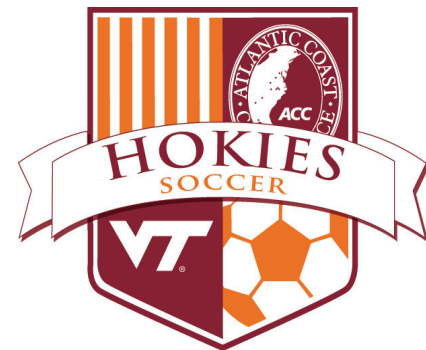

LAST TIME OUT ...

The Hokies fell to Howard, 2-1, on Saturday night in the season opener for both teams at Thompson Field. The Hokies held the majority of the possession in the first half, but could not find the back of the net. Howard got on the board first when Mario Martin scored in the 60th minute. Then at 80:12, Martin scored again, giving the Bison a 2-0 lead. Just 15 seconds later, Tech answered as David Clemens scored off a pass from Michael Garrick. Garrick nearly tied the game with four minutes left, but his volley hit the crossbar. Tech out-shot Howard, 18-4, and out-cornered the Bison, 14-0. Kyle Renfro played all 90 minutes in goal for Tech.

NEXT UP ...

The Hokies host nationally-ranked North Carolina in their ACC opener at Thompson Field on Saturday, Sept. 10 at 7:00 p.m. They conclude the five-game homestand to begin the year on Tuesday, Sept. 13 against Longwood.

TOURNAMENT NOTES...

- After a year absence, the Hokies once again host the Hilton Garden Hokie Invitational in early September. When the Hokies last hosted the tournament in 2009, they lost to #11 South Florida, 1-0, and then tied East Tennessee State, 1-1, in double overtime. Virginia Tech has hosted a home tournament 11 previous times in program history, with the first being in 1982. Virginia is the fourth team in the tournament, but the Hokies will not play the Cavaliers (1-1-0) this weekend. The Hokies and Cavaliers will meet in ACC play on Oct. 21 in Blacksburg.

SCOUTING WISCONSIN/SERIES HISTORY...

- Wisconsin enters the tournament with a record of 1-0-0 after defeating Western Illinois, 1-0, on Aug. 27. Virginia Tech and Wisconsin have met only once before in men's soccer as on Sept. 4, 2009, the Hokies and Badgers battled to a 0-0 (2 OT) tie at the Middleton Sports & Fitness Classic in Madison, Wisc.

SCOUTING CINCINNATI/SERIES HISTORY...

- Cincinnati enters the tournament with a record of 1-0-0 after a 3-1 win at Western Michigan on Aug. 27. This is the 11th all-time meeting between Cincinnati and Virginia Tech in men's soccer, but first since 1991, when Tech won, 2-1, at Cincinnati. The Hokies hold a 7-3 series advantage and have a 2-0 home record against the Bearcats. Tech has won three straight over Cincinnati. The first meeting was in 1979, when Tech defeated the Bearcats, 2-1, in Blacksburg.

- This year's team captains are r-senior James Shupp and junior David Fiorello. It marks the second year in a row that Fiorello will wear the captain's armband for Tech.

WELCOME BACK...

- The Hokies are excited to welcome back Shupp, who redshirted the 2010 season. The Downingtown, Pa., native has 60 career appearances and 56 starts to his credit.

- Tech also welcomes back Drew Ranahan, Taylor Lemmon and Ethan Ashong off redshirt seasons last year. All three are redshirt freshmen in 2011.

TEAMMATES...

- Freshmen Hunter Byrnes and Drew Hartell were high school teammates at F.W. Cox High School in Virginia Beach. They also both played club soccer for Beach FC, the same club that r-junior Jeremy Williams played for in his prep days.

- Freshmen Zach Hoover and Kevin Reitzel and sophomore Nick Smirniotopoulos all played club soccer for McLean Academy in Virginia.

- Drew Ranahan, sophomore Devante Dubose and junior Michael Garrick all played high school soccer at Bishop O'Dowd High School in Oakland, Calif. Dubose and Garrick were also members of the Mustang Soccer Academy for club soccer.

FIRST GOAL OF THE YEAR...

- For the second year in a row, sophomore David Clemens scored the Hokies first goal of the season. Last year, Clemens scored Tech's first goal of 2010 against UAB on Sept. 5. On Saturday, he found the back of the net against Howard in the 81st minute.

HOKIES BY STATE...

COACHING FIRSTS AT TECH

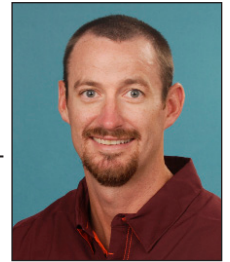

Mike Brizendine enters his third year as Virginia Tech's head coach after spending five years as the Hokies' top assistant.

Brizendine's 2010 squad played five top-20 nationally ranked opponents, including taking sixth-ranked Virginia to overtime on the road. His 2009-10 team was one of only three Atlantic Coast Conference men's soccer programs to receive the NSCAA Team Academic Award, which honors teams with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher. It marked the second time in program history and first since 2003, that the Hokies earned academic recognition from the NSCAA.



An experienced coach on all levels, Brizendine helped guide the Hokies to their first NCAA College Cup appearance in school history in 2007. He has worked with all aspects of the Hokie program. For his contributions, Brizendine was recognized as the NSCAA's Atlantic Region Assistant Coach of the Year in 2007.

Brizendine joined the Hokie staff after a successful stint with Bridgewater College, a Division III program that participates in the Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC). After assisting both the men's and women's programs at Bridgewater in 2000, he became the head men's coach from 2001 to 2003, guiding the team from non-competitive status to a full-fledged Division III program. Brizendine led Bridgewater to its two best single-season records, 12-6 in 2003 and 11-7 in 2002, for a 23-13 mark over two seasons and a .639 winning percentage. For this significant turn-around, his peers named him ODAC Coach of the Year in 2003.

Brizendine graduated from James Madison University in 1999 and earned his Master of Education from Virginia Tech in 2005.

Prior to his time at Bridgewater College, he was an assistant coach at Ferrum College for the men's soccer team in 1999. He has also been active guiding and encouraging kids in youth soccer programs throughout his coaching career.

As a player, he lettered four seasons at James Madison University from 1995-98 and ended his career sixth in all-time scoring for the Dukes. He earned all-conference and all-region recognition during his four-year career. He also played professionally with the Roanoke Wrath (1999) and the Northern Virginia Royals (2000 and 2001) of the Division 3 league.

Brizendine and his wife, Lucy, reside in Blacksburg, Va.

Game-by-Game Recap

Game #1 vs. Howard | August 27 | L, 2-1

BLACKSBURG, Va. -- The Virginia Tech men's soccer team opened the 2011 season on Aug. 27 with a 2-1 loss to Howard at Thompson Field. All three of the goals scored in the game occurred after half-time, with two coming just 15 seconds apart in the 81st minute.

After a scoreless first half, in which Tech held a majority of the possession in the Howard half of the field, the Bison stunned the Hokies as they got on the board first when Mario Martin capitalized with a low finish from eight yards on a pass from Rahman Alarape at 59:02.

Then at 80:12, Martin again finished for Howard, this time off a pass from Akinbola Richardson, making the score 2-0 in favor of the Bison. However, Tech would get the board just 15 seconds later when Michael Garrick found David Clemens, who dribbled past Howard defenders into the box and finished off a nice individual effort from just outside the six-yard box. After their goal, the Hokies kept on pushing numbers forward as Howard tried to hold on. Garrick nearly got the equalizer at 86:08 as his flick over Hamilton's head hit the crossbar and came back down into play, but Tech couldn't put in the ensuing rebound.

For the game, Tech out-shot Howard, 18-4, and out-cornered the Bison, 14-0. Clemens led the Hokie offense with seven shots and his goal marked the second year in a row that he has scored Tech's first goal of the year. Kyle Renfro played all 90 minutes between the pipes for Tech.
