### **About Tonight's Game**

The Hokies enter the game 16-5 overall and 5-4 in ACC action ... Virginia is 16-4 overall and 6-2 in conference play ... UVa is ranked ninth in the AP poll and 11th in the USA Today coaches poll ... This game, the first of two regular season meetings between the two schools, is part of the Virginia 529 Commonwealth Clash, which the Cavaliers lead, 5-4.5.

### Last Time Out: VT 85, BC 79

The Hokies returned to Cassell Coliseum with an 85-79 win over Boston College on Sunday night ... **Seth Allen** and **Justin Bibbs** led the Hokies with 18 points each and **Zach LeDay** added 17 points off the bench ... The Hokies shot 59.1 percent from the floor, including 66.7 percent from three-point range.

### **Series Against the Cavaliers**

This is the 144th all-time meeting between the two schools ... The Cavaliers lead the series, 89-54 ... The two teams split the series last season, with each team winning at home ... The Hokies defeated No. 4 UVa, 70-68, in Cassell Coliseum on Jan. 4 and No. 7 Virginia downed the Hokies, 67-49, Feb. 9 ... Tech is 13-36 in road games against UVa and 3-7 in games in John Paul Jones Arena ... Virginia Tech is 9-16 against the Cavaliers since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season.

### The Big 2-0-0

**Buzz Williams** won his 200th career game with the win over Boston College on Sunday night ... He enters tonight's game with a 200-128 record in his 10th season as a collegiate head coach ... He is 47-42 in his third season at Virginia Tech.

### Allen's Strong Return

Seth Allen returned to the line-up in the win over Syracuse after missing the Florida State game due to a head injury at NC State ... He played 31 minutes with 11 points and five assists in the win over SU ... Against Notre Dame, Allen scored 16

points ... He had 17 points in the wins over Georgia Tech and Clemson and 19 points at UNC ... In the six games since returning to the line-up, Allen is averaging 16.3 points per game, shooting 61.8 percent from the floor and 55.2 percent from beyond the arc ... He is third in the ACC in three-point field goal percentage in league games.

### **Solid Stats for LeDay**

Zach LeDay has posted some great numbers for the Hokies this season ... LeDay has scored in double figures in 20 of the 21 games this season, including three games of 20-or-more-points ... He leads the Hokies in scoring,

at 16.1 points per game and is second on the team in rebounding, at 6.7 boards per game ... In the win over Syracuse, he tied his ACChigh of 22 points ... LeDay grabbed his 400th Virginia Tech rebound against Notre Dame ... LeDay's streak of 16 consecutive doublefigure scoring games is second-best in the ACC this season.

### At the Halfway Mark

The Hokies are 16-5 overall and 5-4 in ACC play ... This is the first time since the ACC went from 16 conference games to 18 conference games in 2012-13 season that the Hokies have been above the .500 mark at the midway point of the conference schedule ... The last time the Hokies were 5-4 after nine conference games as the 2010-11 season ... The last time the Hokies were better than 5-4 after nine ACC games was the 2009-10 season, when Tech started 9-3 in ACC play.

### **Fast Start**

The Hokies are 16-5 this season ... This marks the team's best start through 21 games since the 2009-10 season, when Tech started the campaign 17-4 ... The Hokies finished the month of November, 6-1 overall and finished December, 6-0 ... Tech's 6-0 is its first undefeated December since 2009-10, when Tech finished that December 7-0.

### **Making Shots**

The Hokies lead the ACC in field goal percentage in ACC games and is second in all games this season ... Tech is 17th nationally in field goal percentage and 25th in three-point field goal percentage ... Two Hokies, Seth Allen (2nd) and Zach LeDay (5th) are in the top five in the league in field goal percentage in league games ... Tech is shooting 49.3 percent from the field in ACC play and 49.1 percent in all games ... The Hokies shot 51.0 percent from the floor at UNC and are the first ACC opponent to make better than 50 percent of their shots against the Tar Heels ... Tech shot 59.1 percent from the field in the win over Boston College on Sunday night.

### Hot in the First Half...

The Hokies shot 63.6 percent in the first half, their second-highest percent in a half this season and the best in an ACC game this season. Tech shot 60.9 percent in the second half at Clemson last Sunday night ... The Hokies' 72.7 percent from three-point territory in the first half is their highest percentage of the season in ACC play and the secondhighest overall ... Tech shot 75.0 percent in the second half against The Citadel.

### ... And for the Game

The Hokies' 59.1 percent from the field in the game is the team's third-best of the season and best in ACC play ... The 66.7 percent from three-point territory is a seasonhigh. It is the highest percentage in a game since Tech shot 66.7 percent in a win over Morgan State on Nov. 30, 2014. It ties the school's record for three-point percentage in an ACC game ... Tech shot 66.7 percent in 76-62 win at Wake Forest on Feb. 22, 2011.

### On Top of the List

Entering tonight's game, **Justin Bibbs** is 158-372 from three-point range for his career, good for 42.5 percent ... He is currently 10th all-time in three-point field goal percentage in the ACC, having reached the 150 made three-pointers

plateau with his three made three-pointers in the win over Georgia Tech ... He is currently tops at Virginia Tech, as the existing school mark is 40.9 percent, set by Brian Chase from 1999-2003 ... Bibbs is also nearing 1,000 career points at Virginia Tech ... He enters tonight's game at 927 points.

### On the Road, Again?

Sunday night's win over Boston College was the Hokies' only home game between Jan. 18 and Feb. 12 ... Tech is in a stretch of seven road games in a 10 game span ... The Hokies opened the ACC season with four of six games at home and end the regular season with three of four games in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech will not return home until Feb. 12, when they host these same Cavaliers ... The Hokies play just three home games in February.

### More About the Tech-UVa Series

This is the Hokies most-played rivalry ... The series dates back to Feb. 20, 1915, when the Cavaliers defeated Tech, 39-21, in Charlottesville ... Along with Blacksburg and Charlottesville, the series has also been played in Roanoke, Lynchburg, Richmond, Salem, Hampton, Norfolk and Greensboro, North Carolina (the 2006 ACC Tournament) ... After many years of neutral site games, the series returned to each ampus, beginning in the 2000-01 season, the year Tech joined the Big East Conference ... The series has been a home-and-home series since Tech joined the ACC in the 2004-05 season.

### **Quick Turn Around**

This is the first of two meetings between the in-state rivals ... Tech and UVa meet twice every regular season ... The Hokies and Cavaliers will meet again next Sunday in Blacksburg ... This is the shortest time between games since the Hokies joined the ACC in the 2004-05 season.

### 3X2 + 2X2

In the Hokies' win over The Citadel, Chris Clarke recorded the Hokies' firstever triple-double, scoring 13 points, grabbing 12 rebounds and dishing out a career-high 10 assists ... Clarke is one of three ACC players with a triple-double



this season ... Since that triple-double, Clarke recorded consecutive double-doubles in the wins over Charleston Southern and UMBC and scored 13 points in the win over No. 5/5 Duke ... In the loss at No. 12/13 Florida State, he tied a career-high with 22 points, the most points he has scored in an ACC game ... In the win over Georgia Tech, Clarke had another double-double, with 11 points and 11 rebounds ... He scored 185 points in 22 games last season and has 251 points in 21 games this season.

### CC's 22

Chris Clarke scored 22 points in the loss at Florida State ... The 22 points ties his career-high, which he set on Dec. 28, 2016 in the win over UMBC ... It is the most points he has scored against ACC competition ... The 22 points is the most points for a Hokie in a true road game since the final game of last season when Seth Allen had 22 points at BYU ... It is the most points for a Hokie in an ACC regular season game since Justin Bibbs had 22 points in the win at Wake Forest on Feb. 28 of last year ... The last time a Hokie scored more than 22 points in a road ACC game was Allen's 28 points at Pittsburgh on Jan. 31, 2016 ... Zach LeDay had 22 points in the win over Syracuse.

### **Commonwealth Notes**

Virginia Tech is 429-314 (.577) all-time against schools from Virginia ... Tech is 1-0 this season against Virginia schools ... The Hokies have played 14 schools from the state all-time ... The only state Division I school that Tech has not played is Hampton ... Tech holds winning records against 10 of the schools and even records against two others.

### Clarke in a Giving Mood

Last season, **Chris Clarke** had 33 assists in 22 games ... This season, through 21 games, Clarke has dished out 70 assists ... In the win over High Point, Clarke registered six assists ... He smashed that number in the win over The Citadel, when he recorded a career-high 10 assists ... Last season he averaged 1.5 assists per game and this season; that has risen to 3.4 assists ... His 10 assists in The Citadel game is the most assists by a Hokie since **Devin Wilson** had 11 assists in a loss to No. 4 Duke on Feb. 25, 2015 ... In the win over Syracuse, he dished out a new personal ACChigh of six assists and has seven games of at least five assists this season.

### And a Taking Mood, Too

To go along with his assists numbers, **Chris Clarke** had 21 steals in 22 games last season ... He has 27 steals in the first 21 games of this season ... He leads the Hokies in steals this season.

### 573 in the Cassell

The Hokies have a 573-189 overall record in Cassell Coliseum, for a .752 winning percentage ... The win over Florida State in 2011, was the 500th victory in the building ... Tech has had just one break-even home season and two losing seasons ... Tech is 12-1 in Cassell this year, 4-1 in ACC games.

### A Good Night from the Line

The Hokies made 16 of 17 free throw attempts in the win at Clemson, for 94.1 percent ... That marked the third time this season that Tech had shot better than 90 percent from the line ... Tech made 19 of 20 attempts in the win over New Mexico in the Wooden Legacy and 19 of 21 attempts in the win at Michigan in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge ... The last time the Hokies made at least 94 percent from the line in an ACC game (attempting at least 10 free throws) was on March 4, 2009, when the Hokies made all of their 17 free throw attempts in an 86-78 home win over No. 2 North Carolina.

### What a Sellout, x4

Virginia Tech has sold out four games this season, including the upcoming Feb. 12 game against Virginia ... The sellouts are the home opener against Maine and the ACC games against Duke and Notre Dame ... The Duke game sold out less than 24 hours after single game ACC tickets went on sale to Hokie Club members and season ticket holders.

### More on the Gate

With the three sellouts already in the books and a fourth set for the next home game, against Virginia on Feb. 12, the Hokies are averaging 7,217 per game this season ... Last season, the Hokies averaged 6,658 and in the 2014-15 season, Tech averaged 5,744 ... This year's attendance would be the largest for the Hokies since averaging 8,395 in the 2010-11 season ... Last season, the Hokies averaged 7,529 for nine ACC home games; this season, Tech is averaging 7,830 through five ACC home games.

### Being Stingy is a Good Thing

In the win over Syracuse, the Hokies committed a season-low six turnovers ... The previous low was seven against Texas A&M ... This is the fewest turnovers in an ACC game for the Hokies since committing six turnovers against Wake Forest on Jan. 13, 2016.

### In a Giving Mood

The Hokies dished out 20 assists, on 28 made baskets in the win over Syracuse ... It was the ninth time this season that the Hokies have had at least 18 assists in a game ... It is the most assists for the Hokies in an ACC game since the Hokies had 23 assists against Wake Forest on Jan. 15, 2011 ... That 23 assists is a high in an ACC game for Tech ... In the 113-71 win over The Citadel, the Hokies dished out a season-high 30 assists, second-most assists in school history.

### A Balancing Act

The Hokies had seven players score in double figures in the win over The Citadel, the most since Tech placed seven players in double figures in a 104-74 win over Rider on Dec. 19, 1984 ... With six players scoring in double figures in the win over Duke, Tech completed a span of four games in which it had at least five players score in double figures ... Tech had five players score in double-figures in the win over Syracuse.

### **Hokies vs. Ranked Teams**

Tech is 33-175 all-time against teams ranked in the AP poll ... The Hokies are 16-65 against nationally-ranked teams since joining the ACC for the 2004-05 season ... Tech is 1-3 against ranked teams this season.

### **Scheduling Oddities**

Virginia Tech's first six ACC games and seven of the first eight were games against teams that Tech will play only once this regular season ... The win at Clemson was the first against a home-and-home opponent this season ... The Jan. 14 Notre Dame game was the Hokies' final home Saturday game until the final day of the regular season, March 4, when Tech hosts Wake Forest ... The Hokies only have two remaining Saturday road games this season ... All three of Tech's Saturday ACC home games will come on winter and spring breaks.

### Ty Likes 3s

**Ty Outlaw** has made 29 field goals ... Of that number, 23 have come from three-point range ... He was 3-for-5 from three-point range at NC State ... Both of his baskets at Florida State were two-point field goals, the firsrt

time this season he has had two, two-pointers in the same game ... He has started the last four games and made all three shots, including both threes, in the win at Clemson and was 3-4 from three-point range in the win over Boston College.

# HEAD COACH BUZZ WILLIAMS



In his two yearsplus at Virginia Tech, Buzz Williams already has ushered in an exciting new era of basketball. The head coach of the men's squad is in his third season here in Blacksburg, and he has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take

a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Now in his 10th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 200-128. Williams has compiled a 47-42 record in his first three seasons in Blacksburg.

Last season, the Hokies were one of the most improved

teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. And while he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. Six Marquette players made it to the NBA during Williams' tenure.

"The growth of the Hokies' basketball program and the renewed energy under Buzz Williams in his first two seasons has been remarkable," Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock said. "We've seen improvement in all facets. He's an educator first and foremost. He loves his players. They play hard for him. Everyone within the program and around the department has embraced Buzz's work ethic, passion, and attention to detail. We certainly have positive momentum and want to do all we can to keep it going. We believe in Coach Williams and his staff. Exciting times in Blacksburg."

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA

Division I level for 20 seasons, and 2016-17 was will mark his 10th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07, and his roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 25 years in 2005-06 and the previous team posted the top turnaround in the

nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, serving as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West

Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline. com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple has two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.


