

Open applications for the position of Athletic Training Graduate Assistant for the Fall semester will be accepted through November 10th. Applicants must apply to the ITMA Graduate Program. (<http://www.itma.vt.edu/>)

Responsibilities/Job Description: Work under the supervision of staff Athletic Trainers providing care and coverage of various varsity sports at Virginia Tech. Assist in the supervision and instruction of athletic training student aides. Participate in bi-monthly in-service program.

Dates/Times of Service: August 1st -May 10th. Work hours may include some mornings, nights, weekends and/or holidays. Applicants may be required to travel. In addition, GA Athletic Trainers are expected to be on-call as necessary.

Compensation/Stipend: Full in-state/out-of-state tuition and fees waiver, stipend for room and board, and a book stipend. In certain cases, the stipend will be based on the applicant's certification status. Fees and/or stipends are subject to change according to university policy. Qualifications: NATABOC certified or eligible; Must pass test and apply for Virginia licensure (https://www.dhp.virginia.gov/medicine/medicine_forms.htm#AthleticTrainer) Applicants must be First Aid/CPR certified, AED certification required. Applicant must be accepted into Graduate School (ITMA requires a minimum of 3.0 GPA.)

Master's Degree: Our Graduate Assistants complete their Master's Degree online through the ITMA program. This is a MS in Education that combines Athletic Training classes with classes in Instructional Technology. Please see www.itma.vt.edu for information. Other degrees may be considered; however, some do not comply with the requirements of the Graduate Assistant position.
