### About Today's Game

The Hokies enter the game 9-1 on the season ... Charleston Southern is 4-6 this season.

### Last Time Out: VT 113, Citadel 71

The Hokies had a record-setting day on Saturday, as they defeated The Citadel, 113-71, in Cassell Coliseum ... **Chris Clarke** recorded the first-ever triple-double in school history ... **Ahmed Hill** scored a career-high 22 points, leading seven Hokies in double figures ... The Hokies trailed 44-40 at the half, but outscored the Bulldogs, 73-27, in the second half ... Tech shot 60.9 percent from the game, including 69.2 percent in the second half ... Tech also made 9-of-12 three-point attempts in the second half.

### Series Against the Bucs

This is the sixth all-time meeting between the two schools and the Hokies have won all five previous meetings ... The last time the two schools met was on Dec. 19, 2009, as the Hokies defeated the Bucs, 73-50, in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech is 4-0 in home games against CSU ... Tech is 45-6 all-time against schools currently in the Big South.

### Have a Day, Chris

In the Hokies' win over The Citadel on Saturday, **Chris Clarke** recorded the Hokies' first-ever triple-double, scoring 13 points, grabbing 12 rebounds and dishing out a career-high 10 assists ... Clarke is one of two ACC players and 13 players nationally with a triple-double this season.

## MEN'S BASKETBALL

### Seven, 7

The Hokies had seven players score in double figures in the win over The Citadel, the most since Tech placed seven players in double figures in a 104-74 win over Rider on Dec. 19, 1984 in Cassell Coliseum ... Last season, six players scored in double figures on Dec. 13, 2015 in a win over Lamar.

### Triple Digits

The Hokies scored 113 points in the win over The Citadel ... That is the most since scoring 116 points in a double overtime win over Duquesne in Cassell Coliseum on March 18, 2009 in the first round of the 2009 NIT ... It is the most points for the Hokies in a regulation game since a 115-87 win at Florida Atlantic on Dec. 28, 1993 ... It is the most in a home, regulation game since Feb. 13, 1988, when the Hokies defeated Cincinnati, 115-11, in a Metro Conference game.

### Not Marginal

In the 113-71 win over The Citadel, Tech won by 42 points ... That is the Hokies' largest margin of victory since defeating Monmouth, 91-46, in a Preseason NIT game in Cassell Coliseum on Nov. 14, 2011.

### Big 2nd Half

In the 113-71 win over The Citadel, Tech trailed 44-40 at the intermission ... The Hokies outscored the Bulldogs, 73-27, in the second half ... The 73 points is tied for the most points in any half for the Hokies and the most against Division I competition ... Tech scored 73 points in the second half in a 116-64 home win over Division III Johns Hopkins on Nov. 30, 1981 ... It is 13 points more than Tech scored in the first half against High Point earlier this season, the season-high for Tech until The Citadel game.

### Leading the Way

**Ahmed Hill** has made quite a comeback for the Hokies ... Hill missed the 2015-16 season following knee surgery ... In perhaps his most impactful game, Hill led the Hokies with 20 points and nine rebounds in the win over Ole Miss ... Both numbers tied then-career-highs for Hill ... He scored six of the Hokies' final nine points in the contest, including going 4-of-4 from the line in the final 16 seconds ... Then in the 113-71 win over The Citadel, Hill set a new career-high with 22 points and also handed out a career-high four assists.

### Cleaning the Glass

In the 113-71 win over The Citadel, Tech out rebounded the Bulldogs, 52-28 ... The 24-rebound margin is the most for the Hokies this season and the first time this season Tech has had a double-figure rebounding margin in a game ... The 24-rebound margin is the most for a Virginia Tech team since Tech out rebounded Jacksonville State, 54-29, in the second game of last season.

### The Century Mark

When the Hokies defeated The Citadel, 113-71, on Dec. 17, it marked the 101st time in school history that Tech has scored at least 100 points ... Tech is now 95-6 all-time in such games ... Tech is 91-3 all-time in regulation games in which it has scored at least 100 points ... The Hokies are 70-1 in 100-point home games ... In games in which Tech has scored at least 113 points, the Hokies are 18-0, 16-0 in non-overtime games and 16-0 in such home games.

### What a Sellout, x3

The Virginia Tech Athletics Department has announced that the Dec. 31 ACC opener against Duke in Cassell Coliseum and the Feb. 12 game against Virginia are officially sold out ... Tech will do a student lottery for each game ... It is the second and third sellouts of the season, following the sellout of the home opener against Maine on Nov. 11 ... The Duke game sold out less than 24 hours after single game ACC tickets went on sale to Hokie Club members and season ticket holders ... There were no general public sales for either game ... Single game tickets went on sale to the general public on Wednesday, Dec. 14.

### 3s Company

So far this season, **Ty Outlaw** has made 14 field goals ... Of that number, 13 have come from three-point range ... Outlaw is shooting 43.8 percent from the field, which improves to 50.0 percent from three-point territory.

### It's 11

The Hokies have won 11 consecutive home games, beginning with the 60-57 win over Clemson on Feb. 6, 2016 ... This is the longest home winning streak for the Hokies since the 2009-10 season, when the Hokies won 14 consecutive home games.

### Some Good Numbers for the Hokies

The Hokies have won five consecutive games ... Going back to last season, the Hokies have won 16 of their last 19 games ... **Buzz Williams** improved his overall record at Virginia Tech to 40-38.

### Clarke in a Giving Mood

Last season, **Chris Clarke** recorded 33 assists in 22 games for the Hokies ... His high was four assists in wins over Lamar and Florida State ... This season, through 10 games, Clarke has dished out 42 assists ... In the win over High Point, Clarke registered six assists and had five assists each in the wins over VMI and Ole Miss ... He smashed that number in the win over The Citadel, when he recorded a career-high 10 assists ... Last season he averaged 1.5 assists per game and this season, that has risen to 4.2 assists per game ... His 10 assists in The Citadel game is the most assists by a Hokie since **Devin Wilson** had 11 assists in a loss to No. 4 Duke on Feb. 25, 2015.

### Fast Start

The Hokies are off to a 9-1 start this season ... This marks the team's best start through nine games since the 2009-10 season, when Tech started the campaign 12-1 ... The Hokies finished the month of November 6-1 overall ... This is the first time the Hokies have been eight games over .500 since the 2010-11 season.

### Not Many Points

The Hokies allowed Nebraska just 53 points in the third-place game of the Wooden Legacy on Sunday ... That is the fewest points allowed by the Hokies since Tech defeated Grambling State, 87-52, on Dec. 19, 2015 ... It is the lowest point total of a Virginia Tech opponent from a Power 5 conference since Virginia defeated the Hokies, 50-47, on Jan. 25, 2015.

### Big Stats for LeDay

**Zach LeDay** has posted some great numbers for the Hokies this season ... LeDay has scored in double figures in nine of the 10 games so far this season, including three games of 20-or-more-points ... He leads the Hokies in scoring, at 17.0 points per game and is tied for the lead in rebounding, at 7.4 boards per game ... He is shooting 51.3 percent from the floor and is second on the team in blocked shots and steals.

### Analytics and Such

According to Kenpom.com, the Hokies are ranked 36th nationally ... Tech is seventh in free throw rate, ninth in steal percentage, 14th in effective field goal percentage, 26th in raw offensive efficiency and 28th nationally in adjusted offensive efficiency.

### What A Trip!

Earlier this season, the Hokies returned from an epic 10-day, four-game road trip, that included stops in Anaheim, California and Ann Arbor, Michigan ... Tech was 3-1 on the trip, all against top-level competition and highlighted by a 73-70 win at Michigan in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge ... Tech also posted wins against New Mexico and Nebraska and suffered a close, 68-65, loss to Texas A&M.

### Here You Go

**Seth Allen** was in quite the giving mood in the win over UMES ... Allen tied a career-high with eight assists, while only committing one turnover in 31 minutes of action ... The eight assists was tied for the most by a Hokies this season at that point ... Allen also added 11 points, a blocked shot and a steal in the win.

### From the Start

Entering tonight's game, the Hokies have used the same starting line-up in each of the first 10 games ... Last season, the Hokies used 12 different starting line-ups last season.

### What A Day!

**Justin Robinson** had his best-ever performance for the Hokies in their win over New Mexico ... The sophomore point guard had a career-high 22 points, to go along with a career-high-tying eight assists ... Robinson also played a career-high 40 minutes, but did not commit a turnover in the game ... He added 14 points in the loss to Texas A&M and 11 points and four assists in the win at Michigan ... He had 14 points and six assists in the win over The Citadel.

### On The List

**Seth Allen** has been named to the Bob Cousy Award watch list for the 2016-17 season ... The award is given annually to the nation's top point guard.

### A Fine Start

**Khadim Sy** made his collegiate debut in the win over Maine ... The freshman post earned the start and had a solid six points, four rebounds and team-high three blocked shots in the win ... In the win over High Point, Sy recorded his first double-figure scoring game of his career, with 14 points on 6-of-9 from the field and a team-high six rebounds ... Sy took it a step further in the win over New Mexico, as he grabbed a team-high 10 rebounds, the most for him this season ... He matched the career-high in points with 14 points in the win over The Citadel ... Sy is averaging 6.7 points and 4.0 rebounds per game in 13.3 minutes per game ... He is shooting 68.9 percent from the field and is 9-for-9 from the field in the last two games.

### Up to the Challenge

With the help of Virginia Tech's 73-70 win at Michigan on Nov. 30, the ACC reclaimed the title of the ACC/Big Ten Challenge ... The ACC won nine of the 14 contests ... It marked the ACC's first win in the annual series since 2008 ... The ACC has now won 11 of the 18 titles.

### B1G Week

When the Hokies defeated Nebraska, 66-53, in Anaheim, California in the Wooden Legacy and Michigan, 73-70, in Ann Arbor on Nov 30 in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge, it marked the first time in school history that Tech defeated Big Ten schools in back-to-back games ... In 2009, the Hokies won at Iowa and at Penn State in December, but the games were not back-to-back ... The win over Nebraska marked the Hokies' first win over a Big Ten team since Nov. 27, 2012 (exactly four years to the day), when Tech defeated Iowa, 95-79, in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge in Cassell Coliseum ... It was the Hokies first win over a Big Ten school away from Blacksburg since the Hokies downed the Hawkeyes, 70-64, in Iowa City in the 2009 ACC/Big Ten Challenge ... As a side note, the Hokies won two games against Big Ten schools in the 2009-10 season (also won 66-64 at Penn State that season).

### Putting a Lid on the Hoop

The Hokies allowed Nebraska just 29.8 percent from the floor in the win on Nov. 27 ... That is the lowest opponent field goal percentage for Tech this season and the lowest since Tech held VMI to 25.7 percent from the floor on Nov. 21, 2015.

### They Are Free

The Hokies made 19 of 20 free throws in the win over New Mexico, good for 95.0 percent from the line ... That is the Hokies' second-best free throw percentage in a game with at least 20 attempts of all time ... The only better performance with at least 20 attempts was a 95.7 percent night against Dayton on Dec. 17, 1976 ... In that game, the Hokies made 22 of 23 from the line ... In the Wooden Legacy, the Hokies were a combined 45-55 from the line, for 81.8 percent ... Entering the tournament, the Hokies were shooting 59.4 percent from the free throw line for the season ... In the win over Nebraska, the Hokies were 3-of-their-first-9 from the line, then proceeded to make their final 13 attempts ... In the win at Michigan, Tech was 19-of-21 from the line, for 90.5 percent and made all 12 attempts in the second half and Tech was 15-of-19 from the line in the win over UMES.

### Hamilton to Miss Remainder of Season

**Johnny Hamilton** had surgery on a ruptured flexor tendon in his left thumb and will miss the remainder of the season ... The surgery took place last week ... Hamilton has appeared in three games this season and 20 games in his two-year Virginia Tech career.

### Hot from the Field

In the win over High Point, the Hokies shot 56.1 percent from the field, the most in a game since shooting 61.0 percent in the win over Liberty on Nov. 19, 2014 ... In the win over VMI, the Hokies shot 60.0 percent ... That marked the first time that the Hokies have shot 55 percent or better from the field in back-to-back games since Jan. 23 and 28, 2007, when Tech shot 58.1 percent at Miami and 59.9 percent at Georgia Tech ... Tech shot 60.9 percent from the field in the win over The Citadel.

### Hokies in the National Stats

Through the games of Dec. 18, Tech is 14th nationally in assist/turnover ratio, 20th in field goal percentage and won-lost percentage, 21st in assists per game and 22nd in three-point field goal percentage and fewest fouls ... The Hokies are 37th in (fewest) turnovers per game and 45th in fewest total turnovers ... Individually, **Ahmed Hill** is 30th in three-point field goal percentage.

In the win over High Point, Tech had 24 assists ... At that time, it was the most in a single game for the Hokies since Tech had 25 assists in a win over Charleston Southern on Jan. 7, 2008 ... The Hokies had 19 assists in the win over VMI ... Combined with the 24 assists against High Point, this marks the first time that the Hokies have had 19-or-more assists in back-to-back games since the second and third games of the 2011-12 season ... Tech had 20 assists against both Monmouth and FIU ... In the win over New Mexico, the Hokies dished out 20 assists and in the win over UMES, Tech had 19 assists ... Tech added 18 assists in the win over Ole Miss and 30 assists in the win over The Citadel.

### More on Sharing

In the 113-71 win over The Citadel, the Hokies dished out a season-high 30 assists ... That is the second-most assists in school history ... Tech had 31 assists in a 122-73 win over South Carolina State on Dec. 18, 1982.

### And Even More on Sharing

In the win over VMI, **Justin Robinson** had six assists and **Seth Allen** and **Chris Clarke** had five assists each ... This marks the first time since the Hokies joined the ACC in the 2004-05 season that three Hokies had at least five assists in a single game ... In the win over The Citadel, the same trio had six-or-more assists.

### 444 and Counting

Tech has now hit a three-point field goal in 444 consecutive games, the most in school history ... The Hokies have hit a three-pointer in every game since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season ... Since the three-point arc was added for the 1986-87 season, the Hokies have hit at least one three in all but three games ... The last time Tech did not record a three-point field goal in a game was at Providence on Feb. 1, 2003.

### Few Points

The Hokies allowed UMES 16 points in the first half ... That is the fewest points allowed in a half this season.

### Lotsa Points

During the first four games of the 2016-17 season, the Hokies scored 359 points ... That was the most points scored by a Tech men's basketball team in the first four games of a season since the 1988-89 season, when Tech scored 376 total points ... The 1988-89 team featured Tech's all-time leading scorer Bimbo Coles and sharp-shooter Wally Lancaster.

### Century Marks

In the win over Maine, Virginia Tech guard **Justin Robinson** dished out his 100th career assist and **Seth Allen** hit the century mark for his Virginia Tech career in the win over VMI ... **Justin Bibbs** recorded his 100th career assist in the win over UMES.

### HEAD COACH BUZZ WILLIAMS



In his two years at Virginia Tech, Buzz Williams already has ushered in an exciting new era of basketball. The head coach of the men's squad is in his third season here in Blacksburg, and he has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take a simplistic, yet very

effective approach – “Get Better.”

Last season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature. Williams has compiled a 40-38 record in his first three seasons in Blacksburg.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new highs in this area. And while he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more on finding what he likes to call, “OKGs”, or “our kind of guys.”

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. Six Marquette players made it to the NBA during Williams' tenure. In his nine-plus seasons as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 193-124.

“The growth of the Hokies' basketball program and the renewed energy under Buzz Williams in his first two seasons has been remarkable,” Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock said. “We've seen improvement in all facets. He's an educator first and foremost. He loves his players. They play hard for him. Everyone within the program and around the department has embraced Buzz's work ethic, passion, and attention to detail. We certainly have positive momentum and want to do all we can to keep it going. We believe in Coach Williams and his staff. Exciting times in Blacksburg.”

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 20 seasons, and 2016-17 will mark his 10th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07, and his roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 25 years in 2005-06 and the previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games



coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA

Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple has two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
