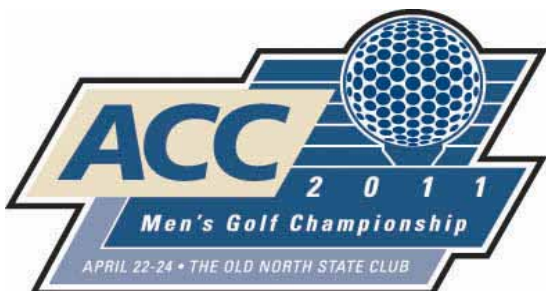

HOKIE NOTES



Entering the ACC Golf Championship

This weekend will mark Virginia Tech's seventh appearance at the ACC Golf Championship ... The Hokies officially joined the ACC on July 1, 2004.

The Hokies this Spring

Virginia Tech has finished in the top five of three of the four tournaments this spring ... Tech's best finish was a second place at the Pinehurst Intercollegiate ... The Hokies' best individual finish this season was a 4th place finish at the Puerto Rico Classic by **Marshall Bailey**.

Five of the Best

The five Hokies competing in the ACC Tournament are all among the top nine all-time scorers at Virginia Tech ... Sophomore **Mikey Moyers** leads the current players in second place, with a 72.88, trailing only Brendon de Jonge ... Senior **Marshall Bailey** is fourth on the all-time list with a 73.24 career stroke average senior **Garland Green** is seventh in career scoring at 73.97, freshman **Bryce Chalkey** is eighth at 74.00 and junior **Blake Redmond** is ninth at 74.06 ... Associate head coach **Brian Sharp** is 10th on the list at 74.14.

Former Hokies on the PGA Tour

A pair of former Hokies are currently competing on the PGA Tour ... Former Hokie Johnson Wagner won his first-ever PGA Tour event at the Houston Shell Open in 2008, earning him a berth the next week at the 2008 Masters Tournament ... He won earlier this season at the Mayakoba Golf Classic in El Camaleon, Riviera Maya, Mexico on the PGA Tour ... Former teammate Brendon de Jonge was the 2008 Nationwide Tour Player of the Year ... He finished second on the money list and won the Xerox Classic in Rochester, N.Y. ... His second-place finish on the Nationwide money list earned him a return to the PGA Tour in 2009; he advanced out of qualifying school to earn his card last season and finished 34th on the money list last year to earn his card for this season ... He also played on the PGA Tour in 2007.

ACC Experience Here

Four Virginia Tech golfers competing this weekend, seniors **Marshall Bailey**, and **Garland Green** along with junior **Blake Redmond** and sophomore **Mikey Moyers**, have played in a previous ACC Golf Championship ... Only freshman **Bryce Chalkey** is making his first appearance in the event ... Bailey tied for sixth place last season.

New Faces Next Year

During the early signing period in November, Virginia Tech announced that Trevor Cone (Concord, N.C.), Miles Curley (Rock Hill, S.C.) and Scott Vincent (Harare, Zimbabwe) have signed national letters of intent to attend Virginia Tech and play golf for the Hokies in Fall 2011.

A Course to Dye For

Virginia Tech's commitment to golf became more evident six years ago, when it was announced that famed golf course architect Pete Dye would lead the renovation of the River Course of Virginia Tech ... The project, which began on Jan. 5, 2004, was completed in 2006 ... A new \$5.5 million clubhouse was completed in 2010 ... Once completed, the course became a Pete Dye Signature Course and has been rechristened as the Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech ... In addition to the upgraded course, a team facility boasts an indoor teaching center, locker room and team meeting room for the Virginia Tech golf team ... These improvements were made possible by support from Bill and Alice Goodwin of Richmond, Va. ... The gift covered all costs of design and construction ... As part of the project, Tech's artificial practice tee was covered and equipped with radiant heaters ... The indoor facility was constructed adjacent to the newly-dedicated golf team practice area, which was made possible through the generosity of long-time golf team supporter and scholarship donor C.M. "Buddy" Neviasser ... This facility provides Tech players with one of the finest total practice complexes in the nation.

We Like this Conference

Although Virginia Tech has only been an ACC member for less than seven years, the school's athletic program has already made quite a splash in the league ... The Hokie football team won the 2004 ACC Championship and played in the inaugural ACC Football Championship game after winning the Coastal Division title, winning the conference title in 2007, 2008 and 2010 ... Men's basketball coach **Seth Greenberg** was the 2005 and 2008 ACC Coach of the Year, the same award that football coach **Frank Beamer** has won twice ... The men's soccer team advanced to the College Cup in 2007 and the softball team appeared in NCAA Women's College World Series in 2008 ... Individually, Tech's **Spyridon Jullien** won three NCAA throwing championships ... **Queen Harrison** appeared in the 2008 Olympics in Beijing and won the 60-meter hurdle championship at the 2010 NCAA Indoor Championship and became the first woman ever to win both the 400m and 100m hurdle titles at the 2010 NCAA Outdoor Championship.

A Good Host

Virginia Tech will host the 2011 NCAA East Regional Golf Championship at the Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech ... The event will be played May 19-21 ... This will be the first NCAA event hosted on the course ... Tech hosted the 1997 NCAA East Regional and the 2004 NCAA Division I Men's Golf Championship at the Homestead Resort in Hot Springs, Va.

The Rest of the Roster

Of the three players on the Hokie roster not competing this weekend, two, senior **Aaron Eckstein** and redshirt freshman **Marc MacDonald**, have played this season ... Eckstein is out with an injury to his left arm ... Sophomore **Jacob Everts** is redshirting this season.

What is a Hokie?

The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute. With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body.

Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Hokie" yell, which is still used today. Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the word was solely the product of his imagination and was used only as an attention-getter for his yell. It soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

ACC Golf Odds & Ends

Georgia Tech is the two-time defending champion ... Chesson Hadley of Georgia Tech was the 2010 medalist ... Wake Forest won the first ACC Golf Championship in 1954 ... Florida State claimed its first ACC Championship in 2008... Virginia Tech and Georgia Tech tied for the 2007 championship, marking the second-consecutive year that the ACC produced co-champions - the 2006 championship tie was represented by North Carolina and Georgia Tech ... 2007 was Virginia Tech's first ACC Men's Golf Championship title ... Boston College will be competing in its sixth golf championship as an ACC member... Wake Forest boasts the most league titles with 18... In the first ACC Championship held in 1954 at Old Town Club in Winston-Salem, Duke earned team honors while Arnold Palmer captured individual honors.

The Head Hokie

Jay Hardwick is in his 28th season as the head coach of Virginia Tech Golf ... Hardwick is a 1971 graduate of Virginia Tech ... Hardwick is also the Director of Golf at Virginia Tech and oversaw the incorporation of the University's new course, The Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech, into the Virginia Tech operation, as well as the construction of team facilities at the course ... Hardwick was inducted into the GCAA's Hall of Fame in 2008 and was the inaugural winner in 2005 of the Labron Harris Jr. Award, given by the PGA of America ... With the Hokies' 2007 ACC Golf Championship, Hardwick became the first coach in NCAA history to win four different conference titles at the same school ...
