## THE SERIES

• This is the 14th meeting between Virginia Tech and Miami.

• The last meeting between Tech and Miami was Jan. 9, 2011. The Hokies fell 69-56 to the Hurricanes Blacksburg. Alyssa Fenyn had 10 points and five assists. The top returning scorer from the game for the Hurricanes is Riqua Williams who had 21 points.

• Tech's last win over the Hurricanes was Jan. 24, 2010 when the Hokies defeated Miami, 73-69 in Coral Gables, Fla. Former Hokie, Nikki Davis led Tech with 29 points. Miami was led by Shenise Johnson with 18 points.

## THE HOKIES

• Tech fell to ACC foe #-/24 North Carolina 37-56 in the team's last outing. Monet Tellier led the Hokies with 16 points while LaTorri Hines-Allen grabbed 10 rebounds.

• The Hokies are being led this season by a trio of guards. Tellier is averaging 13.2 points per game, Wilson is adding 9.9 points and handing out 3.4 assists per game, while Fenyn is tallying 8.3 points per game. LaTorri Hines-Allen is grabbing a team-best 6.3 rebounds per game.

## THE HURRICANES

• Miami defeated Virginia, 56-53 the last time out. Leading the Hurricanes was Shenise Johnson with 20 points and 13 rebounds. Morgan Stroman added nine points for Miami.

• Johnson leads the Hurricanes on the season, averaging 16.4 points, 7.6 rebounds and 5.0 assists per game. Riqua Williams is adding 16.2 points while Morgan Stroman is tossing in 12.9 points and pulling down 6.5 rebounds per game.

**UP NEXT:** Virginia Tech remains on the road to face #7/8 Maryland on Thursday, Jan. 26. Game time is set for 7 p.m. at the Comcast Center in College Park, Md.

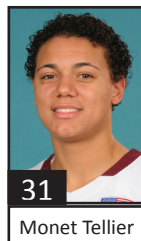

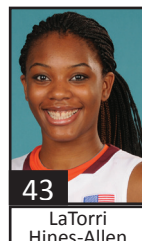

## NOTEWORTHY

**SOLID SECOND HALF**

**LATORRI HINES-ALLEN** scored 11 of her career-high 17 points in the second half against Florida State on Jan. 8. She led all scorers in the game.

**OFF TO A STRONG START**

With the win against Boston College, the Hokies improved to 2-0 in the ACC. Tech is off to its best start in the ACC as this marks the first time the Hokies have started conference play with a 2-0 record since joining the league in 2004-05.

**ACC TIP-OFF**

The Hokies got the ACC season off to a strong start, picking up a 55-33 win over Clemson on Jan. 2. Tech jumped out to an early 32-3 lead in the first half. The Lady Tigers closed the gap to 16 in the second half, but the Hokies responded with a 9-0 run to seal the win. **AERIAL WILSON** tallied a game and career-high 24 points.

**CLASSIC WIN**

Tech defeated UMBC 57-52 on the second day of the Hilton Garden Inn Hokie Classic. **MONET TELLIER** had 18 points. **LARRYQUA HALL** pulled down a game and career-high 11 rebounds for the Hokies.

**HOKIE CLASSIC**

This year's Hilton Garden Inn Hokie Classic marks the 22nd consecutive year for the tournament, which began in 1990 as the Diamond Club Classic and was known as the Lady Luck Classic from 2000-2006 and the Hokie Hardwood Classic in 2007-08.

**HOME SWEET HOME**

## VIRGINIA TECH HEAD COACH DENNIS WOLFF



## DENNIS WOLFF

Head Coach • First Season  
Connecticut, 1978

Dennis Wolff was named the sixth head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 22, 2011.

Prior to accepting the women's head coaching position, Wolff served one season as the Director of Men's Basketball Operations & Assistant to the Head Coach for the Virginia Tech men's basketball program. He assisted head coach Seth Greenberg in the day-to-day operations of the basketball program and also took on additional duties to better reflect a change in NCAA rules governing the operations position.

Before coming to Virginia Tech, Wolff served as the head men's basketball coach at Boston University from 1994-2009. Under Wolff's guidance, the Terriers won three straight conference titles (2002-2004) and made four consecutive postseason appearances (2002-05) for the first time in school history. He was a three-time America East Coach of the Year and a two-time NABC District 1 Coach of the Year selection.

"I am very excited that Dennis Wolff has accepted our offer to become the head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech," said Tech Director of Athletics Jim Weaver. "Coach Wolff has a great history of successful head coaching experience, and I have had the opportunity to get to know and observe him during this academic year. I believe he fits very nicely into the Virginia Tech athletics family and that he will return our women's program to the winning ways of recent years."

Wolff was 247-197 (.556) in 15 years at BU, and is the school's all-time leader in victories. Including two years at Connecticut College in the early 1980s, Wolff is 277-215 (.563) in 17 years as a head coach.

Wolff arrived at BU following a four-year (1990-94) stint as an assistant coach under head coach Jeff Jones at the University of Virginia. Prior to his tenure at Virginia, Wolff spent four years (1985-89) as an assistant coach at Wake Forest and one year (1989-90) at Southern Methodist University.

Wolff began his coaching career at Trinity College, a Division III school in Hartford, Conn., where he served as an assistant from 1978-80. At the age of 25, he was named the head coach at Connecticut College and guided the Camels to a two-year mark of 30-18, including a successful 16-8 record in 1980-81, his first year as a head coach. In 1982, he began his first of three years as an assistant coach at St. Bonaventure. In the last year, Wolff has been involved in the USO Operation Hardwood in Iraq and the USO Operation Hoop Talk in Afghanistan.

A 1978 graduate of the University of Connecticut, Wolff was a two-year letterman under head coaches Dee Rowe and Dom Perno after transferring from Louisiana State University in 1975. A native of New York City, Wolff was a standout guard for Holy Cross High School. In recognition of his scholastic efforts, Wolff has since been inducted into the Holy Cross Athletic Hall of Fame.

Wolff and his wife JoAnn have three children: Nicole, Matt, and Michael. Nicole, the 2002 McDonald's National Player of the Year, played basketball at the University of Connecticut. Matt played basketball at Boston University and Michael plays ice hockey for Brown.
