HOKIE NOTES



Entering the ACC Golf Championship

This weekend will mark Virginia Tech's ninth appearance at the ACC Golf Championship ... The Hokies officially joined the ACC on July 1, 2004 ... The Hokies enter the event ranked No. 30 in the Golfstat.com rankings and No. 38 in the Golfweek/Sagarin rankings.

The Hokies this Season

Virginia Tech has won three tournaments this season and has finished in the top five in eight of the 10 tournaments this season ... The Hokies' best individual finish this season is **Trevor Cone's** second-place finish at the Navy Spring Invitational.

A New Leader

The five Hokies competing in the ACC Tournament are all among the top 20 all-time scorers at Virginia Tech, including a new name at the top of the list ... Sophomore **Scott Vincent** has supplanted Brendon de Jonge in the top spot of the career scoring list, with a 72.52 stroke average ... Senior **Mikey Moyers** is now in fourth place, with a 73.16 and sophomore **Trevor Cone** is fifth at 73.21 ... Junior **Bryce Chalkey** is eighth at 73.80 and freshman **Maclain Huge** enters the list this spring in 20th place at 75.00... Associate head coach **Brian Sharp** is 12th on the list at 74.15.

ACC Experience Here

Four Virginia Tech golfers competing this weekend, senior **Mikey Moyers**, junior **Bryce Chalkey** and sophomores **Trevor Cone** and **Scott Vincent** all played last season in the ACC Championship ... Chalkey tied for 14th place last season ... Graduated senior Blake Redmond was third in last year's event, in which the Hokies tied for fourth place.

New Faces Next Year

During the early signing period in November, Virginia Tech announced that Drew Johnson (Oak Ridge, N.C.) and Ryan Mondy (Blacksburg, Va.) have signed National Letters of Intent to attend Virginia Tech and play golf for the Hokies in Fall 2013.

Hokies on the PGA Tour

A pair of Hokies are currently competing on the PGA Tour ... Johnson Wagner won his first-ever PGA Tour event at the Houston Shell Open in 2008, earning him a berth the next week at the 2008 Masters Tournament ... He won two years ago at the Mayakoba Golf Classic in El Camaleon, Riviera Maya, Mexico on the PGA Tour and won the Sony Open in Hawaii in January, 2012, which helped him to claim PGA Tour Player of the Month for January 2012 ... Former teammate Brendon de Jonge was the 2008 Nationwide Tour Player of the Year ... He finished second on the money list and won the Xerox Classic in Rochester, N.Y. ... His second-place finish on the Nationwide money list earned him a return to the PGA Tour in 2009; he advanced out of qualifying school to earn his card two years ago and finished 34th on the money list in 2010 to earn his card for the 2012 season ... He also played on the PGA Tour in 2007 ... Wagner finished 35th on the 2012 PGA Tour Money List and de Jonge finished 38th on the list.

A Course to Dye For

Virginia Tech's commitment to golf became more evident six years ago, when it was announced that famed golf course architect Pete Dye would lead the renovation of the River Course of Virginia Tech ... The project, which began on Jan. 5, 2004, was completed in 2006 ... A new \$5.5 million clubhouse was completed in 2010 ... Once completed, the course became a Pete Dye Signature Course and has been rechristened as the Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech ... In addition to the upgraded course, a team facility boasts an indoor teaching center, locker room and team meeting room for the Virginia Tech golf team ... These improvements were made possible by support from Bill and Alice Goodwin of Richmond, Va. ... The gift covered all costs of design and construction ... As part of the project, Tech's artificial practice tee was covered and equipped with radiant heaters ... The indoor facility was constructed adjacent to the newly-dedicated golf team practice area, which was made possible through the generosity of long-time golf team supporter and scholarship donor, the late C.M. "Buddy" Neviasser ... This facility provides Tech players with one of the finest total practice complexes in the nation.

A World-Class Player

Scott Vincent missed the Hokies' fourth place finish at the Brickyard Collegiate Golf Championship in October ... Vincent was representing his native Zimbabwe in the World Amateur Team Championship in Antalya, Turkey ... The sophomore from Harare finished in 32nd place individually and Zimbabwe finished tied for 17th place overall.

These Will Be Just Fine

Virginia Tech has played with the same starting lineup in all but one event this season ... That one variation happened in the Brickyard Collegiate Golf Championship in October, when **Scott Vincent** was forced to miss due to the World Amateur Team Championship ... Redshirt junior **Jacob Everts** replaced him in that event.

An Odd Number

Those looking at the Hokies' scores from this season will notice the rounds are not divisible by three ... That is because the Hokies played at the Navy Spring Invitational, that is just a 36-hole event.

Jay's the Only One

When the Hokies tied Georgia Tech for the 2007 ACC Men's Golf Championship, Virginia Tech head coach **Jay Hardwick** became the only coach in NCAA history to win conference titles in four different Division I athletic conferences ... Prior to winning the ACC, Hardwick had led the Hokies to conference titles in the Metro, Atlantic 10 and Big East Conferences.

The Rest of the Roster

Three players on the Hokie roster are not competing this weekend ... Redshirt juniors **Marc MacDonald** and **Jacob Everts** and sophomore **Miles Curley**, all have competed for Tech this season ... Everts has one top 25 finish this season, 22nd at the VCU Shootout.

We Like this Conference

Although Virginia Tech has only been an ACC member for less than nine years, the school's athletic program has already made quite a splash in the league ... The Hokie football team won the 2004 ACC Championship and played in the inaugural ACC Football Championship game after winning the Coastal Division title, winning the conference title in 2007, 2008 and 2010 ... Football coach **Frank Beamer** has twice been named the ACC Coach of the Year ... The men's soccer team advanced to the College Cup in 2007 and the softball team appeared in NCAA Women's College World Series in 2008 ... Individually, both **Spyridon Jullien** and **Alexander Ziegler** have won three NCAA throwing championships each ... **Queen Harrison** appeared in the 2008 Olympics in Beijing and won the 60-meter hurdle championship at the 2010 NCAA Indoor Championship and became the first woman ever to win both the 400m and 100m hurdle titles at the 2010 NCAA Outdoor Championship.

Too Good of a Coach

Of the 11 players ranked ahead of Associate Head Coach **Brian Sharp** on the Virginia Tech all-time scoring list, nine have been coached by Sharp ... Only current PGA Tour competitors Brendon de Jonge and Johnson Wagner were not coached by Sharp ... Sharp was the all-time leading scorer in Virginia Tech history when he graduated in 1995 ... Sharp was inducted into the Virginia Tech Sports Hall of Fame in 2009.

Old North State Club will again be the site of the ACC Men's Golf Championship ... This will be the 17th time Old North State has hosted, and the 12th-consecutive time... Georgia Tech is the four-time defending champion ... Ben Rusch of Virginia was the 2012 medalist ... Wake Forest won the first ACC Golf Championship in 1954 ... Virginia Tech and Georgia Tech tied for the 2007 championship, marking the second-consecutive year that the ACC produced co-champions - the 2006 championship tie was represented by North Carolina and Georgia Tech ... 2007 was Virginia Tech's first ACC Men's Golf Championship title ... Wake Forest boasts the most league titles with 18... In the first ACC Championship held in 1954 at Old Town Club in Winston-Salem, Duke earned team honors while Arnold Palmer captured individual honors.

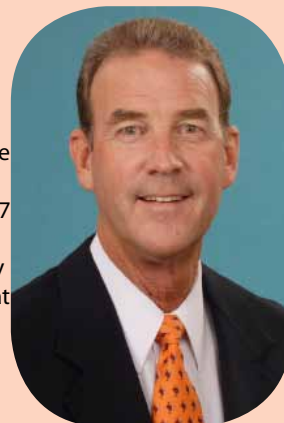
A Good Host

Virginia Tech hosted the 2011 NCAA East Regional Golf Championship at the Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech ... This was the first NCAA event hosted on the course ... Tech hosted the 1997 NCAA East Regional and the 2004 NCAA Division I Men's Golf Championship at the Homestead Resort in Hot Springs, Va.

The Head Hokie

Jay Hardwick is in his 30th season as the head coach of Virginia Tech Golf ... Hardwick is a 1971 graduate of Virginia Tech ...

Hardwick is also the Director of Golf at Virginia Tech and oversaw the incorporation of the University's new course, The Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech, into the Virginia Tech operation, as well as the construction of team facilities at the course ... Hardwick was inducted into the GCAA's Hall of Fame in 2008 and was the inaugural winner in 2005 of the Labron Harris Jr. Award, given by the PGA of America ... With the Hokies' 2007 ACC Golf Championship, Hardwick became the first coach in NCAA history to win four different conference titles at the same school ... What is a Hokie?

The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute. With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body.

Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Hokie" yell, which is still used today. Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the word was solely the product of his imagination and was used only as an attention-getter for his yell. It soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.
