THE SERIES

• This is the 20th meeting between Virginia Tech and Duke.

• The last meeting between Tech and Duke was Feb. 20, 2011. The Hokies fell 90-40 to the then-ranked No. 7 Blue Devils in Durham, N.C. Alyssa Fenyn had seven points and four rebounds. The top returning scorer from the game for the Blue Devils is Tricia Liston who came off the bench for 19 points.

• Tech has fallen in the last 15 games between the two teams and is looking to snap the streak. The Hokies' last win was Nov. 15, 1998 when Tech defeated the Blue Devils 72-70 in Durham, N.C. Duke has been ranked 10th or higher in 14 of the 19 meetings between the two.

THE HOKIES

• Tech fell to in-state conference rival Virginia 52-39 in the team's last outing. Aerial Wilson led the Hokies with 14 points while Monet Tellier added 10 points. Alyssa Fenyn handed out five assists and Porschia Hadley had six rebounds.

• The Hokies are being led this season by a trio of guards. Tellier is averaging 13.3 points per game, Wilson is adding 10.6 points and handing out 3.5 assists per game, while Fenyn is tallying 8.6 points per game. LaTorri Hines-Allen is grabbing a team-best 6.4 rebounds per game.

THE BLUE DEVILS

• Duke defeated Florida State 73-66 the last time out. Tricia Liston tallied 20 points for the Blue Devils. Elizabeth Williams added 18 points and pulled down eight rebounds. Chelsea Gray had 11 points, five assists and four steals.

• The Blue Devils are being led by Williams with 13.3 points and 9.0 rebounds per game. Tricia Liston is notching 12.3 points while Chelsea Gray and Haley Peter are adding 10.5 and 10.0 points per game, respectively. Gray is also handing out 6.0 assists per game.

UP NEXT: Virginia Tech remains at home to host North Carolina on Thursday, Jan. 19 at 5 p.m. prior to the Hokies' men's team facing the Tar Heels that night at 9 p.m.

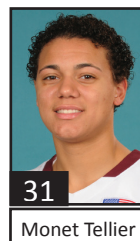

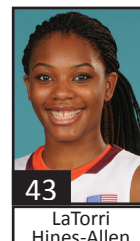

NOTEWORTHY

SOLID SECOND HALF

LATORRI HINES-ALLEN scored 11 of her career-high 17 points in the second half against Florida State on Jan. 8. She led all scorers in the game.

OFF TO A STRONG START

With the win against Boston College, the Hokies improved to 2-0 in the ACC. Tech is off to its best start in the ACC as this marks the first time the Hokies have started conference play with a 2-0 record since joining the league in 2004-05.

ACC TIP-OFF

The Hokies got the ACC season off to a strong start, picking up a 55-33 win over Clemson on Jan. 2. Tech jumped out to an early 32-3 lead in the first half. The Lady Tigers closed the gap to 16 in the second half, but the Hokies responded with a 9-0 run to seal the win. **AERIAL WILSON** tallied a game and career-high 24 points.

CLASSIC WIN

Tech defeated UMBC 57-52 on the second day of the Hilton Garden Inn Hokie Classic. **MONET TELLIER** had 18 points. **LARRYQUA HALL** pulled down a game and career-high 11 rebounds for the Hokies.

Dennis Wolff was named the sixth head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 22, 2011.

Prior to accepting the women's head coaching position, Wolff served one season as the Director of Men's Basketball Operations & Assistant to the Head Coach for the Virginia Tech men's basketball program. He assisted head coach Seth Greenberg in the day-to-day operations of the basketball program and also took on additional duties to better reflect a change in NCAA rules governing the operations position.

Before coming to Virginia Tech, Wolff served as the head men's basketball coach at Boston University from 1994-2009. Under Wolff's guidance, the Terriers won three straight conference titles (2002-2004) and made four consecutive postseason appearances (2002-05) for the first time in school history. He was a three-time America East Coach of the Year and a two-time NABC District 1 Coach of the Year selection.

"I am very excited that Dennis Wolff has accepted our offer to become the head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech," said Tech Director of Athletics Jim Weaver. "Coach Wolff has a great history of successful head coaching experience, and I have had the opportunity to get to know and observe him during this academic year. I believe he fits very nicely into the Virginia Tech athletics family and that he will return our women's program to the winning ways of recent years."

Wolff was 247-197 (.556) in 15 years at BU, and is the school's all-time leader in victories. Including two years at Connecticut College in the early 1980s, Wolff is 277-215 (.563) in 17 years as a head coach.

Wolff arrived at BU following a four-year (1990-94) stint as an assistant coach under head coach Jeff Jones at the University of Virginia. Prior to his tenure at Virginia, Wolff spent four years (1985-89) as an assistant coach at Wake Forest and one year (1989-90) at Southern Methodist University.

Wolff began his coaching career at Trinity College, a Division III school in Hartford, Conn., where he served as an assistant from 1978-80. At the age of 25, he was named the head coach at Connecticut College and guided the Camels to a two-year mark of 30-18, including a successful 16-8 record in 1980-81, his first year as a head coach. In 1982, he began his first of three years as an assistant coach at St. Bonaventure. In the last year, Wolff has been involved in the USO Operation Hardwood in Iraq and the USO Operation Hoop Talk in Afghanistan.

A 1978 graduate of the University of Connecticut, Wolff was a two-year letterman under head coaches Dee Rowe and Dom Perno after transferring from Louisiana State University in 1975. A native of New York City, Wolff was a standout guard for Holy Cross High School. In recognition of his scholastic efforts, Wolff has since been inducted into the Holy Cross Athletic Hall of Fame.

Wolff and his wife JoAnn have three children: Nicole, Matt, and Michael. Nicole, the 2002 McDonald's National Player of the Year, played basketball at the University of Connecticut. Matt played basketball at Boston University and Michael plays ice hockey for Brown.
