About Tonight's Game

The Hokies enter tonight's game 10-17 overall and 2-12 in ACC action ... Duke is 24-3 overall and 11-3 in conference play ... Duke is ranked 4th in the AP poll and 5th in the coaches poll ... This is the only meeting between the two schools this season.

Last Time Out: NC State 69, VT 53

The Hokies lost to NC State on Saturday night, 69-53, in PNC Arena ... Justin Bibbs came off the bench to lead all scorers with 19 points and Adam Smith added 15 points for Tech ... Christian Beyer started for the Hokies and had eight points, a team-best seven rebounds and led Tech with a career-high three assists.

Series Against the Blue Devils

This will be the 52nd meeting between the two schools, in a series that dates back to 1912 ... The Blue Devils lead the all-time series, 43-8 ... Tech has lost the last seven games in the series, most recently a 66-48 loss in Cameron Indoor Stadium exactly one year ago tonight ... Virginia Tech is 6-10 against Duke in home games, and 2-5 in games in Cassell Coliseum ... Duke has been ranked in every game the Hokies and Blue Devils have played in ACC competition ... Tonight marks the third time in the last four seasons that the Hokies and Blue Devils have met on Feb. 25.

Making More Shots

This season, the Hokies are shooting 44.6 percent from the field ... Last season, Tech finished the season making 40.6 percent ... The Hokies make, on average, two more field goals per game this season than last ... Tech is also shooting better from three-point range this season.

Tough Week

The Hokies return home to face No. 4/5 Duke tonight ... This Saturday, the Hokies will travel to Charlottesville to take on No. 2/3 Virginia ... This marks just the second time in school history that Tech will play consecutive games against teams ranked in the top 5 of the AP poll ... The only other time that has happened was on Dec. 5 and 6, 1997, when the Hokies played back-to-back games against No. 5 South Carolina and No. 3 North Carolina at the Charlotte Coliseum in the Harris-Teeter Classic.

Hokies vs. Ranked Teams

Tech is 30-162 all-time against teams ranked in the AP poll ... The Hokies are 13-54 against nationally-ranked teams since joining the ACC for the 2004-05 season ... Tech is 0-5 against ranked teams this season ... The last time the Hokies defeated a nationally-ranked team was Dec. 1, 2012, when Tech defeated No. 15 Oklahoma State, 81-71, in Cassell Coliseum ... These numbers are only for teams ranked in the AP poll.

Hokies vs. 4th-Ranked Teams

The Hokies are 2-7 all-time against teams ranked No. 4 in the AP poll ... The last time the Hokies defeated a No. 4 ranked team was Feb. 13, 2007, when Tech defeated North Carolina, 81-80, in overtime in the Dean E. Smith Center ... Tech is 1-1 against Duke when the Blue Devils are ranked 4th ... Seven of the previous nine meetings for Tech against a 4th-ranked team are against teams currently in the ACC ... These numbers are only for teams ranked in the AP poll.

Youthful Points

The Hokies' five freshmen are averaging 35.5 points per game and the 898 points account for 50.9 percent of the team's scoring ... The group has made 65 of the 135 available starts and has 34 games of double-figure scoring, including five games of 20-or-more points ... In ACC play, **Adam Smith** leads the Hokies in scoring, at 14.8 points per game ... The next three players on the Tech scoring list are freshmen, led by **Justin Bibbs** at 13.4 points per game in ACC play.

Off the Road, Again

Saturday night at NC State was the Hokies' final game of a second, three-game road swing during the ACC regular season ... Earlier this season, Tech played at Florida State, No. 6 Louisville and No. 15 North Carolina in succession ... The most recent stretch saw the Hokies play three road games in eight days ... Tech is one of four ACC teams with a stretch of three-consecutive conference road games, but the only ACC team with two such stretches.

Smith for 3!

In the win over Pittsburgh, **Adam Smith** was 6-for-11 from three-point range and made a three-pointer with 0.7 seconds remaining in regulation to send the game to overtime and then, with 3.4 seconds remaining in the extra session, nailed his final three-pointer of the night to give the Hokies their first ACC win of the season ... The six three-pointers ties Smith's career-high and is the most for him in an ACC game and is tied for the most by a Tech player in an ACC game ... Smith is tied for second in the conference in three-pointers made in ACC games and has made multiple three-pointers in eight of the last nine games for the Hokies.

Young Minutes

Virginia Tech freshmen are playing 51.0 percent of the minutes so far this season ... That is the highest percentage of minutes for freshmen by any team in the conference ... Second among ACC schools is Duke, at 48.1 percent ... In ACC play, the Hokies are at 51.2 percent, second is Duke at 50.4 percent ... Tech's numbers are skewed a bit, as Tech's second-leading scorer, **Justin Bibbs**, missed four games in ACC play due to a concussion ... Bibbs averages 29.9 minutes per game overall and 28.6 minutes per game in ACC action.

The Honors Keep Coming for Beyer

The honors keep on rolling in for **Christian Beyer** ... He has been named a recipient of the Weaver-James-Corrigan Award, given annually by the Atlantic Coast Conference ... The postgraduate scholarships are awarded to selected student-athletes who intend to pursue a graduate degree following completion of their undergraduate requirements ... Each recipient will receive \$5,000 toward his or her graduate education ... Those honored have performed with distinction in both the classroom and their respective sport, while demonstrating exemplary conduct in the community.

Mixing It Up

In the loss at NC State, the Hokies used their 12th different starting line-up of the season ... That is the most different starting line-ups for the Hokies in a single season since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season ... Tech used 10 different starting line-ups a season ago.

Sell Outs

Tonight's Duke game is a sellout ... The Hokies' home game against Virginia on Jan. 25 was the school's first sellout of the season ... These games mark Tech's first sellouts since the final home game of the 2011-12 season ... The Hokies hosted No. 8/9 Notre Dame on Jan. 22 in front of a crowd of 7,451 ... That was the largest home attendance since Feb. 21, 2013, when 7,585 watched the Hokies and No. 6 Duke, prior to the sellout against UVA ... So far this season, the Hokies are averaging 5,494 in attendance at Cassell Coliseum in all games, a number that improves to 7,085 for ACC games ... Last season, after the 15th home game, the Hokies were averaging 4,812 in home attendance and after five home ACC games, Tech was averaging 4,985 in home attendance for ACC games ... Tech has three remaining home games, all ACC games.

Beyer Earns Academic Award

Christian Beyer has been named to the Capital One Academic All-District 3 first team ... The senior from New Bern, North Carolina, will now advance onto the national ballot, currently in the voting process ... Beyer, a former walk-on who has earned a scholarship, will graduate in May with a degree in human nutrition, food & exercise and is in the process of interviewing and being accepted into medical school.

It is Better to Give

At Clemson, **Devin Wilson** handed out his 250th career assist as a Hokie, in just his 56th game ... Wilson now has a career average of 4.5 assists per game, higher than Malcolm Delaney, Jamon Gordon, Al Young or Dell Curry, second through fifth on the Virginia Tech all-time assists list ... All-time leader Bimbo Coles averaged 4.8 assists per game.

Giving to Us, Not to Them

Devin Wilson has been taking great care of the ball during ACC play ... After 13 games, Wilson has 57 assists and just 23 turnovers in 430 minutes of action.

Hokies in Overtime

With the overtime win over Pittsburgh, the Hokies are now 61-46 all-time in overtime games ... Tech is 1-0 this season and was 1-1 in overtime games last season ... Tech is 27-24 in road overtime games, 27-9 in home overtime games, and 7-13 on neutral courts ... Tech is 14-6 in ACC overtime games ... Tech is 3-7 all-time in overtime games against ranked teams ... Tech is 5-9 in double-overtime games and 1-2 in triple overtime games.

Stingy Defense

The Hokies held No. 2/2 Virginia to just 50 points in the game in Cassell Coliseum ... That is the Cavaliers' second lowest point total of the season and the fewest points UVA has scored against the Hokies since Tech defeated the Cavaliers, 47-45, in Charlottesville in 2012 ... The 50 points is the fewest for an ACC opponent against the Hokies since Feb. 15, 2014, when Tech defeated Miami, 52-45, in Cassell Coliseum.

A First Tough Stretch

The Hokies returned home to face No. 8/9 Notre Dame on Jan. 22 and No. 2/2 Virginia ... Those games, along with the games at No. 6/7 Louisville and No. 15/16 North Carolina became the first time in school history that the Hokies have faced four-consecutive top-15 teams ... In addition to these four games, Tech has also played West Virginia, which was ranked No. 17/15 when the two teams met ... Also, the Hokies have faced current No. 10/10 Northern Iowa in Cancun, but the Panthers were not ranked at that time ... The last time an ACC school had such a stretch was North Carolina in the 2009 NCAA Tournament ... The last time an ACC team faced such a stretch in the regular season was NC State in 2001.

A Step Further

With No. 8/9 Notre Dame and No. 2/2 Virginia playing in Cassell Coliseum earlier this season, it marked the first time that the Hokies have played consecutive games against top-10 teams since Feb. 28 and March 4, 2009, when Tech hosted No. 7 Duke and No. 2 North Carolina ... It is only the second time in school history this has happened ... Technically, the Hokies will face a similar stretch this week, as Tech plays No. 4/5 Duke and No. 2/2 UVA.

Heady Times for Beyer

At the beginning of the spring semester, **Buzz Williams** announced that **Christian Beyer** was awarded a scholarship for this semester, his final at Virginia Tech ... Beyer is a three-year member of the men's basketball team and last spring was named the recipient of the Skelton Award, given annually to the top academic male junior student-athlete at Virginia Tech ... In the Notre Dame game, Beyer came off the bench and made his first three-pointer of the season and seven points, three rebounds and a steal in just seven minutes of action, all coming in the second half ... On the morning of Tuesday, Jan. 27, Beyer learned that he had been accepted to medical school at UNC and that night, played a career-high 28 minutes, scored seven points and grabbed five rebounds in the Hokies' win over Pittsburgh ... He had 10 points and a team-high six rebounds at Wake Forest.

All Five

All five Virginia Tech freshmen have scored in double figures in a game so far this season and two, **Justin Bibbs** and **Malik Müller**, have recorded 20-plus point games ... That marks the most freshmen to score in double figures in a game in a single season since the 2007-08 season, when Malcolm Delaney, Jeff Allen, Hank Thorns, Dorenzo Hudson and J.T. Thompson all had single games in double figures ... In all, 10 different Hokies recorded games in double figures during non-conference play this season.

392 and Counting

The Hokies have hit at least one three-pointer in every game since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season ... Tech has now hit a three in 392 consecutive games, the most in school history ... Since the three-point arc was added to college basketball for the 1986-87 season, the Hokies have hit at least one three in all but three games ... The last time that the Hokies did not record a three-point field goal in a game was at Providence on Feb. 1, 2003.

A Strong Start

Justin Bibbs scored 22 points at home against Syracuse, tying his then-career-high ... He followed that with a new career-high 25 points in the loss at Florida State ... Following his 19-point game at NC State, Bibbs now has 16 games in double-figures and four games of 20-or-more points ... That marks the first time that a Virginia Tech freshman has achieved that feat since Dell Curry recorded five games of 20-or-more points in his freshman season of 1983-84 ... The last Hokie freshman to record 16 or more games of double figures was Jeff Allen, who had 22 games in double figures as a freshman in the 2007-08 season.

Even More Bibbs

Justin Bibbs grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds in the loss to Syracuse to go along with his 22 points and recorded his first career double-double ... His double-double was the first by a Tech freshman this season and the first by a Tech freshman since Jan. 22, 2014, when Trevor Thompson had 10 points and 12 rebounds in a loss to Wake Forest.

Combining the Two

When **Devon Wilson** recorded his first career double-double with 10 points and 11 assists in the win over Morgan State, it was the first time a Tech player had a non-points/rebounds double-double since Erick Green had 23 points and 10 assists in the loss at West Virginia on Dec. 8, 2012.

Müller Comes Up Big

Malik Müller has been stepping up his play of late and never was it more obvious in the win over Georgia Tech ... Müller played 27 minutes and led the Hokies with 17 points and four assists ... Of even more importance was his three-pointer with 16.1 seconds remaining to give the Hokies their first lead of the second half ... Müller made six-of-his eight field goal attempts, including three-of-his-five three-point attempts ... Müller matched that 17 points in the loss at Clemson, as he made a career-best five three-point field goals ... In the win over Pittsburgh, Müller had his most-productive game of his collegiate career, scoring a career-high 22 points, with four rebounds, three assists and three steals ... He became the second Virginia Tech freshman (along with **Justin Bibbs**) to score at least 20 points in a game this season ... The 22 points was the first double-figure scoring game for Müller since he netted 15 points in the season-opening win over UMES.

A Young Three

In Tech's win over UMES, freshmen **Malik Müller**, **Justin Bibbs** and **Ahmed Hill** all scored in double-figures ... That marked the first time since Nov. 18, 2000 that three freshmen making their collegiate debuts for the Hokies all scored in double figures ... That night, a 92-68 win over VMI, Carlos Dixon (21 points), Chris Exilus (20 points) and Bryant Matthews (17 points) pulled off the same feat ... In the win over Presbyterian, three freshmen, Hill, Bibbs and **Jalen Hudson** scored in double-figures ... In the loss at Wake Forest, Hill, Müller and Bibbs all scored in double-figures.

Tough Defense

In the home loss to Florida State, the Hokies forced 20 turnovers ... That is the most forced by Tech against ACC competition this season and the second-most forced overall this season ... It is the most turnovers forced in an ACC regular game by Tech since forcing 20 turnovers on March 3, 2010 against NC State in Cassell Coliseum ... The last time the Hokies forced more than 20 turnovers in an ACC game was on Jan. 16, 2010, when Tech forced 23 turnovers at No. 25 Florida State.

Bibbs was Honored

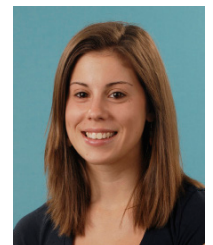

Head Coach Buzz Williams



Buzz Williams begins his first season as the head men's basketball coach at Virginia Tech. Williams comes to the Hokies following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, Williams had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season, the same season the team won the Big East Conference regular season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. Six Marquette players have made it to the NBA during Williams' tenure.

"I am extremely excited about welcoming Buzz Williams to the Hokie Nation," Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock said at the time of Williams' hiring in March. "Buzz is a proven winner who has earned his way up through the ranks with a strong track record of success. I am confident he will energize our fan base and help make Virginia Tech basketball competitive in the Atlantic Coast Conference. I know he will recruit at the highest level."

"It's never easy to leave a great school like Marquette, where I spent seven wonderful years, six as the head coach," Williams said. "But this is a special situation to work at a place like Virginia Tech. I've heard tremendous things about this terrific institution and this is an outstanding opportunity to build a

program. My family and I look forward to becoming a part of this great university and community, and taking on the challenges associated with succeeding in the ACC."

Williams was an assistant at Marquette in the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 19 seasons, and 2013-14 was his seventh campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached over 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league players of the year, two conference freshmen of the year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07 and his roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top-50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting

coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 25 years in 2005-06 and the previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, serving as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40-best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure and he was named one of the top assistants in the country by HoopScoopOnline.com.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M- Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple has two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
