THIS WEEK

Virginia Tech hits the road for its only away contest of the indoor season, traveling north to University Park, Pa., for the Penn State National. Two days of events kick off on Friday, Jan. 28 at 6 p.m.

WEEKEND RECAP: HOKIE INVITATIONAL

In its second home competition of the season, Tech took three titles and saw numerous veterans and newcomers in their first competition of the season. Nick McLaughlin earned the Hokies their first win of the weekend, leading the pack in the 600 meters at 1:20.57, with teammates Kieran Lee (1:20.83) and Jeff Miller (1:20.98) not far behind, earning third and fourth-place finishes, respectively. Leigh Allin won the women's unseeded pole vault with a personal-best height of 12-1.75 (3.70m). Samira Burkhardt, in only her second collegiate competition, earned her second victory in the shot put, improving her best distance to 52-10 (16.10m), which currently tops the ACC and ranks 13th in the nation. The Hokie 4x4 squads got their first action of the season, with the women's team of Asia Washington, Yvonne Amegashie, Natalie Woodford and Aunye Boone cruising to a third-place finish at 3:42.04. This mark ranks fourth in the ACC and 19th nationally. Sophomore transfer Jeff Artis-Gray took third in the long jump at 24-4.25 (7.42m), which puts him second all-time in the Hokie record books.

WEEK ONE RANKINGS

On the men's side, the same teams remain in the top ten though the order has shifted for everyone except Texas A&M at No. 3. LSU vaulted over Florida for the top spot, with top national performances in the 60-meter dash and the long jump. The Hokies dropped one spot down to No. 6, but widened the gap between the next top ACC team, Florida State, who now resides at ninth. In the women's top 10, the top six remain the same besides Clemson and Tennessee swapping spots. Oklahoma dropped out of the 10-spot, leaving room for previously 12th-ranked BYU to crack the top 10.

FIELD HOUSE RECORDS FALL

Rector Field House saw three records fall over two days of competition at the Hokie Invitational. On Friday, Jan. 21, former Indiana State standout Erica Moore, competing unattached, set a new women's 600-meter record at 1:28.02, besting Hazel Clark's mark of 1:28.87 set last season. Duke's 4x800-meter relay shattered a decade-old record, winning at 8:42.54. The previous best was 8:51.92, set in 2001 by Pittsburgh. On Saturday, Duke's Kate Van Buskirk, a member of Friday's 4x800-meter relay squad, set a Field House and NCAA record in the 1,000 meters, recording a blazing 2:41.00. The previous Field House best of 2:43.40 was set in 2005 by Sara Bowman.

QUEEN HARRISON WINS MACARTHUR AWARD

Former Tech athlete Queen Harrison has been selected by the Norfolk Sports Club as the recipient of the 47th annual General Douglas MacArthur Memorial Trophy, given each year to the top collegiate athlete in the United States who formerly attended high school in Virginia. Harrison, a graduate of Hermitage High School in Henrico, Va., is the first track and field athlete to receive the award, and only the third female, the last being Mimi Smith in 1998. The last Hokie to win the award was former running back Lee Suggs in 2002. The MacArthur award will be presented at the 66th Jamboree of the Norfolk Sports Club on Monday, Feb. 28 at the Waterside Marriott.

RECTOR HOSTS ACC CHAMPIONSHIPS

Virginia Tech's indoor track facility, Rector Field House will again play host to the indoor ACC Championships on Feb. 24-26. This is the sixth consecutive season that Virginia Tech has hosted the event. Rector's banked 200-meter track is one of the few of it's kind in the United States and provides an ideal surface to prepare athletes for similar surfaces at the national competition.

2010 SEASON REVIEW

2010 was a memorable season for Virginia Tech that saw unprecedented individual and team success both in the conference and nationally. The Hokies earned three individual NCAA titles, 13 All-America honors, and 11 ACC titles. The women's and men's teams both earned top 10 finishes at the NCAA Championships, with the women placing fifth and the men 10th. The fifth-place finish is the highest showing for any Tech track & field squad, while the men's 10th-place finish is the highest in men's program history. The men's team earned second and third place finishes at the indoor and outdoor conference meets, respectively, while the women took third and sixth.

Queen Harrison wrote and re-wrote history multiple times over the 2010 season. In the indoor season, she earned an NCAA Championship in the 60-meter hurdles, the first in Tech's women's program history. Then, during the outdoor season, Harrison became the first athlete in NCAA history to sweep both the 100 and 400-meter hurdles, earning her second and third titles to close out

an unbelievable career at Tech. She broke five school records during the season and earned four conference titles.

The men's field athletes were recognized for their outstanding performance, as both Yavgeniy Olhovsky and Marcel Lomnicky were named USTFCCCA Southeast Region Men's Field Athletes of the Year. Tech's coaching staff also received accolades, with Dave Cianelli earning 2010 ACC Men's Coach of the Year honors, his fifth such conference award. Throws coach Greg Jack was named 2010 Southeast Region Men's Assistant Coach of the Year and sprints, hurdles and jumps coach Charles Foster, in his first season at Tech, was named 2010 Southeast Region Women's Assistant Coach of the Year.

OLHOVSKY POISED FOR HISTORY

Yavgeniy Olhovsky, already a six-time All-American, can tie the all-time Tech record with one more accolade, or set a new record with two more this season. The current men's record-holder is Spyridon Jullien with seven All-America honors. Kristi Castlin earned her seventh All-America honor last season, becoming only the second athlete in Tech history to do so.



COLLEGIATE RECORD EARNS DUKE'S VAN BUSKIRK WEEKLY HONOR

Duke senior Kate Van Buskirk set a new collegiate record in the 1,000 meters at the Hokie Invitational, coasting to a 2:41.00 finish. This beats the previous record of 2:41.56, set in 1989. Van Buskirk was also a member of Duke's 4x800-meter relay squad that, the previous day, set a new school record. Virginia's Adams Abdulrazaaq and Florida State's Brandon Byram share the honor on the men's side, as both posted school records in their respective events: Byram in the 300 meters and Abdulrazaaq in the 60m hurdles.
