HOKIE NOTES



Entering the NCAA Championship

This week will mark Virginia Tech's first trip to the championship round since 2002, when the Hokies finished 20th ... Tech finished eighth in the 2001 championship ... This season marked the sixth consecutive and 14th overall appearance in the NCAA Men's Golf Championship for Virginia Tech.

The Hokies this Season

Virginia Tech has finished in the top 10 in 11 of the 13 tournaments this season ... Tech's best finish was second place at the Furman Intercollegiate ... The Hokies' best individual finishes this season were four, third-place finishes; **Mikey Moyers** at the Northern Intercollegiate, **Trevor Cone** at the Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate at Blackthorn Club, **Blake Redmond** at the ACC Championship and **Scott Vincent** at the NCAA South Central Regional ... All five Hokies competing this week have at least one top 10 individual finish this season.

All Five in Top 10

The five Hokies that are competing in the NCAA South Central Regional are all among the top 10 all-time scorers at Virginia Tech, including a new name near the top of the list ... Freshman **Trevor Cone** trails only Brendon de Jonge on the career scoring list, with a 73.00 stroke average ... Freshman **Scott Vincent** is fourth at 73.31 and junior **Mikey Moyers** is now in sixth place, with a 73.41 ... Senior **Blake Redmond** is eighth at 73.88 and sophomore **Bryce Chalkey** is 10th at 73.97 ... Associate head coach **Brian Sharp** is 12th on the list at 74.15.

NCAA Experience Here

Three Virginia Tech golfers competing this week, senior **Blake Redmond**, junior **Mikey Moyers** and sophomore **Bryce Chalkey** have played in NCAA competition prior to this year ... **Trevor Cone** and **Scott Vincent** made their first appearance in the NCAAs in the regional in Bowling Green ... Both Redmond and Vincent have top-10 finishes in NCAA regional competition ... No one on the Tech team this season has ever competed at the NCAA championship round level.

Hokies on the PGA Tour

A pair of Hokies are currently competing on the PGA Tour ... Johnson Wagner won his first-ever PGA Tour event at the Houston Shell Open in 2008, earning him a berth the next week at the 2008 Masters Tournament ... He won last season at the Mayakoba Golf Classic in El Camaleon, Riviera Maya, Mexico on the PGA Tour and won the Sony Open in Hawaii this January, which helped him to claim PGA Tour Player of the Month for January ... Former teammate Brendon de Jonge was the 2008 Nationwide Tour Player of the Year ... He finished second on the money list and won the Xerox Classic in Rochester, N.Y. ... His second-place finish on the Nationwide money list earned him a return to the PGA Tour in 2009; he advanced out of qualifying school to earn his card last season and finished 34th on the money list in 2010 to earn his card for last season ... He also played on the PGA Tour in 2007.

New Face Next Year

During the early signing period in November, Virginia Tech announced that **Maclain Huge** (Lovettsville, Va.) has signed a national letter of intent to attend Virginia Tech and play golf for the Hokies in Fall 2012 ... Huge recently won his third consecutive VISAA state high school championship.

A Course to Dye For

Virginia Tech's commitment to golf became more evident six years ago, when it was announced that famed golf course architect Pete Dye would lead the renovation of the River Course of Virginia Tech ... The project, which began on Jan. 5, 2004, was completed in 2006 ... A new \$5.5 million clubhouse was completed in 2010 ... Once completed, the course became a Pete Dye Signature Course and has been rechristened as the Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech ... In addition to the upgraded course, a team facility boasts an indoor teaching center, locker room and team meeting room for the Virginia Tech golf team ... These improvements were made possible by support from Bill and Alice Goodwin of Richmond, Va. ... The gift covered all costs of design and construction ... As part of the project, Tech's artificial practice tee was covered and equipped with radiant heaters ... The indoor facility was constructed adjacent to the newly-dedicated golf team practice area, which was made possible through the generosity of long-time golf team supporter and scholarship donor C.M. "Buddy" Neviasser ... This facility provides Tech players with one of the finest total practice complexes in the nation.

Blake was Busy

Virginia Tech golfer **Blake Redmond** was busy earlier this month, but not on the golf course ... The senior from Sugar Land, Texas graduated from Virginia Tech with a degree in Apparel, Housing, & Resource Management ... Former teammate Marshall Bailey, who completed his career at Tech last season and played in four NCAA Regionals and in one NCAA Championship as an individual, joined him in graduating this year.

What is a Hokie?

The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute. With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body.

Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Hokie" yell, which is still used today. Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the word was solely the product of his imagination and was used only as an attention-getter for his yell. It soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

The Head Hokie

Jay Hardwick is in his 29th season as the head coach of Virginia Tech Golf ... Hardwick is a 1971 graduate of Virginia Tech ... Hardwick is also the Director of Golf at Virginia Tech and oversaw the incorporation of the University's new course, The Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech, into the Virginia Tech operation, as well as the construction of team facilities at the course ... Hardwick was inducted into the GCAA's Hall of Fame in 2008 and was the inaugural winner in 2005 of the Labron Harris Jr. Award, given by the PGA of America ... With the Hokies' 2007 ACC Golf Championship, Hardwick became the first coach in NCAA history to win four different conference titles at the same school ... A Good Host

Virginia Tech hosted the 2011 NCAA East Regional Golf Championship at the Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech ... This was the first NCAA event hosted on the course ... Tech hosted the 1997 NCAA East Regional and the 2004 NCAA Division I Men's Golf Championship at the Homestead Resort in Hot Springs, Va.

The Rest of the Roster

Three players on the Hokie roster are not competing this week ... Redshirt sophomores **Marc MacDonald** and **Jacob Everts** and freshman **Miles Curley**, all have competed for Tech this season ... MacDoanld has one top 25 finish this season.

Advancing

Since 2000, the Hokies have advanced to the NCAA Men's Golf Championship twice, in 2001 and 2002 ... Tech finished eighth in 2001 at Duke University and finished 20th in 2002 at the Scarlet Course at Ohio State ... Two Tech individuals have also advanced to the championship round ... Jurrian van der Vaart finished ninth overall at the Birck Boilermaker Golf Complex at Purdue University in West Lafayette, Ind., in 2008 and Marshall Bailey tied for 124th at the Honors Course in Ooltewah, Tenn., in 2010.

Too Good of a Coach

Of the 11 players ranked ahead of Associate Head Coach **Brian Sharp** on the Virginia Tech all-time scoring list, nine have been coached by Sharp ... Only current PGA Tour competitors Brendon de Jonge and Johnson Wagner were not coached by Sharp ... Sharp was the all-time leading scorer in Virginia Tech history when he graduated in 1995 ... Sharp was inducted into the Virginia Tech Sports Hall of Fame in 2009.

In Memoriam

Virginia Tech Golf lost one of its all-time greats in April, as Tim Collins passed away ... Tim was one of the most decorated golfers to ever play for Virginia Tech and his record in post-season play is unparalleled ... As a sophomore he finished seventh in the NCAA Championship, went on to finish 20th the following year, and fifth in 1967, the best-ever performance for a Virginia Tech golfer ... He was named a third team All-American in 1965 and a second team All-American in 1967, and was inducted into the VT Sports Hall of Fame in 1985 ... After a successful stint on the PGA TOUR he was the golf professional at several facilities and concluded his career as the Director of Golf at Bermuda Run in Clemmons, NC, where he served for many years.

...That Virginia Tech has three top 10 individual finishes? (Tim Collins, fifth in 1967, Tim Collins, seventh in 1965 and Jurrian van der Vaart, ninth in 2008).

...That **Jay Hardwick** is the only coach ever to win conference championships in four different Division I conferences while coaching at the same school? (The Metro Conference in 1993 and 1994, the Atlantic 10 Conference in 1996 and 1997, the BIG EAST Conference in 2001, 2002 and 2003 and the Atlantic Coast Conference in 2007; he has won Coach of the Year honors in three of the four leagues).

...That Associate Head Coach Brian Sharp was the assistant coach on the USA Team at the 2010 Palmer Cup at Royal Portrush in Ireland?

...That Drew Weaver won the 2007 British Amateur at Royal Lytham and St. Annes while a member of the Virginia Tech golf team? (Weaver played in the 2007 British Open and the 2008 Masters while a member of the Virginia Tech golf team.)

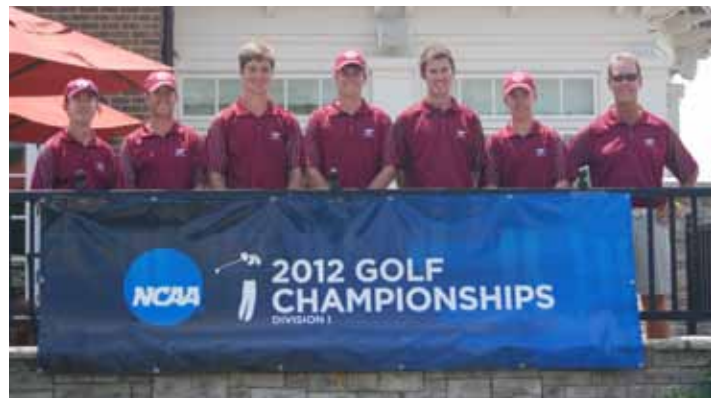

Virginia Tech is one of three ACC teams at the NCAA Championship ... 13th seed Virginia and 18th seed Florida State are also in the field ... Tech is the 28th seed ... Tech is a combined 6-19 against teams in the field at the NCAA Championship ... Tech is 6-14 against non-ACC teams in the field ... Of the other 29 schools in the NCAA Championship this season, Tech has competed against 19 of them ... Under **Jay Hardwick**, this is the Hokies' sixth appearance in the NCAA Championship round (plus two more times that a Hokie individual advanced) ... Tech has made the NCAA Regional twelve times under Hardwick.
