**2015-16 Season** - Enters the NCAAs 17th in all-time scoring at Virginia Tech ... Competed in the starting lineup in every event this season ... Posted 16 rounds at par-or-better and led the team in scoring with a 72.23 average ... Also led the team in "Crunch Time" scoring (final round average) ... Career-best fourth place finishes at the Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate and Kiawah Classic ... Tied for seventh at the 2016 ACC Championship, his best-ever finish in that event ... Finished eighth at the Bridgestone Golf Collegiate and the Furman Intercollegiate ... Finished tied for second at the Worthington Manor U.S. Open local qualifier, advancing to the sectional qualifer in June ... Finished birdie-eagle to advance.

**2014-15 Season** - Competed in the starting lineup in 11 events ... Best finish was 16th at the Mission Inn Spring Spectacular ... Finished 30th at the Puerto Rico Classic and 34th at the Primland Collegiate Invitational ... Finished tied for 65th at NCAA Noblesville Regional.

**2013-14 Season** - Competed in four events in the spring, including the ACC and NCAA Championships ... Competed three times in the fall, twice as a member of the starting lineup ... Best finish was 47th at the ACC Championship ... Was fifth on the team in scoring average and "Crunch Time" average Collegiate Awards/Honors - Co-Captain for the 2015-16 season ... Represented Men's Golf on the Student Athlete Advisory Council for the 2015-16 season ... 2014 and 2015 ACC Academic Honor Roll ... Was 154th at NCAA Championships in Hutchinson, Kansas and tied for 57th at NCAA Auburn Regional.

**Amateur** - Tied for first in the 2016 New Year's Invitational, losing in a four-way playoff ... Finished 18th at the 2013 Eastern Amateur.

**Junior Golf/High School** - 2012 Optimist International Junior champion ... Finished third in the 2013 Junior Valentine Invitational ... Represented the United States in the 2013 Swifts Golf Tour, a two week competition versus a junior team from the United Kingdom ... Two-time junior club champion at Congressional Country Club ... Four year letterman, team captain and four-time Most Valuable Player at Flint High School.

### **Hokies Earn Academic Recognition**

Virginia Tech men's golf received Public Recognition Awards from the NCAA for top academic scores in the classroom, as announced by the NCAA ... Public Recognition Awards get handed out based on a sport's multi-year Academic Progress Rate, better known as APR ... The APR is an annual scorecard of academic achievement calculated for all Division I sports teams nationally ... To receive a Public Recognition Award, a team must have an APR in the top 10 percent of its sport ... This is the seventh consecutive year the Hokies have received the honor.
