About Today's Game

The Hokies enter the game 8-1 on the season ... The Hawks are 3-7 on the season.

Last Time Out: VT 95, Radford 68

The Hokies shot 62 percent from the field en route to a 95-68 win over Radford in Cassell Coliseum on Wednesday night ... Justin Bibbs and Kerry Blackshear Jr., each scored 20 points to lead the Hokies and Justin Robinson had 11 points and nine assists in the win.

The Hokies vs. UMES

Tech is 7-0 all-time against the Hawks and all seven games have been played in Cassell Coliseum... Tech won the last meeting, 75-59, last season ... Tech is 29-0 all-time against teams currently in the MEAC ... Tech will play MEAC member North Carolina A&T on Dec. 28.

Call It a Comeback

The Hokies defeated Ole Miss in Oxford on Dec. 2, 83-80, in overtime ... In doing so, the Hokies fought back from a 16-point second half deficit ... The 16 point comeback is the largest for Tech game since coming back from a 16-point deficit to defeat NC State in the first conference game of the 2015-16 season ... Tech's ACC record for largest comeback victory is 18 points, in a 91-87 overtime win over NC State on Feb. 8, 2009 in Cassell Coliseum.

Sharing is Good

In the win over The Citadel, the Hokies recorded 36 assists ... That sets a new school record for assists in a game, breaking the old mark of 31, set against South Carolina State on Dec. 18, 1982 ... The Hokies assisted on 75 percent of their made baskets in The Citadel victory ... In the win over Washington, the Hokies assisted on 23 of their 30 made baskets, good for 76.7 percent ... For the season, Tech has 178 assists on 285 made field goals, for 62.5 percent ... So far this season, the Hokies' three point guards are a combined 82 assists and 33 turnovers ... Tech has six players with at least double figures in assists this season ... The Hokies are second nationally in assists per

Hokies in National Stats

As of Dec. 8, the Hokies lead the nation in field goal percentage and scoring offense, are is third in three-point field goal percentage, fourth in scoring margin and fifth in assists per game ... Tech is 25th in assist/turnover ratio and 42nd in three-point field goals per game.

A String of Threes

Justin Bibbs has now made at least one three-point field goal in the last 23 games in which he has played, tops currently in the ACC ... Ahmed Hill has made at least one three-pointer in each of his last 10 games, second-best in the ACC behind Bibbs ... The Virginia Tech school record for most consecutive games with a three-point field goal is 73, by Wally Lancaster.

They Are Free, After All

The Hokes made 67 of their first 100 free throw attempts, for 67.0 percent

... Since then (beginning with the win over Washington) Tech has made 144 of their last 182 free throw attempts (79.1 percent) ... Tech is currently shooting 74.8 percent from the line for the season.

The 90s

The Hokies have scored 90-or-more points in six games already this season ... Tech accomplished that feat last season in its 31st game ... Prior to last season, the last time the Hokies registered six games of 90-or-more-points was the 1988-89 season, when Tech had 14 such games ... The current back-to-back stretch is Tech's first since the 1987-88 and 1988-89 seasons.

Analytics and All

As of Dec. 8, the Hokies are ranked 31st by Kenpom.com ... Tech leads the nation in effective field goal percentage, are second in free throw rate and three-point percentage and fourth in raw offensive efficiency ... Tech is fifth in two-point percentage and ninth in length of possesion ... Tech is 12th in raw tempo, 18th in adjusted offensive efficiency, 21st in assist percentage and 24th in free throw percentage.

OT, Baby

The 83-80 overtime win at Ole Miss on Saturday was Tech's first overtime game of the season ... This was the Hokies' first overtime game since defeating No. 12 Virginia, 80-78, in double overtime on Feb. 12, 2017 ... Tech is now 66-49 overall in overtime games and 6-3 in overtime games under **Buzz Williams** ... Tech is 30-11 in home overtime games and 16-8 in overtime in ACC games ... Tech is 28-25 in road overtime games ... The Ole Miss victory was Tech's first over an SEC school in an overtime game (Tech is now 1-2 against SEC schools in overtime).

It Was a Big Week

The Hokies defeated Ole Miss of the SEC 83-80, in overtime on Saturday after defeating lowa of the Big Ten, 79-55, on Nov. 28 in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge in Blacksburg .. This marked the first time since the 2012-13 season that Tech played back-to-back games against Power 5 competition in less than a calendar week not part of an exempt tournament ... In that season, the Hokies defeated Iowa, 95-79, in Cassell Coliseum in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge on Nov. 27 and followed that with an 81-71 home win over No. 15 Oklahoma State ... The last time Tech played such teams in which one of the games was a road game was the 2011-12 season, when Tech lost at Minnesota, 58-55, in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge and lost at home to Kansas State, 69-61, five days later.

Powerful Wins

With the Hokies' win at Ole Miss on Saturday, Tech is one of three ACC schools that have recorded at least three wins this season against non-conference Power 5 teams ... Duke has four such wins and North Carolina also has three such wins ... Tech has two of the three wins away from Cassell Coliseum this season ... Tech had three non-conference Power 5 wins last season.

Doubling Up

Chris Clarke recorded his second double-double of the year and his eighth career double-double with 16 points and 12 rebounds in the win at Ole Miss ... Clarke's eight career double-doubles are tops among current Hokies

... Clarke recorded the Hokies' first-ever triple-double last season in the win over The Citadel.

Home is Where the Wins Are

With the Hokies' win over Radford, Tech is now 6-0 at home this season ... Tech was 15-2 in Cassell last season ... Since **Buzz Williams** arrived in Blacksburg for the 2014-15 season, Tech is 44-16 (.733) in Cassell Coliseum and is 35-7 (.833) since the beginning of the 2015-16 season ... Tech has won 14 consecutive home non-conference games.

Not Marginal at All

The 24-point winning margin against lowa marks the second time in as many games this season that Tech has defeated a Power 5 conference opponent by 24 points ... Tech downed Washington, 103-79 in Madison Square Garden earlier in the month ... The 24-point margin of victory is the largest ever for Tech in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.

Lots of Minutes

Two Hokie players are two of the most experienced ACC players in the league this season ... Justin Bibbs has played a total of 3,258 minutes at Virginia Tech and Devin Wilson has played 2,926 minutes as a Hokie ...

Tech has another player, **Ahmed Hill**, who has played 2,217 in just two-plus seasons at Virginia Tech ... **Justin Robinson** passed the 2,000 minute mark in the win over lowa.

P.J. Comes Through in the Clutch

When **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, picked up his second foul just five minutes into the

lowa game, freshman P.J. Horne stepped up and came through with the best performance of his young career to date ... Horne scored a career-high 16 points, including 12 points in 14 minutes of action in the first half ... He was 6-of-7 from the floor and

made four of his six free throw attempts ... The front court duo combined for 23 points and 12 rebounds in the win and made eight of their 10 shots.

Defense Wins

With the 79-55 win over lowa, the Hokies have now won their last six games when holding an opponent to 55-or-fewer points ... Tech is 7-1 under **Buzz Williams** in such games.

Buzz Williams has announced the signings of Jonathan Kabongo, Jarren McAllister and Landers Nolley II to National Letters of Intent ... The trio will enroll at Virginia Tech in the fall of 2018 ... Kabonogo is a 6-4, 180 lbs., guard from Toronto, Ontario and Putnam Science Academy in Putnam, Connecticut ... McAllister is a 6-4, 185 lbs., guard from Heritage High School in Wake Forest, North Carolina ... Nolley is a 6-7, 210 lbs., shooting guard at Langston Hughes High School in Fairburn, Georgia.

Providing Relief

The Virginia Tech men's basketball team participated in the "Hoops 4 Hurricane Relief" exhibition game against South Carolina in the Colonial Life Center in Columbia, South Carolina on Nov. 5 ... The exhibition event raised funds for those impacted by the recent storms, as net proceeds from the game supported hurricane relief efforts in Texas, South Florida and Puerto Rico ... Tickets for the game were \$10 for a general admission seat ... Funds raised from the game and the online donation will be directed to organizations benefitting the affected areas ... At halftime, both head coaches made sizable donations to the cause.

The Hokies hit the road to Lexington, Ky., as they face nationally-ranked Kentucky in Rupp Arena on Saturday ... Tip is at 2 p.m. and the game will be shown live on ESPN2 and the ESPN app.

That's the most frequently asked question regarding Virginia Tech athletics ... The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute ... With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body ... Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Old Hokie" yell which still is used today ... Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the words he used had no hidden or symbolic meaning, but had been thought up in an effort to get attention ... Hokie soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

Tech are also not recognized names and should not be used ... VT is acceptable as a shortened, agate form ... When referring to the school by its nickname, please use "Hokies" ... Your help in these matters is appreciated.

Continuing to Climb

In the Hokies' win at Boston College last season, **Justin Bibbs** scored his 1,000th career point, becoming the 45th Hokie to score 1,000 career points ... He currently has 1,176 points, 34th on the list, after passing Dick Sayre and Rolan Roberts in the win over Radford ... Bibbs is averaging 18.6 points per game this season, shooting 59.5 percent from the floor, 46.2 percent from three-point range and 94.7 percent from the free throw line ... He has scored in double figures in all seven games he has played this season ... Bibbs is currently shooting 43.6 percent from three-point range for his career, which is first on the Virginia Tech all-time list.

Less Than a Third

The Hokies held lowa to just 33.3 percent from the field on Nov. 28 ... That is the lowest opponent field goal percentage of the season and the lowest since Tech held Charleston Southern to 33.3 percent on Dec. 20 of last year ... It is the lowest field goal percentage for a Power 5 team against Tech since Nov. 27 of last year, when the Hokies held Nebraska to 29.8 percent in the Wooden Legacy in Anaheim, California ... Tech held the Cornhuskers to 19.0 percent from three-point range that game.

Century Marks

The Hokies defeated Washington, 103-79, on Nov. 17 ... The 103 points is the most points Tech has scored against a current Power 5 school in a regulation game since a 109-68 victory over South Carolina on Jan. 25, 1985 in Cassell Coliseum ... It is the first time that they have acheived that feat away from Cassell Coliseum since a 106-75 win over the Gamecocks in Salem, Virginia on Dec. 22, 1960, the only other time this has occurred ... Tech scored more than 100 points in three of its first four games for the first time in school history ... Tech has scored 100-or-more points three times this season for the first time since 1988-89.

Bede Steps Up

In the Hokies' 99-73 win over Houston Baptist, freshman **Wabissa Bede** took every advantage of his time on the court ... Playing 11 minutes, all in the second half, Bede scored a career-high 13 points on 3-of-4 from the field, including making his only three-point attempt ... He also was a perfect 6-of-6 from the free throw line ... All three true freshmen on this year's squad scored in double figures at least once in the first five games this year.

Lots of Options

So far this season, the Hokies have had nine players record double figures in at least one of the eight games played ... One other player has scored nine points in two separate games ... Last season, Tech had eight players score in double figures at least one ... Tech has four players with at least 20 points in a game and **Justin Bibbs** scored 30 points in the win over Washington.

Buzz Williams

Buzz Williams is 61-49 in his fourth year as the Hokies' head coach and an overall record of 214-135 record in 10-plus seasons as a collegiate head coach ... He won his 200th career game last season against Boston College on Jan. 29 in Cassell Coliseum.

It has Happened So Far This Season

Justin Bibbs made his 400th career field goal in the win over Morehead State and reached the 200 made three-point field goal plateau in the win over lowa ... Ahmed Hill scored his 800th career point and Chris Clarke scored his 500th career point in the win over lowa ... Kerry Blackshear Jr., grabbed his 200th career rebounds and scored his 300th career point in the win over lowa ... Justin Robinson reached the 2,000 minutes played for his career plateau in the win over lowa and the 300 assists plateau in the overtime win at Ole Miss.

Selling Out

So far this season, the Hokies have sold out the season opener against Detroit Mercy and again against The Citadel.

Making Points About Points

Virginia Tech defeated Detroit Mercy, 111-79, in the season opener this season ... That is the most points for the Hokies since defeating The Citadel, 113-71, on Dec. 17 of last season ... The 111 points is the most in a season-opener for the Hokies since Tech defeated Johns Hopkins, 116-64 in the 1981-82 season opener in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech followed that with a 132-93 win over The Citadel ... The 132 points is the most points for a Virginia Tech team in a non-overtime game and is the second-highest point total of all time.

More Points About Points

Virginia Tech defeated The Citadel 132-93 ... Tech scored 66 points in each half ... The 66 points is the most points for Tech in a have since last Dec. 16, when Tech set a school-record with 73 second half points against The Citadel.

Sprucing Up the Place

Last May, the Hokies removed about 4,000 seats in the lower bowl



of Cassell Coliseum and replaced them with about 3,400 new, cushioned, wider seats with cup holders ... With the new seats, capacity in Cassell Coliseum is now 9,275 ... Another new feature fans see is a newly re-designed playing court ... The new word marks are encorporated along with images of the War Memorial, Torgersen Bridge and Burruss Hall ... The name of the arena has also changed, as we are now known as "Carilion Clinic Court at Cassell Coliseum", reflecting the tremendous committment of resources by Carilion Clinic, not only to Virginia Tech Men's Basketball, but to Virginia Tech as a whole.

Even More Points About Points

The Hokies scored at least 111 points in back-to-back games to open this season ... That marks the second time in school history that the Hokies have accomplished that feat ... Tech defeated St. Bonaventure, 115-74, in Roanoke on Jan. 3, 1976 and Birmingham Southern, 112-67, in Cassell on Jan. 5, 1976.

Plenty of Points

In the Hokies' win over Washington, **Justin Bibbs** scored 30 points, **Ahmed Hill** scored 23 points and **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** scored 20 points ... That is the first time that a Hokie scored 30 points and two teammates scored at least 20 points in a game since March 18, 2009, when A.D. Vassallo scored 33 points, Jeff Allen had 23 points, J.T. Thompson had 21 points and Malcolm Delaney scored 20 points against Duquesne in the first round of the 2009 NIT.

582 in the Cassell

The Hokies have a 582-190 overall record in Cassell Coliseum, for a .754 winning percentage ... The win over Florida State in 2011 was the 500th victory in the building ... Tech has had just one break-even home season and two losing seasons ... Tech is 6-0 in Cassell Coliseum this season.

Nearing Assist Marks

Devin Wilson needs just three assists to pass Zabian Dowdell into sixth place in career assists at Virginia Tech ... **Justin Robinson** needs just 16 assists to enter the career assists top 10 at Virginia Tech.

Outlaw set a Virginia Tech record when he made eight three-pointers in the home win over No. 25 Miami on Feb. 27 ... Outlaw is on track to graduate with a degree in sociology in May.

475 and Counting

Tech has now hit a three-point field goal in 475 consecutive games, the most in school history ... The Hokies have hit a three-pointer in every game since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season ... Buzz Williams has proven that hard work, determination and an eye for details are key aspects in building an elite-level collegiate basketball program. The head coach of the men's squad begins his fourth season in Blacksburg, and he has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

Though his program has earned growing acclaim nationally, Williams does not focus on such external praise. He wakes up every morning with a sense of purpose to make the Hokies the best that they can be.

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Beginning his 11th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 214-135. Williams has compiled a 61-49 record in his fourth season in Blacksburg.

The Hokies are coming off their most successful season in the last decade. Tech finished the season 22-11 overall and earned their first NCAA Tournament bid since 2007. Tech was 10-8 in the ACC regular season for the second consecutive

season. The Hokies claimed three top 25 victories against ACC foes and finished with an impressive 11-1 in non-conference regular season action.

Williams led the Hokies through many of the usual obstacles that beset college basketball programs each season. Injuries were one such obstacle, but the Hokies weathered the injuries and continued to achieve. Towards the end of the season, with just a handful of healthy bodies, Tech thrived and earned its atlarge NCAA Tournament berth through its efforts.

In his second season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an

identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

"The continued growth of our basketball program under Buzz Williams has been dramatic and noticeable on a national level," Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock said. "With the daily mantra of 'Get Better', this program has accomplished so much in his three seasons in Blacksburg. Buzz recruits and develops responsible, respectful student athletes who achieve and are successful on the court and in our community. Our future is very bright under Buzz's leadership"

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. While he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more focused on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional

finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. During Williams' tenure, six Marquette players made it to the NBA.

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 21 seasons, and 2017-18 was will mark his 11th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07. His roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. **UNO** claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoop-Online.com.

Prior to UNO,

Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in

25 years in 2005-06. The previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, where he served as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple have two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
