#### THE SERIES

This is the second meeting between Virginia Tech and Florida Gulf Coast.

The Eagles notched a 73-65 win over Tech last season at the Caribbean Challenge in Cancun, Mexico.

The top returning scorer for the Hokies from that game is Porschia Hadley who had nine points and seven rebounds. Alyssa Fenyn added eight points and secured seven rebounds.

For the Eagles, Sarah Hansen notched 19 points while Kelsey Jacobson tallied 14.

#### THE HOKIES

Tech fell to UCF 41-32 in the team's last outing. Alyssa Fenyn led the Hokies with 10 points. Latorri Hines-Allen added six points and eight rebounds.

The Hokies are being led this season by a trio of guards. Monet Tellier is averaging 14.4 points per game, Aerial Wilson is adding 10.5 points and handing out 4.1 assists per game, while Alyssa Fenyn is tallying 9.9 points per game and pulling down 6.0 rebounds. Latorri Hines-Allen is grabbing a team-best 6.1 rebounds per game.

Virginia Tech is 13-9 all-time against teams from the Atlantic Sun Conference.

#### THE EAGLES

• FGCU is being led by Sarah Hansen with 14.8 points and 7.8 rebounds per game. Nicoya Jackson and Kelsey Jacobson are adding 13.6 and 10.5 points per game, respectively. Brittany Kennedy is handing out 6.0 assists per game.

• The Eagles defeated conference foe USC Upstate 77-53 the last time out. Hansen had 23 points for FGCU while Jackson and Courtney Chihil each added nine points.

• FGCU has a 1-4 mark all-time against teams from the ACC.

UP NEXT: After the holiday break, Tech will host its annual Hilton Garden Inn Hokie Classic, Dec. 28-29. Participating in this year's tournament are Cincinnati, High Point and UMBC. The Hokies will face Cincinnati on the first day at 7 p.m.

#### NOTEWORTHY

#### HOME SWEET HOME

Tech picked up its first home win on Dec. 11 with a 70-58 win over NC Central in Cassell Coliseum.

#### CARFER HIGH WEEK

LATORRI HINES-ALLEN set a career-high 12 rebounds on the road against Penn State on Dec. 6. She followed that up with a career-high in points on Dec. 11 against NC Central with 14. Hines-Allen also recorded her first career double-double in the game, adding 10 rebounds.

#### **BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE**

AERIAL WILSON led the Hokies against the Hawkeyes, tying a career-high 18 points. In addition, she handed out four assists and grabbed four boards. MONET TELLIER added 16 points for Tech in hard fought, 58-47 loss in Iowa City, Iowa. Freshman LARRYQUA HALL pulled down a career-high eight rebounds and LATORRI HINES-ALLEN also grabbed eight boards for the Hokies.

#### **BIG TEN/VIRGINIA TECH CHALLENGE??**

The Hokies played three straight games against teams from the Big Ten, starting with Minnesota at the SMC Concord Hilton Tournament. In the stretch, Tech faced Iowa in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge, followed by Penn State in a road game.

#### ALL-TOURNAMENT HONORS

MONET TELLIER picked up All-Tournament honors at the SMC Concord Hilton Tournament hosted by St. Mary's in Moraga, Calif. The sophomore guard averaged 20.5 points, pulled down 11 rebounds, dished out six assists and grabbed seven steals in the two game span.

#### OFF THE BENCH

Freshman LARRYQUA HALL came into the Minnesota game and played 22 minutes, scoring seven points, grabbing four rebounds and picking up two steals.

#### HITTING 30

Sophomore guard MONET TELLIER hit a new career high with 31 points on Nov. 21 against William & Mary. She hit 13-of-22 from the field, including 2-of-4 from three point range and went 3-of-5 from the line.

#### DOUBLE-DOUBLE TIME

Junior guard ALYSSA FENYN posted her first doubledouble of the season with 11 points and 11 rebounds against George Washington on Nov. 19.

#### BACK-TO-BACK CAREER GAMES

After setting a career scoring high in the opening game of the season, junior AERIAL WILSON put up another career high in the second game, scoring 18 points against Charlotte on Nov. 16.

#### STRONG START

MONET TELLIER knocked down 29 points in the Hokies' season opening, 77-65 win over Old Dominion on Nov. 11. Tellier posted 20 of her 29 in the first half. In the final minutes of the game, Tellier went 3-of-4 from the free throw line and sank a jumper to help Tech hold off the Monarchs' late run.

#### **CAREER NUMBERS**

Junior AERIAL WILSON set a career-high 16 points against Old Dominion on Nov. 11.

#### **OPENING SUCCESS**

The Hokies defeated Old Dominion, 77-65 on Friday, Nov. 11 in the season opener. With the win, Tech improved to 28-8 all-time in season starts.

#### SHE'S BACK

Redshirt sophomore PORSCHIA HADLEY, who missed all but eight games last season due to knee surgery, returns to provide support in the paint. As a freshman in 2009-10, Hadley averaged 4.4 points, 2.9 rebounds and set a career-high 15 points at then-No. 10 Florida State. She also set a career-high four blocks in an upset victory over then-No. 10 North Carolina. In the eight games she played during her sophomore season, Hadley averaged 4.3 points, 4.9 rebounds and one block per game.

#### A FENYN RETURN

Junior ALYSSA FENYN is the top returning scorer for the Hokies, averaging 9.4 points per game last season. In addition she was second in assists with 67. Fenyn set career highs with 17 points against Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Virginia.

#### TELLIER LOOKS TO BUILD OFF FRESHMAN YEAR

Sophomore MONET TELLIER returns after a solid freshman season. The guard averaged 8.0 points and 4.1 rebounds per game last season and was second on the team in steals with 41. Tellier set career highs with 23 points against Vanderbilt and NC State.

#### **AERIAL ATTACK**

Junior AERIAL WILSON will guide the Hokies on the court this season, playing point guard. During the 2010-11 season she set a career-high 14 points against Minnesota in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge. Also set a career-high eight assists against Alcorn State.

#### WELCOME TO THE HOKIES

Head Coach DENNIS WOLFF is in his first season as head coach of the Virginia Tech women's basketball team. He was previously the head men's basketball coach at Boston University where he guided the Terriers to a 247-197 record and three straight conference titles.

#### VIRGINIA TECH HEAD COACH DENNIS WOLFF



### **DENNIS WOLFF**

Head Coach • First Season Connecticut, 1978

Dennis Wolff was named the sixth head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 22, 2011.

Prior to accepting the women's head coaching position, Wolff served one season as the Director of Men's Basketball Operations & Assistant to the Head Coach for the Virginia Tech men's basketball program. He assisted head coach Seth Greenberg in the day-to-day operations of the basketball program and also took on additional duties to better reflect a change in NCAA rules governing the operations position.

Before coming to Virginia Tech, Wolff served as the head men's basketball coach at Boston University from 1994-2009. Under Wolff's guidance, the Terriers won three straight conference titles (2002-2004) and made four consecutive postseason appearances (2002-05) for the first time in school history. He was a three-time America East Coach of the Year and a two-time NABC District 1 Coach of the Year selection.

"I am very excited that Dennis Wolff has accepted our offer to become the head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech," said Tech Director of Athletics Jim Weaver. "Coach Wolff has a great history of successful head coaching experience, and I have had the opportunity to get to know and observe him during this academic

#### history of successful head I have had the opportunity we him during this academic

year. I believe he fits very nicely into the Virginia Tech athletics family and that he will return our women's program to the winning ways of recent years."

Wolff was 247-197 (.556) in 15 years at BU, and is the school's all-time leader in victories. Including two years at Connecticut College in the early 1980s, Wolff is 277-215 (.563) in 17 years as a head coach.

Wolff arrived at BU following a four-year (1990-94) stint as an assistant coach under head coach Jeff Jones at the University of Virginia. Prior to his tenure at Virginia, Wolff spent four years (1985-89) as an assistant coach at Wake Forest and one year (1989-90) at Southern Methodist University.

Wolff began his coaching career at Trinity College, a Division III school in Hartford, Conn., where he served as an assistant from 1978-80. At the age of 25, he was named the head coach at Connecticut College and guided the Camels to a two-year mark of 30-18, including a successful 16-8 record in 1980-81, his first year as a head coach. In 1982, he began his first of three years as an assistant coach at St. Bonaventure. In the last year, Wolff has been involved in the USO Operation Hardwood in Iraq and the USO Operation Hoop Talk in Afghanistan.

A 1978 graduate of the University of Connecticut, Wolff was a two-year letterman under head coaches Dee Rowe and Dom Perno after transferring from Louisiana State University in 1975. A native of New York City, Wolff was a standout guard for Holy Cross High School. In recognition of his scholastic efforts, Wolff has since been inducted into the Holy Cross Athletic Hall of Fame.

Wolff and his wife JoAnn have three children: Nicole, Matt, and Michael. Nicole, the 2002 McDonald's National Player of the Year, played basketball at the University of Connecticut. Matt played basketball at Boston University and Michael plays ice hockey for Brown.
