### THE SERIES

- This is the 17th meeting between Virginia Tech and North Carolina.

- The last meeting between Tech and UNC was Jan. 30, 2011. The Hokies fell 76-51 to the then-ranked No. 15 Tar Heels in Chapel Hill, N.C. Alyssa Fenyn had 11 points and three steals. The top returning scorer from the game for the Tar Heels is Laura Broomfield who had 14 points.

- Tech's last win over the Tar Heels was Jan. 14, 2010 when the Hokies defeated UNC 79-64 in Blacksburg. The Tar Heels were ranked No. 10 at the time. Former Hokie, Lindsay Biggs led a quartet of Tech players in double-digits with 19 points. Carolina was led by Chay Shegog with 13 points.

### THE HOKIES

- Tech fell to ACC foe #6/7 Duke 61-34 in the team's last outing. Alyssa Fenyn led the Hokies with 11 points while Monet Tellier added nine points and grabbed six rebounds. Aerial Wilson handed out four assists.

- The Hokies are being led this season by a trio of guards. Tellier is averaging 13.1 points per game, Wilson is adding 10.1 points and handing out 3.6 assists per game, while Fenyn is tallying 8.8 points per game. LaTorri Hines-Allen is grabbing a team-best 6.1 rebounds per game.

### THE TAR HEELS

- Carolina fell to UConn 86-35 the last time out. Tierra Ruffin-Pratt tallied nine points and eight rebounds for the Tar Heels. Krista Gross added eight points while Laura Broomfield also pulled down eight rebounds.

- The Tar Heels are being led by Shegog with 16.6 points per game. Ruffin-Pratt and Brittany Roundtree are adding 10.3 and 10.1 points per game, respectively. Roundtree also leads the team in assists with 53 on the season. Broomfield is pulling down a team-best 10.6 rebounds per game.

**UP NEXT:** Virginia Tech will return to the road to face #10/11 Miami on Monday, Jan. 23. Game time is set for 7 p.m. at the BankUnited Center in Coral Gables, Fla.

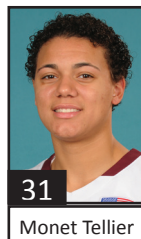

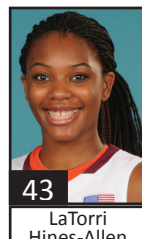

## NOTEWORTHY

**SOLID SECOND HALF**

**LATORRI HINES-ALLEN** scored 11 of her career-high 17 points in the second half against Florida State on Jan. 8. She led all scorers in the game.

**OFF TO A STRONG START**

With the win against Boston College, the Hokies improved to 2-0 in the ACC. Tech is off to its best start in the ACC as this marks the first time the Hokies have started conference play with a 2-0 record since joining the league in 2004-05.

**ACC TIP-OFF**

The Hokies got the ACC season off to a strong start, picking up a 55-33 win over Clemson on Jan. 2. Tech jumped out to an early 32-3 lead in the first half. The Lady Tigers closed the gap to 16 in the second half, but the Hokies responded with a 9-0 run to seal the win. **AERIAL WILSON** tallied a game and career-high 24 points.

**CLASSIC WIN**

**HOKIE CLASSIC**

This year's Hilton Garden Inn Hokie Classic marks the 22nd consecutive year for the tournament, which began in 1990 as the Diamond Club Classic and was known as the Lady Luck Classic from 2000-2006 and the Hokie Hardwood Classic in 2007-08.

**HOME SWEET HOME**

Tech picked up its first home win on Dec. 11 with a 70-58 win over NC Central in Cassell Coliseum.

**CAREER HIGH WEEK**

**LATORRI HINES-ALLEN** set a career-high 12 rebounds on the road against Penn State on Dec. 6. She followed that up with a career-high 18 points on Dec. 11 against NC Central with 14. Hines-Allen also recorded her first career double-double in the game, adding 10 rebounds.

**BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE**

**AERIAL WILSON** led the Hokies against the Hawkeyes, tying a career-high 18 points. In addition, she handed out four assists and grabbed four boards. **MONET TELLIER** added 16 points for Tech in hard fought, 58-47 loss in Iowa City, Iowa. Freshman **LARRYQUA HALL** pulled down a career-high eight rebounds and **LATORRI HINES-ALLEN** also grabbed eight boards for the Hokies.

**BIG TEN/VIRGINIA TECH CHALLENGE??**

The Hokies played three straight games against teams from the Big Ten, starting with Minnesota at the SMC Concord Hilton Tournament. In the stretch, Tech faced Iowa in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge, followed by Penn State in a road game.

**ALL-TOURNAMENT HONORS**

**MONET TELLIER** picked up All-Tournament honors at the SMC Concord Hilton Tournament hosted by St. Mary's in Moraga, Calif. The sophomore guard averaged 20.5 points, pulled down 11 rebounds, dished out six assists and grabbed seven steals in the two game span.

**OFF THE BENCH**

Freshman **LARRYQUA HALL** came into the Minnesota game and played 22 minutes, scoring seven points, grabbing four rebounds and picking up two steals.

**HITTING 30**

Sophomore guard **MONET TELLIER** hit a new career-high with 31 points on Nov. 21 against William & Mary. She hit 13-of-22 from the field, including 2-of-4 from three point range and went 3-of-5 from the line.

**DOUBLE-DOUBLE TIME**

Junior guard **ALYSSA FENYN** posted her first double-double of the season with 11 points and 11 rebounds against George Washington on Nov. 19.

**BACK-TO-BACK CAREER GAMES**

After setting a career scoring high in the opening game of the season, junior **AERIAL WILSON** put up another career-high in the second game, scoring 18 points against Charlotte on Nov. 16.

**STRONG START**

**MONET TELLIER** knocked down 29 points in the Hokies' season opening, 77-65 win over Old Dominion on Nov. 11. Tellier posted 20 of her 29 in the first half. She also set a career-high four blocks in an upset victory over then-No. 10 North Carolina. In the eight games she played during her sophomore season, Hadley averaged 4.3 points, 4.9 rebounds and one block per game.

**A FENYN RETURN**

Head Coach **DENNIS WOLFF** is in his first season as head coach of the Virginia Tech women's basketball team. He was previously the head men's basketball coach at Boston University where he guided the Terriers to a 247-197 record and three straight conference titles.

**POWER PLAYER**

Assistant Coach **CHANTELLE ANDERSON** played six season in the WNBA and overseas while suiting up for the Sacramento Monarchs, San Antonio Silverstars and the Atlanta Dream. Prior to her professional days, she was a four-year standout and three-time All-American at Vanderbilt where she set the all-time scoring record with 2,600 points.

## VIRGINIA TECH HEAD COACH DENNIS WOLFF



## DENNIS WOLFF

Head Coach • First Season  
Connecticut, 1978

Dennis Wolff was named the sixth head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 22, 2011.

Prior to accepting the women's head coaching position, Wolff served one season as the Director of Men's Basketball Operations & Assistant to the Head Coach for the Virginia Tech men's basketball program. He assisted head coach Seth Greenberg in the day-to-day operations of the basketball program and also took on additional duties to better reflect a change in NCAA rules governing the operations position.

Before coming to Virginia Tech, Wolff served as the head men's basketball coach at Boston University from 1994-2009. Under Wolff's guidance, the Terriers won three straight conference titles (2002-2004) and made four consecutive postseason appearances (2002-05) for the first time in school history. He was a three-time America East Coach of the Year and a two-time NABC District 1 Coach of the Year selection.

"I am very excited that Dennis Wolff has accepted our offer to become the head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech," said Tech Director of Athletics Jim Weaver. "Coach Wolff has a great history of successful head coaching experience, and I have had the opportunity to get to know and observe him during this academic year. I believe he fits very nicely into the Virginia Tech athletics family and that he will return our women's program to the winning ways of recent years."

Wolff was 247-197 (.556) in 15 years at BU, and is the school's all-time leader in victories. Including two years at Connecticut College in the early 1980s, Wolff is 277-215 (.563) in 17 years as a head coach.

Wolff arrived at BU following a four-year (1990-94) stint as an assistant coach under head coach Jeff Jones at the University of Virginia. Prior to his tenure at Virginia, Wolff spent four years (1985-89) as an assistant coach at Wake Forest and one year (1989-90) at Southern Methodist University.

Wolff began his coaching career at Trinity College, a Division III school in Hartford, Conn., where he served as an assistant from 1978-80. At the age of 25, he was named the head coach at Connecticut College and guided the Camels to a two-year mark of 30-18, including a successful 16-8 record in 1980-81, his first year as a head coach. In 1982, he began his first of three years as an assistant coach at St. Bonaventure. In the last year, Wolff has been involved in the USO Operation Hardwood in Iraq and the USO Operation Hoop Talk in Afghanistan.

A 1978 graduate of the University of Connecticut, Wolff was a two-year letterman under head coaches Dee Rowe and Dom Perno after transferring from Louisiana State University in 1975. A native of New York City, Wolff was a standout guard for Holy Cross High School. In recognition of his scholastic efforts, Wolff has since been inducted into the Holy Cross Athletic Hall of Fame.

Wolff and his wife JoAnn have three children: Nicole, Matt, and Michael. Nicole, the 2002 McDonald's National Player of the Year, played basketball at the University of Connecticut. Matt played basketball at Boston University and Michael plays ice hockey for Brown.
