### About Tonight's Game

The Hokies enter the game 14-4 overall and 3-3 in ACC action ... Clemson is 11-7 overall and 1-5 in league play.

### Last Time Out: VT 62, GT 61

The Hokies recorded a close, come-from-behind win over Georgia Tech, 62-61, in Cassell Coliseum on Wednesday night ... **Seth Allen** made a contested lay-up with 15 seconds remaining and the Hokies' defense tightened on the Yellow Jackets final possession for the win ... **Allen** and **Zach LeDay** scored 17 points each and **Chris Clarke** recorded his third double-double of the season with 11 points and 11 rebounds in the win.

### Series Against the Tigers

This is the 32nd all-time meeting between the two schools ... The Hokies lead the series 16-15 and won the last meeting, 60-57, in Cassell Coliseum last season ... Virginia Tech is 5-9 in road games against Clemson ... Virginia Tech is 8-10 against the Tigers since the Hokies joined the ACC in 2004, including 7-10 in conference regular season games ... The Hokies are 1-1 against Clemson under **Buzz Williams**.

### Allen's Strong Return

**Seth Allen** returned to the Virginia Tech line-up in the win over Syracuse after missing the Florida State game due to a head injury at NC State ... **Allen** played 31 minutes with 11 points and five assists in the win over SU ... Against Notre Dame, **Allen** scored 16 points ... In the win over Georgia Tech, he had 17 points ... In the three games since returning to the line-up, **Allen** is averaging 14.7 points per game, shooting 61.5 percent from the floor and 57.1 percent from the line.

### Clarke Stays Hot

In the last 10 games, all of which **Chris Clarke** has scored in double figures, he has scored 163 points, averaging 16.3 points ... Over the same period, he is averaging 8.5 rebounds and 4.0 assists per game ... In the win over Georgia

Tech, Clarke scored 11 points and grabbed 11 rebounds for his third double-double of the season ... He also has a triple-double this season... It is the Hokies' first double-double against ACC competition since **Zach LeDay** had 15 points and 12 rebounds in the ACC Tournament win over Florida State last season and the first double-double in regular season ACC play since **Justin Bibbs** had 12 points and 10 rebounds at Boston College last season ... The 11 rebounds are the most in an ACC game for Clarke.

### Solid Stats for LeDay

**Zach LeDay** has posted some great numbers for the Hokies this season ... LeDay has scored in double figures in 17 of the 18 games so far this season, including three games of 20-or-more-points ... He leads the Hokies in scoring, at 16.3

points per game and is second on the team in rebounding, at 7.2 boards per game ... In the win over Syracuse, he tied his ACC-high of 22 points ... LeDay grabbed his 400th Virginia Tech rebound against Notre Dame and had 17 points in the win over Georgia Tech.

### CC's 22

**Chris Clarke** scored 22 points in the loss at Florida State ... The 22 points ties his career-high, which he set on Dec. 28, 2016 in the win over UMBC ... It is the most points he has scored against ACC competition ... The 22 points is the most points for a Hokie in a true road game since the final game of last season when **Seth Allen** had 22 points at BYU ... It is the most points for a Hokie in an ACC regular season game since **Justin Bibbs** had 22 points in the win at Wake Forest on Feb. 28 of last year ... The last time a Hokie scored more than 22 points in a road ACC game was Allen's 28 points at Pittsburgh on Jan. 31, 2016 ... **Zach LeDay** had 22 points in the win over Syracuse ... Clarke scored 21 points in the loss to Notre Dame.

### Close Games

Since the Hokies joined the ACC in the 2004-05 season, Tech has played Clemson 18 times ... Of those 18 games, 12 have been decided by 5-or-fewer points ... Four more have been decided by 10-or-fewer points ... In those 18 games, only 24 points divide the two teams.

### Closing in on 200

**Buzz Williams** enters tonight's game with a 198-127 record in his 10th season as a collegiate head coach ... He is 45-41 in his third season at Virginia Tech.

### Entering the List

Entering tonight's game, **Justin Bibbs** is 151-358 from three-point range for his career, good for 42.2 percent ... He is currently 10th all-time in three-point field goal percentage in the ACC, having reached the 150 made three-pointers plateau with his three made three-pointers in the win over Georgia Tech ... He is currently tops at Virginia Tech, as the existing school mark is 40.9 percent, set by Brian Chase from 1999-2003.

### Wrapping Up the Georgia Tech Game

The Hokies' bench outscored the Yellow Jackets' bench, 45-9 ... The Hokies are now 17-6 all-time against the Yellow Jackets and have won the last three games in the series.

### Fast Start

The Hokies are 14-4 this season ... This marks the team's best start through 18 games since the 2009-10 season, when Tech started the campaign 15-3 ... The Hokies finished the month of November 6-1 overall and finished December 6-0 ... Tech's 6-0 is its first undefeated December since 2009-10, when Tech finished that December 7-0.

### What a Sellout, x4

Last Saturday's ACC game against No. 20/20 Notre Dame was a sellout ... That game joined the Dec. 31 win over No. 5/5 Duke and the upcoming Feb. 12 game against Virginia as sellouts ... It is the third and fourth sellouts of the season, following the sellout of the home opener against Maine on Nov. 11 ... The Duke game sold out less than 24 hours after single game ACC tickets went on sale to Hokie Club members and season ticket holders ... Single game tickets went on sale to the general public on Dec. 14.

### More on the Gate

With the four sellouts, the Hokies are averaging 7,204 per game this season ... Last season, the Hokies averaged 6,658 and in the 2014-15 season, Tech averaged 5,744 ... This year's attendance would be the largest for the Hokies since averaging 8,395 in the 2010-11 season ... Last season, the Hokies averaged 7,529 for nine ACC home games; this season, Tech is averaging 7,945 through four ACC home games.

### Clarke in a Giving Mood

Last season, **Chris Clarke** recorded 33 assists in 22 games for the Hokies ... This season, through 18 games, Clarke has dished out 67 assists, second-best on the team ... In the win over High Point, Clarke registered six assists and had five assists each in the wins over VMI and Ole Miss ... He smashed that number in the win over The Citadel, when he recorded a career-high 10 assists ... Last season he averaged 1.5 assists per game and this season; that has risen to 3.7 assists per game ... His 10 assists in The Citadel game is the most assists by a Hokie since **Devin Wilson** had 11 assists in a loss to No. 4 Duke on Feb. 25, 2015 ... In the win over Syracuse, he dished out a new personal ACC-high of six assists and with his five assists against Notre Dame, now has seven games of at least five assists this season.

### And a Taking Mood, Too

To go along with his assists numbers, **Chris Clarke** had 21 steals in 22 games last season ... He has 26 steals in the first 18 games of this season ... He leads the Hokies in steals this season, by more than double the next highest player.

### 3X2 + 2X2

In the Hokies' win over The Citadel, **Chris Clarke** recorded the Hokies' first-ever triple-double, scoring 13 points, grabbing 12 rebounds and dishing out a career-high 10 assists ... Clarke is one of three ACC players with a triple-double this season ... Since that triple-double, Clarke recorded consecutive double-doubles in the wins over Charleston Southern and UMBC and scored 13 points in the win over No. 5/5 Duke ... In the loss at No. 12/13 Florida State, he tied a career-high with 22 points, the most points he has scored in an ACC game ... In the win over Georgia Tech, Clarke had another double-double, with 11 points and 11 rebounds ... He scored 185 points in 22 games last season and has 218 points in 17 games this season ... He scored his 400th career point against Notre Dame.

### A Long Time Coming

The Hokies' 83-73 victory over Syracuse snapped an eight-game losing skid to the Orange ... This marked Tech's first win over Syracuse since Jan. 30, 1978 in Cassell Coliseum.

### Earning It

Head coach **Buzz Williams** announced on Jan. 12 that **Matt Galloway** has earned a full scholarship for the spring semester ... Galloway, who graduated last May with a degree in history, is currently in graduate school at Virginia Tech ... He joined the team last season as a walk-on.

### Being Stingy is a Good Thing

In the win over Syracuse, the Hokies committed a season-low six turnovers ... The previous low was seven against Texas A&M ... This is the fewest turnovers in an ACC game for the Hokies since committing six turnovers against Wake Forest on Jan. 13, 2016.

### In a Giving Mood

The Hokies dished out 20 assists, on 28 made baskets in the win over Syracuse ... It is the ninth time this season that the Hokies have had at least 18 assists in a game ... It is the most assists for the Hokies in an ACC game since the Hokies had 23 assists against Wake Forest on Jan. 15, 2011 ... That 23 assists is a high in an ACC game for Tech.

### Sharing is Good

In the 113-71 win over The Citadel, the Hokies dished out a season-high 30 assists ... That is the second-most assists in school history ... Tech had 31 assists in a 122-73 win over South Carolina State on Dec. 18, 1982 ... With the 20 assists in the win over Syracuse, the Hokies now have nine games of at least 18 assists this season.

### A Balancing Act

The Hokies had seven players score in double figures in the win over The Citadel, the most since Tech placed seven players in double figures in a 104-74 win over Rider on Dec. 19, 1984 in Cassell Coliseum ... With six players scoring in double figures in the win over Duke, Tech completed a span of four games in which it had at least five players score in double figures ... Tech had five players score in double-figures in the win over Syracuse.

### From the Start

Tech used the same starting line-up in its first 13 games this season, before changing the line-up at NC State due to the injury to **Khadim Sy** ... The Hokies used the same starting line-up the next four games and used a third different starting line-up in the win over Georgia Tech ... Last season, the Hokies used 12 different starting line-ups.

### Here You Go

**Seth Allen** was in quite the giving mood in the win over UMES ... Allen tied a career-high with eight assists, while only committing one turnover in 31 minutes of action ... The eight assists was tied for the most by a Hokies this season at that point ... Allen also added 11 points, a blocked shot and a steal in the win.

### On The List

**Seth Allen** was named to the Bob Cousy Award watch list for the 2016-17 season ... The award is given annually to the nation's top point guard.

### A Familiar Face Returns

Senior guard **Devin Wilson** returned to the basketball team on Friday, Dec. 30 for a noon practice after playing on the Virginia Tech football team this fall ... Wilson, who has not played yet this season, had returned to Blacksburg at 2:30 a.m. Dec. 30 with the team, who had defeated Arkansas, 35-24, in the Belk Bowl in Charlotte on Dec. 29.

### Hokies in the National Stats

Through the games of Jan. 19, Tech is 29th in field goal percentage, 34th in scoring offense, 35th in won-lost percentage and 37th in assist/turnover ratio... Individually, **Ahmed Hill** is 31st in three-point field goal percentage.

### Scheduling Oddities

Virginia Tech's first six ACC games and seven of the first eight are games against teams that Tech will play only once this regular season ... Tonight's game is the first against a home-and-home opponent this season ... The Jan. 14 Notre Dame game was the Hokies' final home Saturday game until the final day of the regular season, March 4, when Tech hosts Wake Forest ... The Hokies only have two remaining Saturday road games this season ... All three of Tech's Saturday ACC home games will come on winter and spring breaks.

### 452 and Counting

Tech has now hit a three-point field goal in 452 consecutive games, the most in school history ... The Hokies have hit a three-pointer in every game since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season ... Since the three-point arc was added for the 1986-87 season, the Hokies have hit at least one three in all but three games ... The last time Tech did not record a three-point field goal in a game was at Providence on Feb. 1, 2003.

### Using Analytics

According to Kenpom.com, the Hokies are ranked 50th nationally ... Tech is 24th nationally in effective field goal percentage, 30th in free throw rate, 35th in two-point field goals, 37th in raw offensive efficiency, 28th in two-point field goal percentage defense ... **Zach LeDay** is 23rd in offensive rating.

### Lots of Sharing

In the win over VMI, **Justin Robinson** had six assists and **Seth Allen** and **Chris Clarke** had five assists each ... This marks the first time since the Hokies joined the ACC in the 2004-05 season that three Hokies had at least five assists in a game ... In the win over The Citadel, the same trio had six-or-more assists.

### 572 in the Cassell

The Hokies have a 572-189 overall record in Cassell Coliseum, for a .752 winning percentage ... The win over Florida State in 2011, was the 500th victory in the building ... Tech has had just one break-even home season and two losing seasons ... Tech is 11-1 in Cassell this year, 3-1 in ACC games.

### A Fine Start

**Khadim Sy** made his collegiate debut in the win over Maine ... The freshman post earned the start and had a solid six points, four rebounds and team-high three blocked shots in the win ... In the win over High Point, Sy recorded his first double-figure scoring game of his career, with 14 points and a team-high six rebounds ... Sy grabbed a career-high 10 rebounds in the win over New Mexico ... He matched the career-high in points with 14 points in the win over The Citadel ... He missed the NC State game after injuring his right ankle in the afternoon shoot around before the game ... He returned to action at Florida State, playing eight minutes.

When the Hokies defeated Nebraska, 66-53, in the Wooden Legacy and Michigan, 73-70, in Ann Arbor in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge in the last week in November, it marked the first time in school history that Tech defeated Big Ten schools in back-to-back games ... In 2009, the Hokies won at Iowa and at Penn State in December, but the games were not back-to-back ... The win over Nebraska marked the Hokies' first win over a Big Ten team since Nov. 27, 2012 (exactly four years to the day), when Tech defeated Iowa, 95-79, in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge in Cassell Coliseum ... It was the Hokies first win over a Big Ten school away from Blacksburg since the Hokies downed the Hawkeyes, 70-64, in Iowa City in the 2009 ACC/Big Ten Challenge.

### Bimbo is Hall of Famous

The Virginia Sports Hall of Fame has announced that Virginia Tech men's basketball great **Bimbo Coles** will be inducted into its class of 2017 ... Coles played at Virginia Tech under Virginia Sports Hall of Fame coaches Charlie Moir and Frankie Allen ... He finished his collegiate career as the leading all-time scorer in school and Metro Conference history and also set an all-time scoring mark for Division I players in the state of Virginia ... He scored a total of 2,484 points during his four seasons and became the first player in Metro Conference history to lead the league in scoring three consecutive years ... He remains the Hokies' all-time leader in scoring and assists ... The 46th Annual Induction Banquet will take place on Saturday, April 29, 2017 at the Renaissance Portsmouth-Norfolk Waterfront Hotel in Portsmouth, Virginia.

### HEAD COACH BUZZ WILLIAMS



In his two years-plus at Virginia Tech, Buzz Williams already has ushered in an exciting new era of basketball. The head coach of the men's squad is in his third season here in Blacksburg, and he has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take

a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

Last season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature. Williams has compiled a 45-41 record in his first three seasons in Blacksburg.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. And while he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. Six Marquette players made it to the NBA during Williams' tenure. In his nine-plus seasons as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 198-127.

"The growth of the Hokies' basketball program and the renewed energy under Buzz Williams in his first two seasons has been remarkable," Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock said. "We've seen improvement in all facets. He's an educator first and foremost. He loves his players. They play hard for him. Everyone within the program and around the department has embraced Buzz's work ethic, passion, and attention to detail. We certainly have positive momentum and want to do all we can to keep it going. We believe in Coach Williams and his staff. Exciting times in Blacksburg."

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA

Division I level for 20 seasons, and 2016-17 will mark his 10th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07, and his roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 25 years in 2005-06 and the previous team posted the top turnaround in the



nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, serving as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple has two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
