About Tonight's Game

The Hokies enter tonight's game 6-4 overall following a 64-61 win over The Citadel in Cassell Coliseum on Saturday ... VMI is 5-6 on the season, following a 92-77 win at home over Marist last Friday.

Last Time Out: VT 64, The Citadel 61

The Hokies won their second consecutive game with a 64-61 victory over The Citadel on Saturday afternoon ... Adam Smith scored 16 points to lead the Hokies and Joey van Zegeren and Devin Wilson came off the bench to add 10 points apiece ... Tech fought back from a five-point halftime deficit for the victory.

Series Against The Keydets

This is the renewal of Tech's most-played non-conference rivalry ... The Hokies are 88-43 all-time against VMI, 53-10 at home and 18-1 in games in Cassell Coliseum against the Keydets ... Tech has won the last three meetings between the two schools, most recently a 105-92 victory in Cassell Coliseum on Nov. 18, 2013 ... The Hokies are 151-64 all-time against schools currently in the Southern Conference ... This is the second of two consecutive games against Southern Conference teams, a conference of which Virginia Tech was a member from 1921-1965.

Renewing Old Conference Rivalries

Concluding with tonight's game, the Hokies will have played consecutive games against The Citadel and VMI, both members of the Southern Conference ... The Hokies were members of the Southern Conference from 1921 until 1965, when Tech withdrew from the league to become an independent ... Tech was 14-2 against The Citadel and 53-27 against VMI as members of the Southern Conference.

Familiar Foe

Tonight's game is the 132nd all-time meeting in this series, the second mostplayed rivalry and most-played nonconference rivalry for the Hokies.

Commonwealth Notes

Virginia Tech is 424-311 (.577) all-time against schools from Virginia ... Tech is 1-1 this season against schools from the Commonwealth and was 2-3 last season against state schools ... The Hokies have played 14 schools from the state ... With the win over Norfolk State on Dec. 11, 2011, the only state Division I school that Tech has not played is Hampton ... Tech holds winning records against 10 of the schools and even records against two others ... Tech has played Radford and Liberty from the Commonwealth this year and has a home-and-home with Virginia during ACC play this season.

Youthful Points

The Hokies have five freshmen on this season's roster and all are seeing significant minutes ... The quintet is averaging 31.8 points per game and the 316 points accounts for 46.8 percent of the team's scoring ... The group has made 24 of the 50 available starts for the team and has 10 games of doublefigure scoring.

JVZ Superlatives

With his season-high 18 points, plus 10 rebounds at Penn State, Joey van Zegeren recorded his second career doubledouble, both this season ... He leads the team in field goals made, field goal percentage, rebounding and

blocked shots ... van Zegeren has scored 104 points in 10 games; last season, he scored his 104th point in the team's 21st game, against Maryland on Feb. 1.

Production Off the Bench

So far this season, the Hokies have scored 675 total points ... Of that number, 381 points have come from the starting five of each game and the remaining 294 points come from the reserves ... Tech's bench accounts for 43.6 percent of its scoring in games so far this season.

Big Boards

In the loss at Penn State, Ahmed Hill grabbed a career-best nine rebounds ... It marks the most rebounds by a Virginia Tech player under 6-6 since Malcolm Delaney had nine rebounds in a home win

Ahmed Hill over No. 23/25 Wake Forest on Feb. 16, 2010 ... The last time a Hokie under 6-6 had double-figures in rebounding was on March 10, 2007, when Jamon Gordon had 11 rebounds in a loss to NC State in the 2007 ACC Tournament in Tampa.

Combining the Two

When Devin Wilson recorded his first career double-double with 10 points and 11 assists in the win over Morgan State, it was the first time a Tech player had a non-points/ rebounds double-double

Devin Wilson since Erick Green had 23 points and 10 assists in the loss at West Virginia on Dec. 8, 2012.


From 3!

Virginia Tech made eight three-point field goals in the first half of the win over Morgan State, the most three-pointers in a half this season ... Tech made 12 threes in the game, the most since Dec. 8, 2013, when Tech made 12 threes in the win at Miami ... The last time Tech made more than 12 threes in a game was Nov. 22, 2013, when the Hokies made 13 threes in the loss to No. 1 Michigan State.

SWAT!

The Hokies blocked 12 shots in the win over Morgan State, a season high and the most by a Virginia Tech team since Nov. 12, 2013, when the Hokies blocked 13 shots in the home win over West Virginia ... Joey van Zegeren blocked a career-high-tying six shots in the contest, equaling his mark of six blocks at Notre Dame on Jan. 19, 2014 ... The school record is nine blocked shots in one game.

Good at Sharing

Tech had 19 assists in the win over Morgan State, a season-high and the most by a Virginia Tech team since Tech had 19 assists in the season-opening home win against East Tennessee State on Nov. 10, 2012 ... The last time a Virginia Tech team had 20-or-moreassists in a game was on Nov. 15, 2011, when Tech posted 20 assists in the home win over Florida International.

Cleaning the Glass

In the win over Morgan State, the Hokies grabbed a season-high 43 rebounds ... That is the most rebounds in a game since Tech grabbed 43 boards in the double overtime loss at Pittsburgh last season ... The last time Tech grabbed more than 43 rebounds in a game was Dec. 21, 2013, when Tech had 44 rebounds at VCU.

Teaming Up on the RedHawks

In the win over Miami University, Adam Smith scored 26 points

and Justin Bibbs added 22 points ... Smith and Bibbs became the first Hokie teammates to each score 20-or-more-points in the same game since that same Wake Forest game last season, when Jarell Eddie scored 20 points to go along with **Devin Wilson's** 26 points ... Bibbs and Smith accounted for all 10 threepointers in the contest tonight, each making five.

Warming Up from 3 Adam Smith made six

in the win over Morgan State, a new career-high ... The six threes is one off the school record of seven threes in one game, by three players, most recently Malcolm Delaney vs. UNLV on Nov. 28, 2010 ... Smith's previous career high was five threes, which he accomplished in the previous game, a win over Miami University in Mexico.

Been a Long Time

Christian Beyer's 13 points in the win against Alabama A&M marks the first time a Virginia Tech walk-on has scored in double figures since Dec. 2, 2000, when Alex Martin scored 13 points against Syracuse in the finals of the 2000 Carrier Classic.

Putting a Lid on the Basket

Miami University's 17 points in the first half on the Hokies' win is the fewest points Tech has allowed in a half this season and the fewest in any half since Miami (Fla.) scored 15 points in the first half in Cassell Coliseum on Feb. 15, 2013.

Finally a Two

After hitting a twopoint field goal and a three-pointer in the win over Alabama A&M, **Will Johnston** has made 56 field goals and all but five of them have been three-pointers ... He made a career-high four three-

pointers in the win over Furman, a feat he matched at FSU last season ... In the win over Morgan State, Johnston turned his lone twopointer into a three-point play, hitting the free throw after being fouled.

Hot, Hot, Hot from the Field

The Hokies shot 61.0 percent from the field in the win over Liberty ... The last time the Hokies shot better than 61 percent from the field in a game was on Nov. 14, 2011, when Tech shot 62.5 percent from the floor in a win over Monmouth ... Tech shot 73.7 percent from the field in the second half vs. Liberty.

A Young Three

In Tech's win over Maryland-Eastern Shore, freshmen **Malik Müller**, **Justin Bibbs** and **Ahmed Hill** all scored in doublefigures ... That marked the first time since Nov. 18, 2000 that three freshmen making their collegiate

debuts for the Hokies all scored in double figures ... That night, a 92-68 win over VMI, Carlos Dixon (21 points), Chris Exilus (20 points) and Bryant Matthews (17 points) pulled off the same feat.

Not in a Giving Mood

Virginia Tech committed just six turnovers in the win over UMES, including none in the first half ... That is the fewest turnovers committed by the Hokies in a game since March 12, 2014, when the Hokies committed just three turnovers against Miami in the ACC Tournament ... The Hokies went 32 minutes and 15 seconds before committing their first turnover this season ... Tech committed just eight turnovers in the loss at Penn State.

All-Time Record

Virginia Tech is now 1371-1153 all-time in collegiate basketball, good for a .543 winning percentage ... Last season's game against Clemson marked the 2,500th game in school history ... This is the Hokies' 106th season of men's basketball.

Larger Than Last Year

In the win over Miami University, the Hokies led the game, 67-38, with 9:09 remaining ... That 29-point lead was larger than the largest lead of last season, which was 27 points in the win over UMES ... The last time the Hokies led a game by more than 28 points was on Nov. 15, 2012, when Tech led VMI, 86-51 ... Tech's 25-point margin of victory against UMES tied the largest margin of victory from last season, also 25 points against the Hawks ... In the season-opening win over UMES, Tech had a 28-point lead ... Tech's 22 points halftime lead in the win over Miami University is its largest halftime lead of the season and the largest since a 23-point lead over UMES on Dec. 31, 2013.

375 and Counting

The Hokies have hit at least one threepointer in every game since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season ... Tech has now hit a three in 375 consecutive games, the most in school history ... Since the three-point arc was added to college basketball for the 1986-87 season, the Hokies have hit at least one three in all but three games ... The last time that the Hokies did not record a three-point field goal in a game was at Providence on Feb. 1, 2003.

VT in NCAA Stats

As of Dec. 19, 2014, the Hokies are 41st nationally in field goal percentage and 30th nationally in three-point field goal percentage.

Smart Group

Three current Hokies have earned All-ACC Academic team honors while at Virginia Tech ... Joey van Zegeren and Will Johnston were named to the team last season and Christian Beyer was named to the team in 2013 ... Last year, Beyer won the Skelton Award, given annually to the top male student-athlete at Virginia Tech.

The Multi-Lingual Big Man

Communicating with **Joey van Zegeren** is easy for most students at Virginia Tech, regardless of nationality ... The redshirt junior from The Netherlands is fluent in five languages and has understanding of several others ... If you see him around campus, make sure to say "Hello", or "Hola", or "Hallo", or "Bonjour", or, well, you get the idea.

Stepping Up Once Again

The Hokies' win over Alabama A&M marked **Christian Beyer's** second career start and first career home start ... He entered the game without a rebound or a point and just four minutes played in the first eight games of the season ... He scored a career-high 13 points and grabbed a team-high nine rebounds, while playing 27 minutes.

Dishing It Out

In the win over Morgan State, **Devin Wilson** recorded 11 assists, matching his career high posted in last year's win over Furman ... The 11 assists is also one assist shy of the Tech overall school record of 12, set by Dave Sensibaugh, Bimbo Coles and, most recently, Troy Manns in 1997 ... In the home win over Miami last season, Wilson had nine assists, his personal high in assists in an ACC game and ties the school's record for assists in an ACC game ... He matched that total of assists with nine in the NC State game.

It was the first time that the Hokies have started a walk-on in a non-Senior Day situation since at least the 1999-2000 season ... In the loss at Notre Dame last season, walkon **Christian Beyer** made his first collegiate start ... Johnston started in the win over The Citadel, the 17th of his career.

What is a Hokie?

That's the most frequently asked question regarding Virginia Tech athletics ... The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute ... With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body ... Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Old Hokie" yell which still is used today ... Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the words he used had no hidden or symbolic meaning, but had been thought up in an effort to get attention ... Hokie soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

Our Name, Please

When referring to Virginia Tech, we ask that you please leave it at that - Virginia Tech ... Virginia Tech University is not now and never has been a name for the school ... The official name of the university is Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University ... "Vah Tech", VPI, VPI&SU, VPI and SU and Va. Tech are also not recognized names and should not be used ... VT is acceptable as a shortened, agate form ... When referring to the school by its nickname, please use "Hokies" ... Your help in these matters is appreciated.

Head Coach Buzz Williams



Buzz Williams begins his first season as the head men's basketball coach at Virginia Tech. Williams comes to the Hokies following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, Williams had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season, the same season the team won the Big East Conference regular season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. Six Marquette players have made it to the NBA during Williams' tenure.

"I am extremely excited about welcoming Buzz Williams to the Hokie Nation," Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock said at the time of Williams' hiring in March. "Buzz is a proven winner who has earned his way up through the ranks with a strong track record of success. I am confident he will energize our fan base and help make Virginia Tech basketball competitive in the Atlantic Coast Conference. I know he will recruit at the highest level."

"It's never easy to leave a great school like Marquette, where I spent seven wonderful years, six as the head coach," Williams said. "But this is a special situation to work at a place like Virginia Tech. I've heard tremendous things about this terrific institution and this is an outstanding opportunity to build a program. My family and I look forward to becoming a part of this great university and community, and taking on the challenges associated with succeeding in the ACC."

Williams was an assistant at Marquette in the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 19 seasons, and 2013-14 was his seventh campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached over 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league players of the year, two conference freshmen of the year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07 and his roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament guarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top-50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting

coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 25 years in 2005-06 and the previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, serving as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40-best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure and he was named one of the top assistants in the country by HoopScoopOnline.com.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M- Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple has two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.


