## HOKIE NOTES

### About Tonight's Game

The Hokies enter the game 17-7 overall and 6-5 in ACC action ... The Cavaliers are 23-1 overall and 12-0 in conference play ... UVa is ranked second in both major polls ... Tonight's game is part of the Commonwealth Clash, sponsored by Virginia529.

### Last Time Out: VT 85, NC State 75

The Hokies picked up a big home win, 85-75, over NC State on Wednesday night ... **Justin Robinson** scored a career-high 32 points to lead the Hokies ... **Kerry Blackshear Jr.** added 18 points and **Justin Bibbs** scored 11 points ... The Hokies shot an ACC-high 63.5 percent from the floor, despite shooting just 3-10 from three-point range ... Tech outscored the much-taller Wolfpack 56-30 in the paint and scored 23 points off of 15 NCSU turnovers.

### The Hokies vs. Virginia

Tech is 55-91 all-time against the Cavaliers and 13-37 all-time against UVa in road games... UVa won the earlier meeting this season, 78-52 in Cassell Coliseum on Jan. 3 ... The teams split the two meetings in each of the last two seasons ... Tech is 10-17 in ACC regular season games ... Tech is 2-5 against the Cavaliers under **Buzz Williams**.

### Big Night for "5"

**Justin Robinson** recorded a new career-high of 32 points in the Hokies' win over NC State on Wednesday night ... Robinson's previous high was 26 points, set against Florida State on Jan. 20, one game after he had set a personal best of 23 points at Louisville ... In the win over NC State, Robinson also set new career-highs in field goals made (11), field goals attempted (17) and free throws attempted (14) ... His 32 points are the most scored by a Hokie since teammate **Justin Bibbs** scored 32 points vs. Wake Forest on Jan. 13, 2016 ... The last time a Hokie scored more than 32 points in an ACC game was on Jan. 24, 2013, when Erick Green scored 35 points vs. Virginia ... Robinson's 32 points is tied for the fifth-most in an ACC game for a Hokie.

### Hot Hokies

In the win over NC State, the Hokies shot a blistering 63.5 percent from the floor, despite making just three of 10 three-point attempts ... The 63.5 percent is the highest in an ACC game this season ... It is the third-highest percentage of the season for Tech ... Tech has shot 60 percent-or-better five times this season.

### A Giving "5"

#### Justin Robinson

tied a school record and established a new Virginia Tech ACC game mark with his career-high 12 assists in the win at Boston College ... He joins Dave Sensibaugh, Bimbo Coles and Troy Manns with 12

assists in a game and broke the ACC game record of 11 he previously held, along with teammate **Devin Wilson** ... In league play, Robinson leads the ACC in assists and is fourth in assist/turnover ratio ... Robinson is seventh in career assists at Virginia Tech ... He currently has 392 career assists.

### Hot in 2018

**Justin Robinson** has begun the New Year on a bit of a hot streak ... In the 10 games played in 2018, Robinson is averaging 18.0 points per game ... He has 57 assists in the new year ... He recorded his first double-double of the season and with 11 points and 10 assists against Pitt and has scored in double figures in all nine games ... He set new career highs in points, in the Louisville (23 points), Florida State (26 points) and NC State (32 points) games ... He had a career-high 12 assists in the win at Boston College.

### Continuing to Climb

In the Hokies' win at Boston College last season, **Justin Bibbs** scored his 1,000th career point, becoming the 45th Hokie to reach that plateau ... He currently has 1,350 points, 21st on the list, after passing Carlos Dixon in the win over NC State.

### More About the Tech-UVa Series

This is the Hokies most-played rivalry ... The series dates back to Feb. 20, 1915, when the Cavaliers defeated Tech, 39-21, in Charlottesville ... Along with Blacksburg and Charlottesville, the series has also been played in Roanoke, Lynchburg, Richmond, Salem, Hampton, Norfolk and Greensboro, North Carolina (the 2006 ACC Tournament) ... After many years of neutral site games, the series returned to each campus, beginning in the 2000-01 season, the year Tech joined the Big East Conference ... This has been a home-and-home series since Tech joined the ACC in the 2004-05 season.

### More About the Commonwealth Clash

The Hokies won last year's Commonwealth Clash ... The clash tied, 11-11, but Tech won the tie-breaker by winning four ACC team titles ... Tech leads this season, 4-2 ... This season's two men's basketball games will count towards half a point each ... The Commonwealth Clash is sponsored by Virginia529, The Official College Savings Plan of Virginia Tech.

### Good Day for the Frosh

In the Hokies loss to Miami, the three-man true freshman class had a solid outing ... **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** scored 15 points, making 3-5 from three-point range ... **Wabissa Bede** scored five points in seven minutes of action ... **P.J. Horne** had his most impressive outing of the conference schedule to date ... He played a career-high 23 minutes, scoring eight points and grabbing a team-high seven rebounds ... Combined, the trio were 10-of-18 from the field, including 4-of-8 from three-point range.

### Doubling Up

**Chris Clarke** recorded his third double-double of the year and his ninth career double-double with 12 points and 14 rebounds in the win at Notre Dame ... His three double-doubles this season have all come from off the bench, best in the ACC this season ... Clarke's nine career double-doubles are tops among current Hokies ... Clarke recorded the Hokies' first-ever triple-double last season against The Citadel.

### On the Boards with CC

**Chris Clarke's** 14 rebounds at Notre Dame are the most in an ACC game for a Hokie this season and the most in an ACC regular season game for a Hokie since Marshall Wood grabbed 16 boards at NC State on Feb. 16, 2013 ... Zach LeDay had 15 rebounds against Wake Forest in last year's ACC Tournament ... The school record for rebounds in an ACC game is 19 by Jeff Allen at Boston College on Feb. 5, 2011.

### Sharing is Good

In the win over The Citadel, the Hokies recorded 36 assists, which set a new school record for assists in a game, breaking the old mark of 31 against South Carolina State on Dec. 18, 1982 ... In the win over Washington, the Hokies assisted on 23 of their 30 made baskets, good for 76.7 percent ... Tech is averaging 17.2 assists per game, up from 15.1 assists per game last season.

### A Very Good Month

With the win at Boston College, the Hokies finished the month of January 2018 with a 5-3 record, all against ACC opponents ... The five wins ties 2007 for the most ACC wins Tech has ever recorded in January ... Three of the five wins were road wins, the same number as January 2007 ... The three road wins equals the total number of ACC road wins from each of the last two seasons.

### Analytics and All

As of Feb. 9, the Hokies are ranked 42nd by Kenpom.com ... Tech is third nationally in effective field goal percentage and fifth nationally in two-point percentage ... Tech is 14th in length of possession, 16th in raw offensive efficiency, 23rd in three-point percentage and 23rd in adjusted offensive efficiency.

### It Was a BIG Night and Week

The win over the defending national champion North Carolina Tar Heels on Jan. 22 was the first of two ESPN "Big Monday" games this season for the Hokies ... The Duke game on Feb. 26 is also a Big Monday contest ... Monday's game marked the first time that the Hokies have been featured on Big Monday, either in the Big East or ACC.

### Threes' Points

In the Hokies' win over Maryland-Eastern Shore, Tech made 15 three-point field goals, marking the second time this season Tech has made at least 15 threes ... So far this season, Tech individual players have made at least three, threes in a game 29 times ... **Ahmed Hill** was 11-of-15 from three-point territory in the two games in Madison Square Garden in the 2K Classic ... Hill has made at least four, three-pointers in a game six times this season and **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** has made at least four, three-pointers in a game five times this season ... Tech has made at least 10 three-pointers in 12 games this season.

### BIG Notes

The win over the 10th ranked Tar Heels was the Hokies' first win over a top 10 team since defeating No. 5 Duke, 89-75, in Cassell Coliseum on Dec. 31, 2016 ... This was the Hokies' first win over a defending national champion since defeating No. 1 Duke, 64-60, in Cassell Coliseum on Feb. 26, 2011 ... The 11-point margin of victory was Tech's largest against the Tar Heels since a 62-48 win over UNC on Dec. 5, 1949 in War Memorial Hall.

McAllister is a 6-4, 185 lbs., guard from Heritage High School in Wake Forest, North Carolina ... Nolley is a 6-7, 210 lbs., shooting guard at Langston Hughes High School in Fairburn, Georgia.

### ACC Notes

**Nickeil Alexander-Walker** is sixth among ACC freshmen, averaging 11.4 points per game ... **Chris Clarke's** three double-doubles off the bench this year is best among ACC players ... **Kerry Blackshear Jr.** is one of four ACC players this season to make every free throw in a game in which he has attempted at least 10 free throws ... Tech's 132 points against The Citadel are the most by an ACC team this season ... Tech's 68.6 percent field goal percentage in that game is best in the ACC this year.

### SNAP!

In the Hokies' wins over No. 10 North Carolina and Notre Dame, Tech snapped a pair of seven-game losing streaks ... Snapping the Notre Dame streak was extremely significant, as it was Tech's first win ever at Notre Dame and the first regular season win over the Irish ... Tech's only other win against Notre Dame was on March 25, 1973, as the Hokies downed the Irish, 92-91 in overtime to claim the 1973 NIT Championship.

### Hokies in National Stats

As of Feb. 9, the Hokies are third in the nation in field goal percentage, tied for 17th in assists per game, 17th in scoring offense and 25th in three-point field goal percentage and assist/turnover ratio and 28th in scoring margin ... **Justin Robinson** is 30th in assists and 37th in assists per game.

### KJ Comes Through

In the Hokies' 81-67 win over Pittsburgh, **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, posted his best game as a Hokie, scoring a career-high 31 points ... The 31 points marks the first time a Hokie has scored 30-or-more points in an ACC regular

season game since **Justin Bibbs** scored 32 points in a win over Wake Forest on Jan. 13, 2016 ... Blackshear becomes one of just seven Hokies to score 30-or-more points in an ACC regular season game ... The 31 points is tied for eighth in most points by a Hokie in an ACC regular season game ... The 31 points are the most points scored by a Virginia Tech player taller than 6-7 in ACC play and the most since Coleman Collins (6-9) scored 32 points at James Madison on Jan. 2, 2006.

### It has Happened This Season

**Justin Bibbs** made his 400th career field goal in the win over Morehead State, reaching the 200 made three-point field goal plateau in the win over Iowa and scored his 1,300th career point in the win at Notre Dame ...

**Ahmed Hill** scored his 900th career point in the win over Pitt and **Chris Clarke** scored his 500th career point in the win over Iowa ... **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, grabbed his 250th career rebound and scored his 400th career point against Virginia ... **Justin Robinson** reached the 300 assists plateau in the overtime win at Ole Miss and the 900 career points mark in the win over NC State.

### Pointing This Out

Twenty-four games into the 2017-18 season, the Hokies are averaging 84.7 points per game ... Last season, Tech averaged 79.1 points per game ... The 84.7 ppg would be the Hokies' highest average since the 1988-89 season, when Tech averaged 87.1 points per game ... The season before, the 1987-88 season, the Hokies set a school record, averaging 91.2 points per game.

### A Balancing Act

The Hokies enter tonight's game with five players averaging in double figures ... Four of the five average between 13.8 points and 13.3 points per game ... Tech has eight players averaging double figures in minutes played this season, with Bibbs at 32.6 minutes and **Justin Robinson** at 30.7 minutes played per game the only players averaging more than 30 minutes per game.

### Lots of Options

So far this season, the Hokies have had nine players record double figures in at least one game ... One other player has scored nine points in two separate games ... Last season, Tech had eight players score in double figures at least one ... Six different Hokies have led the team in scoring so far this season ... Tech has five players with at least 20 points in a game and **Justin Bibbs**, **Justin Robinson** and **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, have each scored at least 30 points in a game this season.

### Selling Out

Virginia Tech has sold out eight games this season, six in ACC play ... A very limited number of tickets remain for the Clemson game on Feb. 21 ... This year's ACC sell outs have been the North Carolina, Florida State, Miami and NC State games, with Louisville and Duke also sold out, still to come.

### Call It a Comeback

The Hokies defeated Ole Miss in Oxford on Dec. 2, 83-80, in overtime ... In doing so, the Hokies fought back from a 16-point second half deficit ... The 16-point comeback is the largest for Tech in a game since coming back from a 16-point deficit to defeat NC State in the first conference game of the 2015-16 season ... Tech's ACC record for largest comeback victory is 18 points, in a 91-87 overtime win over NC State on Feb. 8, 2009 in Cassell Coliseum.

### Lots of Minutes

Hokie players are among the most experienced in the ACC ... **Justin Bibbs** has played a total of 3,750 minutes and **Devin Wilson** has played 3,114 minutes ... Tech has another player, **Ahmed Hill**, who has played 2,653 at Virginia Tech, eclipsing the 2,500 minute mark against Florida State ... **Justin Robinson** passed the 2,500-minute mark in the win at Boston College.

### Home is Where the Wins Are

Since **Buzz Williams** arrived in Blacksburg for the 2014-15 season, Tech is 50-19 (.725) in Cassell Coliseum and is 41-10 (.804) since the beginning of the 2015-16 season ... Tech has won 17 consecutive home non-conference games ... The nine non-conference home wins is second-best at Virginia Tech since the Hokies joined the Metro Conference in 1978.

### Working Overtime

The 85-80 overtime win at Boston College was Tech's second overtime game of the season ... Tech is now 67-49 overall in overtime games and 7-3 in overtime games under **Buzz Williams** ... Tech is 30-11 in home overtime games and 17-8 in overtime in ACC games ... Tech is 28-25 in road overtime games.

### 490 and Counting

Tech has now hit a three-point field goal in 490 consecutive games ... Since the three-point arc was added for the 1986-87 season, the Hokies have hit at least one three in all but three games ... The last time Tech did not record a three-point field goal in a game was at Providence on Feb. 1, 2003.

### That, Too, Was a Big Week

The Hokies defeated Ole Miss of the SEC 83-80, in overtime on Dec. 2 after defeating Iowa of the Big Ten, 79-55, on Nov. 28 in Blacksburg ... That marked the first time since the 2012-13 season that Tech played back-to-back games against Power 5 competition in less than a calendar week, not part of an exempt tournament ... In that season, the Hokies defeated Iowa, 95-79, in Cassell Coliseum on Nov. 27 and followed that with an 81-71 home win over No. 15 Oklahoma State ... Tech finished the 2017-18 non-conference schedule with three wins against Power 5 competition.

## MEN'S BASKETBALL



Buzz Williams has proven that hard work, determination and an eye for details are key aspects in building an elite-level collegiate basketball program. The head coach of the men's squad begins his fourth season in Blacksburg, and he has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

Though his program has earned growing acclaim nationally, Williams does not focus on such external praise. He wakes up every morning with a sense of purpose to make the Hokies the best that they can be.

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Beginning his 11th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 223-141. Williams has compiled a 70-55 record in his fourth season in Blacksburg.

The Hokies are coming off their most successful season in the last decade. Tech finished the season 22-11 overall and earned their first NCAA Tournament bid since 2007. Tech was 10-8 in the ACC regular season for the second consecutive

season. The Hokies claimed three top 25 victories against ACC foes and finished with an impressive 11-1 in non-conference regular season action.

Williams led the Hokies through many of the usual obstacles that beset college basketball programs each season. Injuries were one such obstacle, but the Hokies weathered the injuries and continued to achieve. Towards the end of the season, with just a handful of healthy bodies, Tech thrived and earned its at-large NCAA Tournament berth through its efforts.

In his second season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an

identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

"The continued growth of our basketball program under Buzz Williams has been dramatic and noticeable on a national level," Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock said. "With the daily mantra of 'Get Better', this program has accomplished so much in his three seasons in Blacksburg. Buzz recruits and develops responsible, respectful student athletes who achieve and are successful on the court and in our community. Our future is very bright under Buzz's leadership"

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. While he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more focused on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional

Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in

25 years in 2005-06. The previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, where he served as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple have two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.

finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. During Williams' tenure, six Marquette players made it to the NBA.

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 21 seasons, and 2017-18 will mark his 11th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07. His roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference
