In the Hokies' win over The Citadel, **Chris Clarke** recorded the Hokies' firstever triple-double, scoring 13 points, grabbing 12 rebounds and dishing out a career-high 10 assists



... Clarke is one of three ACC players and 17 players

nationally with a triple-double this season ... Since that triple-double, Clarke recorded two consecutive double-doubles, in the wins over Charleston Southern and UMBC and scored 13 points in the win over No. 5/5 Duke ... In the loss at No. 12/13 Florida State, he tied a career-high with 22 points, the most points he has scored in an ACC game ... He scored 185 points in 22 games last season and has 218 points in 17 games this season ... He scored his 400th career point against Notre Dame.

# **Clarke Stays Hot**

In the last nine games, all of which **Chris Clarke** has scored in double figures, he has scored 152 points, averaging 16.9 points ... Over the same period, he is averaging 8.2 rebounds and 4.2 assists per game ... Clarke has scored in double figures in 11 games this season ... He is averaging 17.6 points and 6.8 rebounds per game in ACC play this season.

# **Med Facts**

Ahmed Hill is the Hokies' second-leading scorer, averaging 14.4 points per game ... He leads the team and is third in the ACC in made three-pointers ... He is third in the ACC and 24th nationally in three-point field goal percentage.

The 22 points is the most points for a Hokie in a true road game since the final game of last season when Seth Allen had 22 points at BYU ... It is the most points for a Hokie in an ACC regular season game since Justin Bibbs had 22 points in the win at Wake Forest on Feb. 28 of last year ... The last time a Hokie scored more than 22 points in a road ACC game was Allen's 28 points at Pittsburgh on Jan. 31, 2016 ... Zach LeDay had 22 points in the win over Syracuse ... Clarke scored 21 points in the loss to Notre Dame.

The Virginia Tech Athletics Department announced that last Saturday's ACC game against No. 20/20 Notre Dame was a sellout ... That game joined the Dec. 31 win over No. 5/5 Duke and the upcoming Feb. 12 game against Virginia as sellouts ... Tech will do a student lottery for the UVa game ... It is the third and fourth sellouts of the season, following the sellout of the home opener against Maine on Nov. 11 ... The Duke game sold out less than 24 hours after single game ACC tickets went on sale to Hokie Club members and season ticket holders ... Single game tickets went on sale to the general public on Dec. 14.

With the four sellouts, the Hokies are averaging 7,259 per game this season ... Last season, the Hokies averaged 6,658 and in the 2014-15 season, Tech averaged 5,744 ... This year's attendance would be the largest for the Hokies since averaging 8,395 in the 2010-11 season ... Last season, the Hokies averaged 7,529 for nine ACC home games; this season, Tech is averaging 8,394 through three ACC home games..

In the win over Syracuse, the Hokies committed a season-low six turnovers ... The previous low was seven against Texas A&M ... This is the fewest turnovers in an ACC game for the Hokies since committing six turnovers against Wake Forest on Jan. 13, 2016.

# In a Giving Mood

The Hokies dished out 20 assists, on 28 made baskets in the win over Syracuse ... It is the ninth time this season that the Hokies have had at least 18 assists in a game ... It is the most assists for the Hokies in an ACC game since the Hokies had 23 assists against Wake Forest on Jan. 15, 2011 ... That 23 assists is a high in an ACC game for Tech.

# **Bunches of 3s**

So far this season, through 17 games, the Hokies have recorded seven games of at least 10 three-point field goals ... The Hokies are third in the ACC in three-point field goal percentage and three-pointers made ... Tech is 22nd nationally in three-point field goal percentage ... Tech made a season-high 13 three-pointers in the loss at NC State.

# **Sharing is Good**

In the 113-71 win over The Citadel, the Hokies dished out a season-high 30 assists

... That is the second-most assists in school history ... Tech had 31 assists in a 122-73 win over South Carolina State on Dec. 18, 1982 ... With the 20 assists in the win over Syracuse, the Hokies now have nine games of at least 18 assists this season and in 14 of the 16 games this season, Tech has at least doublefigure assists.

# **A Balancing Act**

The Hokies had seven players score in double figures in the win over The Citadel, the most since Tech placed seven players in double figures in a 104-74 win over Rider on Dec. 19, 1984 in Cassell Coliseum ... With six players scoring in double figures in the win over Duke, Tech completed a span of four games in which it had at least five players score in double figures ... Tech had five players score in double-figures in the win over Syracuse.

# **Fast Start**

The Hokies are 13-4 this season ... This marks the team's best start through 17 games since the 2009-10 season, when Tech started the campaign 14-3 ... The Hokies finished the month of November 6-1 overall and finished December 6-0 ... Tech's 6-0 is its first undefeated December since 2009-10, when Tech finished that December 7-0.

# **Clarke in a Giving Mood**

Last season, Chris Clarke recorded 33 assists in 22 games for the Hokies ... His high was four assists in wins over Lamar and Florida State ... This season, through 17 games, Clarke has dished out 65 assists ... In the win over High Point, Clarke registered six assists and had five assists each in the wins over VMI and Ole Miss ... He smashed that number in the win over The Citadel, when he recorded a career-high 10 assists ... Last season he averaged 1.5 assists per game and this season, that has risen to 3.8 assists per game ... His 10 assists in The Citadel game is the most assists by a Hokie since Devin Wilson had 11 assists in a loss to No. 4 Duke on Feb. 25, 2015 ... In the win over Syracuse, he dished out a new personal ACC-high of six assists and with his five assists against Notre Dame, now has seven games of at least five assists this season.

# And a Taking Mood, Too

To go along with his assists numbers, **Chris Clarke** had 21 steals in 22 games last season ... He has 25 steals in the first 17 games of this season ... He leads the Hokies in steals this season, by more than double the next highest player.

# From the Start

Tech used the same starting line-up in its first 13 games this season, before changing the line-up at NC State due to the injury to **Khadim Sy**... The Hokies have used the same starting line-up in the last four games... Last season, the Hokies used 12 different starting line-ups.

# Here You Go

Seth Allen was in quite the giving mood in the win over UMES ... Allen tied a career-high with eight assists, while only committing one turnover in 31 minutes of action ... The eight assists was tied for the most by a Hokies this season at that point ... Allen also added 11 points, a blocked shot and a steal in the win.

# On The List

**Seth Allen** was named to the Bob Cousy Award watch list for the 2016-17 season ... The award is given annually to the nation's top point guard.

# A Familiar Face Returns

Senior guard **Devin Wilson** returned to the basketball team on Friday, Dec. 30 for a noon practice after playing on the Virginia Tech football team this fall ... Wilson, who has not played in his first four games back, had returned to

Blacksburg at 2:30 a.m. Dec. 30 with the team, who had defeated Arkansas, 35-24, in the Belk Bowl in Charlotte on Dec. 29.

# **Hokies in the National Stats**

Through the games of Jan. 16, Tech is 30th nationally in three-point field goal percentage, 23rd in field goal percentage, 26th in scoring offense, and 32nd in assist/ turnover ratio... Individually, **Ahmed Hill** is 24th in three-point field goal percentage.

# Lots of Sharing

In the win over VMI, **Justin Robinson** had six assists and **Seth Allen** and **Chris Clarke** had five assists each ... This marks the first time since the Hokies joined the ACC in the 2004-05 season that three Hokies had at least five assists in a game ... In the win over The Citadel, the same trio had six-or-more assists.

# **Scheduling Oddities**

Virginia Tech's first six ACC games and seven of the first eight are games against teams that Tech will play only once this regular season ... The game at Clemson on Jan. 27 is the first game against a home-andhome opponent this season ... Saturday's game against Notre Dame was the Hokies' final home Saturday game until the final day of the regular season, March 4, when Tech hosts Wake Forest ... The Hokies only have two remaining Saturday road games this season ... All three of the Hokies' Saturday ACC home games will come with no students on campus due to winter and spring breaks.

# 451 and Counting

Tech has now hit a three-point field goal in 451 consecutive games, the most in school history ... The Hokies have hit a three-pointer in every game since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season ... Since the three-point arc was added for the 1986-87 season, the Hokies have hit at least one three in all but three games ... The last time Tech did not record a three-point field goal in a game was at Providence on Feb. 1, 2003.

# **Analytics and Such**

According to Kenpom.com, the Hokies are ranked 45th nationally ... Tech is 22nd nationally in effective field goal percentage, 24th in free throw rate, 26th in three-point percentage, 28th in two-point field goals, 31st in raw offensive efficiency, 33rd in two-point field goal percentage defense and 38th in offensive turnover percentage ... **Zach LeDay** is 22nd in offensive rating.

# Some Facts from the Duke Win

The Hokies' 89 points is the most points the Hokies have ever scored against Duke and the 14-point margin of victory ties the largest margin of victory against Duke ... It was the Hokies first win over a top 5 team since Jan. 4, 2016, when the Hokies defeated No. 4 Virginia, 70-68, in Cassell Coliseum and first win over a top 10 team since a 77-62 win over No. 7 Miami on March 5, 2016 in Cassell Coliseum ... This is the first time Tech has defeated a top 5 Duke team since Feb. 26, 2011, when the Hokies downed the topranked Blue Devils, 64-60, in Cassell Coliseum ... The Hokies' 89 points is the most in a win against a nationally-ranked team since a 94-88 win over top-ranked UNC on Jan. 13, 2007 in Cassell Coliseum ... It is tied for the third-most points scored against a nationallyranked team in a Virginia Tech victory ... The Hokies' 89 points is the most allowed by Duke this season.

# 571 in the Cassell

The Hokies have a 571-189 overall record in Cassell Coliseum, for a .751 winning percentage ... The win over Florida State in 2011, was the 500th victory in the building ... Tech has had just one break-even home season and two losing seasons ... Tech is 10-1 in Cassell this year, 2-1 in ACC games.

# Wrapping Up the Notre Dame Game

The Hokies now fall to 7-1 all-time against the Fighting Irish ... Tech is now 1-2 against nationally-ranked teams this season, 1-1 in Cassell Coliseum.

In his two yearsplus at Virginia He and his staff take

a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

Last season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the

ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity - one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature. Williams has compiled a 44-41 record in his first three seasons in Blacksburg.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. And while he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Tech, Buzz Williams already has ushered in an exciting new era of basketball. The head coach of the men's squad is in his third season here in Blacksburg, and he has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball.

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marguette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. Six Marguette players made it to the NBA during Williams' tenure. In his nine-plus seasons as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 197-127.

"The growth of the Hokies' basketball program and the renewed energy under Buzz Williams in his first two seasons has been remarkable," Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock said. "We've seen improvement in all facets. He's an educator first and foremost. He loves his players. They play hard for him. Everyone within the program and around the department has embraced Buzz's work ethic, passion, and attention to detail. We certainly have positive momentum and want to do all we can to keep it going. We believe in Coach Williams and his staff. Exciting times in Blacksburg."

Williams was an assistant at Marguette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA

Division I level for 20 seasons, and 2016-17 was will mark his 10th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07, and his roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 25 years in 2005-06 and the previous team posted the top turnaround in the



nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, serving as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West

Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline. com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple has two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.




