The Hokies enter the game 12-2 overall and 1-1 in ACC action ... Florida State is 14-1 overall and 2-0 in league play ... The Hokies are ranked 21st in the AP poll and 23rd in the USA Today Coaches poll, while the Seminoles are 12th in the AP poll and 13th in the coaches poll.

Last Time Out: NCSU 104, 21/23 VT 8

The Hokies lost at NC State, 104-78, in Raleigh on Wednesday night ... **Ahmed Hill** led four Hokies in double-figures with 17 points ... **Zach LeDay** added 16 points and six rebounds ... NCSU out rebounded the Hokies, 40-25 ... Tech made a season-high 13 three-pointers in the game.

Series Against the Seminoles

This is the 53rd all-time meeting between the two schools ... The Seminoles lead the series 30-22 ... Tech has won the last two meetings, most recently a 96-85 victory in the ACC Tournament last season ... Tech won both meetings last season ... Tech is 5-18 in road games in the series and have not won in Tallahassee since 1990.

Med Heating Up

Over the last six games, **Ahmed Hill** has scored a total of 114 points, for a 19.0 ppg during that span ... He leads the team in made three-pointers.

Bunches of 3s

So far this season, through 14 games, the Hokies have recorded seven games of at least 10 three-point field goals ... The Hokies lead the ACC in three-point field goal percentage and are third in three-pointers made ... Tech made a season-high 13 three-pointers in the loss at NC State.

Leading the Way

Ahmed Hill has made quite a comeback for the Hokies ... Hill missed the 2015-16 season following knee surgery ... In perhaps his most impactful game, Hill led the Hokies with 20 points and nine rebounds in the win over Ole Miss ...

Both numbers tied then-career-highs for Hill ... He scored six of the Hokies' final nine points in the contest, including going 4-of-4 from the line in the final 16 seconds ... Then, in the 113-71 win over The Citadel, Hill set a new career-high with 22 points and also handed out a career-high four assists ... He currently leads the ACC and is 30th nationally in three-point field goal percentage.

Clarke Steps Up

In the Hokies' win over The Citadel, **Chris Clarke** recorded the Hokies' first-ever triple-double, scoring 13 points, grabbing 12 rebounds and dishing out a career-high 10 assists ... Clarke is one of three ACC players and 17 players nationally with a triple-double this season ... Since that triple-double, Clarke recorded two consecutive double-doubles, in the wins over Charleston Southern and UMBC and scored 13 points in the win over No. 5/5 Duke.

Clarke Stays Hot

In the last six games, all of which **Chris Clarke** has scored in double figures, he has scored 92 points, averaging 15.3 points ... Over the same period, he is averaging 8.3 rebounds and 4.3 assists per game.

3s Company

The Hokies made a season-high 13 three-point field goals in the loss at NC State on Wednesday night, tying a school mark for most three-pointers in an ACC game ... The other time the Hokies made 13 three-pointers in an ACC game was on Jan. 19, 2012, against No. 8 UNC in Cassell Coliseum ... The 13 three-pointers are the most threes for Tech in a single game since Tech made 13 three-pointers in a loss to No. 1 Michigan State in 2013 in Brooklyn ... The last time the Hokies made more than 13 three-pointers in a game was on Nov. 19, 2012, when the Hokies made 14 three-pointers in a win at UNC Greensboro ... The school record for three-pointers in a game is 16 against Marquette in 1989.

Some Facts from the Duke Win

The Hokies' 89 points is the most points the Hokies have ever scored against the Blue Devils ... The 14-point margin of victory ties the largest margin of victory against Duke ... This marks the Hokies first win over a top 5 team since Jan. 4, 2016, when the Hokies defeated No. 4 Virginia, 70-68, in Cassell Coliseum ... This is the first win by the Hokies over a top 10 team since a 77-62 win over No. 7 Miami on March 5, 2016 in Cassell Coliseum ... This is the first time the Hokies have defeated a top 5 Duke team since Feb. 26, 2011, when the Hokies downed the top-ranked Blue Devils, 64-60, in Cassell Coliseum ... The Hokies' 89 points is the most in a win against a nationally-ranked team since a 94-88 win over top-ranked North Carolina on Jan. 13, 2007 in Cassell Coliseum ... It is tied for the third-most points scored against a nationally-ranked team in a Virginia Tech victory ... The Hokies' 89 points is the most allowed by Duke this season ... Tech has now won three of its last four ACC openers.

Into the Polls

The Hokies are ranked 21st in this week's AP poll and 23rd in the USA Today Coaches poll ... This is the first time the Hokies have been ranked in either poll since the polls of Nov. 15, 2010, when Tech was 22nd in the AP poll and 24th in the coaches poll ... All-time, the Hokies are 3-2 when ranked 21st in the AP poll ... The last time the Hokies were ranked 21st in the AP poll was the preseason AP poll in 2010 ... Tech is 59-29 all-time as a ranked team.

Solid Stats for LeDay

Zach LeDay has posted some great numbers for the Hokies this season ... LeDay has scored in double figures in 13 of the 14 games so far this season, including three games of 20-or-more-points ... He leads the Hokies in scoring, at 16.1 points per game and is second on the team in rebounding, at 7.4 boards per game.

Ranked Match-Up

Today's game against Florida State is the Hokies' first game in which both Virginia Tech and its opponent have been ranked since Nov. 16, 2010, when the 22nd ranked Hokies lost at No. 3 Kansas State, 73-57 ... This is the first time in the 52 meetings with Florida State that both teams have been ranked.

Sharing is Good

In the 113-71 win over The Citadel, the Hokies dished out a season-high 30 assists ... That is the second-most assists in school history ... Tech had 31 assists in a 122-73 win over South Carolina State on Dec. 18, 1982 ... With the 18 assists in the loss at NC State, the Hokies now have eight games of at least 18 assists this season and 13 of the 14 games this season, Tech has at least double-figure assists.

A Balancing Act

The Hokies had seven players score in double figures in the win over The Citadel, the most since Tech placed seven players in double figures in a 104-74 win over Rider on Dec. 19, 1984 in Cassell Coliseum ... With six players scoring in double figures in the win over Duke, Tech completed a span of four games in which it had at least five players score in double figures.

14 in a Row

The Hokies have won 14 consecutive home games, beginning with the 60-57 win over Clemson on Feb. 6, 2016 ... This is the longest home winning streak for the Hokies since the 2009-10 season, when the Hokies won 14 consecutive home games ... The last time Tech won more than 14 consecutive games in Cassell Coliseum was in the 1994-95 and 1995-96 seasons, when the Hokies strung together 17 home victories.

A New High for J Rob

In the Hokies' 87-70 win over UMBC, **Justin Robinson** made four of his six three-point field goal attempts ... That sets a new career-high for the sophomore ... Senior **Seth Allen** joined him in that game, also making four of the Hokies' 11 three-points.

Fast Start

The Hokies are off to a 12-2 start this season ... This marks the team's best start through 13 games since the 2009-10 season, when Tech started the campaign 12-2 ... The Hokies finished the month of November 6-1 overall and finished December 6-0 ... Tech's 6-0 is its first undefeated December since 2009-10, when Tech finished that December 7-0 ... This is the first time the Hokies have been 10 games over .500 since the 2010-11 season.

Clarke in a Giving Mood

Last season, **Chris Clarke** recorded 33 assists in 22 games for the Hokies ... His high was four assists in wins over Lamar and Florida State ... This season, through 14 games, Clarke has dished out 53 assists ... In the win over High Point, Clarke registered six assists and had five assists each in the wins over VMI and Ole Miss ... He smashed that number in the win over The Citadel, when he recorded a career-high 10 assists ... Last season he averaged 1.5 assists per game and this season, that has risen to 4.0 assists per game ... His 10 assists in The Citadel game is the most assists by a Hokie since **Devin Wilson** had 11 assists in a loss to No. 4 Duke on Feb. 25, 2015 ... He has five games of at least five assists this season.

And a Taking Mood, Too

To go along with his assists numbers, **Chris Clarke** had 21 steals in 22 games last season ... He has 20 steals in the first 14 games of this season ... By double, he leads the Hokies in steals this season.

A Fine Start

Khadim Sy made his collegiate debut in the win over Maine ... The freshman post earned the start and had a solid six points, four rebounds and team-high three blocked shots in the win ... In the win over High Point, Sy recorded his first double-figure scoring game of his career, with 14 points on 6-of-9 from the field and a team-high six rebounds ... Sy grabbed a team-high 10 rebounds, the most for him this season, in the win over New Mexico ... He matched the career-high in points with 14 points in the win over The Citadel ... Sy is averaging 5.8 points and 4.1 rebounds per game in 13.1 minutes per game ... He missed the NC State game after injuring his right ankle in the afternoon shoot around on Wednesday.

Here You Go

Seth Allen was in quite the giving mood in the win over UMES ... Allen tied a career-high with eight assists, while only committing one turnover in 31 minutes of action ... The eight assists was tied for the most by a Hokies this season at that point ... Allen also added 11 points, a blocked shot and a steal in the win.

On The List

Seth Allen has been named to the Bob Cousy Award watch list for the 2016-17 season ... The award is given annually to the nation's top point guard.

A Familiar Face Returns

When the teams came out on the court for warm-ups on Saturday morning, the Hokies had a familiar face back in uniform ... Senior guard **Devin Wilson** returned to the team on Friday, Dec. 30 for a noon practice ... Wilson, who did not play against Duke or NC State, had returned to Blacksburg at 2:30 a.m. Dec. 30 with the Hokie football team, who had defeated Arkansas, 35-24, in the Belk Bowl in Charlotte on Dec. 29.

From the Start

Tech used the same starting line-up in its first 13 games this season, before changing the line-up at NC State due to the injury to **Khadim Sy** ... Last season, the Hokies used 12 different starting line-ups.

Ty Likes 3s

So far this season, **Ty Outlaw** has made 19 field goals ... Of that number, 17 have come from three-point range ... He is shooting 41.3 percent from the field this season, which improves to 43.6 percent from beyond the arc ... He was 3-for-5 from three-point range at NC State.

Hokies vs. Ranked Teams

Tech is 33-172 all-time against teams ranked in the AP poll ... The Hokies are 16-64 against nationally-ranked teams since joining the ACC for the 2004-05 season ... Tech is 1-0 against ranked teams this season ... Tech has won its last three home games against nationally-ranked teams, all ranked in the top 10.

Scheduling Oddity

Virginia Tech's first six ACC games and seven of the first eight are games against teams that Tech will play only once this regular season ... The game at Clemson on Jan. 27 is the first game against a home-and-home opponent this season.

Hokie Points

The Hokies scored 113 points in the win over The Citadel ... That is the most since scoring 116 points in a double overtime win over Duquesne in Cassell Coliseum on March 18, 2009 in the first round of the 2009 NIT ... It is the most points for the Hokies in a regulation game since a 115-87 win at Florida Atlantic on Dec. 28, 1993 ... It is the most in a home, regulation game since Feb. 13, 1988, when the Hokies defeated Cincinnati, 115-11, in a Metro Conference game ... Tech is now 95-6 all-time in such games ... Tech is 91-3 all-time in regulation games in which it has scored at least 100 points ... The Hokies are 70-1 in 100-point home games ... In games in which Tech has scored at least 113 points, the Hokies are 18-0, 16-0 in non-overtime games and 16-0 in such home games.

Big 2nd Half

In the 113-71 win over The Citadel, Tech trailed 44-40 at the intermission ... The Hokies outscored the Bulldogs, 73-27, in the second half ... The 73 points is tied for the most points in any half for the Hokies and the most against Division I competition ... Tech scored 73 points in the second half in a 116-64 home win over Division III Johns Hopkins on Nov. 30, 1981 ... It is 13 points more than Tech scored in the first half against High Point earlier this season, the season-high for Tech until The Citadel game.

Cleaning the Glass

In the 113-71 win over The Citadel, Tech out rebounded the Bulldogs, 52-28 ... The 24-rebound margin is the most for the Hokies this season and the first time this season Tech has had a double-figure rebounding margin in a game ... The 24-rebound margin is the most for a Virginia Tech team since Tech out rebounded Jacksonville State, 54-29, in the second game of last season.

Not Marginal

In the 113-71 win over The Citadel, Tech won by 42 points ... That is the Hokies' largest margin of victory since defeating Monmouth, 91-46, in a Preseason NIT game in Cassell Coliseum on Nov. 14, 2011.

Analytics and Such

According to Kenpom.com, the Hokies are ranked 40th nationally ... Tech is 10th nationally in three-point percentage, 11th in free throw rate, 14th in effective field goal percentage, 23rd in steal percentage, 28th in raw offensive efficiency and 39th in two-point field goal percentage ... **Zach LeDay** is 32nd in offensive rating.

Tech has now hit a three-point field goal in 448 consecutive games, the most in school history ... The Hokies have hit a three-pointer in every game since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season ... Since the three-point arc was added for the 1986-87 season, the Hokies have hit at least one three in all but three games ... The last time Tech did not record a three-point field goal in a game was at Providence on Feb. 1, 2003.

Hamilton to Miss Remainder of Season

Johnny Hamilton had surgery on a ruptured flexor tendon in his left thumb and will miss the remainder of the season ... The surgery took place in mid-December ... Hamilton appeared in three games this season and 20 games in his two-years at Tech.

What A Day!

Justin Robinson had his best-ever performance for the Hokies in their win over New Mexico ... The sophomore had a career-high 22 points, to go along with a career-high-tying eight assists ... Robinson also played a career-high 40 minutes, but did not commit a turnover in the game ... He added 14 points in the loss to Texas A&M and 11 points and four assists in the win at Michigan.

570 in the Cassell

The Hokies have a 570-188 overall record in Cassell Coliseum, for a .752 winning percentage ... The win over Florida State in 2011, was the 500th victory in the building ... Tech has had just one break-even home season and two losing seasons ... Tech is 9-0 in Cassell this year, 1-0 in ACC games.

Big Week

When the Hokies defeated Nebraska, 66-53, in the Wooden Legacy and Michigan, 73-70, in Ann Arbor in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge, it marked the first time in school history that Tech defeated Big Ten schools in back-to-back games ... In 2009, the Hokies won at Iowa and at Penn State in December, but the games were not back-to-back ... The win over Nebraska marked the Hokies' first win over a Big Ten team since Nov. 27, 2012 (exactly four years to the day), when Tech defeated Iowa, 95-79, in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge in Cassell Coliseum ... It was the Hokies first win over a Big Ten school away from Blacksburg since the Hokies downed the Hawkeyes, 70-64, in Iowa City in the 2009 ACC/Big Ten Challenge.

HEAD COACH BUZZ WILLIAMS



In his two years-plus at Virginia Tech, Buzz Williams already has ushered in an exciting new era of basketball. The head coach of the men's squad is in his third season here in Blacksburg, and he has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take

a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

Last season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature. Williams has compiled a 43-39 record in his first three seasons in Blacksburg.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new highs in this area. And while he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. Six Marquette players made it to the NBA during Williams' tenure. In his nine-plus seasons as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 196-125.

"The growth of the Hokies' basketball program and the renewed energy under Buzz Williams in his first two seasons has been remarkable," Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock said. "We've seen improvement in all facets. He's an educator first and foremost. He loves his players. They play hard for him. Everyone within the program and around the department has embraced Buzz's work ethic, passion, and attention to detail. We certainly have positive momentum and want to do all we can to keep it going. We believe in Coach Williams and his staff. Exciting times in Blacksburg."

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA

Division I level for 20 seasons, and 2016-17 will mark his 10th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07, and his roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 25 years in 2005-06 and the previous team posted the top turnaround in the



nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, serving as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple has two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
