The Hokies enter the game 16-6 overall and 5-5 in ACC action ... Miami is 15-7 overall and 5-5 in conference play ... This is the first of two meetings between the two schools this season ... Miami plays at Virginia Tech on Feb. 27.

Last Time Out: #9/11 Uva 71, VT 48

The Hokies lost at No. 9/11 Virginia, 71-48, in John Paul Jones Arena last Wednesday night ... **Seth Allen** led the Hokies with 14 points and **Zach LeDay** added 12 points off the bench ... The two schools play again this Sunday in Cassell Coliseum.

Series Against the Hurricanes

The Hurricanes lead the series, 19-13 ... Miami took two of three meetings last season ... The Hokies lost to No. 11 Miami, 65-49, on Feb. 25 in Coral Gables and Tech defeated No. 7 Miami, 77-62, on March 5 in the regular season finale in Cassell Coliseum ... No. 11 Miami defeated the Hokies, 88-82, in the quarterfinal of the 2016 ACC Tournament in the Verizon Center in Washington, D.C. ... Tech is 4-9 in road games against UM and 4-7 in games in the Watsco Center ... Virginia Tech is 12-13 against the Hurricanes since both teams joined the ACC in the 2004-05 season ... Every game in the series has been played since the Hokies joined Miami in the Big East Conference in the 2000-01 season.

The Big 2-0-0

Buzz Williams won his 200th career game with the win over Boston College on Jan. 29 ... He enters tonight's game with a 200-129 record in his 10th season as a collegiate head coach ... He is 47-43 in his third season at Virginia Tech.

Allen Heating Up

Seth Allen returned to the line-up in the win over Syracuse after missing the Florida State game due to an injury ... He played 31 minutes with 11 points and five assists in the win over SU ... In the seven games since returning to the line-up, Allen is averaging 16.0 points per game, shooting 56.5 percent from the floor and 50.0 percent from beyond the arc ... He is third in the ACC in three-point field goal percentage in league games.

Solid Stats for LeDay

Zach LeDay has posted some great numbers for the Hokies this season ... LeDay has scored in double figures in 21 of the 22 games, including three games of 20-or-more-points ... He leads the Hokies in scoring, at 15.9 points per game and is second on the team in rebounding, at 6.6 boards per game ... In the win over Syracuse, he tied his ACC-high of 22 points ... LeDay grabbed his 400th Virginia Tech rebound against Notre Dame ... LeDay's streak of 17 consecutive double-figure scoring games is second-best in the ACC this season.

Seniors Leading the Way

The Hokies' two fifth-year seniors, **Seth Allen** and **Zach LeDay**, are leading by example this season ... The duo are the team's top two scorers and are averaging a combined 28.4 points per game this season ... They are shooting a combined 53.8 percent from the field, including 39.6 percent from three-point range ... Allen is second on the team in assists and LeDay is second on the team in rebounds and leads the team in blocked shots.

Better Percentages

The Hokies are shooting better this season as compared to last season in all three categories ... Last season, the Hokies shot 44.9 percent from the field and 34.8 percent from three-point range ... This season, Tech is shooting 48.7 percent from the field and 38.3 percent from three-point range ... Tech has also improved upon last season's 69.7 percent from the line, now shooting 70.7 percent ... Tech averaged 12.2 assists per game last season; that has improved to 15.3 per game this season.

At the Halfway Mark

The Hokies are 16-6 overall and 5-5 in ACC play ... at 5-4 nine games into the conference schedule, this was the first time since the ACC went from 16 conference games to 18 conference games in 2012-13 season that the Hokies have been above the .500 mark at the midway point of the conference schedule ... The last time the Hokies were 5-4 after nine conference games as the 2010-11 season ... The last time the Hokies were better than 5-4 after nine ACC games was the 2009-10 season, when Tech started 9-3 in ACC play.

Great Beginning

The Hokies are 16-6 this season ... This marks the team's best start through 22 games since the 2009-10 season, when Tech started the campaign 18-4 ... The Hokies finished the month of November this season, 6-1 overall and finished December, 6-0 ... Tech's 6-0 is its first undefeated December since 2009-10, when Tech finished that December 7-0.

Making Shots

The Hokies are second in field goal percentage in ACC games and third in all games this season ... Tech is 21st nationally in field goal percentage and 47th in three-point field goal percentage ... Two Hokies, **Seth Allen** (2nd) and **Zach LeDay** (4th) are in the top five in the league in field goal percentage in league games ... Tech is shooting 48.2 percent from the field in ACC play and 48.7 percent in all games ... The Hokies shot 51.0 percent from the floor at UNC and are the first ACC opponent to make better than 50 percent of their shots against the Tar Heels ... Tech shot 59.1 percent from the field in the win over Boston College.

Making Shots, Part 2

The Hokies shot 63.6 percent in the first half of the win over Boston College, their second-highest percent in a half this season and the best in an ACC game this season ... Tech shot 60.9 percent in the second half at Clemson ... The Hokies' 72.7 percent from three-point territory in the first half is their highest percentage of the season in ACC play and the second-highest overall ... The Hokies' 59.1 percent from the field in the game is the team's third-best of the season and best in ACC play ... The 66.7 percent from three-point territory is a season-high. It is the highest percentage in a game since Tech shot 66.7 percent in a win over Morgan State on Nov. 30, 2014. It ties the school's record for three-point percentage in an ACC game ... Tech shot 66.7 percent in 76-62 win at Wake Forest on Feb. 22, 2011.

On Top of the List

Entering tonight's game, **Justin Bibbs** is 159-375 from three-point range for his career, good for 42.4 percent ... He is currently 10th all-time in three-point field goal percentage in the ACC, having reached the 150 made three-pointers plateau with his three made three-pointers in the win over Georgia Tech ... He is currently tops at Virginia Tech, as the existing school mark is 40.9 percent, set by Brian Chase from 1999-2003 ... Bibbs is also nearing 1,000 career points at Virginia Tech ... He enters tonight's game at 932 points.

On the Road, Again?

The Jan. 29 win over Boston College was the Hokies' only home game between Jan. 18 and Feb. 12 ... Tech is in a stretch of seven road games in a 10-game span ... The Hokies opened ACC play with four of six games at home and end the regular season with three of four games in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech returns home Feb. 12, when they host arch-rival Virginia ... The Hokies play just three home games in February.

3X2 + 2X2

In the Hokies' win over The Citadel, **Chris Clarke** recorded the Hokies' first-ever triple-double, scoring 13 points, grabbing 12 rebounds and dishing out a career-high 10 assists ... Clarke is one of three ACC players with a triple-double this season ... Clarke recorded consecutive double-doubles in the wins over Charleston Southern and UMBC ... In the loss at No. 12/13 Florida State, he tied a career-high with 22 points, the most points he has scored in an ACC game ... In the win over Georgia Tech, Clarke had another double-double, with 11 points and 11 rebounds ... He scored 185 points in 22 games last season and 256 points in 22 games this season.

CC's 22

Chris Clarke scored 22 points in the loss at Florida State ... The 22 points ties his career-high, which he set on Dec. 28, 2016 in the win over UMBC ... It is the most points he has scored against ACC competition ... The 22 points is the most points for a Hokie in a true road game since the final game of last season when **Seth Allen** had 22 points at BYU ... It is the most points for a Hokie in an ACC regular season game since **Justin Bibbs** had 22 points in the win at Wake Forest on Feb. 28 of last year ... The last time a Hokie scored more than 22 points in a road ACC game was Allen's 28 points at Pittsburgh on Jan. 31, 2016 ... **Zach LeDay** had 22 points in the win over Syracuse.

Clarke in a Giving Mood

Last season, **Chris Clarke** had 33 assists in 22 games ... This season, through 22 games, Clarke has dished out 72 assists, third-best on the team ... In the win over High Point, Clarke registered six assists ... He smashed that number in the win over The Citadel, when he recorded a career-high 10 assists ... Last season he averaged 1.5 assists per game and this season; that has risen to 3.4 assists ... His 10 assists in The Citadel game is the most assists by a Hokie since **Devin Wilson** had 11 assists in a loss to No. 4 Duke on Feb. 25, 2015 ... In the win over Syracuse, he dished out a new personal ACC-high of six assists.

And a Taking Mood, Too

To go along with his assists numbers, **Chris Clarke** had 21 steals in 22 games last season ... He has 28 steals in 22 games this season ... He leads the Hokies in steals this season.

573 in the Cassell

The Hokies have a 573-189 overall record in Cassell Coliseum, for a .752 winning percentage ... The win over Florida State in 2011 was the 500th victory in the building ... Tech has had just one break-even home season and two losing seasons ... Tech is 12-1 in Cassell this year, 4-1 in ACC games.

A Good Night from the Line

The Hokies made 16 of 17 free throw attempts in the win at Clemson, for 94.1 percent ... That marked the third time this season that Tech had shot better than 90 percent from the line ... Tech made 19 of 20 attempts in the win over New Mexico in the Wooden Legacy and 19 of 21 attempts in the win at Michigan in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge ... The last time the Hokies made at least 94 percent from the line in an ACC game (attempting at least 10 free throws) was on March 4, 2009, when the Hokies made all of their 17 free throw attempts in an 86-78 home win over No. 2 North Carolina.

What a Sellout, x4

Virginia Tech has sold out four games this season, including the Feb. 12 game against UVa ... The sellouts are the home opener against Maine and ACC games against Duke and Notre Dame ... The Duke game sold out less than 24 hours after single game ACC tickets went on sale to Hokie Club members and season ticket holders.

More on the Gate

With the three sellouts already in the books and a fourth set for the next home game, against Virginia on Feb. 12, the Hokies are averaging 7,217 per game this season ... Last season, the Hokies averaged 6,658 and in the 2014-15 season, Tech averaged 5,744 ... This year's attendance would be the largest for the Hokies since averaging 8,395 in the 2010-11 season ... Last season, the Hokies averaged 7,529 for nine ACC home games; this season, Tech is averaging 7,830 through five ACC home games.

Being Stingy is a Good Thing

In the win over Syracuse, the Hokies committed a season-low six turnovers ... The previous low was seven against Texas A&M ... This is the fewest turnovers in an ACC game for the Hokies since committing six turnovers against Wake Forest on Jan. 13, 2016.

Giving an Assist

The Hokies dished out 20 assists on 28 made baskets in the win over Syracuse ... It was the ninth time this season that the Hokies have had at least 18 assists in a game ... It is the most assists for the Hokies in an ACC game since the Hokies had 23 assists against Wake Forest on Jan. 15, 2011 ... That 23 assists is a high in an ACC game for Tech ... In the 113-71 win over The Citadel, the Hokies dished out a season-high 30 assists, second-most assists in school history.

456 and Counting

Tech has now hit a three-point field goal in 456 consecutive games, the most in school history ... The Hokies have hit a three-pointer in every game since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season ... Since the three-point arc was added for the 1986-87 season, the Hokies have hit at least one three in all but three games ... The last time Tech did not record a three-point field goal in a game was at Providence on Feb. 1, 2003.

Scheduling Oddities

Virginia Tech's first six ACC games and seven of the first eight were games against teams that Tech will play only once this regular season ... The win at Clemson was the first against a home-and-home opponent this season ... The Jan. 14 Notre Dame game was the Hokies' final home Saturday game until the final day of the regular season, March 4, when Tech hosts Wake Forest ... The Hokies only have two remaining Saturday road games this season ... All three of Tech's Saturday ACC home games will come on winter and spring breaks.

Ty Likes 3s

Ty Outlaw has made 31 field goals ... Of that number, 24 have come from three-point range ... He was 3-for-5 from three-point range at NC State ... Both of his baskets at Florida State were two-point field goals, the first time this season he has had two, two-pointers in the same game ... He has started the last five games and made all three shots, including both threes, in the win at Clemson and was 3-4 from three-point range in the win over Boston College.

Hokies in the National Stats

Through the games of Feb. 5, Tech is 21st nationally in field goal percentage and fewest fouls, 46th in fewest turnovers, 47th in three-point field goal percentage and 49th in scoring offense ... **Chris Clarke** is one of 19 players nationally and one of three in the ACC to record a triple-double this season.

Using Analytics

According to Kenpom.com, the Hokies are ranked 55th nationally ... Tech is 17th nationally in two-point field goals and defensive free throw rate, 19th in effective field goal percentage, 30th in adjusted offensive efficiency of opposing offenses, 41st in raw offensive efficiency, 43rd in three-point field goal percentage, 45th in steal percentage and 46th in average adjusted offensive efficiency of opponents ... **Zach LeDay** is 33rd in offensive rating.

A Balancing Act

The Hokies had seven players score in double figures in the win over The Citadel, the most since Tech placed seven players in double figures in a 104-74 win over Rider on Dec. 19, 1984 ... With six players scoring in double figures in the win over Duke, Tech completed a span of four games in which it had at least five players score in double figures ... Tech had five players score in double-figures in the win over Syracuse.

Beating Top Teams

Last season, the Hokies won two games against top 10 teams, including a home one over No. 7 Miami ... That marked the first time that had happened since Tech defeated three top 10 (actually top 5) teams in the 2006-07 season ... Tech added another Top 5 victory this season, defeating No. 5/5 Duke, 89-75, on Dec. 31.

He was an assistant coach with the Canadian National team at the FIBA U18 Americas Championship in Valdivia, Chile, a team that featured Virginia Tech signee Nickeil Alexander-Walker and finished with the Silver Medal ... Last summer, he was an assistant with the Canadian team at the FIBA U19 Championship in Herkalion, Greece, where **Justin Bibbs'** USA Basketball team won the gold medal ... McNeilly has contributed to the Canadian National team since 2011.

Scoring Balance

The Hokies have five players averaging in double figures ... The Hokies have played 11 players this season and eight have scored at least 90 points ... Six players have scored at least 185 points and five have scored at least 200 points, but just one player, **Zach LeDay**, has scored more than 300 points.

Zach is Honored

Zach LeDay was named to the Wooden Legacy All-Tournament team, following his performance in Anaheim ... LeDay averaged 14.3 points and 5.7 rebounds in the three-game event.

What A Trip!

Earlier this season, the Hokies returned from an epic 10-day, four-game road trip, that included stops in Anaheim, California and Ann Arbor, Michigan ... Tech was 3-1 on the trip, all against top-level competition and highlighted by a 73-70 win at Michigan in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge ... Tech also posted wins against New Mexico and Nebraska and had a close, 68-65, loss to Texas A&M.

Big Week

When the Hokies defeated Nebraska, 66-53, in the Wooden Legacy and Michigan, 73-70, in Ann Arbor in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge in the last week in November, it marked the first time in school history that Tech defeated Big Ten schools in back-to-back games ... In 2009, the Hokies won at Iowa and at Penn State in December, but the games were not back-to-back ... The win over Nebraska marked the Hokies' first win over a Big Ten team since Nov. 27, 2012 (exactly four years to the day), when Tech defeated Iowa, 95-79, in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge in Cassell Coliseum ... It was the Hokies first win over a Big Ten school away from Blacksburg since the Hokies downed the Hawkeyes, 70-64, in Iowa City in the 2009 ACC/Big Ten Challenge.

Buzz's Bunch is a non-profit organization that Coach Buzz Williams created seven years ago when he was first named head coach at Marquette University.

Some Facts from the Duke Win

The Hokies' 89 points is the most points the Hokies have ever scored against Duke and the 14-point margin of victory ties the largest margin of victory against Duke ... It was the Hokies first win over a top 5 team since Jan. 4, 2016, when the Hokies defeated No. 4 Virginia, 70-68, in Cassell Coliseum and first win over a top 10 team since a 77-62 win over No. 7 Miami on March 5, 2016 in Cassell Coliseum ... This is the first time Tech has defeated a top 5 Duke team since Feb. 26, 2011, when the Hokies downed the top-ranked Blue Devils, 64-60, in Cassell Coliseum ... The Hokies' 89 points is the most in a win against a nationally-ranked team since a 94-88 win over top-ranked UNC on Jan. 13, 2007 in Cassell Coliseum ... It is tied for the third-most points scored against a nationally-ranked team in a Virginia Tech victory ... The Hokies' 89 points is the most allowed by Duke this season.

Last Year vs. Miami

Last season, the Hokies and Hurricanes met three times ... In those three games, **Seth Allen** averaged 16.7 points per game, including a 31-point performance in the loss in the ACC Tournament ... **Justin Robinson** averaged 12.0 ppg and **Zach LeDay** averaged 11.3 ppg.

A Familiar Face Returns

Devin Wilson returned to the basketball team on Friday, Dec. 30 for a noon practice after playing on the Virginia Tech football team this fall ... Wilson, who has not played yet this season and will redshirt the 2016-17 season, had returned to Blacksburg at 2:30 a.m. Dec. 30 with the team, who had defeated Arkansas, 35-24, in the Belk Bowl in Charlotte on Dec. 29.

In his two years-plus at Virginia Tech, Buzz Williams already has ushered in an exciting new era of basketball. The head coach of the men's squad is in his third season here in Blacksburg, and he has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take

a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Now in his 10th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 200-129. Williams has compiled a 47-43 record in his first three seasons in Blacksburg.

Last season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. And while he has been

able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. Six Marquette players made it to the NBA during Williams' tenure.

"The growth of the Hokies' basketball program and the renewed energy under Buzz Williams in his first two seasons has been remarkable," Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock said. "We've seen improvement in all facets. He's an educator first and foremost. He loves his players. They play hard for him. Everyone within the program and around the department has embraced Buzz's work ethic, passion, and attention to detail. We certainly have positive momentum and want to do all we can to keep it going. We believe in Coach Williams and his staff. Exciting times in Blacksburg."

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA

Division I level for 20 seasons, and 2016-17 will mark his 10th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07, and his roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 25 years in 2005-06 and the previous team posted the top turnaround in the



nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, serving as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple has two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
