THE SERIES

- This is the 28th meeting between Virginia Tech and Florida State. The Hokies and the Seminoles have a long history as both were previously members of the Metro Conference.
- The two teams last met Jan. 6, 2011. The Hokies fell 79-48 to the Seminoles in Blacksburg. Monet Tellier led the Hokies with 11 points. Nia Evans added eight points and Aerial Wilson handed out three assists for Tech. The Seminoles were led by Chasity Clayton with 16 points while Alexa Deluzio added 15.
- Tech is looking to snap a five game skid against Florida State. FSU has won 13 of the last 14 meetings between the two teams. Tech's last win was Feb. 13, 2006 when the Hokies defeated the Seminoles 76-69 in Tallahassee.

THE HOKIES

- Tech is off to a strong start in the ACC, having won the last two. Most recently the Hokies picked up a 38-35 win over Boston College. Monet Tellier led Tech with 15 points while handing out four assists. Alyssa Fenyn tallied six points, including a pivotal three pointer in the final minute of the game to help secure the win for the Hokies. Latorri Hines-Allen pulled down a team best eight rebounds.
- The Hokies are being led this season by a trio of guards. Monet Tellier is averaging 14.1 points per game, Aerial Wilson is adding 10.8 points and handing out 3.4 assists per game, while Alyssa Fenyn is tallying 8.8 points per game. Latorri Hines-Allen is grabbing a team-best 6.8 rebounds per game.

THE SEMINOLES

- The Seminoles defeated Clemson, 59-47 in their last outing. Cierra Bravard and Alexa Deluzio led the team with 16 points each. Deluzio also tallied five assists in the game. Chasity Clayton grabbed 10 rebounds.
- FSU is being led by Bravard with 15.5 points per game while Deluzio is adding 14.3 points and handing out 3.1 assists per game. Natasha Howard is adding 10.7 points while grabbing a team-high 8.8 rebounds per game.

UP NEXT: Virginia Tech is back on the road for a trip to Charlottesville, Va. to face ACC in-state rival Virginia on Thursday, Jan. 12. Game time is set for 7 p.m. in John Paul Jones Arena.

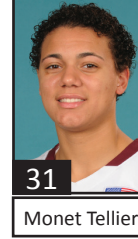

NOTEWORTHY

OFF TO A STRONG START

With the win against Boston College, the Hokies improved to 2-0 in the ACC. Tech is off to its best start in the ACC as this marks the first time the Hokies have started conference play with a 2-0 record since joining the league in 2004-05.

ACC TIP-OFF

The Hokies got the ACC season off to a strong start, picking up a 55-33 win over Clemson on Jan. 2. Tech jumped out to an early 32-3 lead in the first half. The Lady Tigers closed the gap to 16 in the second half, but the Hokies responded with a 9-0 run to seal the win. **AERIAL WILSON** tallied a game and career-high 24 points.

CLASSIC WIN

Tech defeated UMBC 57-52 on the second day of the Hilton Garden Inn Hokie Classic. **MONET TELLIER** had 18 points. **LARRYQUA HALL** pulled down a game and career-high 11 rebounds for the Hokies.

Dennis Wolff was named the sixth head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 22, 2011.

Prior to accepting the women's head coaching position, Wolff served one season as the Director of Men's Basketball Operations & Assistant to the Head Coach for the Virginia Tech men's basketball program. He assisted head coach Seth Greenberg in the day-to-day operations of the basketball program and also took on additional duties to better reflect a change in NCAA rules governing the operations position.

Before coming to Virginia Tech, Wolff served as the head men's basketball coach at Boston University from 1994-2009. Under Wolff's guidance, the Terriers won three straight conference titles (2002-2004) and made four consecutive postseason appearances (2002-05) for the first time in school history. He was a three-time America East Coach of the Year and a two-time NABC District 1 Coach of the Year selection.

"I am very excited that Dennis Wolff has accepted our offer to become the head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech," said Tech Director of Athletics Jim Weaver. "Coach Wolff has a great history of successful head coaching experience, and I have had the opportunity to get to know and observe him during this academic year. I believe he fits very nicely into the Virginia Tech athletics family and that he will return our women's program to the winning ways of recent years."

Wolff was 247-197 (.556) in 15 years at BU, and is the school's all-time leader in victories. Including two years at Connecticut College in the early 1980s, Wolff is 277-215 (.563) in 17 years as a head coach.

Wolff arrived at BU following a four-year (1990-94) stint as an assistant coach under head coach Jeff Jones at the University of Virginia. Prior to his tenure at Virginia, Wolff spent four years (1985-89) as an assistant coach at Wake Forest and one year (1989-90) at Southern Methodist University.

Wolff began his coaching career at Trinity College, a Division III school in Hartford, Conn., where he served as an assistant from 1978-80. At the age of 25, he was named the head coach at Connecticut College and guided the Camels to a two-year mark of 30-18, including a successful 16-8 record in 1980-81, his first year as a head coach. In 1982, he began his first of three years as an assistant coach at St. Bonaventure. In the last year, Wolff has been involved in the USO Operation Hardwood in Iraq and the USO Operation Hoop Talk in Afghanistan.

A 1978 graduate of the University of Connecticut, Wolff was a two-year letterman under head coaches Dee Rowe and Dom Perno after transferring from Louisiana State University in 1975. A native of New York City, Wolff was a standout guard for Holy Cross High School. In recognition of his scholastic efforts, Wolff has since been inducted into the Holy Cross Athletic Hall of Fame.

Wolff and his wife JoAnn have three children: Nicole, Matt, and Michael. Nicole, the 2002 McDonald's National Player of the Year, played basketball at the University of Connecticut. Matt played basketball at Boston University and Michael plays ice hockey for Brown.
