HOKIE NOTES

About Today's Game

The Hokies enter the game 13-4 overall and 2-2 in ACC action ... The Cardinals are 12-4 overall and 2-1 in conference play.

Last Time Out: VT 83, WFU 75

The Hokies jumped put to a big early lead and never trailed, defeating Wake Forest, 83-75, in Winston-Salem on Wednesday night ... The Hokies took a 45-30 lead into intermission and led by as many as 17 points in the second half ... **Ahmed Hill** scored 21 points to lead five Hokies in double figures ... **Justin Bibbs** added 18 points and **Chris Clarke** came off the bench with 14 points and six rebounds ... Tech shot 50.9 percent from the floor, including 42.9 percent from three-point range ... The Hokies assisted on 20 of their 29 made shots.

The Hokies vs. Louisville

Tech is 8-31 all-time against the Cardinals, in a series that began in 1979, when the Hokies joined the Metro Conference ... Tech is 3-16 against Louisville in road games and 0-2 in games in the KFC Yum Center ... Louisville has won the last 12 meetings and all three ACC meetings ... Tech is 0-3 against Louisville under **Buzz Williams**.

Bibbs a Demon vs. Wake

Following Wednesday night's win at Wake Forest, **Justin Bibbs** has played seven career games against the Demon Deacons ... In those games, Bibbs has scored in double figures in six of the contests and started all but one of the games ... For his career, he is averaging 16.6 points per game and is shooting 53.2 percent from the floor, including 42.1 percent from three-point range ... Take away the two ACC Tournament games and Bibbs averages 18.4 points per game against the Deacs.

Sharing is Good

In the win over The Citadel, the Hokies recorded 36 assists ... That set a new school record for assists in a game, breaking the old mark of 31, set against South Carolina State on Dec. 18, 1982 In the win over Washington, the Hokies assisted on 23 of their 30 made baskets, good for 76.7 percent ... For the season, Tech has 303 assists on 501 made field goals, for 60.5 percent ... Tech has nine players with at least double figures in assists this season ... Including the win at Wake Forest, Tech has eight games this season of 20-or-more assists ... Tech is averaging 17.8 assists per game, up from 15.1 assists per game last season.

KJ Comes Through

In the Hokies' 81-67 win over Pittsburgh, redshirt sophomore **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, posted his best game as a Hokie, scoring a career-high 31 points to lead Tech ... It is his fourth game of 20-or-more points this season and first-ever of 30 or more points ... The 31 points is the first time a Hokie has scored 30-or-more points in an ACC regular season game since **Justin Bibbs** scored 32 points in a win over Wake Forest in Cassell Coliseum on Jan. 13, 2016 ... Blackshear becomes one of just seven Hokies to score 30-or-more points in an ACC regular season game ... The seven players have accomplished the feat 15 times ... The 31 points is tied for eighth in most points by a Hokie in an ACC regular season game ... The 31 points are the most points scored by a Virginia Tech player taller than 6-7 in ACC play and the most since Coleman Collins (6-9) scored 32 points at James Madison on Jan. 2, 2006 ... The 31 points is tied for the fifth-most by an ACC player this season and second-most in an ACC game this season.

JRob is Double Good at Sharing

A major contributor to **Kerry Blackshear Jr.'s** 31 points in the win over Pitt was **Justin Robinson** ... "5" recorded a season-high 10 assists in the contest, one off his own (shared with **Devin Wilson**) school record for assists in an ACC game of 11 and two off the school overall record ... Robinson recorded 10 assists and just two turnovers in the contest and recorded his first double-double of the season and the second of his career with his 11 point, 10 assist performance.

Analytics and All

As of Jan. 12, the Hokies are ranked 46th by Kenpom.com ... Tech is second nationally in effective field goal percentage and fifth in two-point percentage ... Tech is 12th in free throw rate and length of possession, 17th in raw offensive efficiency, 23rd in three-point percentage, 28th in assist percentage, 42nd in adjusted offensive efficiency and 47th in raw defensive efficiency.

A Balancing Act

The Hokies enter today's game with five players averaging in double figures ... **Ahmed Hill** leads Tech scorers, averaging 15.2 points per game ... Tech has nine players averaging double figures in minutes played this season, with **Justin Bibbs**, at 31.5 minutes played per game the only player averaging more than 30 minutes per game.

Usually Close

Since **Buzz Williams** became the head coach at Virginia Tech, the Hokies and Wake Forest have met seven times on the hardwood ... Tech is 5-2 in those games, but the most common thread is the competitiveness of the games ... None of the seven games have been decided by double figure margins and the average score in the series is Tech's advantage of 84.4-81.7.

Threes' Points

In the Hokies' win over Maryland-Eastern Shore, Tech made 15 three-point field goals, marking the second time this season Tech has made at least 15 threes ... So far this season, Tech individual players have made at least three, threes in a game 20 times ... **Ahmed Hill** was 11-of-15 from three-point territory in the two games in Madison Square Garden in the 2K Classic ... Hill has made at least four, three-pointers in a game six times this season and **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** has made at least four, three-pointers in a game four times this season ... Tech has made at least 10 three-pointers in eight games this season.

Strong from the Line

Justin Bibbs made his first two free throws this season before missing his third attempt ... Since then, Bibbs has been 23-of-27 from the line ... He is shooting 83.3 percent from the line this season.

Seeing the Hokies

The attendance for the Hokies' game at Syracuse on Dec. 31, 2017 was 20,688, the second-largest crowd of the season to see the Hokies play (a crowd of 22,690 saw Tech and Kentucky play at Rupp Arena on Dec.16) ... The Syracuse crowd was the 12th-largest to see a regular season game involving the Hokies.

Joining the List

In the Hokies' win over Presbyterian, **Justin Robinson** led Tech with four assists ... In doing so, he passed Erick Green into 10th place on the Tech all-time assists list ... Robinson now has 354 career assists in about two and one-half seasons ... He passed Brendan Dunlap into ninth place on the list in the win over North Carolina A&T.

Hokies in National Stats

As of Jan. 12, the Hokies lead the nation in field goal percentage, are 16th in scoring margin and 18th in scoring offense and assists per game ... Tech is 23rd in three-point field goal percentage and 29th in assist/turnover ratio ... Individually, **Ahmed Hill** is eighth nationally in three-point field goal percentage and **Justin Robinson** is 33rd in assists per game.

Continuing to Climb

In the Hokies' win at Boston College last season, **Justin Bibbs** scored his 1,000th career point, becoming the 45th Hokie to reach that plateau ... He currently has 1,249 points, 29th on the list, after passing Loyd King in the win at Wake Forest.

Call It a Comeback

The Hokies defeated Ole Miss in Oxford on Dec. 2, 83-80, in overtime ... In doing so, the Hokies fought back from a 16-point second half deficit ... The 16-point comeback is the largest for Tech in a game since coming back from a 16-point deficit to defeat NC State in the first conference game of the 2015-16 season ... Tech's ACC record for largest comeback victory is 18 points, in a 91-87 overtime win over NC State on Feb. 8, 2009 in Cassell Coliseum.

Coming Next Year

Buzz Williams has announced the signings of **Jonathan Kabongo**, **Jarren McAllister** and **Landers Nolley II** to National Letters of Intent ... The trio will enroll at Virginia Tech in the fall of 2018 ... Kabonogo is a 6-4, 180 lbs., guard from Toronto, Ontario and Putnam Science Academy in Putnam, Connecticut ... McAllister is a 6-4, 185 lbs., guard from Heritage High School in Wake Forest, North Carolina ... Nolley is a 6-7, 210 lbs., shooting guard at Langston Hughes High School in Fairburn, Georgia.

Last Meeting at UofL

The Hokies lost to No. 8 Louisville, 94-90, on Feb. 18, 2017, in one of the most exciting ACC games of the season ... Tech led by one at the half after falling behind by 10 points in the first half ... In a battle of threes, Tech made a school-record 17 three-pointers and Louisville made a dozen treys ... Seth Allen led the Hokies with 25 points, making a career-high six three-pointers and **Ty Outlaw** added 19 points for Tech ... The Hokies shot 59.2 percent from the floor, including 65.4 percent from three-point range ... Tech shot 63.6 percent in the second half and made eight of 12 three-point attempts ... Tech's 90 points and 17 made threes set new KFC Yum! Center marks for visiting teams.

On This Date

The Hokies are 20-13 all-time on Jan. 13 ... Tech won its last game on this date, 93-91, over Wake Forest in Blacksburg in 2016 ... Tech is 5-7 in road games and 3-2 in ACC games on this date ... Tech is 0-2 against Louisville on Jan. 13.

Perfect from the Line

Kerry Blackshear Jr., was 11-for-11 from the free throw line in the win over Radford ... It is the ninth time in school history that a Hokie has shot at least 10 free throws in a game and made all attempted ... The record is 18-for-18 from the line by Rod Wheeler against Richmond on Dec. 28, 1990.

Selling Out

The Hokies sold out the season opener against Detroit Mercy and the game against The Citadel ... It was announced on Dec. 15 that home games against North Carolina, Duke, Florida State and Miami have all sold out ... The Louisville game is expected to join the list of sell outs.

Big Margin

The Hokies defeated Maryland-Eastern Shore, 93-40 ... The 53-point margin of victory is the largest by a **Buzz Williams**-coached Virginia Tech team, surpassing the 42-point margin of victory over The Citadel last season ... The 40 points scored by Maryland-Eastern Shore are the fewest by an opponent against Virginia Tech under Williams ... The 53-point margin is the largest for the Hokies since Jan. 2, 2011, when the Hokies defeated Mount St. Mary's, 99-34 ... That is also the last game the Hokies held an opponent to 40-or-fewer-points in a game ... The Hokies had a 54-point lead in the win over UMES, the largest since a 72-point lead in the MSM game in 2011.

Lots of Options

So far this season, the Hokies have had nine players record double figures in at least one game ... One other player has scored nine points in two separate games ... Last season, Tech had eight players score in double figures at least one ... Tech has four players with at least 20 points in a game and **Justin Bibbs** and **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, have each scored at least 30 points in a game this season.

Lots of Minutes

Hokie players are among the most experienced ACC players this season ... **Justin Bibbs** has played a total of 3,505 minutes at Virginia Tech and **Devin Wilson** has played 3,028 minutes as a Hokie, passing the 3,000 minute mark in the home loss to Virginia ... Tech has another player, **Ahmed Hill**, who has played 2,454 in just two-plus seasons at Virginia Tech ... **Justin Robinson** passed the 2,000-minute mark in the win over Iowa and **Chris Clarke** reached 1,500 minutes played during the Syracuse game.

Home is Where the Wins Are

Since **Buzz Williams** arrived in Blacksburg for the 2014-15 season, Tech is 48-17 (.738) in Cassell Coliseum and is 39-8 (.830) since the beginning of the 2015-16 season ... Tech has won 17 consecutive home non-conference games ... The nine non-conference home wins is second-best at Virginia Tech since the Hokies joined the Metro Conference in 1978 ... Tech is 10-1 in Cassell Coliseum this season.

Defense Wins

With the 63-55 win over Presbyterian, the Hokies have now won their last seven games when holding an opponent to 55-or-fewer points ... Tech is 8-1 under **Buzz Williams** in such games.

Less Than a Third

The Hokies held Iowa to just 33.3 percent from the field on Nov. 28 ... It is the lowest field goal percentage for a Power 5 team against Tech since Nov. 27 of last year, when the Hokies held Nebraska to 29.8 percent in the Wooden Legacy in Anaheim, California ... Tech held the Cornhuskers to 19.0 percent from three-point range that game.

Not Marginal at All

The 24-point winning margin against Iowa in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge marked the second time in as many games this season that Tech defeated a Power 5 conference opponent by 24 points ... Tech downed Washington, 103-79 in Madison Square Garden earlier in November ... The 24-point margin of victory is the largest ever for Tech in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.

Sy Returns

Khadim Sy has returned to the Virginia Tech men's basketball program ... The sophomore post player from Dakar, Senegal will practice with the team this semester, but will redshirt the 2017-18 season ... He will have three years of eligibility available beginning the Fall 2018.

Plenty of Points

In the Hokies' win over Washington, **Justin Bibbs** scored 30 points, **Ahmed Hill** scored 23 points and **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** scored 20 points ... That is the first time that a Hokie scored 30 points and two teammates scored at least 20 points in a game since March 18, 2009, when A.D. Vassallo scored 33 points, Jeff Allen had 23 points, J.T. Thompson had 21 points and Malcolm Delaney scored 20 points against Duquesne in the 2009 NIT.

586 in the Cassell

The Hokies have a 586-191 overall record in Cassell Coliseum, for a .754 winning percentage ... The win over Florida State in 2011 was the 500th victory in the building ... Tech has had just one break-even home season and two losing seasons ... Tech is 10-1 in Cassell Coliseum this season.

Working Overtime

The 83-80 overtime win at Ole Miss on Dec. 2 was Tech's first overtime game of the season ... This was the Hokies' first overtime game since defeating No. 12 Virginia, 80-78, in double overtime on Feb. 12, 2017 ... Tech is now 66-49 overall in overtime games and 6-3 in overtime games under **Buzz Williams** ... Tech is 30-11 in home overtime games and 16-8 in overtime in ACC games ... Tech is 28-25 in road overtime games ... The Ole Miss victory was Tech's first over an SEC school in an overtime game (Tech is now 1-2 against SEC schools in overtime).

It has Happened This Season

Justin Bibbs made his 400th career field goal in the win over Morehead State, reached the 200 made three-point field goal plateau in the win over Iowa and scored his 1,200th career point in the win over Presbyterian ... **Ahmed Hill** scored his 900th career point in the win over Pitt and **Chris Clarke** scored his 500th career point in the win over Iowa ... Clarke reached the 1,500 minutes played mark at Syracuse ... **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, grabbed his 250th career rebounds and scored his 400th career point against Virginia ... **Justin Robinson** reached the 2,000 minutes played for his career plateau in the win over Iowa and the 300 assists plateau in the overtime win at Ole Miss ... **Devin Wilson** passed Zabian Dowdell into sixth place in career assists at Tech in the win over UMES and played his 3,000th minute at Tech in the loss to Virginia.

Outlaw to Miss Season, but Get Degree

Redshirt senior wing **Ty Outlaw** will miss the 2017-18 season following surgery for a torn ACL in his right knee ... He suffered the injury in July ... Outlaw set a Virginia Tech record when he made eight three-pointers in the home win over No. 25 Miami on Feb. 27 ... Outlaw finished his degree requirements at the end of the Fall 2017 semester and will walk at graduation in the spring.

That Was a Big Week

The Hokies defeated Ole Miss of the SEC 83-80, in overtime on Dec. 2 after defeating Iowa of the Big Ten, 79-55, on Nov. 28 in Blacksburg ... Buzz Williams

Buzz Williams is 66-52 in his fourth year as the Hokies' head coach and an overall record of 219-138 record in 10-plus seasons as a collegiate head coach ... He won his 200th career game last season against Boston College on Jan. 29 in Cassell Coliseum.

Buzz Williams has proven that hard work, determination and an eye for details are key aspects in building an elite-level collegiate basketball program. The head coach of the men's squad begins his fourth season in Blacksburg, and he has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

Though his program has earned growing acclaim nationally, Williams does not focus on such external praise. He wakes up every morning with a sense of purpose to make the Hokies the best that they can be.

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Beginning his 11th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 219-138. Williams has compiled a 66-52 record in his fourth season in Blacksburg.

The Hokies are coming off their most successful season in the last decade. Tech finished the season 22-11 overall and earned their first NCAA Tournament bid since 2007. Tech was 10-8 in the ACC regular season for the second consecutive

season. The Hokies claimed three top 25 victories against ACC foes and finished with an impressive 11-1 in non-conference regular season action.

Williams led the Hokies through many of the usual obstacles that beset college basketball programs each season. Injuries were one such obstacle, but the Hokies weathered the injuries and continued to achieve. Towards the end of the season, with just a handful of healthy bodies, Tech thrived and earned its at-large NCAA Tournament berth through its efforts.

In his second season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an

identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

"The continued growth of our basketball program under Buzz Williams has been dramatic and noticeable on a national level," Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock said. "With the daily mantra of 'Get Better', this program has accomplished so much in his three seasons in Blacksburg. Buzz recruits and develops responsible, respectful student athletes who achieve and are successful on the court and in our community. Our future is very bright under Buzz's leadership"

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. While he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more focused on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional

Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in

25 years in 2005-06. The previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, where he served as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple have two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.

finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. During Williams' tenure, six Marquette players made it to the NBA.

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 21 seasons, and 2017-18 will mark his 11th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07. His roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference
