THE SERIES

- This is the 46th meeting between Virginia Tech and Virginia. The Hokies have faced the Cavaliers more times than any other team in history. The two teams first met in 1976 during Tech's inaugural season.
- The last meeting between Tech and UVa was Feb. 27, 2011. The Hokies fell in overtime 73-71 to the Cavaliers in Blacksburg. Alyssa Fenyn led Virginia Tech with 17 points while Latorri Hines-Allen added 10. The Cavaliers were led by China Crosby and Ataira Franklin with 15 and 14, respectively.
- Tech has fallen in the last 10 games between the two teams and is looking to snap the streak. The Hokies' last win was Jan. 22, 2007 when Tech defeated the Cavaliers 60-58 in Charlottesville.

- After getting off to a 2-0 start in the ACC, Tech fell to Florida State 75-40 the last time out. Latorri Hines-Allen led the Hokies with a game and career-high 17 points while Alyssa Fenyn added eight points. Aerial Wilson handed out five assists in the game.
- The Hokies are being led this season by a trio of guards. Monet Tellier is averaging 13.5 points per game, Wilson is adding 10.4 points and handing out 3.7 assists per game, while Fenyn is tallying 8.8 points per game. Hines-Allen is grabbing a team-best 6.4 rebounds per game.

THE CAVALIERS

- The Cavaliers defeated Clemson, 54-47 in their last outing. Chelsea Shine put up 13 points for UVa while Lexie Gerson had 10. Simone Egwu notched a double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds.
- UVa is being led by Ariana Moorer with 12.6 points per game while Altaira Franklin is adding 12.4 points and handing out 3.0 assists per game. Shine is adding 9.5 points while grabbing a team-high 6.6 rebounds per game.

UP NEXT: Virginia Tech returns to Cassell Coliseum to face No. 6/7 Duke on Sunday, Jan. 15 at 2 p.m.

Head Coach • First Season Connecticut, 1978

Dennis Wolff was named the sixth head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 22, 2011.

Prior to accepting the women's head coaching position, Wolff served one season as the Director of Men's Basketball Operations & Assistant to the Head Coach for the Virginia Tech men's basketball program. He assisted head coach Seth Greenberg in the day-to-day operations of the basketball program and also took on additional duties to better reflect a change in NCAA rules governing the operations position.

Before coming to Virginia Tech, Wolff served as the head men's basketball coach at Boston University from 1994-2009. Under Wolff's guidance, the Terriers won three straight conference titles (2002-2004) and made four consecutive postseason appearances (2002-05) for the first time in school history. He was a three-time America East Coach of the Year and a two-time NABC District 1 Coach of the Year selection.

"I am very excited that Dennis Wolff has accepted our offer to become the head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech," said Tech Director of Athletics Jim Weaver. "Coach Wolff has a great history of successful head coaching experience, and I have had the opportunity to get to know and observe him during this academic

year. I believe he fits very nicely into the Virginia Tech athletics family and that he will return our women's program to the winning ways of recent years."

Wolff was 247-197 (.556) in 15 years at BU, and is the school's all-time leader in victories. Including two years at Connecticut College in the early 1980s, Wolff is 277-215 (.563) in 17 years as a head coach.

Wolff arrived at BU following a four-year (1990-94) stint as an assistant coach under head coach Jeff Jones at the University of Virginia. Prior to his tenure at Virginia, Wolff spent four years (1985-89) as an assistant coach at Wake Forest and one year (1989-90) at Southern Methodist University.

Wolff began his coaching career at Trinity College, a Division III school in Hartford, Conn., where he served as an assistant from 1978-80. At the age of 25, he was named the head coach at Connecticut College and guided the Camels to a two-year mark of 30-18, including a successful 16-8 record in 1980-81, his first year as a head coach. In 1982, he began his first of three years as an assistant coach at St. Bonaventure. In the last year, Wolff has been involved in the USO Operation Hardwood in Iraq and the USO Operation Hoop Talk in Afghanistan.

A 1978 graduate of the University of Connecticut, Wolff was a two-year letterman under head coaches Dee Rowe and Dom Perno after transferring from Louisiana State University in 1975. A native of New York City, Wolff was a standout guard for Holy Cross High School. In recognition of his scholastic efforts, Wolff has since been inducted into the Holy Cross Athletic Hall of Fame.

Wolff and his wife JoAnn have three children: Nicole, Matt, and Michael. Nicole, the 2002 McDonald's National Player of the Year, played basketball at the University of Connecticut. Matt played basketball at Boston University and Michael plays ice hockey for Brown.
