THE SERIES

- This is the 13th meeting between Virginia Tech and Maryland.
- The last meeting between Tech and Maryland was Feb. 24, 2011. The Hokies fell 61-48 to the then-ranked No. 15 Terrapins in College Park, Md. Former Tech player Brittany Gordon had a double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds. The Hokies top returning scorer from the game, Monet Tellier added nine points. Alyssa Thomas notched 15 points for the Terps.
- Tech's last win over the Terrapins was Feb. 24, 2005 when the Hokies defeated Maryland, 87-79 in College Park, Md.

THE HOKIES

- Tech fell to ACC foe #8/10 Miami 79-48 in the team's last outing. Monet Tellier led the Hokies with 18 points while Aerial Wilson added 15. The Hokies turned in one of their best free throw shooting performances of the season, knocking down 80 percent on 16-of-20. Tech also kept pace with the Hurricanes on the boards with both teams pulling down 36 rebounds, but the Hokies scored 17 second chance points to Miami's 12.
- The Hokies are being led this season by a trio of guards. Tellier is averaging 13.5 points per game, Wilson is adding 10.2 points and handing out 3.4 assists per game, while Fenyn is tallying 8.0 points per game. LaTorri Hines-Allen is grabbing a team-best 6.3 rebounds per game.

THE TERRAPINS

- Maryland fell to No. 5 Duke 80-72 the last time out. Alyssa Thomas had 26 points and 10 rebounds for the Terps. Tianna Hawkins and Lynetta Kizer added 17 and 12 points, respectively.
- Thomas leads the Terrapins on the season, averaging 17.2 points and 7.7 rebounds per game. Laurin Mincy is adding 13.9 points and Hawkins is knocking down 11.5 points while pulling down a team-best 10.0 rebounds per game. Anjale Barrett is dishing out 5.6 assists.

UP NEXT: Virginia Tech returns home to host North Carolina State on Sunday, Jan. 29 in a TV game on RSN. Game time is slated for 1 p.m. at Cassell Coliseum.

NOTEWORTHY

DEFENSIVE STAND

Tech is the top team in the ACC in points allowed per game. Since starting conference action, the Hokies are allowing their ACC counterparts an average of 55.9 points.

TAKING CHARITY

The Hokies had one of their best performances of the season from the free throw line against Miami on Jan. 23. Tech shot 80 percent on 16-of-20.

SOLID SECOND HALF

LATORRI HINES-ALLEN scored 11 of her career-high 17 points the two game span. in the second half against Florida State on Jan. 8. She led all scorers in the game.

OFF TO A STRONG START

With the win against Boston College, the Hokies improved to 2-0 in the ACC. Tech is off to its best start in the ACC as this marks the first time the Hokies have started conference play with a 2-0 record since joining the league in 2004-05.

ACC TIP-OFF

The Hokies got the ACC season off to a strong start, picking went 3-of-5 from the line. up a 55-33 win over Clemson on Jan. 2. Tech jumped out to an early 32-3 lead in the first half. The Lady Tigers closed the gap to 16 in the second half, but the Hokies responded with a 9-0 run to seal the win. AERIAL WILSON tallied a game and career-high 24 points.

CLASSIC WIN

Tech defeated UMBC 57-52 on the second day of the Hilton Garden Inn Hokie Classic. MONET TELLIER had 18 points. LARRYQUA HALL pulled down a game and career-high 11 rebounds for the Hokies.

HOKIE CLASSIC

Head Coach • First Season Connecticut, 1978

Dennis Wolff was named the sixth head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 22, 2011.

Prior to accepting the women's head coaching position, Wolff served one season as the Director of Men's Basketball Operations & Assistant to the Head Coach for the Virginia Tech men's basketball program. He assisted head coach Seth Greenberg in the day-to-day operations of the basketball program and also took on additional duties to better reflect a change in NCAA rules governing the operations position.

Before coming to Virginia Tech, Wolff served as the head men's basketball coach at Boston University from 1994-2009. Under Wolff's guidance, the Terriers won three straight conference titles (2002-2004) and made four consecutive postseason appearances (2002-05) for the first time in school history. He was a three-time America East Coach of the Year and a two-time NABC District 1 Coach of the Year selection.

"I am very excited that Dennis Wolff has accepted our offer to become the head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech," said Tech Director of Athletics Jim Weaver. "Coach Wolff has a great history of successful head coaching experience, and I have had the opportunity to get to know and observe him during this academic

year. I believe he fits very nicely into the Virginia Tech athletics family and that he will return our women's program to the winning ways of recent years."

Wolff was 247-197 (.556) in 15 years at BU, and is the school's all-time leader in victories. Including two years at Connecticut College in the early 1980s, Wolff is 277-215 (.563) in 17 years as a head coach.

Wolff arrived at BU following a four-year (1990-94) stint as an assistant coach under head coach Jeff Jones at the University of Virginia. Prior to his tenure at Virginia, Wolff spent four years (1985-89) as an assistant coach at Wake Forest and one year (1989-90) at Southern Methodist University.

Wolff began his coaching career at Trinity College, a Division III school in Hartford, Conn., where he served as an assistant from 1978-80. At the age of 25, he was named the head coach at Connecticut College and guided the Camels to a two-year mark of 30-18, including a successful 16-8 record in 1980-81, his first year as a head coach. In 1982, he began his first of three years as an assistant coach at St. Bonaventure. In the last year, Wolff has been involved in the USO Operation Hardwood in Iraq and the USO Operation Hoop Talk in Afghanistan.

A 1978 graduate of the University of Connecticut, Wolff was a two-year letterman under head coaches Dee Rowe and Dom Perno after transferring from Louisiana State University in 1975. A native of New York City, Wolff was a standout guard for Holy Cross High School. In recognition of his scholastic efforts, Wolff has since been inducted into the Holy Cross Athletic Hall of Fame.

Wolff and his wife JoAnn have three children: Nicole, Matt, and Michael. Nicole, the 2002 McDonald's National Player of the Year, played basketball at the University of Connecticut. Matt played basketball at Boston University and Michael plays ice hockey for Brown.
