last season, also 25 points against the Hawks ... In the season-opening win over UMES, Tech had a 28-point lead.

The Multi-Lingual Big Man

Communicating with **Joey van Zegeren** is easy for most students at Virginia Tech, regardless of nationality ... The redshirt junior from The Netherlands is fluent in five languages and has understanding of several others ... If you see him around campus, make sure to say "Hello", or "Hola", or "Hallo", or "Bonjour", or, well, you get the idea.

Stretching It Out

Tech's 22 points halftime lead in the win over Miami University is its largest halftime lead of the season and the largest since a 23-point lead over UMES on Dec. 31, 2013.

Dishing It Out

In the win over Furman last season, **Devin Wilson** recorded 11 assists ... The last Hokie freshman to record 11 assists in a single game was Dell Curry, who had 11 assists as a freshman against Maryland-Eastern Shore on Dec. 4, 1982 ...

The 11 assists is also one assist shy of the Tech overall school record of 12, set by Dave Sensibaugh, Bimbo Coles and, most recently, Troy Manns in 1997 ... In the home win over Miami, Wilson had nine assists, his personal high in assists in an ACC game and ties the school's record for assists in an ACC game ... He matched that total of assists with nine in the NC State game.

All-Time Record

Virginia Tech is now 1369-1151 all-time in collegiate basketball, good for a .543 winning percentage ... Last season's game against Clemson marked the 2,500th game in school history ... This is the Hokies' 106th season of men's basketball.


There's a First Time for Everything

Will Johnston made his first collegiate start at Virginia in the 2012-13 season ... It marked the first time a walk-on had started for the Hokies since Joey Racer started in the home finale against NC State two seasons ago ... It was the first time that the Hokies have started a walk-on in a non-Senior Day situation since at least the 1999-2000 season ... In the loss at Notre Dame last season, walk-on Christian Beyer made his first collegiate start ... Johnston started in the win over Miami University, the 15th of his career.

It Runs in the Family

Virginia Tech senior **Will Johnston** is not the only student-athlete in his family ... Older sister, Paige, ran track at Arkansas ... Younger sister, Marie, runs track at Virginia Tech this season after transferring from Wake Forest ... Youngest sister, Kari, is a freshman on Virginia Tech's nationally-ranked women's soccer team ... Will has seven sisters in all.

Of those nine, there are three juniors (one of whom is new to the Hokies this season), one sophomore and the rest are freshmen ... Entering the season-opener vs. UMES, five Virginia Tech players had career starts for the Hokies, led by 31 starts by sophomore **Devin Wilson** ... In the UMES game, Malik Müller and Justin Bibbs made their first career starts ... Ahmed Hill, Jalen **Hudson** and **Satchel Pierce** also saw their first collegiate action in the game... Shane Henry made his Division I debut in the win ... In the loss to Northern Iowa, add Henry and Hill to the list of players making their first collegiate starts.

The Hokies have returned from the Hard Rock Resort Maya Riveria and the 2014 Cancun Challenge, but the event goes one ... Today's game against Morgan State is the final game of the event ... The Hokies are 2-1 in the Cancun Challenge ...

The Hokies play seven games against teams in the top 25 of last year's NCAA RPI ... Tech plays 10 games against top 50 teams and 13 against top 100 teams ... Tech plays nine games against teams in the 2014 NCAA Tournament, four games against NIT teams ... Four of the Hokies' nine ACC home games are against 2014 NCAA Tournament teams ... The Virginia Tech – VMI game will be the 132nd all-time meeting in the series, the second most-played rivalry and most-played non-conference rivalry for the Hokies ... Tech will play Radford for the eighth time; Radford is 12.9 miles from the Virginia Tech campus ... Tech will play five games against schools from the Commonwealth of Virginia, four in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech will play The Citadel for the first time since Feb. 16, 1966; author Pat Conroy was on that Citadel team ... This will be the 19th meeting between the two schools ... Of the nine home non-conference games, three are against teams from Virginia, two against teams from Maryland, two against teams from South Carolina.

That's the most frequently asked question regarding Virginia Tech athletics ... The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute ... With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body ... Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Old Hokie" yell which still is used today ... Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the words he used had no hidden or symbolic meaning, but had been thought up in an effort to get attention ... Hokie soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

Our Name, Please

When referring to Virginia Tech, we ask that you please leave it at that - Virginia Tech ... Virginia Tech University is not now and never has been a name for the school ... The official name of the university is Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University ... "Vah Tech", VPI, VPI&SU, VPI and SU and Va. Tech are also not recognized names and should not be used ... VT is acceptable as a shortended, agate form ... When referring to the school by its nickname, please use "Hokies" ... Your help in these matters is appreciated.

Head Coach Buzz Williams



Buzz Williams begins his first season as the head men's basketball coach at Virginia Tech. Williams comes to the Hokies following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, Williams had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season, the same season the team won the Big East Conference regular season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. Six Marquette players have made it to the NBA during Williams' tenure.

"I am extremely excited about welcoming Buzz Williams to the Hokie Nation," Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock said at the time of Williams' hiring in March. "Buzz is a proven winner who has earned his way up through the ranks with a strong track record of success. I am confident he will energize our fan base and help make Virginia Tech basketball competitive in the Atlantic Coast Conference. I know he will recruit at the highest level."

"It's never easy to leave a great school like Marquette, where I spent seven wonderful years, six as the head coach," Williams said. "But this is a special situation to work at a place like Virginia Tech. I've heard tremendous things about this terrific institution and this is an outstanding

opportunity to build a program. My family and I look forward to becoming a part of this great university and community, and taking on the challenges associated with succeeding in the ACC."

Williams was an assistant at Marquette in the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 19 seasons, and 2013-14 was his seventh campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached over 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league players of the year, two conference freshmen of the year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07 and his roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top-50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator

at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 25 years in 2005-06 and the previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, serving as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40-best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure and he was named one of the top assistants in the country by HoopScoopOnline.com.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M- Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple has two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
