-The Hokies add 12 new faces to the team...10 freshman and three transfers. The transfers hail from Patrick Henry Community College, Hosuton Baptist and Greensboro College.

- The team welcomes many fresh faces including the three who scored during the exhibition matches.

#### THE OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY...

- The Ohio State Buckeyes did not fair well in exhibition play going 0-2 against Syracuse and Butler. Both teams topped the Bucks 2-1.


