HOKIE NOTES



Entering the ACC Golf Championship

This weekend will mark Virginia Tech's eighth appearance at the ACC Golf Championship ... The Hokies officially joined the ACC on July 1, 2004.

The Hokies this Season

Virginia Tech has finished in the top 10 in nine of the 10 tournaments this season ... Tech's best finish was second place at the Furman Intercollegiate ... The Hokies' best individual finish this season are a pair for third-place finishes; **Mikey Moyers** at the Northern Intercollegiate and **Trevor Cone** at the Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate at Blackthorn Club.

A New Leader

The five Hokies competing in the ACC Tournament are all among the top nine all-time scorers at Virginia Tech, including a new name at the top of the list ... Freshman **Trevor Cone** has supplanted Brendon de Jonge in the top spot of the career scoring list, with a 72.52 stroke average ... Junior **Mikey Moyers** is now in fifth place, with a 73.36 and freshman Scott Vincent is seventh at 73.72 ... Senior **Blake Redmond** is ninth at 74.01 and sophomore **Bryce Chalkey** is 11th at 74.08 and ... Associate head coach **Brian Sharp** is 12th on the list at 74.15.

Hokies on the PGA Tour

A pair of Hokies are currently competing on the PGA Tour ... Johnson Wagner won his first-ever PGA Tour event at the Houston Shell Open in 2008, earning him a berth the next week at the 2008 Masters Tournament ... He won last season at the Mayakoba Golf Classic in El Camaleon, Riviera Maya, Mexico on the PGA Tour and won the Sony Open in Hawaii this January, which helped him to claim PGA Tour Player of the Month for January ... Former teammate Brendon de Jonge was the 2008 Nationwide Tour Player of the Year ... He finished second on the money list and won the Xerox Classic in Rochester, N.Y. ... His second-place finish on the Nationwide money list earned him a return to the PGA Tour in 2009; he advanced out of qualifying school to earn his card last season and finished 34th on the money list in 2010 to earn his card for last season ... He also played on the PGA Tour in 2007.

ACC Experience Here

Three Virginia Tech golfers competing this weekend, senior **Blake Redmond**, junior **Mikey Moyers** and sophomore **Bryce Chalkey** have played in a previous ACC Golf Championship ... **Trevor Cone** and **Scott Vincent** are making their first appearance in the ACC Championship ... Redmond tied for 13th place last season.

New Face Next Year

During the early signing period in November, Virginia Tech announced that Malcain Huger (Lovettsville, Va.) has signed a national letter of intent to attend Virginia Tech and play golf for the Hokies in Fall 2012.

A Course to Dye For

Virginia Tech's commitment to golf became more evident six years ago, when it was announced that famed golf course architect Pete Dye would lead the renovation of the River Course of Virginia Tech ... The project, which began on Jan. 5, 2004, was completed in 2006 ... A new \$5.5 million clubhouse was completed in 2010 ... Once completed, the course became a Pete Dye Signature Course and has been rechristened as the Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech ... In addition to the upgraded course, a team facility boasts an indoor teaching center, locker room and team meeting room for the Virginia Tech golf team ... These improvements were made possible by support from Bill and Alice Goodwin of Richmond, Va. ... The gift covered all costs of design and construction ... As part of the project, Tech's artificial practice tee was covered and equipped with radiant heaters ... The indoor facility was constructed adjacent to the newly-dedicated golf team practice area, which was made possible through the generosity of long-time golf team supporter and scholarship donor C.M. "Buddy" Neviasser ... This facility provides Tech players with one of the finest total practice complexes in the nation.

We Like this Conference

Although Virginia Tech has only been an ACC member for less than eight years, the school's athletic program has already made quite a splash in the league ... The Hokie football team won the 2004 ACC Championship and played in the inaugural ACC Football Championship game after winning the Coastal Division title, winning the conference title in 2007, 2008 and 2010 ... Men's basketball coach **Seth Greenberg** was the 2005 and 2008 ACC Coach of the Year, the same award that football coach **Frank Beamer** has won twice ... The men's soccer team advanced to the College Cup in 2007 and the softball team appeared in NCAA Women's College World Series in 2008 ... Individually, Tech's **Spyridon Jullien** won three NCAA throwing championships ... **Queen Harrison** appeared in the 2008 Olympics in Beijing and won the 60-meter hurdle championship at the 2010 NCAA Indoor Championship and became the first woman ever to win both the 400m and 100m hurdle titles at the 2010 NCAA Outdoor Championship.

A Good Host

Virginia Tech hosted the 2011 NCAA East Regional Golf Championship at the Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech ... This was the first NCAA event hosted on the course ... Tech hosted the 1997 NCAA East Regional and the 2004 NCAA Division I Men's Golf Championship at the Homestead Resort in Hot Springs, Va.

Only current PGA Tour competitors Brendon de Jonge and Johnson Wagner were not coached by Sharp ... Sharp was the all-time leading scorer in Virginia Tech history when he graduated in 1995 ... Sharp was inducted into the Virginia Tech Sports Hall of Fame in 2009.

Old North State Club will again be the site of the ACC Men's Golf Championship ... This will be the 16th time Old North State has hosted, and the 11th consecutive time... Georgia Tech is the three-time defending champion ... Paul Haley of Georgia Tech was the 2011 medalist ... Wake Forest won the first ACC Golf Championship in 1954 ... Florida State claimed its first ACC Championship in 2008... Virginia Tech and Georgia Tech tied for the 2007 championship, marking the second-consecutive year that the ACC produced co-champions - the 2006 championship tie was represented by North Carolina and Georgia Tech ... 2007 was Virginia Tech's first ACC Men's Golf Championship title ... Boston College will be competing in its seventh golf championship as an ACC member... Wake Forest boasts the most league titles with 18... In the first ACC Championship held in 1954 at Old Town Club in Winston-Salem, Duke earned team honors while Arnold Palmer captured individual honors.

The Head Hokie

Jay Hardwick is in his 29th season as the head coach of Virginia Tech Golf ... Hardwick is a 1971 graduate of Virginia Tech ... Hardwick is also the Director of Golf at Virginia Tech and oversaw the incorporation of the University's new course, The Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech, into the Virginia Tech operation, as well as the construction of team facilities at the course ... Hardwick was inducted into the GCAA's Hall of Fame in 2008 and was the inaugural winner in 2005 of the Labron Harris Jr. Award, given by the PGA of America ... With the Hokies' 2007 ACC Golf Championship, Hardwick became the first coach in NCAA history to win four different conference titles at the same school ...
